

## **Wise Sayings Of Solomon 4 - Proverbs 13**

**Summarized of God freeing His people from Egypt.**

**Exodus 20 Referred to the 10 Commandments.**

**Genesis 3 Referred to the fall of mankind.**

**1 John 4:4 Ye are of God, little children, and have overcome them: because greater is He that is in you, than he that is in the world.**

**Proverbs 13:1-25 (AV) & (NKJV)**

**Proverbs 13:1 (AV) A wise son *heareth* his father's instruction: but a scorner heareth not rebuke.**

**Proverbs 13:1 (NKJV) A wise son *heeds* his father's instruction, But a scoffer does not listen to rebuke.**

**Ephesians 6:4 And, ye fathers, provoke not your children to wrath: but bring them up in the nurture and admonition of the Lord.**

**Proverbs 22:6 Train up a child in the way he should go: and when he is old, he will not depart from it.**

**Proverbs 13:2 (AV) A man shall eat good by the fruit of *his* mouth: but the soul of the transgressors *shall eat* violence.**

**Proverbs 13:2 (NKJV) A man shall eat well by the fruit of *his* mouth, But the soul of the unfaithful feeds on violence.**

**James 3:8-10 But the tongue can no man tame; it is an unruly evil, full of deadly poison. 9 Therewith bless we God, even the Father; and therewith curse we men, which are made after the similitude of God. 10 Out of the same mouth proceedeth blessing and cursing. My brethren, these things ought not so to be.**

**Proverbs 13:3 (AV) He that keepeth his mouth keepeth his life: *but* he that openeth wide his lips shall have destruction.**

**Proverbs 13:3 (NKJV) He who guards his mouth preserves his life, *But* he who opens wide his lips shall have destruction.**

**Proverbs 21:23 Whoso keepeth his mouth and his tongue keepeth his soul from troubles.**

**Proverbs 13:4 (AV) The soul of the sluggard desireth, and *hath* nothing: but the soul of the diligent shall be made fat.**

**Proverbs 13:4 (NKJV) The soul of a lazy *man* desires, and *has* nothing; But the soul of the diligent shall be made rich.**

**Ephesians 4:28 Let him that stole steal no more: but rather let him labour, working with his hands the thing which is good, that he may have to give to him that needeth.**

**1 Timothy 5:8 But if any provide not for his own, and specially for those of his own house, he hath denied the faith, and is worse than an infidel.**

**1 John 3:17 But whoso hath this world's good, and seeth his brother have need, and shutteth up his bowels of compassion from him, how dwelleth**

**the love of God in him?**

**Genesis 3:19** In the sweat of thy face shalt thou eat bread, till thou return unto the ground; for out of it wast thou taken: for dust thou art, and unto dust shalt thou return.

**Proverbs 13:5 (AV)** A righteous *man* hateth lying: but a wicked *man* is loathsome, and cometh to shame.

**Proverbs 13:5 (NKJV)** A righteous *man* hates lying, But a wicked *man* is loathsome and comes to shame.

**Exodus 20:16** Thou shalt not bear false witness against thy neighbour.

**John 14:6** Jesus saith unto him, I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by Me.

**John 8:44** Ye are of your father the devil, and the lusts of your father ye will do. He was a murderer from the beginning, and abode not in the truth, because there is no truth in him. When he speaketh a lie, he speaketh of his own: for he is a liar, and the father of it.

**Proverbs 13:6 (AV)** Righteousness keepeth *him that is* upright in the way: but wickedness overthroweth the sinner.

**Proverbs 13:6 (NKJV)** Righteousness guards *him whose* way is blameless, But wickedness overthrows the sinner.

**Matthew 5:48** Be ye therefore perfect, even as your Father which is in heaven is perfect.

**Leviticus 11:45** For I am the LORD that bringeth you up out of the land of Egypt, to be your God: ye shall therefore be Holy, for I am Holy.

**Acts 15:20** But that we write unto them, that they abstain from pollutions of idols, and from fornication, and from things strangled, and from blood.

**Genesis 39:12** And she caught him by his garment, saying, Lie with me: and he left his garment in her hand, and fled, and got him out.

**Mark 16:17** And these signs shall follow them that believe; In my name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues;

**Proverbs 13:7 (AV)** There is that maketh himself rich, yet *hath* nothing: *there is* that maketh himself poor, yet *hath* great riches.

**Proverbs 13:7 (NKJV)** There is one who makes himself rich, yet *has* nothing; *And* one who makes himself poor, yet *has* great riches.

**Luke 12** Summarized of the parable of the rich man V20 But God said unto him, Thou fool, this night thy soul shall be required of thee: then whose shall those things be, which thou hast provided?

**Matthew 6:20** But lay up for yourselves treasures in heaven, where neither moth nor rust doth corrupt, and where thieves do not break through nor steal:

**Matthew 6:24** No man can serve two masters: for either he will hate the one, and love the other; or else he will hold to the one, and despise the other. Ye cannot serve God and mammon.

**Luke 9:58** And Jesus said unto him, Foxes have holes, and birds of the air have nests; but the Son of man hath not where to lay his head.

**Proverbs 13:8 (AV)** The ransom of a man's life *are* his riches: but the poor heareth not rebuke.

**Proverbs 13:8 (NKJV)** The ransom of a man's life *is* his riches, But the poor does not hear rebuke.

**Philippians 4:11** Not that I speak in respect of want: for I have learned, in whatsoever state I am, therewith to be content.

**Proverbs 13:9 (AV)** The light of the righteous rejoiceth: but the lamp of the wicked shall be put out.

**Proverbs 13:9 (NKJV)** The light of the righteous rejoices, But the lamp of the wicked will be put out.

**Luke 11:33** No man, when he hath lighted a candle, putteth it in a secret place, neither under a bushel, but on a candlestick, that they which come in may see the light.

**Daniel 3** Referred to Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego standing for God.

**Acts 5:29** Then Peter and the other apostles answered and said, We ought to obey God rather than men.

**Luke 22:31,32** And the Lord said, Simon, Simon, behold, Satan hath desired to have you, that he may sift you as wheat: 32 But I have prayed for thee, that thy faith fail not: & when thou art converted, strengthen thy brethren.

**Matthew 5:16** Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works, and glorify your Father which is in heaven.

**Proverbs 13:10 (AV)** Only by pride cometh contention: but with the well advised *is* wisdom.

**Proverbs 13:10 (NKJV)** By pride comes nothing but strife, But with the well-advised *is* wisdom.

**Romans 12:3** For I say, through the grace given unto me, to every man that is among you, not to think of himself more highly than he ought to think; but to think soberly, according as God hath dealt to every man the measure of faith.

**Proverbs 13:11 (AV)** Wealth *gotten* by vanity shall be diminished: but he that gathereth by labour shall increase.

**Proverbs 13:11 (NKJV)** Wealth *gained* by dishonesty will be diminished, But he who gathers by labor will increase.

**Proverbs 13:12 (AV)** Hope deferred maketh the heart sick: but *when* the desire cometh, *it is* a tree of life.

**Proverbs 13:12 (NKJV)** Hope deferred makes the heart sick, But *when* the desire comes, *it is* a tree of life.

**Isaiah 1:26** And I will restore thy judges as at the first, and thy counsellors as at the beginning: afterward thou shalt be called, The city of righteousness, the faithful city.

**Proverbs 13:13 (AV)** Whoso despiseth the Word shall be destroyed: but he

**that feareth the commandment shall be rewarded.**

**Proverbs 13:13 (NKJV) He who despises the Word will be destroyed, But he who fears the commandment will be rewarded.**

**Job 37-39 Referred to God's armoury Job 38:23 Which I have reserved against the time of trouble, against the day of battle and war?**

**Proverbs 13:14 (AV) The law of the wise *is* a fountain of life, to depart from the snares of death.**

**Proverbs 13:14 (NKJV) The law of the wise *is* a fountain of life, To turn *one* away from the snares of death.**

**Isaiah 35:8 And an highway shall be there, and a way, and it shall be called The way of holiness; the unclean shall not pass over it; but it shall be for those: the wayfaring men, though fools, shall not err therein.**

**John 14:6 Jesus saith unto him, I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by Me.**

**Proverbs 13:15 (AV) Good understanding giveth favour: but the way of transgressors *is* hard.**

**Proverbs 13:15 (NKJV) Good understanding gains favor, But the way of the unfaithful *is* hard.**

**James 1:5 If any of you lack wisdom, let him ask of God, that giveth to all men liberally, and upbraideth not; and it shall be given him.**

**Luke 2:47 And all that heard Him were astonished at His understanding and answers.**

**Proverbs 13:16 (AV) Every prudent *man* dealeth with knowledge: but a fool layeth open *his* folly.**

**Proverbs 13:16 (NKJV) Every prudent *man* acts with knowledge, But a fool lays open *his* folly.**

**Proverbs 6:6 Go to the ant, thou sluggard; consider her ways, and be wise:**

**Proverbs 13:17 (AV) A wicked messenger falleth into mischief: but a faithful ambassador *is* health.**

**Proverbs 13:17 (NKJV) A wicked messenger falls into trouble, But a faithful ambassador *brings* health.**

**Proverbs 13:18 (AV) Poverty and shame *shall be to* him that refuseth instruction: but he that regardeth reproof shall be honoured.**

**Proverbs 13:18 (NKJV) Poverty and shame *will come* to him who disdains correction, But he who regards a rebuke will be honored.**

**Proverbs 13:19 (AV) The desire accomplished is sweet to the soul: but *it is* abomination to fools to depart from evil.**

**Proverbs 13:19 (NKJV) A desire accomplished is sweet to the soul, But *it is* an abomination to fools to depart from evil.**

**Proverbs 13:20 (AV) He that walketh with wise *men* shall be wise: but a companion of fools shall be destroyed.**

**Proverbs 13:20 (NKJV) He who walks with wise *men* will be wise, But the**

**companion of fools will be destroyed.**

**1 Corinthians 15:33 Do not be deceived: Evil company corrupts good habits.**  
**Proverbs 13:21 (AV) Evil pursueth sinners: but to the righteous good shall be repayed.** **Proverbs 13:21 (NKJV)**

**Evil pursues sinners, But to the righteous, good shall be repaid.**

**2 Samuel 12 Summarized of David's sin with Bathsheba. V12 For thou didst it secretly: but I will do this thing before all Israel, and before the sun.**

**Proverbs 13:22 (AV) A good *man* leaveth an inheritance to his children's children: and the wealth of the sinner is laid up for the just.**

**Proverbs 13:22 (NKJV) A good *man* leaves an inheritance to his children's children, But the wealth of the sinner is stored up for the righteous.**

**Exodus 12:36 And the LORD gave the people favour in the sight of the Egyptians, so that they lent unto them such things as they required. And they spoiled the Egyptians.**

**James 4:3 Ye ask, and receive not, because ye ask amiss, that ye may consume it upon your lusts.**

**Proverbs 13:23 (AV) Much food *is in* the tillage of the poor: but there is *that is* destroyed for want of judgment.**

**Proverbs 13:23 (NKJV) Much food *is in* the fallow *ground* of the poor, And for lack of justice there is waste.**

**Proverbs 13:24 (AV) He that spareth his rod hateth his son: but he that loveth him chasteneth him betimes.**

**Proverbs 13:24 (NKJV) He who spares his rod hates his son, But he who loves him disciplines him promptly.**

**Ephesians 6:4 And, ye fathers, provoke not your children to wrath: but bring them up in the nurture and admonition of the Lord.**

**Proverbs 22:6 Train up a child in the way he should go: and when he is old, he will not depart from it.**

**Proverbs 13:25 (AV) The righteous eateth to the satisfying of his soul: but the belly of the wicked shall want.**

**Proverbs 13:25 (NKJV) The righteous eats to the satisfying of his soul, But the stomach of the wicked shall be in want.**

**Luke 21:34 And take heed to yourselves, lest at any time your hearts be overcharged with surfeiting, and drunkenness, and cares of this life, and so that day come upon you unawares.**

**Matthew 7:14 Because strait is the gate, and narrow is the way, which leadeth unto life, and few there be that find it.**
