- Proverbs 7:1-27 My son, keep my words, and lay up my commandments with thee.
- Genesis 3:11 And he said, Who told thee that thou wast naked? Hast thou eaten of the tree, whereof I commanded thee that thou shouldest not eat?
- Ephesians 6:4 And, ye fathers, provoke not your children to wrath: but bring them up in the nurture and admonition of the Lord.
- Proverbs 7:2 Keep my commandments, and live; and my law as the apple of thine eye.
- Genesis 2:16,17 And the LORD God commanded the man, saying, Of every tree of the garden thou mayest freely eat: 17 But of the tree of the knowledge of good and evil, thou shalt not eat of it: for in the day that thou eatest thereof thou shalt surely die.
- Luke 10:19 Behold, I give unto you power to tread on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy: and nothing shall by any means hurt you.
- Mark 7:13 Making the word of God of none effect through your tradition, which ye have delivered: and many such like things do ye.

- Genesis 39:2 (NKJV) The LORD was with Joseph, and he was a successful man; and he was in the house of his master the Egyptian.
- Genesis 39:3 (AV) And his master saw that the LORD was with him, and that the LORD made all that he did to prosper in his hand.
- Genesis 39:3 (NKJV) And his master saw that the LORD was with him and that the LORD made all he did to prosper in his hand.
- Genesis 39:4 (AV) And Joseph found grace in his sight, and he served him: and he made him overseer over his house, and all *that* he had he put into his hand.
- Genesis 39:4 (NKJV) So Joseph found favor in his sight, and served him. Then he made him overseer of his house, and all *that* he had he put under his authority.
- Genesis 39:5 (AV) And it came to pass from the time *that* he had made him overseer in his house, and over all that he had, that the LORD blessed the Egyptian's house for Joseph's sake; and the blessing of the LORD was upon all that he had in the house, and in the field.

- Genesis 39:6 (AV) And he left all that he had in Joseph's hand; and he knew not ought he had, save the bread which he did eat. And Joseph was *a* goodly *person*, and well favoured.
- Genesis 39:6 (NKJV) Thus he left all that he had in Joseph's hand, and he did not know what he had except for the bread which he ate. Now Joseph was handsome in form and appearance.
- Genesis 39:7 (AV) And it came to pass after these things, that his master's wife cast her eyes upon Joseph; and she said, Lie with me.
- Genesis 39:7 (NKJV) And it came to pass after these things that his master's wife cast longing eyes on Joseph, and she said, Lie with me.
- Genesis 39:8 (AV) But he refused, and said unto his master's wife, Behold, my master wotteth not what *is* with me in the house, and he hath committed all that he hath to my hand;
- Genesis 39:8 (NKJV) But he refused and said to his master's wife, Look, my master does not know what *is* with me in the house, and he has committed all that he has to my hand.
- Genesis 39:9 (AV) *There is* none greater in this house than I; neither hath he kept back any thing from me but thee, because thou *art* his wife: how then can I do this great wickedness, and sin against God?
- Genesis 39:9 (NKJV) *There is* no one greater in this house than I, nor has he kept back anything from me but you, because you *are* his wife. How then can I do this great wickedness, and sin against God?
- Psalms 51:4 Against thee, thee only, have I sinned, and done this evil in thy sight: that thou mightest be justified when thou speakest, and be clear when thou judgest.
- **Exodus 32 Summarized of Israelites' sins.**
- Numbers 25 Summarized of Israelites' sins advised by Balaam.
- Genesis 39:10 (AV) And it came to pass, as she spake to Joseph day by day, that he hearkened not unto her, to lie by her, *or* to be with her.

- Mark 14:52 And he (John Mark) left the linen cloth, and fled from them naked.

- Genesis 39:13 (NKJV) And so it was, when she saw that he had left his garment in her hand and fled outside,
- Genesis 39:14 (AV) That she called unto the men of her house, and spake unto them, saying, See, he hath brought in an Hebrew unto us to mock us; he came in unto me to lie with me, and I cried with a loud voice:
- Genesis 39:14 (NKJV) that she called to the men of her house and spoke to them, saying, See, he has brought in to us a Hebrew to mock us. He came in to me to lie with me, and I cried out with a loud voice.
- 2 Samuel 13:15 Then Amnon hated her exceedingly; so that the hatred wherewith he hated her was greater than the love wherewith he had loved her. And Amnon said unto her, Arise, be gone.
- Genesis 39:15 (AV) And it came to pass, when he heard that I lifted up my voice and cried, that he left his garment with me, and fled, and got him out.
- 2 Samuel 12:14 Howbeit, because by this deed thou hast given great occasion to the enemies of the LORD to blaspheme, the child also that is born unto thee shall surely die.

- Genesis 39:20 (AV) And Joseph's master took him, and put him into the prison, a place where the king's prisoners *were* bound: and he was there in the prison.
- Genesis 39:20 (NKJV) Then Joseph's master took him and put him into the prison, a place where the king's prisoners *were* confined. And he was there in the prison.
- Genesis 39:21 (AV) But the LORD was with Joseph, and shewed him mercy, and gave him favour in the sight of the keeper of the prison.
- Genesis 39:21 (NKJV) But the LORD was with Joseph and showed him mercy, and He gave him favor in the sight of the keeper of the prison.
- Genesis 39:22 (AV) And the keeper of the prison committed to Joseph's hand all the prisoners that *were* in the prison; and whatsoever they did there, he was the doer *of it*.
- Genesis 39:22 (NKJV) And the keeper of the prison committed to Joseph's hand all the prisoners who *were* in the prison; whatever they did there, it was his doing.
- Genesis 39:23 (AV) The keeper of the prison looked not to any thing *that was* under his hand; because the LORD was with him, and *that* which he did, the LORD made *it* to prosper.
- Genesis 39:23 (NKJV) The keeper of the prison did not look into anything that was under Joseph's authority, because the LORD was with him; and whatever he did, the LORD made it prosper.
- **Exodus 20:14 Thou shalt not commit adultery.**
- Isaiah 52:11 Depart ye, depart ye, go ye out from thence, touch no unclean thing; go ye out of the midst of her; be ye clean, that bear the vessels of the LORD.
- Proverbs 7:6,7 For at the window of my house I looked through my casement, 7 And beheld among the simple ones, I discerned among the youths, a young man void of understanding,
- Proverbs 7:4 Say unto wisdom, Thou art my sister; and call understanding thy kinswoman:
- Proverbs 7:8-10 Passing through the street near her corner; and he went the way to her house, 9 In the twilight, in the evening, in the black and dark night: 10 And, behold, there met him a woman *with* the attire of an harlot, and subtil of heart.
- Proverbs 7:10 (NKJV) And there a woman met him, With the attire of a harlot, and a crafty heart.
- **Proverbs 31 Referred to the Virtuous woman in contrast.**
- Proverbs 7:11-21 (She *is* loud and stubborn; her feet abide not in her house: 12 Now *is she* without, now in the streets, and lieth in wait at every corner.) 13 So she caught him, and kissed him, *and* with an impudent face

said unto him, 14 *I have* peace offerings with me; this day have I payed my vows. 15 Therefore came I forth to meet thee, diligently to seek thy face, and I have found thee. 16 I have decked my bed with coverings of tapestry, with carved *works*, with fine linen of Egypt. 17 I have perfumed my bed with myrrh, aloes, and cinnamon. 18 Come, let us take our fill of love until the morning: let us solace ourselves with loves. 19 For the goodman (husband) *is* not at home, he is gone a long journey: 20 He hath taken a bag of money with him, *and* will come home at the day appointed. 21 With her much fair speech she caused him to yield, with the flattering of her lips she forced him.
