- Proverbs 15:6 (AV) In the house of the righteous *is* much treasure: but in the revenues of the wicked is trouble.
- Proverbs 15:6 (NKJV) *In* the house of the righteous *there is* much treasure, But in the revenue of the wicked is trouble.
- Proverbs 31 Referred to the Virtuous woman.
- Proverbs 15:7 (AV) The lips of the wise disperse knowledge: but the heart of the foolish *doeth* not so.
- Proverbs 15:7 (NKJV) The lips of the wise disperse knowledge, But the heart of the fool *does* not *do* so.
- Proverbs 15:8 (AV) The sacrifice of the wicked *is* an abomination to the LORD: but the prayer of the upright *is* his delight.
- Proverbs 15:8 (NKJV) The sacrifice of the wicked *is* an abomination to the LORD, But the prayer of the upright *is* His delight.
- Matthew 15:8 This people draweth nigh unto me with their mouth, and honoureth me with their lips; but their heart is far from me.
- Genesis 4 Summarized of Cain & Abel's sacrifices.
- Proverbs 15:9 (AV) The way of the wicked *is* an abomination unto the LORD: but he loveth him that followeth after righteousness.

- Job 1:21,22 And said, Naked came I out of my mother's womb, and naked shall I return thither: the LORD gave, and the LORD hath taken away; blessed be the name of the LORD. 22 In all this Job sinned not, nor charged God foolishly.
- 2 Corinthians 11 Referred to Paul's in Perils list.
- 1 Thessalonians 5:18 In every thing give thanks: for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus concerning you.
- Proverbs 15:16 (AV) Better *is* little with the fear of the LORD than great treasure and trouble therewith.
- Proverbs 15:16 (NKJV) Better *is* a little with the fear of the LORD, Than great treasure with trouble.
- Proverbs 15:17 (AV) Better *is* a dinner of herbs where love is, than a stalled ox and hatred therewith.
- Proverbs 15:17 (NKJV) Better *is* a dinner of herbs where love is, Than a fatted calf with hatred.
- Luke 15:29,30 And he answering said to his father, Lo, these many years do I serve thee, neither transgressed I at any time thy commandment: and yet thou never gavest me a kid, that I might make merry with my friends: 30 But as soon as this thy son was come, which hath devoured thy living with harlots, thou hast killed for him the fatted calf.
- Proverbs 15:18 (AV) A wrathful man stirreth up strife: but *he that is* slow to anger appeaseth strife.
- Proverbs 15:18 (NKJV) A wrathful man stirs up strife, But *he who is* slow to anger allays contention.
- Proverbs 15:19 (AV) The way of the slothful *man is* as an hedge of thorns: but the way of the righteous *is* made plain.
- Proverbs 15:19 (NKJV) The way of the lazy *man is* like a hedge of thorns, But the way of the upright *is* a highway.
- Proverbs 15:20 (AV) A wise son maketh a glad father: but a foolish man despiseth his mother.
- Proverbs 15:20 (NKJV) A wise son makes a father glad, But a foolish man despises his mother.
- Proverbs 15:21 (AV) Folly is joy to him that is destitute of wisdom: but a man

- of understanding walketh uprightly.
- Proverbs 15:21 (NKJV) Folly *is* joy *to him who is* destitute of discernment, But a man of understanding walks uprightly.
- Proverbs 15:22 (AV) Without counsel purposes are disappointed: but in the multitude of counsellors they are established.
- Proverbs 15:22 (NKJV) Without counsel, plans go awry, But in the multitude of counselors they are established.
- Proverbs 15:23 (AV) A man hath joy by the answer of his mouth: and a word spoken in due season, how good is it!
- Proverbs 15:23 (NKJV) A man has joy by the answer of his mouth, And a word spoken in due season, how good it is!
- Psalms 23:1 « A Psalm of David. » The LORD is my shepherd; I shall not want. ...
- Galatians 6:1 Brethren, if a man be overtaken in a fault, ye which are spiritual, restore such an one in the spirit of meekness; considering thyself, lest thou also be tempted.
- Romans 12:3 For I say, through the grace given unto me, to every man that is among you, not to think of himself more highly than he ought to think; but to think soberly, according as God hath dealt to every man the measure of faith.
- Proverbs 15:24 (AV) The way of life *is* above to the wise, that he may depart from hell beneath.
- Proverbs 15:24 (NKJV) The way of life *winds* upward for the wise, That he may turn away from hell below.
- Isaiah 35:8 And an highway shall be there, and a way, and it shall be called The way of holiness; the unclean shall not pass over it; but it shall be for those: the wayfaring men, though fools, shall not err therein.
- 2 Corinthians 5:8 We are confident, I say, and willing rather to be absent from the body, and to be present with the Lord.
- Proverbs 15:25 (AV) The LORD will destroy the house of the proud: but he will establish the border of the widow.
- Proverbs 15:25 (NKJV) The LORD will destroy the house of the proud, But He will establish the boundary of the widow.
- Proverbs 15:26 (AV) The thoughts of the wicked *are* an abomination to the LORD: but *the words* of the pure *are* pleasant words.
- Proverbs 15:26 (NKJV) The thoughts of the wicked *are* an abomination to the LORD, But the words of the pure *are* pleasant.
- Proverbs 15:27 (AV) He that is greedy of gain troubleth his own house; but he that hateth gifts shall live.
- Proverbs 15:27 (NKJV) He who is greedy for gain troubles his own house, But

- he who hates bribes will live.
- Proverbs 13:11 Wealth gotten by vanity shall be diminished: but he that gathereth by labour shall increase.
- Proverbs 15:28 (AV) The heart of the righteous studieth to answer: but the mouth of the wicked poureth out evil things.
- Proverbs 15:28 (NKJV) The heart of the righteous studies how to answer, But the mouth of the wicked pours forth evil.
- Proverbs 15:29 (AV) The LORD *is* far from the wicked: but he heareth the prayer of the righteous.
- Proverbs 15:29 (NKJV) The LORD *is* far from the wicked, But He hears the prayer of the righteous.
- Referred to Saul's demise.
- Luke 18:14 I tell you, this man (Publican) went down to his house justified rather than the other (Pharisee): for every one that exalteth himself shall be abased; and he that humbleth himself shall be exalted.
- Proverbs 15:30 (AV) The light of the eyes rejoiceth the heart: *and* a good report maketh the bones fat.
- Proverbs 15:30 (NKJV) The light of the eyes rejoices the heart, *And* a good report makes the bones healthy.
- Proverbs 15:31 (AV) The ear that heareth the reproof of life abideth among the wise.
- Proverbs 15:31 (NKJV) The ear that hears the rebukes of life Will abide among the wise.
- Proverbs 15:32 (AV) He that refuseth instruction despiseth his own soul: but he that heareth reproof getteth understanding.
- Proverbs 15:32 (NKJV) He who disdains instruction despises his own soul, But he who heeds rebuke gets understanding.
- Proverbs 15:33 (AV) The fear of the LORD *is* the instruction of wisdom; and before honour *is* humility.
- Proverbs 15:33 (NKJV) The fear of the LORD *is* the instruction of wisdom, And before honor *is* humility.
- Numbers 12:3 (Now the man Moses was very meek, above all the men which were upon the face of the earth.)
