- Proverbs 10 & 11 Referred to Solomon's wise sayings explanding on the 10 Commandments as Jesus taught the people.
- **Proverbs 12:1-28 (AV) & (NKJV)**
- Proverbs 12:1 (AV) Whoso loveth instruction loveth knowledge: but he that hateth reproof *is* brutish.

 Proverbs 12:1 (NKJV) Whoever loves instruction loves knowledge, But he who hates correction *is* stupid.
- Luke 24:32 And they said one to another, Did not our heart burn within us, while He talked with us by the way, and while He opened to us the scriptures?
- 1 John 1:9 If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.
- Proverbs 12:2 (AV) A good (Godly) *man* obtaineth favour of the LORD: but a man of wicked devices will He condemn.
- Proverbs 12:2 (NKJV) A good *man* obtains favor from the LORD, But a man of wicked intentions He will condemn.
- 2 Corinthians 13:5 Examine yourselves, whether ye be in the faith; prove your own selves. Know ye not your own selves, how that Jesus Christ is in you, except ye be reprobates?
- Acts 13 Referred to Paul dealing with Elymas.
- Luke 16 Summarized of the Rich man & Lazarus.
- Proverbs 12:3 (AV) A man shall not be established by wickedness: but the root of the righteous shall not be moved.
- Proverbs 12:3 (NKJV) A man is not established by wickedness, But the root of the righteous cannot be moved.
- Hebrews 13:5 Let your conversation be without covetousness; and be content with such things as ye have: for He hath said, I will never leave thee, nor forsake thee.
- Proverbs 12:4 (AV) A virtuous woman *is* a crown to her husband: but she that maketh ashamed *is* as rottenness in his bones.
- Proverbs 31 Referred to Solomon's writings on the Virtuous woman.
- Proverbs 12:4 (NKJV) An excellent wife *is* the crown of her husband, But she who causes shame *is* like rottenness in his bones.
- Referred to Bathsheba David's wife & Solomon's mother.
- Jeremiah 23:3 And I will gather the remnant of my flock out of all countries whither I have driven them, and will bring them again to their folds; and they shall be fruitful and increase.
- Luke 10:19 Behold, I give unto you power to tread on serpents & scorpions, & over all the power of the enemy: & nothing shall by any means hurt you.

- Romans 16:20 And the God of peace shall bruise Satan under your feet shortly. The grace of our Lord Jesus Christ be with you. Amen.
- Proverbs Referred to the strange woman.
- Proverbs 12:5 (AV) The thoughts of the righteous *are* right: *but* the counsels of the wicked *are* deceit. Proverbs 12:5 (NKJV) The thoughts of the righteous *are* right, *But* the counsels of the wicked *are* deceitful.
- 2 Corinthians 10:5 Casting down imaginations, and every high thing that exalteth itself against the knowledge of God, and bringing into captivity every thought to the obedience of Christ;
- Genesis 39:12 And she caught him by his garment, saying, Lie with me: and he left his garment in her hand, and fled, and got him out.
- 1 Corinthians 2:16 For who hath known the mind of the Lord, that he may instruct Him? But we have the mind of Christ.
- 1 Peter 5:2 Feed the flock of God which is among you, taking the oversight thereof, not by constraint, but willingly; not for filthy lucre, but of a ready mind;
- 2 Timothy 1:7 For God hath not given us the spirit of fear; but of power, and of love, and of a sound mind.
- Genesis 6:5 And GOD saw that the wickedness of man was great in the earth, and that every imagination of the thoughts of his heart was only evil continually.
- Isaiah 58:12 And they that shall be of thee shall build the old waste places: thou shalt raise up the foundations of many generations; and thou shalt be called, The repairer of the breach, The restorer of paths to dwell in.
- Proverbs 12:6 (AV) The words of the wicked *are* to lie in wait for blood: but the mouth of the upright shall deliver them.
- Proverbs 12:6 (NKJV) The words of the wicked *are*, Lie in wait for blood, But the mouth of the upright will deliver them.
- John 10:10 The thief cometh not, but for to steal, and to kill, and to destroy: I am come that they might have life, and that they might have it more abundantly.
- Proverbs 12:7 (AV) The wicked are overthrown, and *are* not: but the house of the righteous shall stand. Proverbs 12:7 (NKJV) The wicked are overthrown and *are* no more, But the house of the righteous will stand.
- Proverbs 12:8 (AV) A man shall be commended according to his wisdom: but he that is of a perverse heart shall be despised.
- Proverbs 12:8 (NKJV) A man will be commended according to his wisdom, But he who is of a perverse heart will be despised.
- Luke 2 Referred to Jesus at the temple at age 12. V47 And all that heard Him were astonished at His understanding and answers.
- Proverbs 12:9 (AV) *He that is* despised, and hath a servant, *is* better than he that honoureth himself, and lacketh bread.

- Proverbs 12:9 (NKJV) Better *is the one* who is slighted but has a servant, Than he who honors himself but lacks bread.
- Romans 12:3 For I say, through the grace given unto me, to every man that is among you, not to think of himself more highly than he ought to think; but to think soberly, according as God hath dealt to every man the measure of faith.
- Proverbs 12:10 (AV) A righteous *man* regardeth the life of his beast: but the tender mercies of the wicked *are* cruel.
- Proverbs 12:10 (NKJV) A righteous *man* regards the life of his animal, But the tender mercies of the wicked *are* cruel.
- Proverbs 12:11 (AV) He that tilleth his land shall be satisfied with bread: but he that followeth vain *persons is* void of understanding.
- Proverbs 12:11 (NKJV) He who tills his land will be satisfied with bread, But he who follows frivolity *is* devoid of understanding.
- Proverbs 12:12 (AV) The wicked desireth the net of evil *men*: but the root of the righteous yieldeth *fruit*. Proverbs 12:12 (NKJV) The wicked covet the catch of evil *men*, But the root of the righteous yields *fruit*.
- Proverbs 12:13 (AV) The wicked is snared by the transgression of *his* lips: but the just shall come out of trouble.
- Proverbs 12:13 (NKJV) The wicked is ensnared by the transgression of *his* lips, But the righteous will come through trouble.
- **Exodus 20:16 Thou shalt not bear false witness against thy neighbour.**
- Proverbs 12:14 (AV) A man shall be satisfied with good by the fruit of *his* mouth: and the recompence of a man's hands shall be rendered unto him.
- Proverbs 12:14 (NKJV) A man will be satisfied with good by the fruit of *his* mouth, And the recompense of a man's hands will be rendered to him.
- Matthew 16:27 For the Son of man shall come in the glory of His Father with His angels; and then He shall reward every man according to his works.
- Proverbs 12:15 (AV) The way of a fool *is* right in his own eyes: but he that hearkeneth unto counsel *is* wise. Proverbs 12:15 (NKJV) The way of a fool *is* right in his own eyes, But he who heeds counsel *is* wise.
- 1 Corinthians 13:11 When I was a child, I spake as a child, I understood as a child, I thought as a child: but when I became a man, I put away childish things.
- Proverbs 12:16 (AV) A fool's wrath is presently known: but a prudent *man* covereth shame.

 Proverbs 12:16 (NKJV) A fool's wrath is known at once, But a prudent *man* covers shame.
- Genesis 39:12 And she caught him by his garment, saying, Lie with me: and he left his garment in her hand, and fled, and got him out.
- 2 Timothy 2:22 Flee also youthful lusts: but follow righteousness, faith, charity, peace, with them that call on the Lord out of a pure heart.
- Proverbs 12:17 (AV) He that speaketh truth sheweth forth righteousness: but

- a false witness deceit. Proverbs 12:17 (NKJV) He *who* speaks truth declares righteousness, But a false witness, deceit.
- Matthew 7:5 Thou hypocrite, first cast out the beam out of thine own eye; & then shalt thou see clearly to cast out the mote out of thy brother's eye.
- Proverbs 12:18 (AV) There is that speaketh like the piercings of a sword: but the tongue of the wise *is* health.
- Proverbs 12:18 (NKJV) There is one who speaks like the piercings of a sword, But the tongue of the wise *promotes* health.
- Jude 1:20 But ye, beloved, building up yourselves on your most holy faith, praying in the Holy Ghost,
- Matthew 23 Referred to Jesus cursing the hypocritical religious leaders.
- Proverbs 12:19 (AV) The lip of truth shall be established for ever: but a lying tongue *is* but for a moment.

 Proverbs 12:19 (NKJV) The truthful lip shall be established forever, But a lying tongue *is* but for a moment.
- Matthew 6:30 Wherefore, if God so clothe the grass of the field, which to day is, and to morrow is cast into the oven, shall he not much more clothe you, O ye of little faith?
- Proverbs 12:20 (AV) Deceit *is* in the heart of them that imagine evil: but to the counsellors of peace *is* joy.
- Proverbs 12:20 (NKJV) Deceit is in the heart of those who devise evil, But counselors of peace have joy. Galatians 5 Referred to the ungodly friut.
- Matthew 15:18 But those things which proceed out of the mouth come forth from the heart; and they defile the man.
- Genesis 6:5 And GOD saw that the wickedness of man was great in the earth, and that every imagination of the thoughts of his heart was only evil continually.
- Proverbs 12:21 (AV) There shall no evil happen to the just: but the wicked shall be filled with mischief.

 Proverbs 12:21 (NKJV) No grave trouble will overtake the righteous, But the wicked shall be filled with evil.
- Proverbs 12:22 (AV) Lying lips *are* abomination to the LORD: but they that deal truly *are* His delight. Proverbs 12:22 (NKJV) Lying lips *are* an abomination to the LORD, But those who deal truthfully *are* His delight.
- Proverbs 12:23 (AV) A prudent man concealeth knowledge: but the heart of fools proclaimeth foolishness. Proverbs 12:23 (NKJV) A prudent man conceals knowledge, But the heart of fools proclaims foolishness.
- 1 Timothy 5:13 And withal they learn to be idle, wandering about from house to house; and not only idle, but tattlers also and busybodies, speaking things which they ought not.
- Proverbs 29:11 A fool uttereth all his mind: but a wise man keepeth it in till afterwards.
- 1 Corinthians 15:33 Be not deceived: evil communications corrupt good manners.

- Luke 15 Referred to the prodigal son partying till the money ran out.
- Proverbs 12:24 (AV) The hand of the diligent shall bear rule: but the slothful shall be under tribute.
- Proverbs 12:24 (NKJV) The hand of the diligent will rule, But the lazy *man* will be put to forced labor.
- 1 Samuel 8:7 And the LORD said unto Samuel, Hearken unto the voice of the people in all that they say unto <u>thee</u>: for they have not <u>rejected</u> <u>thee</u>, but they have rejected Me, that I should not reign over them.
- Proverbs 12:25 (AV) Heaviness in the heart of man maketh it stoop: but a good word maketh it glad.
- Proverbs 12:25 (NKJV) Anxiety in the heart of man causes depression, But a good word makes it glad.
- Isaiah 61:3 To appoint unto them that mourn in Zion, to give unto them beauty for ashes, the oil of joy for mourning, the garment of praise for the spirit of heaviness; that they might be called trees of righteousness, the planting of the LORD, that he might be glorified.
- Luke 8 Referred to the Gadarene Demoniac set free by Jesus.
- Hebrews 13:8 Jesus Christ the same yesterday, and to day, and for ever.
- Proverbs 12:26 (AV) The righteous *is* more excellent than his neighbour: but the way of the wicked seduceth them.
- Proverbs 12:26 (NKJV) The righteous should choose his friends carefully, For the way of the wicked leads them astray.
- John 8:36 If the Son therefore shall make you free, ye shall be free indeed.
- John 16:8 And when He is come, He will reprove the world of sin, and of righteousness, and of judgment:
- Proverbs 12:27 (AV) The slothful *man* roasteth not that which he took in hunting: but the substance of a diligent man *is* precious.
- Proverbs 12:27 (NKJV) The lazy *man* does not roast what he took in hunting, But diligence *is* man's precious possession.
- Proverbs 12:28 (AV) In the way of righteousness *is* life; and *in* the pathway *thereof there is* no death.
- Proverbs 12:28 (NKJV) In the way of righteousness *is* life, And in *its* pathway *there is* no death.
- John 14:6 Jesus saith unto him, I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by Me.
- 2 Corinthians 5:8 We are confident, I say, and willing rather to be absent from the body, and to be present with the Lord.
