- Matthew 22:37-39 Jesus said unto him, Thou shalt love the Lord thy God with all thy heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy mind. 38 This is the first and great commandment. 39 And the second is like unto it, Thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself.
- Deuteronomy 6:5 And thou shalt love the LORD thy God with all thine heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy might.
- Leviticus 19:18 Thou shalt not avenge, nor bear any grudge against the children of thy people, but thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself: I am the LORD.
- Proverbs 18:1-26 (AV) & (NKJV)
- Proverbs 18:1 (AV) Through desire a man, having separated himself, seeketh and intermeddleth with all wisdom.
- Proverbs 18:1 (NKJV) A man who isolates himself seeks his own desire; He rages against all wise judgment.
- Proverbs 18:2 (AV) A fool hath no delight in understanding, but that his heart may discover itself.
