Wise Sayings Of Solomon 10 - Proverbs 19

- Referred to Solomon fine tuning the 10 commandments.
- Matthew 22:37-39 Jesus said unto him, Thou shalt love the Lord thy God with all thy heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy mind. 38 This is the first and great commandment. 39 And the second is like unto it, Thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself.
- Matthew 10:37 He that loveth father or mother more than Me is not worthy of Me: and he that loveth son or daughter more than Me is not worthy of Me.
- Proverbs 19:1-29 (AV) & (NKJV)
- Proverbs 19:1 (AV) Better *is* the poor that walketh in his integrity, than *he* that is perverse in his lips, and is a fool.
- Proverbs 19:1 (NKJV) Better *is* the poor who walks in his integrity Than *one* who is perverse in his lips, and is a fool.
- Job 1:21,22 And said, Naked came I out of my mother's womb, and naked shall I return thither: the LORD gave, and the LORD hath taken away; blessed be the Name of the LORD. 22 In all this Job sinned not, nor charged God foolishly.
- Proverbs 19:2 (AV) Also, *that* the soul (person) *be* without knowledge, *it is* not good; and he that hasteth with *his* feet sinneth.
- Proverbs 19:2 (NKJV) Also it is not good *for* a soul *to be* without knowledge, And he sins who hastens with *his* feet.
- Revelation 13 Referred to ungodly globalism under the beast.
- Revelation 19:11 Referred to Jesus' return with Godly Globalism.
- Proverbs 19:3 (AV) The foolishness of man perverteth his way: and his heart fretteth against the LORD.
- Proverbs 19:3 (NKJV) The foolishness of a man twists his way, And his heart frets against the LORD.
- Genesis 6:5 And GOD saw that the wickedness of man was great in the earth, and that every imagination of the thoughts of his heart was only evil continually.
- Numbers 22 Referred to Balaam & the angel of the Lord standing to kill him.
- Proverbs 19:4 (AV) Wealth maketh many friends; but the poor is separated from his neighbour.
- Proverbs 19:4 (NKJV) Wealth makes many friends, But the poor is separated from his friend.
- Revelation 18:4 And I heard another voice from heaven, saying, Come out of her, My people, that ye be not partakers of her sins, and that ye receive

- not of her plagues.
- Proverbs 19:5 (AV) A false witness shall not be unpunished, and *he that* speaketh lies shall not escape.
- Proverbs 19:5 (NKJV) A false witness will not go unpunished, And *he who* speaks lies will not escape.
- 1 John 1:9 If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.
- Deuteronomy 19:14,15 Thou shalt not remove thy neighbour's landmark, which they of old time have set in thine inheritance, which thou shalt inherit in the land that the LORD thy God giveth thee to possess it. 15 One witness shall not rise up against a man for any iniquity, or for any sin, in any sin that he sinneth: at the mouth of two witnesses, or at the mouth of three witnesses, shall the matter be established.
- 1 Timothy 5:19 Against an elder (pastor) receive not an accusation, but before two or three witnesses.
- Deuteronomy 19:16-21 If a false witness rise up against any man to testify against him that which is wrong; 17 Then both the men, between whom the controversy is, shall stand before the LORD, before the priests and the judges, which shall be in those days; 18 And the judges shall make diligent inquisition: and, behold, if the witness be a false witness, and hath testified falsely against his brother; 19 Then shall ye do unto him, as he had thought to have done unto his brother: so shalt thou put the evil away from among you. 20 And those which remain shall hear, and fear, and shall henceforth commit no more any such evil among you. 21 And thine eye shall not pity; but life shall go for life, eye for eye, tooth for tooth, hand for hand, foot for foot.
- Exodus 20:8 And all the people saw the thunderings, and the lightnings, and the noise of the trumpet, and the mountain smoking: and when the people saw it, they removed, and stood afar off.
- Numbers 14 Summarized of the false reports from the ungodly spies & God's judgment.
- Proverbs 19:6 (AV) Many will intreat the favour of the prince: and every man *is* a friend to him that giveth gifts.
- Proverbs 19:6 (NKJV) Many entreat the favor of the nobility, And every man *is* a friend to one who gives gifts.
- Proverbs 19:7 (AV) All the brethren of the poor do hate him: how much more do his friends go far from him? he pursueth *them with* words, *yet* they *are* wanting *to him*.
- Proverbs 19:7 (NKJV) All the brothers of the poor hate him; How much more do his friends go far from him! He may pursue *them with* words, *yet* they

- abandon *him*.
- Proverbs 19:8 (AV) He that getteth wisdom loveth his own soul: he that keepeth understanding shall find good.
- Proverbs 19:8 (NKJV) He who gets wisdom loves his own soul; He who keeps understanding will find good.
- Proverbs 19:9 (AV) A false witness shall not be unpunished, and *he that* speaketh lies shall perish.
- Proverbs 19:9 (NKJV) A false witness will not go unpunished, And *he who* speaks lies shall perish.
- Proverbs 19:10 (AV) Delight is not seemly for a fool; much less for a servant to have rule over princes.
- Proverbs 19:10 (NKJV) Luxury is not fitting for a fool, Much less for a servant to rule over princes.
- Proverbs 19:11 (AV) The discretion of a man deferreth his anger; and *it is* his glory to pass over a transgression.
- Proverbs 19:11 (NKJV) The discretion of a man makes him slow to anger, And his glory *is* to overlook a transgression.
- Matthew 14:14 And Jesus went forth, and saw a great multitude, and was moved with compassion toward them, and he healed their sick.
- Luke 20:23 But He perceived their craftiness, and said unto them, Why tempt ye Me?
- Daniel 6 Summarized of Daniel falsly accused & the lions' den. V24 And the king commanded, and they brought those men which had accused Daniel, and they cast them into the den of lions, them, their children, and their wives; and the lions had the mastery of them, and brake all their bones in pieces or ever they came at the bottom of the den.
- Esther 8:4 Then the king held out the golden sceptre toward Esther. So Esther arose, and stood before the king,
- Proverbs 19:12 (AV) The king's wrath *is* as the roaring of a lion; but his favour *is* as dew upon the grass.
- Proverbs 19:12 (NKJV) The king's wrath *is* like the roaring of a lion, But his favor *is* like dew on the grass.
- 1 Samuel 17 & 18 Summarized of David & Absalom.
- Proverbs 19:13 (AV) A foolish son *is* the calamity of his father: and the contentions of a wife *are* a continual dropping.
- Proverbs 19:13 (NKJV) A foolish son *is* the ruin of his father, And the contentions of a wife *are* a continual dripping.
- 1 Kings 11 Referred to Solomon's many wives.
- Proverbs 19:14 (AV) House and riches *are* the inheritance of fathers: and a prudent wife *is* from the LORD.

- Proverbs 19:14 (NKJV) Houses and riches *are* an inheritance from fathers, But a prudent wife *is* from the LORD.
- Proverbs 19:15 (AV) Slothfulness casteth into a deep sleep; and an idle soul shall suffer hunger.
- Proverbs 19:15 (NKJV) Laziness casts *one* into a deep sleep, And an idle person will suffer hunger.
- Ephesians 4:28 Let him that stole steal no more: but rather let him labour, working with his hands the thing which is good, that he may have to give to him that needeth.
- Colossians 3:23 And whatsoever ye do, do it heartily, as to the Lord, and not unto men;
- Proverbs 19:16 (AV) He that keepeth the commandment keepeth his own soul; *but* he that despiseth his ways shall die.
- Proverbs 19:16 (NKJV) He who keeps the commandment keeps his soul, *But* he who is careless of his ways will die.
- Proverbs 19:17 (AV) He that hath pity upon the poor lendeth unto the LORD; and that which he hath given will He pay him again.
- Proverbs 19:17 (NKJV) He who has pity on the poor lends to the LORD, And He will pay back what he has given.
- Proverbs 19:18 (AV) Chasten thy son while there is hope, and let not thy soul spare for his crying.
- Proverbs 19:18 (NKJV) Chasten your son while there is hope, And do not set your heart on his destruction.

God is a God of order.

- 1 Corinthians 14:40 Let all things be done decently and in order.
- Exodus 25:9 According to all that I shew thee (Moses), after the pattern of the tabernacle, and the pattern of all the instruments thereof, even so shall ye make it.
- 1 Chronicles 28:11,12 Then David gave to Solomon his son the pattern of the porch, & of the houses thereof, & of the treasuries thereof, & of the upper chambers thereof, & of the inner parlours thereof, & of the place of the mercy seat, 12 And the pattern of all that he had by the spirit, of the courts of the house of the LORD, & of all the chambers round about, of the treasuries of the house of God, & of the treasuries of the dedicated things:
- 1 Corinthians 11:3 But I would have you know, that the head of every man is Christ; & the head of the woman is the man; & the head of Christ is God.

- Proverbs 19:19 (NKJV) *A man of* great wrath will suffer punishment; For if you rescue *him*, you will have to do it again.
- Proverbs 19:20 (AV) Hear counsel, and receive instruction, that thou mayest be wise in thy latter end.
- Proverbs 19:20 (NKJV) Listen to counsel and receive instruction, That you may be wise in your latter days.
- Proverbs 19:21 (AV) *There are* many devices in a man's heart; nevertheless the counsel of the LORD, that shall stand.
- Proverbs 19:21 (NKJV) There are many plans in a man's heart, Nevertheless the LORD'S counsel that will stand.
- James 4:13-15 Go to now, ye that say, To day or to morrow we will go into such a city, & continue there a year, & buy & sell, & get gain: 14 Whereas ye know not what shall be on the morrow. For what is your life? It is even a vapour, that appeareth for a little time, & then vanisheth away. 15 For that ye ought to say, If the Lord will, we shall live, & do this, or that.
- Psalms 37:5 Commit thy way unto the LORD; trust also in him; and he shall bring it to pass.
- Matthew 7:21 Not every one that saith unto Me, Lord, Lord, shall enter into the kingdom of heaven; but he that doeth the will of My Father which is in heaven.
- Matthew 7:13,14 Enter ye in at the strait gate: for wide is the gate, and broad is the way, that leadeth to destruction, and many there be which go in thereat: 14 Because strait is the gate, and narrow is the way, which leadeth unto life, and few there be that find it.
- Proverbs 19:22 (AV) The desire of a man *is* his kindness: and a poor man *is* better than a liar.
- Proverbs 19:22 (NKJV) What is desired in a man is kindness, And a poor man is better than a liar.
- Proverbs 19:23 (AV) The fear of the LORD *tendeth* to life: and *he that hath it* shall abide satisfied; he shall not be visited with evil.
- Proverbs 19:23 (NKJV) The fear of the LORD *leads* to life, And *he who has it* will abide in satisfaction; He will not be visited with evil.
- Isaiah 6 Referred to Isaiah's vision of God in Heaven.
- Hebrews 13:5 Let your conversation be without covetousness; and be content with such things as ye have: for He hath said, I will never leave thee, nor forsake thee.

- Proverbs 19:24 (AV) A slothful *man* hideth his hand in *his* bosom, and will not so much as bring it to his mouth again.
- Proverbs 19:24 (NKJV) A lazy *man* buries his hand in the bowl, And will not so much as bring it to his mouth again.
- Proverbs 19:25 (AV) Smite a scorner, and the simple will beware: and reprove one that hath understanding, *and* he will understand knowledge.
- Proverbs 19:25 (NKJV) Strike a scoffer, and the simple will become wary; Rebuke one who has understanding, *and* he will discern knowledge.
- Proverbs 19:20 Hear counsel, and receive instruction, that thou mayest be wise in thy latter end.
- Proverbs 19:26 (AV) He that wasteth *his* father, *and* chaseth away *his* mother, *is* a son that causeth shame, and bringeth reproach.
- Proverbs 19:26 (NKJV) He who mistreats *his* father *and* chases away *his* mother *Is* a son who causes shame and brings reproach.
- Exodus 20:12 Honour thy father and thy mother: that thy days may be long upon the land which the LORD thy God giveth thee.
- Proverbs 19:27 (AV) Cease, my son, to hear the instruction *that causeth* to err from the words of knowledge.
- Proverbs 19:27 (NKJV) Cease listening to (Godly) instruction, my son, And you will stray from the words of knowledge.
- Proverbs 19:28 (AV) An ungodly witness scorneth judgment: and the mouth of the wicked devoureth iniquity.
- Proverbs 19:28 (NKJV) A disreputable witness scorns justice, And the mouth of the wicked devours iniquity.
- Isaiah 1:26 And I will restore thy judges as at the first, and thy counsellors as at the beginning: afterward thou shalt be called, The city of righteousness, the faithful city.
- Proverbs 19:29 (AV) Judgments are prepared for scorners, and stripes for the back of fools.
- Proverbs 19:29 (NKJV) Judgments are prepared for scoffers, And beatings for the backs of fools.
