- Ezekiel 3:4 And He said unto me, Son of man, go, get thee unto the house of Israel, and speak with My Words unto them. 7 But the house of Israel will not hearken unto thee; for they will not hearken unto Me: for all the house of Israel are impudent and hardhearted.
- 2 Timothy 2:15 Study to shew thyself approved unto God, a workman that needeth not to be ashamed, rightly dividing the Word of Truth.
- Proverbs 17:1-28 (AV) & (NKJV)
- Proverbs 17:1 (AV) Better *is* a dry morsel, and quietness therewith, than an house full of sacrifices *with* strife.
- Proverbs 17:1 (NKJV) Better *is* a dry morsel with quietness, Than a house full of feasting *with* strife.
- Proverbs 17:2 (AV) A wise servant shall have rule over a son that causeth shame, and shall have part of the inheritance among the brethren.
- Proverbs 17:2 (NKJV) A wise servant will rule over a son who causes shame, And will share an inheritance among the brothers.
- Genesis 24 Referred to Abraham's servant sent to get a wife for Isaac.
- Proverbs 17:3 (AV) The fining pot *is* for silver, and the furnace for gold: but the LORD trieth the hearts.
- Proverbs 17:3 (NKJV) The refining pot *is* for silver and the furnace for gold, But the LORD tests the hearts.
- Isaiah 35:8 And an highway shall be there, and a way, and it shall be called The way of holiness; the unclean shall not pass over it; but it shall be for those: the wayfaring men, though fools, shall not err therein.
- Proverbs 17:4 (AV) A wicked doer giveth heed to false lips; *and* a liar giveth ear to a naughty tongue.
- Proverbs 17:4 (NKJV) An evildoer gives heed to false lips; A liar listens eagerly to a spiteful tongue.
- Luke 18:3,8 And there was a widow in that city; and she came unto him, saying, Avenge me of mine adversary. 8 I tell you that He will avenge them speedily. Nevertheless when the Son of Man cometh, shall He find faith on the earth?
- Proverbs 17:5 (AV) Whoso mocketh the poor reproacheth his Maker: *and* he that is glad at calamities shall not be unpunished.
- Proverbs 17:5 (NKJV) He who mocks the poor reproaches his Maker; He who is glad at calamity will not go unpunished.
- John 12:8 For the poor always ye have with you; but Me ye have not always.
- Acts 3:6 Then Peter said, Silver and gold have I none; but such as I have give I thee: In the Name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth rise up and walk.

- Job 1 & 2 Referred to Job tested.
- Proverbs 17:6 (AV) Children's children *are* the crown of old men; and the glory of children *are* their fathers.
- Proverbs 17:6 (NKJV) Children's children *are* the crown of old men, And the glory of children *is* their father.
- Psalms 127:3-5 Lo, children are an heritage of the LORD: and the fruit of the womb is his reward. 4 As arrows are in the hand of a mighty man; so are children of the youth. 5 Happy is the man that hath his quiver full of them: they shall not be ashamed, but they shall speak with the enemies in the gate.
- Ephesians 6:4 And, ye fathers, provoke not your children to wrath: but bring them up in the nurture and admonition of the Lord.
- Hebrews 5:14 But strong meat belongeth to them that are of full age, even those who by reason of use have their senses exercised to discern both good and evil.
- Proverbs 17:7 (AV) Excellent speech becometh not a fool: much less do lying lips a prince.
- Proverbs 17:7 (NKJV) Excellent speech is not becoming to a fool, Much less lying lips to a prince.
- Proverbs 17:8 (AV) A gift *is as* a precious stone in the eyes of him that hath it: whithersoever it turneth, it prospereth.
- Proverbs 17:8 (NKJV) A present *is* a precious stone in the eyes of its possessor; Wherever he turns, he prospers.
- Proverbs 17:9 (AV) He that covereth a transgression seeketh love; but he that repeateth a matter separateth *very* friends.
- Proverbs 17:9 (NKJV) He who covers a transgression seeks love, But he who repeats a matter separates friends.
- Galatians 6:1 Brethren, if a man be overtaken in a fault, ye which are spiritual, restore such an one in the spirit of meekness; considering thyself, lest thou also be tempted.
- Proverbs 17:10 (AV) A reproof entereth more into a wise man than an hundred stripes into a fool.
- Proverbs 17:10 (NKJV) Rebuke is more effective for a wise *man* Than a hundred blows on a fool.
- Proverbs 17:11 (AV) An evil *man* seeketh only rebellion: therefore a cruel messenger shall be sent against him.
- Proverbs 17:11 (NKJV) An evil *man* seeks only rebellion; Therefore a cruel messenger will be sent against him.
- John 10:10 The thief cometh not, but for to steal, and to kill, and to destroy: I am come that they might have life, and that they might have it more abundantly.
- 2 Corinthians 12:7 And lest I should be exalted above measure through the

- abundance of the revelations, there was given to me a thorn in the flesh, the messenger of Satan to buffet me, lest I should be exalted above measure.
- Numbers 22:23 And the ass saw the angel of the LORD standing in the way, and his sword drawn in his hand: and the ass turned aside out of the way, and went into the field: and Balaam smote the ass, to turn her into the way.
- 1 Kings 22:22 And the LORD said unto him, Wherewith? And he said, I will go forth, and I will be a lying spirit in the mouth of all his prophets. And he said, Thou shalt persuade him, and prevail also: go forth, and do so.

- 2 Kings 2:23 And he went up from thence unto Bethel: and as he was going up by the way, there came forth little children out of the city, and mocked him, and said unto him, Go up, thou bald head; go up, thou bald head. 24 And he turned back, and looked on them, and cursed them in the name of the LORD. And there came forth two she bears out of the wood, and tare forty and two children of them.

- Proverbs 17:13 (AV) Whoso rewardeth evil for good, evil shall not depart from his house.
- Proverbs 17:13 (NKJV) Whoever rewards evil for good, Evil will not depart from his house.
- Romans 12:19 Dearly beloved, avenge not yourselves, but rather give place unto wrath: for it is written, Vengeance is mine; I will repay, saith the Lord.
- Proverbs 17:14 (AV) The beginning of strife *is as* when one letteth out water: therefore leave off contention, before it be meddled with.
- Proverbs 17:14 (NKJV) The beginning of strife *is like* releasing water; Therefore stop contention before a quarrel starts.
- Proverbs 17:15 (AV) He that justifieth the wicked, and he that condemneth the just, even they both *are* abomination to the LORD.
- Proverbs 17:15 (NKJV) He who justifies the wicked, and he who condemns the just, Both of them alike *are* an abomination to the LORD.
- Proverbs 6 Referred to the 7 things that are an abomination to the LORD
- Acts 22:7 And I fell unto the ground, and heard a voice saying unto me, Saul, Saul, why persecutest thou Me?
- Proverbs 17:16 (AV) Wherefore *is there* a price in the hand of a fool to get wisdom, seeing *he hath* no heart *to it*?

- Proverbs 17:16 (NKJV) Why *is there* in the hand of a fool the purchase price of wisdom, Since *he has* no heart *for it*?
- Proverbs 17:17 (AV) A friend loveth at all times, and a brother is born for adversity.
- Proverbs 17:17 (NKJV) A friend loves at all times, And a brother is born for adversity.
- Colossians 3:23 And whatsoever ye do, do it heartily, as to the Lord, and not unto men;
- Proverbs 17:18 (AV) A man void of understanding striketh hands, *and* becometh surety in the presence of his friend.
- Proverbs 17:18 (NKJV) A man devoid of understanding shakes hands in a pledge, *And* becomes surety for his friend.
- Proverbs 17:19 (AV) He loveth transgression that loveth strife: *and* he that exalteth his gate seeketh destruction.
- Proverbs 17:19 (NKJV) He who loves transgression (sin)loves strife, And he who exalts his gate seeks destruction.
- Proverbs 26:21 As coals are to burning coals, and wood to fire; so is a contentious man to kindle strife.
- Proverbs 17:20 (AV) He that hath a froward heart findeth no good: and he that hath a perverse tongue falleth into mischief.
- Proverbs 17:20 (NKJV) He who has a deceitful heart finds no good, And he who has a perverse tongue falls into evil.
- Galatians 3:1 O foolish Galatians, who hath bewitched you, that ye should not obey the truth, before whose eyes Jesus Christ hath been evidently set forth, crucified among you?
- Mark 7:21 For from within, out of the heart of men, proceed evil thoughts, adulteries, fornications, murders, 22 Thefts, covetousness, wickedness, deceit, lasciviousness, an evil eye, blasphemy, pride, foolishness: 23 All these evil things come from within, and defile the man.
- Galatians 5 Referred to the ungodly fruit of the flesh.
- Proverbs 17:21 (AV) He that begetteth a fool *doeth it* to his sorrow: and the father of a fool hath no joy.
- Proverbs 17:21 (NKJV) He who begets a scoffer *does so* to his sorrow, And the father of a fool has no joy.
- Proverbs 17:22 (AV) A merry heart doeth good *like* a medicine: but a broken spirit drieth the bones.
- Proverbs 17:22 (NKJV) A merry heart does good, *like* medicine, But a broken spirit dries the bones.
- Job 1:21 And said, Naked came I out of my mother's womb, and naked shall I return thither: the LORD gave, and the LORD hath taken away; blessed be the name of the LORD.
- Psalms 31:15 My times are in thy hand: deliver me from the hand of mine

- enemies, and from them that persecute me.
- Hebrews 13:5 Let your conversation be without covetousness; and be content with such things as ye have: for He hath said, I will never leave thee, nor forsake thee.
- Proverbs 17:23 (AV) A wicked *man* taketh a gift out of the bosom to pervert the ways of judgment.
- Proverbs 17:23 (NKJV) A wicked *man* accepts a bribe behind the back To pervert the ways of justice.
- Proverbs 17:24 (AV) Wisdom *is* before him that hath understanding; but the eyes of a fool *are* in the ends of the earth.
- Proverbs 17:24 (NKJV) Wisdom *is* in the sight of him who has understanding, But the eyes of a fool *are* on the ends of the earth.
- 1 Corinthians 13:11 When I was a child, I spake as a child, I understood as a child, I thought as a child: but when I became a man, I put away childish things.
- Proverbs 17:25 (AV) A foolish son *is* a grief to his father, and bitterness to her that bare him.
- Proverbs 17:25 (NKJV) A foolish son *is* a grief to his father, And bitterness to her who bore him.
- Ephesians 6:4 And, ye fathers, provoke not your children to wrath: but bring them up in the nurture and admonition of the Lord.
- Luke 15:17 And when he came to himself, he said, How many hired servants of my father's have bread enough and to spare, and I perish with hunger!
- Proverbs 17:26 (AV) Also to punish the just *is* not good, *nor* to strike princes for equity.
- Proverbs 17:26 (NKJV) Also, to punish the righteous *is* not good, *Nor* to strike princes for *their* uprightness.
- Proverbs 17:27 (AV) He that hath knowledge spareth his words: *and* a man of understanding is of an excellent spirit.
- Proverbs 17:27 (NKJV) He who has knowledge spares his words, *And* a man of understanding is of a calm spirit.
- Proverbs 17:28 (AV) Even a fool, when he holdeth his peace, is counted wise: and he that shutteth his lips is esteemed a man of understanding.
- Proverbs 17:28 (NKJV) Even a fool is counted wise when he holds his peace; *When* he shuts his lips, *he is considered* perceptive.
- Mark 13:31 Heaven and earth shall pass away: but my words shall not pass away.
