- Proverbs 14:1 (AV) Every wise woman buildeth her house: but the foolish plucketh it down with her hands.
- **Proverbs 31 Referred to the Virtuous Woman.**
- Matthew 18:18 Verily I say unto you, Whatsoever ye shall bind on earth shall be bound in heaven: and whatsoever ye shall loose on earth shall be loosed in heaven.
- Proverbs 14:1 (NKJV) The wise woman builds her house, But the foolish pulls it down with her hands.
- Proverbs 14:2 (AV) He that walketh in his uprightness feareth the LORD: but he that is perverse in his ways despiseth him.
- Proverbs 14:2 (NKJV) He who walks in his uprightness fears the LORD, But he who is perverse in his ways despises Him.
- Proverbs 1:7 The fear of the LORD is the beginning of knowledge: but fools despise wisdom and instruction.
- Proverbs 14:3 (AV) In the mouth of the foolish *is* a rod of pride: but the lips of the wise shall preserve them.
- Proverbs 14:3 (NKJV) In the mouth of a fool *is* a <u>rod of pride</u>, But the lips of the wise will preserve them.
- Proverbs 14:4 (AV) Where no oxen *are*, the crib *is* clean: but much increase *is* by the strength of the ox.
- Proverbs 14:4 (NKJV) Where no oxen *are*, the trough *is* clean; But much increase *comes* by the strength of an ox.
- Proverbs 14:5 (AV) A faithful witness will not lie: but a false witness will utter lies.
- Proverbs 14:5 (NKJV) A faithful witness does not lie, But a false witness will utter lies.
- Matthew 16:19 And I will give unto thee the keys of the kingdom of heaven: and whatsoever thou shalt bind on earth shall be bound in heaven: and whatsoever thou shalt loose on earth shall be loosed in heaven.
- Acts 8:11 And to him they had regard, because that of long time he had

- bewitched them with sorceries.
- Proverbs 14:6 (AV) A scorner seeketh wisdom, and *findeth it* not: but knowledge *is* easy unto him that understandeth.
- Proverbs 14:6 (NKJV) A scoffer seeks wisdom and does not *find it*, But knowledge *is* easy to him who understands.
- Proverbs 21:24 Proud and haughty scorner is his name, who dealeth in proud wrath.
- Romans 8:31 What shall we then say to these things? If God be for us, who can be against us?
- Proverbs 14:7 (AV) Go from the presence of a foolish man, when thou perceivest not *in him* the lips of knowledge.
- Proverbs 14:7 (NKJV) Go from the presence of a foolish man, When you do not perceive *in him* the lips of knowledge.
- 1 Corinthians 15:33 Do not be deceived: Evil company corrupts good habits.
- Hebrews 5:12-14 12 For when for the time ye ought to be teachers, ye have need that one teach you again which be the first principles of the oracles of God; and are become such as have need of milk, and not of strong meat. 13 For every one that useth milk is unskilful in the Word of righteousness: for he is a babe. 14 But strong meat belongeth to them that are of full age, even those who by reason of use have their senses exercised to discern both good and evil.

- Mark 16:17 And these signs shall follow them that believe; In my name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues;
- Proverbs 14:9 (AV) Fools make a mock at sin: but among the righteous *there* is favour.

- Hebrews 13:5 Let your conversation be without covetousness; and be content with such things as ye have: for He hath said, I will never leave thee, nor forsake thee.
- Proverbs 14:11 (AV) The house of the wicked shall be overthrown: but the tabernacle of the upright shall flourish.
- Proverbs 14:11 (NKJV) The house of the wicked will be overthrown, But the tent of the upright will flourish.
- Matthew 7 Referred to the 2 houses built 1 on rock, & 1 on sand.
- Proverbs 14:12 (AV) There is a way which seemeth right unto a man, but the end thereof *are* the ways of death.
- Proverbs 14:12 (NKJV) There is a way *that seems* right to a man, But its end *is* the way of death.
- Romans 2:23 For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God;
- John 3:7 Marvel not that I said unto thee, Ye must be born again.
- John 14:6 Jesus saith unto him, I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by Me.
- Proverbs 14:13 (AV) Even in laughter the heart is sorrowful; and the end of that mirth *is* heaviness.
- Proverbs 14:13 (NKJV) Even in laughter the heart may sorrow, And the end of mirth *may be* grief.
- Proverbs 14:14 (AV) The backslider in heart shall be filled with his own ways: and a good man *shall be satisfied* from himself.
- Proverbs 14:14 (NKJV) The backslider in heart will be filled with his own ways, But a good man will be satisfied from above.
- John 14:26 But the Comforter, which is the Holy Ghost, whom the Father will

- send in my name, he shall teach you all things, and bring all things to your remembrance, whatsoever I have said unto you.
- Proverbs 14:15 (AV) The simple believeth every word: but the prudent *man* looketh well to his going.
- Proverbs 14:15 (NKJV) The simple believes every word, But the prudent considers well his steps.
- Proverbs 14:16 (AV) A wise *man* feareth, and departeth from evil: but the fool rageth, and is confident.
- Proverbs 14:16 (NKJV) A wise *man* fears and departs from evil, But a fool rages and is self-confident.
- Proverbs 14:17 (AV) *He that is* soon angry dealeth foolishly: and a man of wicked devices is hated.
- Proverbs 14:17 (NKJV) A quick-tempered *man* acts foolishly, And a man of wicked intentions is hated.
- 1 Timothy 2:1,2 I exhort therefore, that, first of all, supplications, prayers, intercessions, and giving of thanks, be made for all men; 2 For kings, and for all that are in authority; that we may lead a quiet and peaceable life in all godliness and honesty.
- Proverbs 14:18 (AV) The simple inherit folly: but the prudent are crowned with knowledge.
- Proverbs 14:18 (NKJV) The simple inherit folly, But the prudent are crowned with knowledge.
- Proverbs 14:19 (AV) The evil bow before the good; and the wicked at the gates of the righteous.
- Proverbs 14:19 (NKJV) The evil will bow before the good, And the wicked at the gates of the righteous.
- Referred to God raising up His people from prison to Authority Joseph, Daniel, & Esther.
- Proverbs 14:20 (AV) The poor is hated even of his own neighbour: but the rich *hath* many friends.
- Proverbs 14:20 (NKJV) The poor *man* is hated even by his own neighbor, But the rich *has* many friends.
- Luke 15 Referred to the parable of the prodigal son.
- Proverbs 14:21 (AV) He that despiseth his neighbour sinneth: but he that hath mercy on the poor, happy *is* he.
- Proverbs 14:21 (NKJV) He who despises his neighbor sins; But he who has mercy on the poor, happy *is* he.
- John 12:8 For the poor always ye have with you; but me ye have not always.
- Proverbs 14:22 (AV) Do they not err that devise evil? but mercy and truth shall be to them that devise good.
- Proverbs 14:22 (NKJV) Do they not go astray who devise evil? But mercy and

- truth belong to those who devise good.
- Proverbs 14:23 (AV) In all labour there is profit: but the talk of the lips *tendeth* only to penury.
- Proverbs 14:23 (NKJV) In all labor there is profit, But idle chatter *leads* only to poverty.
- Proverbs 14:24 (AV) The crown of the wise *is* their riches: *but* the foolishness of fools *is* folly.
- Proverbs 14:24 (NKJV) The crown of the wise is their riches, *But* the foolishness of fools *is* folly.
- Proverbs 14:1 (AV) Every wise woman buildeth her house: but the foolish plucketh it down with her hands.
- Proverbs 14:25 (AV) A true witness delivereth souls: but a deceitful *witness* speaketh lies.
- Proverbs 14:25 (NKJV) A true witness delivers souls, But a deceitful *witness* speaks lies.
- Proverbs 14:26 (AV) In the fear of the LORD *is* strong confidence: and his children shall have a place of refuge.
- Proverbs 14:26 (NKJV) In the fear of the LORD *there is* strong confidence, And His children will have a place of refuge.
- Hebrews 13:5 Let your conversation be without covetousness; and be content with such things as ye have: for he hath said, I will never leave thee, nor forsake thee.
- Romans 8:38,39 For I am persuaded, that neither death, nor life, nor angels, nor principalities, nor powers, nor things present, nor things to come, 39 Nor height, nor depth, nor any other creature, shall be able to separate us from the love of God, which is in Christ Jesus our Lord.
- Proverbs 14:27 (AV) The fear of the LORD *is* a fountain of life, to depart from the snares of death.
- Proverbs 14:27 (NKJV) The fear of the LORD *is* a fountain of life, To turn *one* away from the snares of death.
- Proverbs 14:28 (AV) In the multitude of people *is* the king's honour: but in the want of people *is* the destruction of the prince.
- Proverbs 14:28 (NKJV) In a multitude of people *is* a king's honor, But in the lack of people *is* the downfall of a prince.
- Proverbs 14:29 (AV) *He that is* slow to wrath *is* of great understanding: but *he that is* hasty of spirit exalteth folly.
- Proverbs 14:29 (NKJV) *He who is* slow to wrath has great understanding, But *he who is* impulsive exalts folly.
- Proverbs 14:30 (AV) A sound heart *is* the life of the flesh: but envy the rottenness of the bones.
- Proverbs 14:30 (NKJV) A sound heart is life to the body, But envy is

- rottenness to the bones.
- Proverbs 14:31 (AV) He that oppresseth the poor reproacheth his Maker: but he that honoureth him hath mercy on the poor.
- Proverbs 14:31 (NKJV) He who oppresses the poor reproaches his Maker, But he who honors Him has mercy on the needy.
- Proverbs 14:32 (AV) The wicked is driven away in his wickedness: but the righteous hath hope in his death.
- Proverbs 14:32 (NKJV) The wicked is banished in his wickedness, But the righteous has a refuge in his death.
- 2 Corinthians 5:8 We are confident, I say, and willing rather to be absent from the body, and to be present with the Lord.
- Luke Referred to the account of Lazarus & the Rich man.
- Proverbs 14:33 (AV) Wisdom resteth in the heart of him that hath understanding: but *that which is* in the midst of fools is made known.
- Proverbs 14:33 (NKJV) Wisdom rests in the heart of him who has understanding, But *what is* in the heart of fools is made known.
- James 1:5 If any of you lack wisdom, let him ask of God, that giveth to all men liberally, and upbraideth not; and it shall be given him.
- Proverbs 14:34 (AV) Righteousness exalteth a nation: but sin *is* a reproach to any people.
- Proverbs 14:34 (NKJV) Righteousness exalts a nation, But sin *is* a reproach to *any* people.
- Proverbs 14:35 (AV) The king's favour *is* toward a wise servant: but his wrath is *against* him that causeth shame.
- Proverbs 14:35 (NKJV) The king's favor *is* toward a wise servant, But his wrath *is against* him who causes shame.
- Matthew 24:12 And because iniquity shall abound, the love of many shall wax cold.
- Hebrews 5:14 14 But strong meat belongeth to them that are of full age, even those who by reason of use have their senses exercised to discern both good and evil.
