- Galatians 6:3 (AV) For if a man think himself to be something, when he is nothing, he deceiveth himself.
- Galatians 6:3 (NKJV) For if anyone thinks himself to be something, when he is nothing, he deceives himself.
- Proverbs 16:18 Pride goeth before destruction, and an haughty spirit before a fall.
- James 4:10 Humble yourselves in the sight of the Lord, and He shall lift you up.
- Matthew 3:2 And (John the Baptist) saying, Repent ye: for the kingdom of heaven is at hand.
- Matthew 4:17 From that time Jesus began to preach, and to say, Repent: for the kingdom of heaven is at hand.

- Galatians 6:7 (AV) Be not deceived; God is not mocked: for whatsoever a man soweth, that shall he also reap.
- Galatians 6:7 (NKJV) Do not be deceived, God is not mocked; for whatever a man sows, that he will also reap.
- Hebrews 5:14 But strong meat belongeth to them that are of full age, even those who by reason of use have their senses exercised to discern both good and evil.
- 2 Samuel 12 Referred to David's sin with Bathsheba. V14 Howbeit, because by this deed thou hast given great occasion to the enemies of the LORD to blaspheme, the child also *that is* born unto thee shall surely die.
- 1 John 1:9 If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.
- John 11 Referred to Lazarus raised.
- Galatians 6:8 (AV) For he that soweth to his flesh shall of the flesh reap corruption; but he that soweth to the Spirit shall of the Spirit reap life everlasting.
- Galatians 6:8 (NKJV) For he who sows to his flesh will of the flesh reap corruption, but he who sows to the Spirit will of the Spirit reap everlasting life.
- Genesis 18 Summarized of Abraham bargaining with God to save the ungodly if 10 righteous.
- Genesis 19:26 But his (Lot's) wife looked back from behind him, and she became a pillar of salt.
- Hebrews 9:27 And as it is appointed unto men once to die, but after this the judgment:

- Romans 12:3 (NKJV) For I say, through the grace given to me, to everyone who is among you, not to think *of himself* more highly than he ought to think, but to think soberly, as God has dealt to each one a measure of faith.
- 2 Corinthians 13:5 Examine yourselves, whether ye be in the faith; prove your own selves. Know ye not your own selves, how that Jesus Christ is in you, except ye be reprobates?
