Wise Sayings Of Solomon 1 - Proverbs 10

- 1 Kings 3:12 Behold, I have done according to thy words: Io, I have given thee a wise and an understanding heart; so that there was none like thee before thee, neither after thee shall any arise like unto thee.
- 1 Kings 3 Referred to the wise judgement Solomon made for 2 prostitutes.
- Luke 6:45-49 A good man out of the good treasure of his heart bringeth forth that which is good; and an evil man out of the evil treasure of his heart bringeth forth that which is evil: for of the abundance of the heart his mouth speaketh. 46 And why call ye Me, Lord, Lord, and do not the things which I say? 47 Whosoever cometh to Me, and heareth My sayings, and doeth them, I will shew you to whom he is like: 48 He is like a man which built an house, and digged deep, and laid the foundation on a rock: and when the flood arose, the stream beat vehemently upon that house, and could not shake it: for it was founded upon a rock. 49 But he that heareth, and doeth not, is like a man that without a foundation built an house upon the earth; against which the stream did beat vehemently, and immediately it fell; and the ruin of that house was great.
- Matthew 7:17,18,20 Even so every good tree bringeth forth good fruit; but a corrupt tree bringeth forth evil fruit. 18 A good tree cannot bring forth evil fruit, neither can a corrupt tree bring forth good fruit. 20 Wherefore by their fruits ye shall know them.
- Matthew 7:15 Beware of false prophets, which come to you in sheep's clothing, but inwardly they are ravening wolves.
- Proverbs 10:1-32 (AV) & (NKJV)
- Proverbs 10:1 (AV) The proverbs of Solomon. A wise son maketh a glad father: but a foolish son *is* the heaviness of his mother.
- 1 Timothy 3:2,12 A bishop then must be blameless, the husband of one wife, vigilant, sober, of good behaviour, given to hospitality, apt to teach; 12 Let the deacons be the husbands of one wife, ruling their children and their own houses well.
- Proverbs 10:1 (NKJV) The Proverbs of Solomon: A wise son makes a glad father, But a foolish son *is* the grief of his mother.
- Proverbs 22:6 Train up a child in the way he should go: and when he is old, he will not depart from it.
- Proverbs 10:2 (AV) Treasures of wickedness profit nothing: but righteousness delivereth from death.
- Proverbs 10:2 (NKJV) Treasures of wickedness profit nothing, But

- righteousness delivers from death.
- Matthew 18:18 Verily I say unto you, Whatsoever ye shall bind on earth shall be bound in heaven: and whatsoever ye shall loose on earth shall be loosed in heaven.
- Proverbs 10:3 (AV) The LORD will not suffer the soul of the righteous to famish: but he casteth away the substance of the wicked.
- Proverbs 10:3 (NKJV) The LORD will not allow the righteous soul to famish, But He casts away the desire of the wicked.
- Exodus 16:21,22 And they gathered it (manna) every morning, every man according to his eating: and when the sun waxed hot, it melted. 22 And it came to pass, that on the sixth day they gathered twice as much bread, two omers for one man: and all the rulers of the congregation came and told Moses.
- Genesis 6:5 And GOD saw that the wickedness of man was great in the earth, and that every imagination of the thoughts of his heart was only evil continually.
- Proverbs 10:4 (AV) He becometh poor that dealeth *with* a slack hand: but the hand of the diligent maketh rich.
- Proverbs 10:4 (NKJV) He who has a slack hand becomes poor, But the hand of the diligent makes rich.
- Proverbs 10:5 (AV) He that gathereth in summer *is* a wise son: *but* he that sleepeth in harvest *is* a son that causeth shame.
- Proverbs 10:5 (NKJV) He who gathers in summer *is* a wise son; He who sleeps in harvest *is* a son who causes shame.
- Ecclesiastes 3:1 To every thing there is a season, and a time to every purpose under the heaven:
- John 8:36 If the Son therefore shall make you free, ye shall be free indeed.
- Proverbs 10:6 (AV) Blessings *are* upon the head of the just: but violence covereth the mouth of the wicked.
- Proverbs 10:6 (NKJV) Blessings *are* on the head of the righteous, But violence covers the mouth of the wicked.
- Matthew 5:3 Blessed are the poor in spirit: for theirs is the kingdom of heaven.
- Proverbs 10:7 (AV) The memory of the just *is* blessed: but the name of the wicked shall rot.
- Proverbs 10:7 (NKJV) The memory of the righteous *is* blessed, But the name of the wicked will rot.
- Matthew 23:11 But he that is greatest among you shall be your servant.
- Proverbs 10:8 (AV) The wise in heart will receive commandments: but a prating fool shall fall.

- Proverbs 10:8 (NKJV) The wise in heart will receive commands, But a prating fool will fall.
- Proverbs 10:9 (AV) He that walketh uprightly walketh surely: but he that perverteth his ways shall be known.
- Proverbs 10:9 (NKJV) He who walks with integrity walks securely, But he who perverts his ways will become known.
- Job 2:3 And the LORD said unto Satan, Hast thou considered My servant Job, that there is none like him in the earth, a perfect and an upright man, one that feareth God, & escheweth evil? and still he holdeth fast his integrity, although thou movedst Me against him, to destroy him without cause.
- Proverbs 10:10 (AV) He that winketh with the eye causeth sorrow: but a prating fool shall fall.
- Proverbs 10:10 (NKJV) He who winks with the eye causes trouble, But a prating fool will fall.
- Hebrews 5:14 But strong meat belongeth to them that are of full age, even those who by reason of use have their senses exercised to discern both good and evil.
- Acts 8:9 But there was a certain man, called Simon, which beforetime in the same city used sorcery, and bewitched the people of Samaria, giving out that himself was some great one:
- Proverbs 10:11 (AV) The mouth of a righteous *man is* a well of life: but violence covereth the mouth of the wicked.
- Proverbs 10:11 (NKJV) The mouth of the righteous *is* a well of life, But violence covers the mouth of the wicked.
- Proverbs 10:12 (AV) Hatred stirreth up strifes: but love covereth all sins.
- Proverbs 10:12 (NKJV) Hatred stirs up strife, But love covers all sins.
- Matthew 14:14 And Jesus went forth, and saw a great multitude, and was moved with compassion toward them, and He healed their sick.
- John 8:7,11 So when they continued asking him, he lifted up himself, and said unto them, He that is without sin among you, let him first cast a stone at her. 11 She said, No man, Lord. And Jesus said unto her, Neither do I condemn thee: go, and sin no more.
- Proverbs 10:13 (AV) In the lips of him that hath understanding wisdom is found: but a rod *is* for the back of him that is void of understanding.
- Proverbs 10:13 (NKJV) Wisdom is found on the lips of him who has understanding, But a rod *is* for the back of him who is devoid of understanding.
- **Exodus 22:18 Thou shalt not suffer a witch to live.**
- Ephesians 6:12 For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this

- world, against spiritual wickedness in high places.
- Hebrews 12:6 For whom the Lord loveth He chasteneth, and scourgeth every son whom He receiveth.
- Proverbs 10:14 (AV) Wise *men* lay up knowledge: but the mouth of the foolish *is* near destruction.
- Proverbs 10:14 (NKJV) Wise *people* store up knowledge, But the mouth of the foolish *is* near destruction.
- John 10:10 The thief cometh not, but for to steal, and to kill, and to destroy: I am come that they might have life, and that they might have it more abundantly.
- Proverbs 10:15 (AV) The rich man's wealth *is* his strong city: the destruction of the poor *is* their poverty.
- Proverbs 10:15 (NKJV) The rich man's wealth *is* his strong city; The destruction of the poor *is* their poverty.
- Job 1 & 42 Referred to Job's riches.
- Proverbs 10:16 (AV) The labour of the righteous *tendeth* to life: the fruit of the wicked to sin.
- Proverbs 10:16 (NKJV) The labor of the righteous *leads* to life, The wages of the wicked to sin.
- Colossians 3:23 And whatsoever ye do, do it heartily, as to the Lord, and not unto men;
- Proverbs 10:17 (AV) He *is in* the way of life that keepeth instruction: but he that refuseth reproof erreth.
- Proverbs 10:17 (NKJV) He who keeps instruction is in the way of life, But he who refuses correction goes astray.
- Matthew 5:15 Neither do men light a candle, and put it under a bushel, but on a candlestick; and it giveth light unto all that are in the house.
- Proverbs 10:18 (AV) He that hideth hatred *with* lying lips, and he that uttereth a slander, *is* a fool.
- Proverbs 10:18 (NKJV) Whoever hides hatred *has* lying lips, And whoever spreads slander *is* a fool.
- 2 Samuel 15:6,7 And on this manner did Absalom to all Israel that came to the king for judgment: so Absalom stole the hearts of the men of Israel. 7 And it came to pass after forty years, that Absalom said unto the king, I pray thee, let me go and pay my vow, which I have vowed unto the LORD, in Hebron.
- Proverbs 10:19 (AV) In the multitude of words there wanteth not sin: but he that refraineth his lips *is* wise.
- Proverbs 10:19 (NKJV) In the multitude of words sin is not lacking, But he who restrains his lips *is* wise.

- Galatians 5:22,23 (NKJV) But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, longsuffering, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, 23 gentleness, self-control. Against such there is no law.
- Proverbs 10:20 (AV) The tongue of the just *is as* choice silver: the heart of the wicked *is* little worth.
- Proverbs 10:20 (NKJV) The tongue of the righteous *is* choice silver; The heart of the wicked *is worth* little.
- Matthew 26 Summarized of Peter lying by denying Jesus.
- Proverbs 10:21 (AV) The lips of the righteous feed many: but fools die for want of wisdom.
- Proverbs 10:21 (NKJV) The lips of the righteous feed many, But fools die for lack of wisdom.
- Matthew 10:37 He that loveth father or mother more than Me is not worthy of Me: and he that loveth son or daughter more than Me is not worthy of Me.
- Proverbs 10:22 (AV) The blessing of the LORD, it maketh rich, and he addeth no sorrow with it.
- Proverbs 10:22 (NKJV) The blessing of the LORD makes *one* rich, And He adds no sorrow with it.
- Proverbs 10:23 (AV) *It is* as sport to a fool to do mischief: but a man of understanding hath wisdom.
- Proverbs 10:23 (NKJV) To do evil *is* like sport to a fool, But a man of understanding has wisdom.
- Proverbs 10:24 (AV) The fear of the wicked, it shall come upon him: but the desire of the righteous shall be granted.
- Proverbs 10:24 (NKJV) The fear of the wicked will come upon him, And the desire of the righteous will be granted.
- James 4:3 Ye ask, and receive not, because ye ask amiss, that ye may consume it upon your lusts.
- Proverbs 10:25 (AV) As the whirlwind passeth, so *is* the wicked no *more*: but the righteous *is* an everlasting foundation.
- Proverbs 10:25 (NKJV) When the whirlwind passes by, the wicked *is* no *more*, But the righteous *has* an everlasting foundation.
- Luke 6:47,48 Whosoever cometh to Me, and heareth My sayings, and doeth them, I will shew you to whom he is like: 48 He is like a man which built an house, and digged deep, and laid the foundation on a rock: and when the flood arose, the stream beat vehemently upon that house, and could not shake it: for it was founded upon a rock.
- Proverbs 10:26 (AV) As vinegar to the teeth, and as smoke to the eyes, so *is* the sluggard to them that send him.
- Proverbs 10:26 (NKJV) As vinegar to the teeth and smoke to the eyes, So is

- the lazy man to those who send him.
- Proverbs 10:27 (AV) The fear of the LORD prolongeth days: but the years of the wicked shall be shortened.
- Proverbs 10:27 (NKJV) The fear of the LORD prolongs days, But the years of the wicked will be shortened.
- Exodus 20:12 Honour thy father and thy mother: that thy days may be long upon the land which the LORD thy God giveth thee.
- Proverbs 10:28 (AV) The hope of the righteous *shall be* gladness: but the expectation of the wicked shall perish.
- Proverbs 10:28 (NKJV) The hope of the righteous *will be* gladness, But the expectation of the wicked will perish.
- Proverbs 10:29 (AV) The way of the LORD *is* strength to the upright: but destruction *shall be* to the workers of iniquity.
- Proverbs 10:29 (NKJV) The way of the LORD *is* strength for the upright, But destruction *will come* to the workers of iniquity.
- Proverbs 10:30 (AV) The righteous shall never be removed: but the wicked shall not inhabit the earth.
- Proverbs 10:30 (NKJV) The righteous will never be removed, But the wicked will not inhabit the earth.
- Mark 13:20 And except that the Lord had shortened those days, no flesh should be saved: but for the elect's sake, whom he hath chosen, he hath shortened the days.
- Genesis 18:23 And Abraham drew near, and said, Wilt thou also destroy the righteous with the wicked?
- Referred to that Abraham interceded for righteous down to if 10.
- Proverbs 10:31 (AV) The mouth of the just bringeth forth wisdom: but the froward tongue shall be cut out.
- Proverbs 10:31 (NKJV) The mouth of the righteous brings forth wisdom, But the perverse tongue will be cut out.
- Proverbs 10:32 (AV) The lips of the righteous know what is acceptable: but the mouth of the wicked *speaketh* frowardness.
- Proverbs 10:32 (NKJV) The lips of the righteous know what is acceptable, But the mouth of the wicked *what is* perverse.
- Proverbs 10:8 (AV) The wise in heart will receive commandments: but a prating fool shall fall.
