- Proverbs 8 Summarized of Jesus as Wisdom being part of Creation with God.
- **Proverbs 9:1-18 (AV) & (NKJV)**
- Proverbs 9:1 (AV) Wisdom hath builded her house, she hath hewn out her seven pillars:
- Proverbs 9:1 (NKJV) Wisdom has built her house, She has hewn out her seven pillars;
- John 14:2 In My Father's house are many mansions: if it were not so, I would have told you. I go to prepare a place for you.
- Proverbs 9:2 (AV) She hath killed her beasts; she hath mingled her wine; she hath also furnished her table.
- Proverbs 9:2 (NKJV) She has slaughtered her meat, She has mixed her wine, She has also furnished her table.
- Luke 14 Referred to the wedding feast in heaven.
- Esther 1:8 And the drinking was according to the law; none did compel: for so the king had appointed to all the officers of his house, that they should do according to every man's pleasure.
- Mark 8:2,3 I have compassion on the multitude, because they have now been with me three days, and have nothing to eat: 3 And if I send them away fasting to their own houses, they will faint by the way: for divers of them came from far.
- Summarized of the 2 times Jesus fed thousands in the wilderness.
- Proverbs 9:3 (AV) She hath sent forth her maidens: she crieth upon the highest places of the city,
- Proverbs 9:3 (NKJV) She has sent out her maidens, She cries out from the highest places of the city,
- Luke 14:15-24 And when one of them that sat at meat with Him heard these things, he said unto Him, Blessed *is* he that shall eat bread in the kingdom of God.
- Matthew 5:3 Blessed are the poor in spirit: for theirs is the kingdom of heaven.
- Luke 14:16 Then said He unto him, A certain man made a great supper, and bade many: 17 And sent his servant at supper time to say to them that were bidden, Come; for all things are now ready.
- Acts 17:30 And the times of this ignorance God winked at; but now commandeth all men every where to repent:
- Summarized of salvation by Jesus Christ.

- Luke 14:19-21 And another said, I have bought five yoke of oxen, and I go to prove them: I pray thee have me excused. 20 And another said, I have married a wife, and therefore I cannot come. 21 So that servant came, and shewed his lord these things. Then the master of the house being angry said to his servant, Go out quickly into the streets and lanes of the city, and bring in hither the poor, and the maimed, and the halt, and the blind.
- Luke 10 Summarized of the Parable of the Good Samaritan helping the injured man.
- Matthew 11:28-30 Come unto Me, all ye that labour and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest. 29 Take My yoke upon you, and learn of Me; for I am meek and lowly in heart: and ye shall find rest unto your souls. 30 For My

- yoke is easy, and My burden is light.
- Luke 14:22 And the servant said, Lord, it is done as thou hast commanded, and yet there is room.
- Mark 16:17 And these signs shall follow them that believe; In my name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues;
- Luke 14:23 And the lord said unto the servant, Go out into the highways and hedges, and compel *them* to come in, that my house may be filled.
- 1 Kings 18:37 Hear me, O LORD, hear me, that this people may know that Thou art the LORD God, and that Thou hast turned their heart back again.

- Proverbs 9:4 Are you confused about life, don't know what's going on? Come with me, oh come, have dinner with me!
- Hebrews 9:27 And as it is appointed unto men once to die, but after this the judgment:
- John 4 Summarized of the woman at the well V25,26, 30 The woman saith unto him, I know that Messias cometh, which is called Christ: when he is come, he will tell us all things. 26 Jesus saith unto her, I that speak unto thee am he. 30 Then they went out of the city, and came unto him.
- Luke 8:39,40 Return to thine own house, and shew how great things God hath done unto thee. And he went his way, and published throughout the whole city how great things Jesus had done unto him. 40 And it came to pass, that, when Jesus was returned, the people gladly received him: for they were all waiting for Him.
- Revelation 19 Referred to Jesus' return.
- Romans 8:13 For if ye live after the flesh, ye shall die: but if ye through the Spirit do mortify the deeds of the body, ye shall live.
- Proverbs 9:5 (AV) Come, eat of my bread, and drink of the wine *which* I have mingled.
- Proverbs 9:5 (NKJV) Come, eat of my bread And drink of the wine I have mixed.

- John 6:56,63 He that eateth my flesh, and drinketh my blood, dwelleth in me, and I in him. 63 It is the spirit that quickeneth; the flesh profiteth nothing: the words that I speak unto you, they are spirit, and they are life.
- John 3:7 Marvel not that I said unto thee, Ye must be born again.
- Proverbs 9:6 (AV) Forsake the foolish, and live; and go in the way of understanding.
- Proverbs 9:6 (NKJV) Forsake foolishness and live, And go in the way of understanding.
- Romans 10:17 So then faith cometh by hearing, and hearing by the Word of God.
- Proverbs 9:7 (AV) He that reprove h a scorner getteth to himself shame: and he that rebuketh a wicked *man getteth* himself a blot.
- Proverbs 9:7 (NKJV) He who corrects a scoffer gets shame for himself, And he who rebukes a wicked *man only* harms himself.
- 1 Kings 18:37 Hear me, O LORD, hear me, that this people may know that Thou art the LORD God, and that Thou hast turned their heart back again.
- Matthew 18:18 Verily I say unto you, Whatsoever ye shall bind on earth shall be bound in heaven: and whatsoever ye shall loose on earth shall be loosed in heaven.
- John 14:6 Jesus saith unto him, I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by Me.
- Proverbs 9:8 (AV) Reprove not a scorner, lest he hate thee: rebuke a wise man, and he will love thee.
- Proverbs 9:8 (NKJV) Do not correct a scoffer, lest he hate you; Rebuke a wise *man*, and he will love you.
- Proverbs 9:9 (AV) Give *instruction* to a wise *man*, and he will be yet wiser: teach a just *man*, and he will increase in learning.
- Proverbs 9:9 (NKJV) Give *instruction* to a wise *man*, and he will be still wiser; Teach a just *man*, and he will increase in learning.
- Referred to Paul's letters to Timothy to instruct him.
- Proverbs 9:10 (AV) The fear of the LORD *is* the beginning of wisdom: and the knowledge of the holy *is* understanding.
- Proverbs 9:10 (NKJV) The fear of the LORD *is* the beginning of wisdom, And the knowledge of the Holy One *is* understanding.
- Isaiah 6 Referred to his vision of God on His throne.
- Proverbs 9:11 (AV) For by me thy days shall be multiplied, and the years of thy life shall be increased.
- Proverbs 9:11 (NKJV) For by me your days will be multiplied, And years of life will be added to you.
- Exodus 20:12 Honour thy father and thy mother: that thy days may be long

- upon the land which the LORD thy God giveth thee.
- Proverbs 9:12 (AV) If thou be wise, thou shalt be wise for thyself: but *if* thou scornest, thou alone shalt bear *it*.
- Proverbs 9:12 (NKJV) If you are wise, you are wise for yourself, And *if* you scoff, you will bear *it* alone.
- Luke 2:52 And Jesus increased in wisdom and stature, and in favour with God and man.
- Luke 2:46,47 And it came to pass, that after three days they found him in the temple, sitting in the midst of the doctors, both hearing them, and asking them questions. 47 And all that heard him were astonished at his understanding and answers.
- Proverbs 9:13 (AV) A foolish woman *is* clamorous: *she is* simple, and knoweth nothing.
- Proverbs 9:13 (NKJV) A foolish woman is clamorous; *She is* simple, and knows nothing.
- Acts 16 Referred to the girl with divination spirit. V16-18 And it came to pass, as we went to prayer, a certain damsel possessed with a spirit of divination met us, which brought her masters much gain by soothsaying: 17 The same followed Paul and us, and cried, saying, These men are the servants of the most high God, which shew unto us the way of salvation. 18 And this did she many days. But Paul, being grieved, turned and said to the spirit, I command thee in the name of Jesus Christ to come out of her. And he came out the same hour.
- 1 Corinthians 2:4 And my speech and my preaching was not with enticing words of man's wisdom, but in demonstration of the Spirit and of power:
- 2 Samuel 15:6 And on this manner did Absalom to all Israel that came to the king for judgment: so Absalom stole the hearts of the men of Israel.
- John 10:10 The thief cometh not, but for to steal, and to kill, and to destroy: I am come that they might have life, and that they might have it more abundantly.
- 1 Timothy 2:5 For there is one God, and one mediator between God and men, the man Christ Jesus;
- Proverbs 9:14 (AV) For she sitteth at the door of her house, on a seat in the high places of the city,
- Proverbs 9:14 (NKJV) For she sits at the door of her house, On a seat by the highest places of the city,
- John 4:20-24 Our fathers worshipped in this mountain; and ye say, that in Jerusalem is the place where men ought to worship. 21 Jesus saith unto her, Woman, believe Me, the hour cometh, when ye shall neither in this mountain, nor yet at Jerusalem, worship the Father. 22 Ye worship ye

know not what: we know what we worship: for salvation is of the Jews. 23 But the hour cometh, and now is, when the true worshippers shall worship the Father in spirit and in truth: for the Father seeketh such to worship Him. 24 God is a Spirit: and they that worship Him must worship Him in spirit and in truth.

- 1 John 2:22 Who is a liar but he that denieth that Jesus is the Christ? He is antichrist, that denieth the Father and the Son.
- 2 Corinthians 11:4 For if he that cometh preacheth another Jesus, whom we have not preached, or if ye receive another spirit, which ye have not received, or another gospel, which ye have not accepted, ye might well bear with him.
- Proverbs 9:17 (AV) Stolen waters are sweet, and bread *eaten* in secret is pleasant.
- Proverbs 9:17 (NKJV) Stolen water is sweet, And bread *eaten* in secret is pleasant.
- **Exodus 20:14 Thou shalt not commit adultery.**
- Proverbs 9:18 (AV) But he knoweth not that the dead *are* there; *and that* her guests *are* in the depths of hell.
- Proverbs 9:18 (NKJV) But he does not know that the dead *are* there, *That* her guests *are* in the depths of hell.
- Joshua 24:15 And if it seem evil unto you to serve the LORD, choose you this day whom ye will serve; whether the gods which your fathers served that were on the other side of the flood, or the gods of the Amorites, in whose land ye dwell: but as for me and my house, we will serve the LORD.
