- Psalms 140:5 The proud have hid a snare for me, and cords; they have spread a net by the wayside; they have set gins for me. Selah.
- Hebrews 13:5 Let your conversation be without covetousness; and be content with such things as ye have: for he hath said, I will never leave thee, nor forsake thee.
- 1 John 4:4 Ye are of God, little children, and have overcome them: because greater is He that is in you, than he that is in the world.
- **Proverbs 16:1-33 (AV) & (NKJV)**
- Proverbs 16:1 (AV) The preparations of the heart in man, and the answer of the tongue, *is* from the LORD.
- Proverbs 16:1 (NKJV) The preparations of the heart *belong* to man, But the answer of the tongue *is* from the LORD.
- Daniel 1:8 But Daniel purposed in his heart that he would not defile himself with the portion of the king's meat, nor with the wine which he drank: therefore he requested of the prince of the eunuchs that he might not defile himself.
- Colossians 3:23 And whatsoever ye do, do it heartily, as to the Lord, and not unto men;
- Ezra 7:10 For Ezra had prepared his heart to seek the law of the LORD, and to do it, and to teach in Israel statutes and judgments.

- Referred to the kings that did right in their own eyes was evil in the sight of God.
- Leviticus 19 Referred to God's laws.
- Proverbs 16:3 (AV) Commit thy works unto the LORD, and thy thoughts shall be established.
- Proverbs 16:3 (NKJV) Commit your works to the LORD, And your thoughts will be established.

- Psalms 37:5 Commit thy way unto the LORD; trust also in him; and he shall bring it to pass.
- Mark 7:6 He answered and said unto them, Well hath Esaias prophesied of you hypocrites, as it is written, This people honoureth Me with their lips, but their heart is far from Me.

- Proverbs 16:23 (AV) The heart of the wise teacheth his mouth, and addeth learning to his lips.
- Proverbs 16:23 (NKJV) The heart of the wise teaches his mouth, And adds learning to his lips.
- Proverbs 16:24 (AV) Pleasant words *are as* an honeycomb, sweet to the soul, and health to the bones.
- Proverbs 16:24 (NKJV) Pleasant words *are like* a honeycomb, Sweetness to the soul and health to the bones.
- Proverbs 16:25 (AV) There is a way that seemeth right unto a man, but the end thereof *are* the ways of death.
- Proverbs 16:25 (NKJV) There is a way *that seems* right to a man, But its end *is* the way of death.
- Proverbs 16:26 (AV) He that laboureth laboureth for himself; for his mouth craveth it of him.
- Proverbs 16:26 (NKJV) The person who labors, labors for himself, For his *hungry* mouth drives him *on*.
- 2 Thessalonians 3:10 For even when we were with you, this we commanded you, that if any would not work, neither should he eat.

- Proverbs 16:27 (AV) An ungodly man diggeth up evil: and in his lips *there is* as a burning fire.
- Proverbs 16:27 (NKJV) An ungodly man digs up evil, And *it is* on his lips like a burning fire.
- Proverbs 16:28 (AV) A froward man soweth strife: and a whisperer separateth chief friends.
- Proverbs 16:28 (NKJV) A perverse (backsliding) man sows strife, And a whisperer separates the best of friends.
- John 10:10 The thief cometh not, but for to steal, and to kill, and to destroy: I am come that they might have life, and that they might have it more abundantly.
- Proverbs 16:29 (AV) A violent man enticeth his neighbour, and leadeth him into the way *that is* not good.
- Proverbs 16:29 (NKJV) A violent man entices his neighbor, And leads him in a way *that is* not good.
- Proverbs 16:30 (AV) He shutteth his eyes to devise froward things: moving his lips he bringeth evil to pass.
- Proverbs 16:30 (NKJV) He winks his eye to devise perverse things; He purses his lips *and* brings about evil.
- Proverbs 16:31 (AV) The hoary head *is* a crown of glory, *if* it be found in the way of righteousness.
- Proverbs 16:31 (NKJV) The silver-haired head *is* a crown of glory, *If* it is found in the way of righteousness.
- Proverbs 16:32 (AV) *He that is* slow to anger *is* better than the mighty; and he that ruleth his spirit than he that taketh a city.
- Proverbs 16:32 (NKJV) *He who is* slow to anger *is* better than the mighty, And he who rules his spirit than he who takes a city.
- Proverbs 16:33 (AV) The lot is cast into the lap; but the whole disposing thereof *is* of the LORD.
