Jesus Christ - The Wisdom Of God - Proverbs 8

Isaiah 6 Referred to Isaiah's vision of God.

Ezekiel, Daniel, Jeremiah, Abraham, & David, etc all had visions of God.

- Isaiah 11:1-5 And there shall come forth a Rod out of the stem of Jesse, and a Branch shall grow out of his roots: 2 And the Spirit of the LORD shall rest upon him, the Spirit of wisdom and understanding, the Spirit of counsel and might, the Spirit of knowledge and of the fear of the LORD; 3 And shall make Him of quick understanding in the fear of the LORD: and He shall not judge after the sight of His eyes, neither reprove after the hearing of His ears: 4 But with righteousness shall He judge the poor, and reprove with equity for the meek of the earth: and He shall smite the earth with the rod of His mouth, and with the breath of His lips shall He slay the wicked. 5 And righteousness shall be the girdle of His loins, and faithfulness the girdle of His reins.
- Isaiah 1:26 And I will restore thy judges as at the first, and thy counsellors as at the beginning: afterward thou shalt be called, The city of righteousness, the faithful city.
- John 10:20 many of them said, He hath a devil, and is mad; why hear ye Him? Mark 1:22 And they were astonished at His doctrine: for He taught them as one that had authority, and not as the scribes.
- Luke 2:52 Jesus increased in wisdom & in stature & in favor with God & man.
- Luke 2 Referred to when Jesus was 12 years old in temple V46,47 And it came to pass, that after 3 days they found Him in the temple, sitting in the midst of the doctors, both hearing them, and asking them questions. 47 And all that heard Him were astonished at His understanding and answers.
- Romans 16:27 to the <u>only wise God</u> be glory forevermore through <u>Jesus</u> Christ! Amen.
- Proverbs 4:5 Get wisdom, get understanding: forget it not; neither decline from the words of my mouth.
- 1 Corinthians 1:24 but to those who are called, both Jews and Greeks, <u>Christ</u> the power of God and the wisdom of God.
- Ephesians 6:12 For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high places.
- 1 Corinthians 1:30 He is the source of your life in <u>Christ Jesus</u>, Whom God made our <u>wisdom</u> & our righteousness and sanctification & redemption.
- 1 Corinthians 4:10 We are fools for <u>Christ</u>'s sake, but you are <u>wise</u> in <u>Christ</u>. We are weak, but you are strong. You are held in honour, but we in disrepute.
- Ephesians 1:17 that the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of glory,

- may give you a Spirit of wisdom and of revelation in the knowledge of Him,
- Acts 17:30 And the times of this ignorance God winked at; but now commandeth all men every where to repent:
- John 16:8 And when He is come, He will reprove the world of sin, and of righteousness, and of judgment:
- Mark 9:24 And straightway the father of the child cried out, and said with tears, Lord, I believe; help thou mine unbelief.
- Colossians 1:28 Him we proclaim, warning everyone and teaching everyone with all <u>wisdom</u>, that we may present everyone mature in <u>Christ</u>.
- 2 Timothy 2:15 Study to shew thyself approved unto God, a workman that needeth not to be ashamed, rightly dividing the word of truth.
- Matthew 11:16 But whereunto shall I liken this generation? It is like unto children sitting in the markets, and calling unto their fellows,
- Colossians 3:16 Let the <u>Word of Christ dwell in you</u> richly, teaching and admonishing one another in all <u>wisdom</u>, singing psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, with thankfulness in your hearts to God.
- 1 Chronicles 15:16 And David spake to the chief of the Levites to appoint their brethren to be the singers with instruments of musick, psalteries and harps and cymbals, sounding, by lifting up the voice with joy.
- 1 Thessalonians 5:18 In every thing give thanks: for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus concerning you.
- 2 Timothy 3:15 and how from childhood you have been acquainted with the sacred writings, which are able to make you <u>wise</u> for salvation through faith in <u>Christ Jesus</u>.
- Luke 24:45 Then opened He their understanding, that they might understand the Scriptures,
- 1 Kings 18:37 Hear me, O LORD, hear me, that this people may know that thou art the LORD God, and that thou hast turned their heart back again.
- Proverbs 8:1 Doth not wisdom cry? and understanding put forth her voice? Matthew 11:28 Come unto Me, all ye that labour and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest.
- Proverbs 8:2 (AV) She standeth in the top of high places, by the way in the places of the paths.
- Jonah 2:2 And said, I cried by reason of mine affliction unto the LORD, and He heard me; out of the belly of hell cried I, and Thou heardest my voice.
- Luke 18:11 The Pharisee stood and prayed thus with himself, God, I thank thee, that I am not as other men are, extortioners, unjust, adulterers, or even as this publican.
- John 3:7 Marvel not that I said unto thee, Ye must be born again.
- Proverbs 8:3,4 (AV) She crieth at the gates, at the entry of the city, at the coming in at the doors. 4 Unto you, O men, I call; and my voice *is* to the sons of man.

- Galatians 3:28 There is neither Jew nor Greek, there is neither bond nor free, there is neither male nor female: for ye are all one in Christ Jesus.
- Proverbs 8:5 (AV) O ye simple, understand wisdom: and, ye fools, be ye of an understanding heart.
- Proverbs 8:5 (NKJV) O you <u>simple ones</u>, understand prudence, And you fools, be of an understanding heart.
- 1 Corinthians 3:19 For the wisdom of this world is foolishness with God. For it is written, He taketh the wise in their own craftiness.
- John 14:6 Jesus saith unto him, I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by Me.
- **Exodus 20 Referred to the 10 Commandments.**
- John 18:38 Pilate saith unto Him, What is truth? & when he had said this, he went out again unto the Jews, & said to them, I find in him no fault at all.
- Matthew 5:22 But I say unto you, That whosoever is angry with his brother without a cause shall be in danger of the judgment: and whosoever shall say to his brother, Raca, shall be in danger of the council: but whosoever shall say, Thou fool, shall be in danger of hell fire.
- Matthew 23:17 Ye fools and blind: for whether is greater, the gold, or the temple that sanctifieth the gold?
- Matthew 7:29 For He taught them as One having authority, and not as the scribes.
- Proverbs 8:6,7 (AV) Hear; for I will speak of excellent things; and the opening of my lips *shall be* right things. 7 For my mouth shall speak truth; and wickedness *is* an abomination to my lips. 7 (NKJV) For my mouth will speak truth; Wickedness *is* an abomination to my lips.
- Matthew 22:21 They say unto him, Caesar's. Then saith he unto them, Render therefore unto Caesar the things which are Caesar's; and unto God the things that are God's.
- Summarized of many times the religious leaders tried to trick Jesus.
- Mark 12:24 And Jesus answering said unto them, Do ye not therefore err, because ye know not the scriptures, neither the power of God?
- Proverbs 8:8 (AV) All the words of my mouth *are* in righteousness; *there is* nothing froward or perverse in them.
- Proverbs 8:8 (NKJV) All the words of my mouth *are* with righteousness; Nothing crooked or perverse *is* in them.
- Joshua 24:15 And if it seem evil unto you to serve the LORD, choose you this day whom ye will serve; whether the gods which your fathers served that were on the other side of the flood, or the gods of the Amorites, in whose land ye dwell: but as for me and my house, we will serve the LORD.
- Matthew 11:28 Come unto Me, all ye that labour and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest.
- Proverbs 8:9 (AV) They are all plain to him that understandeth, and right to

them that find knowledge.

Luke 8:10 And he said, Unto you it is given to know the mysteries of the kingdom of God: but to others in parables; that seeing they might not see, and hearing they might not understand.

Romans 10:17 So then faith comes by hearing, & hearing by the Word of God. Proverbs 8:10 (AV) Receive my instruction, and not silver; and knowledge rather than choice gold.

Matthew 17:27 Notwithstanding, lest we should offend them, go thou to the sea, and cast an hook, and take up the fish that first cometh up; and when thou hast opened his mouth, thou shalt find a piece of money: that take, and give unto them for me and thee.

Revelation 19 Referred to Jesus' return.

Revelation 22:20 He which testifieth these things saith, Surely I come quickly. Amen. Even so, come, Lord Jesus.

Proverbs 8:11 (AV) For wisdom *is* better than rubies; and all the things that may be desired are not to be compared to it. 12 I wisdom dwell with prudence, and find out knowledge of witty inventions.

In the Gospel of Mark, more people are healed by deliverance than healing.

Proverbs 8:13-36 (AV) The fear of the LORD is to hate evil: pride, and arrogancy, and the evil way, and the froward mouth, do I hate. 14 Counsel is mine, and sound wisdom: I am understanding; I have strength. 15 By me kings reign, and princes decree justice. 16 By me princes rule, and nobles, even all the judges of the earth. 17 I love them that love me; and those that seek me early shall find me. 18 Riches and honour are with me; yea, durable riches and righteousness. 19 My fruit *is* better than gold, yea, than fine gold; and my revenue than choice silver. 20 I lead in the way of righteousness, in the midst of the paths of judgment: 21 That I may cause those that love me to inherit substance; and I will fill their treasures. 22 The LORD possessed me in the beginning of His way, before His works of old. 23 I was set up from everlasting, from the beginning, or ever the earth was. 24 When there were no depths, I was brought forth; when there were no fountains abounding with water. 25 Before the mountains were settled, before the hills was I brought forth: 26 While as yet he had not made the earth, nor the fields, nor the highest part of the dust of the world. 27 When He prepared the heavens, I was there: when He set a compass upon the face of the depth: 28 When He established the clouds above: when He strengthened the fountains of the deep: 29 When He gave to the sea His decree, that the waters should not pass His commandment: when He appointed the foundations of the earth: 30 Then I was by Him, as one brought up with Him: and I was daily His delight, rejoicing always before Him; 31 Rejoicing in the habitable part of His earth; and my delights were with the sons of men. 32 Now therefore hearken unto me, O ye children:

for blessed *are they that* keep my ways. 33 Hear instruction, and be wise, and refuse it not. 34 Blessed *is* the man that heareth me, watching daily at my gates, waiting at the posts of my doors. 35 For whoso findeth me findeth life, and shall obtain favour of the LORD. 36 But he that sinneth against me wrongeth his own soul: all they that hate me love death.

- Proverbs 8:22 The LORD possessed me in the beginning of His way, before His works of old.
- Luke 4:7 If Thou therefore wilt worship me, all shall be Thine. 8 And Jesus answered and said unto him, Get thee behind Me, Satan: for it is written, Thou shalt worship the Lord thy God, and Him only shalt thou serve.
- Luke 10:19 Behold, I give unto you power to tread on serpents & scorpions, & over all the power of the enemy: and nothing shall by any means hurt you.
- Romans 16:20 And the God of peace shall bruise Satan under your feet shortly. The grace of our Lord Jesus Christ be with you. Amen.
- Jeremiah 29:13 And ye shall seek Me, and find Me, when ye shall search for Me with all your heart.
- Proverbs 8:32 Now therefore hearken unto me, O ye children: for blessed *are they that* keep my ways.
- Matthew 5:3 Blessed are the poor in spirit: for theirs is the kingdom of heaven.
- Romans 3:23 For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God; Proverbs 8:33 Hear instruction, and be wise, and refuse it not.
- James 1:22 But be ye doers of the Word, and not hearers only, deceiving your own selves.
- Proverbs 8:34 Blessed *is* the man that heareth me, watching daily at my gates, waiting at the posts of my doors.
- John 4:10 Jesus answered and said unto her, If thou knewest the gift of God, and who it is that saith to thee, Give Me to drink; thou wouldest have asked of Him, and He would have given thee living water.
- Proverbs 8:35,36 For whose findeth me findeth life, and shall obtain favour of the LORD. 36 But he that sinneth against me wrongeth his own soul: all they that hate me love death.
- John 10:28,29 And I give unto them eternal life; and they shall never perish, neither shall any man pluck them out of My hand. 29 My Father, which gave them Me, is greater than all; and no man is able to pluck them out of My Father's hand.
