Fire Rituals - Godly Or Not - Leviticus 18

- **Explained of modern fire rituals.**
- Daniel 3 Referred to Jesus protecting Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego in the fiery furnace.
- Referred to many Biblical examples of Godly fire.
- Leviticus 18:21 And thou shalt not let any of thy seed <u>pass through the fire</u> to Molech, neither shalt thou profane the Name of thy God: I *am* the LORD.
- Deuteronomy 18:9,10 When thou art come into the land which the LORD thy God giveth thee, thou shalt not learn to do after the abominations of those nations. 10 There shall not be found among you *any one* that maketh his son or his daughter to <u>pass through the fire</u>, or that useth divination, or an observer of times, or an enchanter, or a witch,
- John 10:10 The thief cometh not, but for to steal, and to kill, and to destroy: I am come that they might have life, and that they might have it more abundantly.
- 1 Kings 11:7,8 Then did Solomon build an high place for Chemosh, the abomination of Moab, in the hill that *is* before Jerusalem, and for Molech, the abomination of the children of Ammon. 8 And likewise did he for all his strange wives, which burnt incense and sacrificed unto their gods.
- 2 Kings 16:3 But he walked in the way of the kings of Israel, yea, and made his son to pass through the fire, according to the abominations of the heathen, whom the LORD cast out from before the children of Israel.
- 2 Kings 17:17 And they caused their sons and their daughters to <u>pass</u> through the fire, and used divination and enchantments, and sold themselves to do evil in the sight of the LORD, to provoke Him to anger.
- 2 Kings 21:6 And he made his son <u>pass through the fire</u>, and observed times, and used enchantments, and dealt with familiar spirits and wizards: he wrought much wickedness in the sight of the LORD, to provoke *Him* to anger.
- 2 Kings 23:10 And he defiled Topheth, which *is* in the valley of the children of Hinnom, that no man might make his son or his daughter to <u>pass</u> through the fire to Molech.
- Exodus 12:12 For I will pass through the land of Egypt this night, and will smite all the firstborn in the land of Egypt, both man and beast; and against all the gods of Egypt I will execute judgment: I am the LORD.

- 2 Chronicles 33:6 And he caused his children to <u>pass through the fire</u> in the valley of the son of Hinnom: also he observed times, and used enchantments, and used witchcraft, and dealt with a familiar spirit, and with wizards: he wrought much evil in the sight of the LORD, to provoke Him to anger.
- 2 Chronicles 33:9 14 Summarized of Manasseh's sins & his repentance.
- Jeremiah 32:35 And they built the high places of Baal, which *are* in the valley of the son of Hinnom, to cause their sons and their daughters to pass through *the fire* unto Molech; which I commanded them not, neither came it into My Mind, that they should do this abomination, to cause Judah to sin.
- Ezekiel 16:21 That thou hast slain My children, and delivered them to cause them to pass through *the fire* for them?
- Ezekiel 20:26 And I polluted them in their own gifts, in that they caused to pass through *the fire* all that openeth the womb, that I might make them desolate, to the end that they might know that I *am* the LORD.
- Ezekiel 20:31 For when ye offer your gifts, when ye make your sons to <u>pass</u> through the fire, ye pollute yourselves with all your idols, even unto this day: and shall I be enquired of by you, O house of Israel? *As* I live, saith the Lord GOD, I will not be enquired of by you.
- 2 Chronicles 7:14 If my people, which are called by My Name, shall humble themselves, and pray, and seek My face, and turn from their wicked ways; then will I hear from heaven, and will forgive their sin, and will heal their land.
- Ezekiel 23:37 That they have committed adultery, and blood *is* in their hands, and with their idols have they committed adultery, and have also caused their sons, whom they bare unto Me, to <u>pass for them through the fire</u>, to devour *them*.
- Leviticus 18:21 And thou shalt not let any of thy <u>seed pass through the fire</u> to Molech, neither shalt thou profane the Name of thy God: I *am* the LORD.
- Leviticus 20:2,3 Again, thou shalt say to the children of Israel, Whosoever he be of the children of Israel, or of the strangers that sojourn in Israel, that giveth any of his seed unto Molech; he shall surely be put to death: the people of the land shall stone him with stones. 3 And I will set My face against that man, and will cut him off from among his people; because he hath given of his seed unto Molech, to defile My sanctuary, and to profane My Holy Name.
- 2 Corinthians 6:15 And what concord hath Christ with Belial? or what part hath he that believeth with an infidel?

- Leviticus 20:4,5 And if the people of the land do any ways hide their eyes from the man, when he giveth of his seed unto Molech, and kill him not: 5 Then I will set My face against that man, and against his family, and will cut him off, and all that go a whoring after him, to commit whoredom with Molech, from among their people.
- Acts 7:42-50 Then God turned, and gave them up to worship the host of heaven; as it is written in the book of the prophets, O ye house of Israel, have ye offered to Me slain beasts and sacrifices by the space of forty years in the wilderness? 43 Yea, ye took up the tabernacle of Moloch, and the star of your god Remphan, figures which ye made to worship them: and I will carry you away beyond Babylon. 44 Our fathers had the tabernacle of witness in the wilderness, as He had appointed, speaking unto Moses, that he should make it according to the fashion that he had seen. 45 Which also our fathers that came after brought in with Jesus (Joshua) into the possession of the Gentiles, whom God drave out before the face of our fathers, unto the days of David; 46 Who found favour before God, and desired to find a tabernacle for the God of Jacob. 47 But Solomon built Him an house. 48 Howbeit the most High dwelleth not in temples made with hands; as saith the prophet, 49 Heaven is My throne, and earth is My footstool: what house will ve build Me? saith the Lord: or what *is* the place of My rest? 50 Hath not My hand made all these things?
- Exodus 32 Summarized of God on the Mount & Israel making the golden calf.
- Ezekiel 14:3 Son of man, these men have set up their idols in their heart, and put the stumblingblock of their iniquity before their face: should I be enquired of at all by them?
- Leviticus 21:9 And the <u>daughter</u> of any priest, if she profane herself by playing the whore, she profaneth her father: she shall be <u>burnt with fire</u>.
- Numbers 16:37 Speak unto Eleazar the <u>son</u> of Aaron the priest, that he take up the censers out of the <u>burning</u>, and scatter thou the <u>fire</u> yonder; for they are hallowed.
- Summarized of the 70 rebellious Levites.
- Numbers 26:61 And Nadab and Abihu died, when they offered strange fire before the LORD.
- Deuteronomy 12:31 Thou shalt not do so unto the LORD thy God: for every abomination to the LORD, which He hateth, have they done unto their gods; for even their <u>sons</u> and their <u>daughters</u> they have <u>burnt in the fire</u> to their gods.
- Judges 12:1 And the men of Ephraim gathered themselves together, and

- went northward, and said unto Jephthah, Wherefore passedst thou over to fight against the <u>children</u> of Ammon, and didst not call us to go with thee? we will <u>burn thine house upon thee with fire</u>.
- Judges 15:6 Then the Philistines said, Who hath done this? And they answered, Samson, the <u>son</u> in law of the Timnite, because he had taken his wife, and given her to his companion. And the Philistines came up, and burnt her and her father with fire.
- 2 Kings 17:31 And the Avites made Nibhaz and Tartak, and the Sepharvites burnt their children in fire to Adrammelech and Anammelech, the gods of Sepharvaim.
- 2 Chronicles 28:3 Moreover he <u>burnt</u> incense in the valley of the <u>son</u> of Hinnom, and <u>burnt his children in the fire</u>, after the abominations of the heathen whom the LORD had cast out before the <u>children</u> of Israel.
- Jeremiah 7:31 And they have built the high places of Tophet, which *is* in the valley of the <u>son</u> of Hinnom, to <u>burn their sons and their daughters in the fire</u>; which I commanded *them* not, neither came it into My Heart.
- Jeremiah 7:16 Therefore pray not thou for this people, neither lift up cry nor prayer for them, neither make intercession to Me: for I will not hear thee.
- Jeremiah 49:2 Therefore, behold, the days come, saith the LORD, that I will cause an alarm of war to be heard in Rabbah of the Ammonites; and it shall be a desolate heap, and her <u>daughters shall be burned with fire</u>: then shall Israel be heir unto them that were his heirs, saith the LORD.
- Ezekiel 23:47 And the company shall stone them with stones, and dispatch them with their swords; they shall slay their sons and their daughters, and burn up their houses with fire.
- Strongs #04432 Molek *mo'- lek* AV- Molech 8; Molech= "king" 1) the god of the Ammonites and Phoenicians to whom some Israelites sacrificed their infants in the valley of Hinnom.
- Jeremiah 19:5 They have built also the high places of Baal, to <u>burn their</u> sons with fire *for* burnt offerings unto Baal, which I commanded not, nor spake *it*, neither came *it* into My Mind:
- Jeremiah 32:35 And they built the high places of Baal, which *are* in the valley of the son of Hinnom, to cause their <u>sons and their daughters to pass through the fire unto Molech</u>; which I commanded them not, neither came it into My Mind, that they should do this abomination, to cause Judah to sin.
- Strongs #01168 Ba'al *bah'- al* AV- Baal 62, Baalim 18; 80 Baal= "lord" 1) supreme male divinity of the Phoenicians or Canaanites 2) a Reubenite 3) the son of Jehiel and grandfather of Saul 4) a town of Simeon, probably identical to Baalath-beer.

- Galatians 3:1 O foolish Galatians, who hath bewitched you, that ye should not obey the truth, before whose eyes Jesus Christ hath been evidently set forth, crucified among you?
- Acts 8:9 But there was a certain man, called Simon, which beforetime in the same city used sorcery, and bewitched the people of Samaria, giving out that himself was some great one:
- Acts 8:21,22 Thou hast neither part nor lot in this matter: for thy heart is not right in the sight of God. 22 Repent therefore of this thy wickedness, and pray God, if perhaps the thought of thine heart may be forgiven thee.

Referred to the lake of fire for the ungodly.

- Luke 16:20 Referred to the Parable of Lazarus & the Rich man.
- Luke 16:23 And in hell he lift up his eyes, being in torments, and seeth Abraham afar off, and Lazarus in his bosom. 24 And he cried and said, Father Abraham, have mercy on me, and send Lazarus, that he may dip the tip of his finger in water, and cool my tongue; for I am tormented in this flame.
- Ephesians 1:13 In Whom ye also trusted, after that ye heard the Word of truth, the gospel of your salvation: in Whom also after that ye believed, ye were sealed with that Holy Spirit of promise,
- Matthew 3:11,12 I indeed baptize you with water unto repentance: but He that cometh after me is mightier than I, Whose shoes I am not worthy to bear: He shall baptize you with the Holy Ghost, and with fire: 12 Whose fan is in His hand, and He will throughly purge His floor, and gather His wheat into the garner; but He will burn up the chaff with unquenchable fire.
- Matthew 25:32 When the Son of man shall come in His glory, and all the Holy angels with Him, then shall He sit upon the throne of His glory: 32 And before Him shall be gathered all nations: and He shall separate them one from another, as a shepherd divideth his sheep from the goats:
- Mark 9:49 For every one shall be salted with <u>fire</u>, and every sacrifice shall be salted with salt.
- Romans 12:1 I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that ye present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable unto God, which is your reasonable service.
- Luke 3:16,17 John answered, saying unto *them* all, I indeed baptize you with water; but One mightier than I cometh, the latchet of Whose shoes I am not worthy to unloose: He shall baptize you with the Holy Ghost and with fire: 17 Whose fan *is* in His hand, and He will throughly purge His floor, and will gather the wheat into His garner; but the chaff He will burn with fire unquenchable.

- Luke 12:49 I am come to send <u>fire</u> on the earth; and what will I, if it be already kindled?
- Mark 1:22 And they were astonished at his doctrine: for he taught them as one that had authority, and not as the scribes.
- Acts 13:50 But the Jews stirred up the devout and honourable women, and the chief men of the city, and raised persecution against Paul and Barnabas, and expelled them out of their coasts.
- Acts 14:19,20 And there came thither certain Jews from Antioch and Iconium, who persuaded the people, and, having stoned Paul, drew him out of the city, supposing he had been dead. 20 Howbeit, as the disciples stood round about him, he rose up, and came into the city: and the next day he departed with Barnabas to Derbe.
- Isaiah 52:11 Depart ye, depart ye, go ye out from thence, touch no unclean thing; go ye out of the midst of her; be ye clean, that bear the vessels of the LORD.
- Exodus 19:14 And Moses went down from the mount unto the people, and sanctified the people; and they washed their clothes. 15 And he said unto the people, Be ready against the third day: come not at your wives.
- Matthew 11:28 Come unto me, all ye that labour and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest.
- 1 Peter 5:8 Be sober, be vigilant; because your adversary the devil, as a roaring lion, walketh about, seeking whom he may devour:
- Acts 2:3 And there appeared unto them cloven tongues like as of <u>fire</u>, and it sat upon each of them.
- Acts 8:19 Saying, Give me also this power, that on whomsoever I lay hands, he may receive the Holy Ghost.
- Galatians 5:22,23 But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, longsuffering, gentleness, goodness, faith, 23 Meekness, temperance: against such there is no law.
- 1 Thessalonians 5:19 Quench not the Spirit.
- Ephesians 4:30 And grieve not the Holy Spirit of God, whereby ye are sealed unto the day of redemption.
