- **Exodus 20 Referred to the 10 Commandments.**
- Matthew 22:37-39 Jesus said unto him, Thou shalt love the Lord thy God with all thy heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy mind. 38 This is the first and great commandment. 39 And the second is like unto it, Thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself.
- Proverbs 11:1-31 (AV) & (NKJV)
- Proverbs 11:1 (AV) A false balance *is* abomination to the LORD: but a just weight *is* His delight.
- Proverbs 11:1 (NKJV) Dishonest scales *are* an abomination to the LORD, But a just weight *is* His delight.
- John 18:38 Pilate saith unto him, What is truth? And when he had said this, he went out again unto the Jews, and saith unto them, I find in Him no fault at all.
- Hebrews 5:14 But strong meat belongeth to them that are of full age, even those who by reason of use have their senses exercised to discern both good and evil.
- Proverbs 11:2 (AV) *When* pride cometh, then cometh shame: but with the lowly *is* wisdom.
- Proverbs 11:2 (NKJV) When pride comes, then comes shame; But with the humble *is* wisdom.
- Proverbs 16:18 Pride goes before destruction, & a haughty spirit before a fall.
- Luke 14:11 For whosoever exalteth himself shall be abased; and he that humbleth himself shall be exalted.
- Matthew 21 Referred to Jesus riding on a donkey.
- Revelation 19:11 Referred to Jesus' return as a Conquerer.
- Proverbs 11:3 (AV) The integrity of the upright shall guide them: but the perverseness of transgressors shall destroy them.
- Proverbs 11:3 (NKJV) The integrity of the upright will guide them, But the perversity of the unfaithful will destroy them.
- Job 2:9,10 Then said his wife unto him, Dost thou still retain thine integrity? curse God, and die. 10 But he said unto her, Thou speakest as one of the foolish women speaketh. What? shall we receive good at the hand of God, and shall we not receive evil? In all this did not Job sin with his lips.
- Isaiah 5:21 Woe unto them that are wise in their own eyes, and prudent in their own sight!
- 2 Chronicles 36:12 And he did that which was evil in the sight of the LORD his God, and humbled not himself before Jeremiah the prophet speaking from the mouth of the LORD.
- 1 Samuel 28:6 And when Saul enquired of the LORD, the LORD answered him

- not, neither by dreams, nor by Urim, nor by prophets.
- 1 Chronicles 10:14 And (Saul) enquired not of the LORD: therefore he slew him, and turned the kingdom unto David the son of Jesse.
- Matthew 6:20 But lay up for yourselves treasures in heaven, where neither moth nor rust do corrupt, & where thieves do not break through nor steal:
- Proverbs 11:4 (AV) Riches profit not in the day of wrath: but righteousness delivereth from death.
- Proverbs 11:4 (NKJV) Riches do not profit in the day of wrath, But righteousness delivers from death.
- Job 37-39 Referred to God's treasure houses. Job 38:23 Which I have reserved against the time of trouble, against the day of battle and war?
- Ephesians 1:13 In whom ye also trusted, after that ye heard the word of truth, the gospel of your salvation: in whom also after that ye believed, ye were sealed with that holy Spirit of promise,
- Proverbs 11:5 (AV) The righteousness of the perfect shall direct his way: but the wicked shall fall by his own wickedness.
- Proverbs 11:5 (NKJV) The righteousness of the blameless will direct his way aright, But the wicked will fall by his own wickedness.
- Matthew 7:14 Because strait is the gate, and narrow is the way, which leadeth unto life, and few there be that find it.
- Isaiah 35:8 And an highway shall be there, and a way, and it shall be called The way of holiness; the unclean shall not pass over it; but it shall be for those: the wayfaring men, though fools, shall not err therein.
- Isaiah 30:21 thine ears shall hear a word behind thee saying, This is the way, walk ye in it, when ye turn to the right hand, & when ye turn to the left.
- Genesis 39:12 And she caught him by his garment, saying, Lie with me: and he left his garment in her hand, and fled, and got him out.
- Galatians 5 Referred to the Fruit of the Spirit
- Proverbs 11:6 (AV) The righteousness of the upright shall deliver them: but transgressors shall be taken in *their own* naughtiness.
- Proverbs 11:6 (NKJV) The righteousness of the upright will deliver them, But the unfaithful will be caught by *their* lust.
- 1 John 1:9 If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.
- Summarized of Joseph rising from a prisoner to a high ruler.
- Proverbs 11:7 (AV) When a wicked man dieth, *his* expectation shall perish: and the hope of unjust *men* perisheth.
- Proverbs 11:7 (NKJV) When a wicked man dies, *his* expectation will perish, And the hope of the unjust perishes.
- Luke 12 Summarized of the Parable of the rich man building bigger barns. V20 But God said unto him, Thou fool, this night thy soul shall be required of thee: then whose shall those things be, which thou hast provided?

- Hebrews 9:27 And as it is appointed unto men once to die, but after this the judgment:
- 2 Corinthians 6:2 (For He saith, I have heard thee in a time accepted, and in the day of salvation have I succoured thee: behold, now is the accepted time; behold, now is the day of salvation.)
- Psalms 95:8 Harden not your heart, as in the provocation, and as in the day of temptation in the wilderness:
- Luke 8:12 Those by the way side are they that hear; then cometh the devil, and taketh away the word out of their hearts, lest they should believe and be saved. Luke 16 Summarized the Parable of the rich man & Lazarus.
- Proverbs 11:8 (AV) The righteous is delivered out of trouble, and the wicked cometh in his stead.
- Proverbs 11:8 (NKJV) The righteous is delivered from trouble, And it comes to the wicked instead.
- Psalms 44:4 Thou art my King, O God: command deliverances for Jacob.
- Isaiah 43:2 When you pass through the waters, I will be with thee; & through the rivers, they shall not overflow thee: when thou walkest through the fire, thou shalt not be burned; neither shall the flame kindle upon thee.
- Proverbs 11:9 (AV) An hypocrite with *his* mouth destroyeth his neighbour: but through knowledge shall the just be delivered.
- Proverbs 11:9 (NKJV) The hypocrite with *his* mouth destroys his neighbor, But through knowledge the righteous will be delivered.
- Hebrews 5:14 But strong meat belongeth to them that are of full age, even those who by reason of use have their senses exercised to discern both good and evil.
- 1 Timothy 5:13 And withal they (young widows) learn to be idle, wandering about from house to house; and not only idle, but tattlers also and busybodies, speaking things which they ought not.
- Proverbs 11:10 (AV) When it goeth well with the righteous, the city rejoiceth: and when the wicked perish, *there is* shouting.
- Proverbs 11:10 (NKJV) When it goes well with the righteous, the city rejoices; And when the wicked perish, *there is* jubilation.
- Isaiah 1:26 And I will restore thy judges as at the first, and thy counsellors as at the beginning: afterward thou shalt be called, The city of righteousness, the faithful city.
- Proverbs 11:11 (AV) By the blessing of the upright the city is exalted: but it is overthrown by the mouth of the wicked.
- Proverbs 11:11 (NKJV) By the blessing of the upright the city is exalted, But it is overthrown by the mouth of the wicked.
- Break off the curses in Jesus' Name.
- Proverbs 11:12 (AV) He that is void of wisdom despiseth his neighbour: but a man of understanding holdeth his peace.

- Proverbs 11:12 (NKJV) He who is devoid of wisdom despises his neighbor, But a man of understanding holds his peace.
- Proverbs 4:5 Get wisdom, get understanding: forget it not; neither decline from the words of my mouth.
- Proverbs 1:7 The fear of the LORD is the beginning of knowledge: but fools despise wisdom and instruction.
- Matthew 26:63 But Jesus held his peace. And the high priest answered and said unto him, I adjure thee by the living God, that thou tell us whether thou be the Christ, the Son of God.
- Proverbs 11:13 (AV) A talebearer revealeth secrets: but he that is of a faithful spirit concealeth the matter.
- Proverbs 11:13 (NKJV) A talebearer reveals secrets, But he who is of a faithful spirit conceals a matter.
- Proverbs 29:11 A fool uttereth all his mind: but a wise man keepeth it in till afterwards.
- Proverbs 11:14 (AV) Where no counsel *is*, the people fall: but in the multitude of (Godly) counsellors *there is* safety.
- Proverbs 11:14 (NKJV) Where *there is* no counsel, the people fall; But in the multitude of (Godly) counselors *there is* safety.
- Proverbs 11:15 (AV) He that is surety for a stranger shall smart *for it*: and he that hateth suretiship is sure. (co-signer or collateral)
- Proverbs 11:15 (NKJV) He who is surety for a stranger will suffer, But one who hates being surety is secure.
- Proverbs 11:16 (AV) A gracious woman retaineth honour: and strong *men* retain riches.
- Proverbs 11:16 (NKJV) A gracious woman retains honor, But ruthless *men* retain riches. 1 Samuel 25 Summarized of Abigail, David's wife.
- Proverbs 11:17 (AV) The merciful man doeth good to his own soul: but *he that is* cruel troubleth his own flesh.
- Proverbs 11:17 (NKJV) The merciful man does good for his own soul, But *he* who is cruel troubles his own flesh.
- Matthew 5:7 Blessed are the merciful: for they shall obtain mercy.
- Matthew 6:14,15 For if ye forgive men their trespasses, your heavenly Father will also forgive you: 15 But if ye forgive not men their trespasses, neither will your Father forgive your trespasses.
- Proverbs 11:18 (AV) The wicked worketh a deceitful work: but to him that soweth righteousness *shall be* a sure reward.
- Proverbs 11:18 (NKJV) The wicked *man* does deceptive work, But he who sows righteousness *will have* a sure reward.
- Proverbs 11:19 (AV) As righteousness *tendeth* to life: so he that pursueth evil *pursueth it* to his own death.
- Proverbs 11:19 (NKJV) As righteousness leads to life, So he who pursues evil

- pursues it to his own death.
- 1 Corinthians 6:19 What? know ye not that your body is the temple of the Holy Ghost which is in you, which ye have of God, & ye are not your own?
- Revelation 20:15 And whosoever was not found written in the book of life was cast into the lake of fire.
- Deuteronomy 30:19 I call heaven and earth to record this day against you, that I have set before you life and death, blessing and cursing: therefore choose life, that both thou and thy seed may live:
- Proverbs 11:20 (AV) They that are of a froward heart *are* abomination to the LORD: but *such* as *are* upright in *their* way *are* his delight.
- Proverbs 11:20 (NKJV) Those who are of a perverse heart *are* an abomination to the LORD, But *the* blameless in their ways *are* His delight.
- Proverbs 6 Referred to the 7 things God hates.
- Acts 8:21 Thou hast neither part nor lot in this matter: for thy heart is not right in the sight of God.
- 2 Samuel 12:14 Howbeit, because by this deed thou hast given great occasion to the enemies of the LORD to blaspheme, the child also that is born unto thee shall surely die.
- Proverbs 11:21 (AV) *Though* hand *join* in hand, the wicked shall not be unpunished: but the seed of the righteous shall be delivered.
- Proverbs 11:21 (NKJV) *Though they join* forces, the wicked will not go unpunished; But the posterity of the righteous will be delivered.
- Proverbs 11:22 (AV) *As* a jewel of gold in a swine's snout, *so is* a fair woman which is without discretion.
- Proverbs 11:22 (NKJV) *As* a ring of gold in a swine's snout, *So is* a lovely woman who lacks discretion.
- 1 Kings 11:3,4 And he (Solomon) had seven hundred wives, princesses, and three hundred concubines: and his wives turned away his heart.
- Proverbs 11:23 (AV) The desire of the righteous *is* only good: *but* the expectation of the wicked *is* wrath.
- Proverbs 11:23 (NKJV) The desire of the righteous *is* only good, *But* the expectation of the wicked *is* wrath.
- John 14:13 And whatsoever ye shall ask in my name, that will I do, that the Father may be glorified in the Son.
- Matthew 5:45 That ye may be the children of your Father which is in heaven: for he maketh his sun to rise on the evil and on the good, and sendeth rain on the just and on the unjust.
- Proverbs 11:24 (AV) There is that scattereth, and yet increaseth; and *there is* that withholdeth more than is meet, but *it tendeth* to poverty.
- Proverbs 11:24 (NKJV) There is *one* who scatters, yet increases more; And there is *one* who withholds more than is right, But it *leads* to poverty.
- Luke 11:23 He that is not with Me is against Me: and he that gathereth not

- with Me scattereth.
- Proverbs 11:25 (AV) The liberal soul shall be made fat: and he that watereth shall be watered also himself.
- Proverbs 11:25 (NKJV) The generous soul will be made rich, And he who waters will also be watered himself.
- 2 Corinthians 9:7 Every man according as he purposeth in his heart, so let him give; not grudgingly, or of necessity: for God loveth a cheerful giver.
- Proverbs 11:26 (AV) He that withholdeth corn, the people shall curse him: but blessing *shall be* upon the head of him that selleth *it*.
- Proverbs 11:26 (NKJV) The people will curse him who withholds grain, But blessing *will be* on the head of him who sells *it*.
- Genesis 41 Referred to Joseph selling the stored corn.
- Proverbs 11:27 (AV) He that diligently seeketh good procureth favour: but he that seeketh mischief, it shall come unto him.
- Proverbs 11:27 (NKJV) He who earnestly seeks good finds favor, But trouble will come to him who seeks *evil*.
- Psalms 34:7 The angel of the LORD encampeth round about them that fear him, and delivereth them.
- Proverbs 11:28 (AV) He that trusteth in his riches shall fall: but the righteous shall flourish as a branch.
- Proverbs 11:28 (NKJV) He who trusts in his riches will fall, But the righteous will flourish like foliage.
- Matthew 6:20 But lay up for yourselves treasures in heaven, where neither moth nor rust do corrupt, & where thieves do not break through nor steal:
- Proverbs 11:29 (AV) He that troubleth his own house shall inherit the wind: and the fool *shall be* servant to the wise of heart.
- Proverbs 11:29 (NKJV) He who troubles his own house will inherit the wind, And the fool *will be* servant to the wise of heart.
- Proverbs 11:30 (AV) The fruit of the righteous *is* a tree of life; and he that winneth souls *is* wise.
- Proverbs 11:30 (NKJV) The fruit of the righteous *is a* tree of life, And he who wins souls *is* wise.
- Proverbs 11:31 (AV) Behold, the righteous shall be recompensed in the earth: much more the wicked and the sinner.
- Proverbs 11:31 (NKJV) If the righteous will be recompensed on the earth, How much more the ungodly and the sinner.
- Luke 16 Referred to the Parable of the rich man & Lazarus.
