Belial Soweth Discord Among Brethren - Proverbs 6L

- Proverbs 6:12 A naughty (Belial) person, a wicked man, walketh with a froward mouth.
- Proverbs 6:16-19 These six *things* doth the LORD hate: yea, seven *are* an abomination unto him: 17 A proud look, a lying tongue, and hands that shed innocent blood, 18 An heart that deviseth wicked imaginations, feet that be swift in running to mischief, 19 A false witness *that* speaketh lies, and he that soweth discord among brethren.
- 1 John 1:9 If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.
- Nehemiah 9:2 And the seed of Israel separated themselves from all strangers, and stood and confessed their sins, and the iniquities of their fathers.
- 2 Chronicles 7:14 If My people, which are called by My name, shall humble themselves, and pray, and seek My face, and turn from their wicked ways; then will I hear from heaven, and will forgive their sin, and will heal their land.
- Proverbs 6:19 (AV) A false witness *that* speaketh lies, and he that soweth discord among brethren.
- Proverbs 6:19 (NKJV) A false witness *who* speaks lies, And one who sows discord among brethren.
- Proverbs 6:19 (ESV) a false witness who breathes out lies, and one who sows discord among brothers.
- Proverbs 6:19 (Message) a mouth that lies under oath, a troublemaker in the family.
- John 6:70 Jesus answered them, Have not I chosen you twelve, and one of you is a devil?
- John 10:10 The thief cometh not, but for to steal, and to kill, and to destroy: I am come that they might have life, and that they might have it more abundantly.
- Luke 10:19 Behold, I give unto you power to tread on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy: and nothing shall by any means hurt you.
- Romans 16:20 And the God of peace shall bruise Satan under your feet shortly. The grace of our Lord Jesus Christ be with you. Amen.
- Matthew 18:18 Verily I say unto you, Whatsoever ye shall bind on earth shall be bound in heaven: and whatsoever ye shall loose on earth shall be

- loosed in heaven.
- 1 Samuel 17:50,51 So David prevailed over the Philistine with a sling and with a stone, and smote the Philistine, and slew him; but there was no sword in the hand of David. 51 Therefore David ran, and stood upon the Philistine, and took his sword, and drew it out of the sheath thereof, and slew him, and cut off his head therewith. And when the Philistines saw their champion was dead, they fled.
- Ephesians 6:12 For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high places.

- 1 Corinthians 1:12,13 Now this I say, that every one of you saith, I am of Paul; and I of Apollos; and I of Cephas; and I of Christ. 13 Is Christ divided? was Paul crucified for you? or were ye baptized in the name of Paul?
- Galatians 3:28 There is neither Jew nor Greek, there is neither bond nor free, there is neither male nor female: for ye are all one in Christ Jesus.
- Strongs #04090 *med-awn*' or (plural) AV-discord 1, strife 1, variant 1; 3 1) strife, contention
- Judges 6:12 And the angel of the LORD appeared unto him (Gideon), and said unto him, The LORD is with thee, thou mighty man of valour.
- Proverbs 6:14 Frowardness *is* in his heart, he deviseth mischief continually; he soweth discord <04090>.
- Acts 8:21 Thou (Simon Magus) hast neither part nor lot in this matter: for thy heart is not right in the sight of God.
- Proverbs 6:19 A false witness *that* speaketh lies, and he that soweth discord <04090> among brethren.
- Proverbs 10:12 Hatred stirreth up strifes <04090>: but love covereth all sins. Matthew 6:12 And forgive us our debts, as we forgive our debtors.
- 2 Samuel 12:10 Now therefore the sword shall never depart from thine house; because thou hast despised Me, and hast taken the wife of Uriah the Hittite to be thy wife.

Psalms 51 Referred to David repenting.

Summarized of David numbering Israel & God's judgment.

- 1 Timothy 2:1,2 I exhort therefore, that, first of all, supplications, prayers, intercessions, and giving of thanks, be made for all men; 2 For kings, and for all that are in authority; that we may lead a quiet and peaceable life in all godliness and honesty.
- Mark 3:27 No man can enter into a strong man's house, and spoil his goods, except he will first bind the strong man; and then he will spoil his house.
- 2 Samuel 13:1 And it came to pass after this, that Absalom the son of David had a fair sister, whose name was <u>Tamar</u>; and Amnon the son of David loved her.

Leviticus 18 & 20 Referred to God's laws on immorality.

- 2 Samuel 13:2 And Amnon was so vexed, that he fell sick for his sister <u>Tamar</u>; for she was a virgin; and Amnon thought it hard for him to do any thing to her.
- 2 Samuel 13:4-8 And he said unto him, Why art thou, being the king's son, lean from day to day? wilt thou not tell me? And Amnon said unto him, I love Tamar, my brother Absalom's sister. 5 And Jonadab said unto him, Lay thee down on thy bed, and make thyself sick: and when thy father cometh to see thee, say unto him, I pray thee, let my sister Tamar come, and give me meat, and dress the meat in my sight, that I may see it, and eat it at her hand. 6 So Amnon lay down, and made himself sick: and when the king was come to see him, Amnon said unto the king, I pray thee, let Tamar my sister come, and make me a couple of cakes in my sight, that I may eat at her hand. 7 Then David sent home to Tamar, saying, Go now to thy brother Amnon's house, and dress him meat. 8 So Tamar went to her brother Amnon's house; and he was laid down. And she took flour, and kneaded it, and made cakes in his sight, and did bake the cakes.
- 2 Samuel 13:10 And Amnon said unto <u>Tamar</u>, Bring the meat into the chamber (bedroom), that I may eat of thine hand. And <u>Tamar</u> took the cakes which she had made, and brought *them* into the chamber to Amnon her brother.
- 1 Thessalonians 5:22 Abstain from all appearance of evil.

Referred to Abigail & Sapphira's responses to evil plans.

- Matthew 10:37 He that loveth father or mother more than Me is not worthy of Me: and he that loveth son or daughter more than Me is not worthy of Me.
- 2 Samuel 13:16 And she said unto him, There is no cause: this evil in sending me away is greater than the other that thou didst unto me. But

he would not hearken unto her.

- 2 Samuel 13:19,20 And <u>Tamar</u> put ashes on her head, and rent her garment of divers colours that *was* on her, and laid her hand on her head, and went on crying. 20 And Absalom her brother said unto her, Hath Amnon thy brother been with thee? but hold now thy peace, my sister: he *is* thy brother; regard not this thing. So <u>Tamar</u> remained desolate in her brother Absalom's house.
- 2 Samuel 13:22 And Absalom spake unto his brother Amnon neither good nor bad: for Absalom hated Amnon, because he had forced his sister <u>Tamar</u>.
- 2 Samuel 13:27,28 But Absalom pressed him, that he let Amnon and all the king's sons go with him. 28 Now Absalom had commanded his servants, saying, Mark ye now when Amnon's heart is merry with wine, and when I say unto you, Smite Amnon; then kill him, fear not: have not I commanded you? be courageous, and be valiant.
- 2 Samuel 13:32 And Jonadab, the son of Shimeah David's brother, answered and said, Let not my lord suppose *that* they have slain all the young men the king's sons; for Amnon only is dead: for by the appointment of Absalom this hath been determined from the day that he forced his sister <u>Tamar</u>.
- Luke 22:24,26 And there was also a <u>strife</u> among them, which of them should be accounted the greatest. 26 But ye shall not be so: but he that is greatest among you, let him be as the younger; and he that is chief, as he that doth serve.
- Romans 13:13 Let us walk honestly, as in the day; not in rioting and drunkenness, not in chambering and wantonness, not in <u>strife</u> and envying.
- 1 Corinthians 3:3 For ye are yet carnal: for whereas *there is* among you envying, and strife, and divisions, are ye not carnal, and walk as men?
- 2 Corinthians 12:20 For I fear, lest, when I come, I shall not find you such as I would, and that I shall be found unto you such as ye would not: lest there be debates, envyings, wraths, strifes, backbitings, whisperings, swellings, tumults:
- Galatians 5:19-23 Now the works of the flesh are manifest, which are these; Adultery, fornication, uncleanness, lasciviousness, 20 Idolatry, witchcraft, hatred, variance, emulations, wrath, strife, seditions, heresies, 21 Envyings, murders, drunkenness, revellings, and such like: of the which I tell you before, as I have also told you in time past, that they which do such things shall not inherit the kingdom of God. 22 But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, longsuffering, gentleness, goodness, faith, 23 Meekness, temperance: against such there is no law.

- Philippians 1:15 Some indeed preach Christ even of envy and <u>strife</u>; and some also of good will:
- Matthew 7:15 Beware of false prophets, which come to you in sheep's clothing, but inwardly they are ravening wolves.
- 2 Corinthians 11:4 For if he that cometh preacheth another Jesus, whom we have not preached, or if ye receive another spirit, which ye have not received, or another gospel, which ye have not accepted, ye might well bear with him.
- Philippians 2:3 *Let* nothing *be done* through <u>strife</u> or vainglory; but in lowliness of mind let each esteem other better than themselves.
- Romans 12:3 For I say, through the grace given unto me, to every man that is among you, not to think of himself more highly than he ought to think; but to think soberly, according as God hath dealt to every man the measure of faith.
- 1 Timothy 6:4 He is proud, knowing nothing, but doting about questions and <u>strifes</u> of words, whereof cometh envy, <u>strife</u>, railings, evil surmisings,
- 2 Timothy 2:23 But foolish and unlearned questions avoid, knowing that they do gender <u>strifes</u>.
- Titus 3:10 A man that is an heretick after the first and second admonition reject;
- Hebrews 6:16 For men verily swear by the greater: and an oath for confirmation *is* to them an end of all <u>strife</u>.
- James 3:14 But if ye have bitter envying and strife in your hearts, glory not, and lie not against the truth.
- James 3:16 For where envying and <u>strife</u> *is*, there *is* confusion and every evil work.
- Exodus 20:17 Thou shalt not covet thy neighbour's house, thou shalt not covet thy neighbour's wife, nor his manservant, nor his maidservant, nor his ox, nor his ass, nor any thing that is thy neighbour's.
- Mark 7:21-23 For from within, out of the heart of men, proceed evil thoughts, adulteries, fornications, murders, 22 Thefts, covetousness, wickedness, deceit, lasciviousness, an evil eye, blasphemy, pride, foolishness: 23 All these evil things come from within, and defile the man.
- Ephesians 4:3 Endeavouring to keep the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace.
