- Psalms 145:13 Thy kingdom *is* an everlasting kingdom, and Thy <u>dominion</u> endureth throughout all generations.

- Deuteronomy 7:1-26 (AV) & (NKJV)
- Deuteronomy 7:1 (AV) When the LORD thy God shall bring thee into the land whither thou goest to possess it, and hath cast out many nations before thee, the Hittites, and the Girgashites, and the Amorites, and the Canaanites, and the Perizzites, and the Hivites, and the Jebusites, seven nations greater and mightier than thou;
- Exodus Summarized of God destroying Egypt & freeing the Israelites.
- Deuteronomy 7:1 (NKJV) When the LORD your God brings you into the land which you go to possess, and has cast out many nations before you, the Hittites and the Girgashites and the Amorites and the Canaanites and the Perizzites and the Hivites and the Jebusites, seven nations greater and mightier than you,
- Referred to David versus Goliath; Gideon versus the Midianites; & Jehosephat.
- 2 Peter 3:9 The Lord is not slack concerning his promise, as some men count slackness; but is longsuffering to us-ward, not willing that any should perish, but that all should come to repentance.
- Hebrews 9:27 And as it is appointed unto men once to die, but after this the judgment:
- Mark 16:9 Now when *Jesus* was risen early the first *day* of the week, He appeared first to <u>Mary</u> Magdalene, out of whom He had cast <u>seven</u> devils.
- Luke 8:2 And certain women, which had been healed of evil spirits and infirmities, <u>Mary</u> called Magdalene, out of whom went <u>seven</u> devils, Acts 8 Referred to Simon Magus not really saved.

- Luke 8:30 And Jesus asked him, saying, What is thy name? And he said, Legion: because many devils were entered into him.
- Luke 10:19 Behold, I give unto you power to tread on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy: and nothing shall by any means hurt you.
- Deuteronomy 7:2 (AV) And when the LORD thy God shall deliver them before thee; thou shalt smite them, *and* utterly destroy them; thou shalt make no covenant with them, nor shew mercy unto them:

- Deuteronomy 7:3 (AV) Neither shalt thou make marriages with them; thy daughter thou shalt not give unto his son, nor his daughter shalt thou take unto thy son.
- Matthew 10:37 He that loveth father or mother more than <e is not worthy of Me: and he that loveth son or daughter more than Me is not worthy of Me.
- Deuteronomy 7:3 (NKJV) Nor shall you make marriages with them. You shall not give your daughter to their son, nor take their daughter for your son.
- 2 Corinthians 6:14 Be ye not unequally yoked together with unbelievers: for what fellowship hath righteousness with unrighteousness? and what communion hath light with darkness?
- Numbers 22:6 Come now therefore, I pray thee, curse me this people; for they are too mighty for me: peradventure I shall prevail, that we may smite them, and that I may drive them out of the land: for I wot that he whom thou blessest is blessed, and he whom thou cursest is cursed.
- Deuteronomy 23:5 Nevertheless the LORD thy God would not hearken unto Balaam; but the LORD thy God turned the curse into a blessing unto thee, because the LORD thy God loved thee.
- Revelation 2:14 But I have a few things against thee, because thou hast there them that hold the doctrine of Balaam, who taught Balac to cast a stumblingblock before the children of Israel, to eat things sacrificed unto

- idols, and to commit fornication.
- Deuteronomy 18:9-14 When thou art come into the land which the LORD thy God giveth thee, thou shalt not learn to do after the abominations of those nations. ...
- Acts 15:20 But that we write unto them, that they abstain from pollutions of idols, and from fornication, and from things strangled, and from blood.
- John 3:16 For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life.
- Deuteronomy 7:4 (AV) For they will turn away thy son from following Me, that they may serve other gods: so will the anger of the LORD be kindled against you, and destroy thee suddenly.
- Deuteronomy 7:4 (NKJV) For they will turn your sons away from following Me, to serve other gods; so the anger of the LORD will be aroused against you and destroy you suddenly.
- Numbers 16:30 But if the LORD make a new thing, and the earth open her mouth, and swallow them up, with all that appertain unto them, and they go down quick into the pit; then ye shall understand that these men have provoked the LORD.
- Numbers 16 Referred to God dealing with Korah & the rebels.
- Deuteronomy 7:5 (AV) But thus shall ye deal with them; ye shall destroy their altars, and break down their images, and cut down their groves, and burn their graven images with fire.
- Deuteronomy 7:5 (NKJV) But thus you shall deal with them: you shall destroy their altars, and break down their *sacred* pillars, and cut down their wooden images, and burn their carved images with fire.
- Ezekiel 30:13 Thus saith the Lord GOD; I will also destroy the idols, and I will cause their images to cease out of Noph; and there shall be no more a prince of the land of Egypt: and I will put a fear in the land of Egypt.
- Psalms 19:1 « To the chief Musician, A Psalm of David. » The heavens declare the glory of God; and the firmament sheweth his handywork.
- Psalms 24:1 « A Psalm of David. » The earth is the LORD'S, and the fulness thereof; the world, and they that dwell therein.
- Revelation 6:16 And said to the mountains and rocks, Fall on us, and hide us from the face of him that sitteth on the throne, and from the wrath of the Lamb:
- Galatians 6:7 Be not deceived; God is not mocked: for whatsoever a man soweth, that shall he also reap.
- Deuteronomy 7:6 (AV) For thou *art* an holy people unto the LORD thy God: the LORD thy God hath chosen thee to be a special people unto himself, above all people that *are* upon the face of the earth.
- Deuteronomy 7:6 (NKJV) For you are a holy people to the LORD your God; the

- LORD your God has chosen you to be a people for Himself, a special treasure above all the peoples on the face of the earth.
- Genesis 12:1 Now the LORD had said unto Abram, Get thee out of thy country, and from thy kindred, and from thy father's house, unto a land that I will shew thee:
- John 16:8 And when He is come, He will reprove the world of sin, and of righteousness, and of judgment:
- Deuteronomy 7:7 (AV) The LORD did not set his love upon you, nor choose you, because ye were more in number than any people; for ye *were* the fewest of all people:
- Deuteronomy 7:7 (NKJV) The LORD did not set His love on you nor choose you because you were more in number than any other people, for you were the least of all peoples;
- Hebrews 13:5 Let your conversation be without covetousness; and be content with such things as ye have: for he hath said, I will never leave thee, nor forsake thee.
- John 10:28,29 And I give unto them eternal life; and they shall never perish, neither shall any man pluck them out of My hand. 29 My Father, which gave them Me, is greater than all; and no man is able to pluck them out of My Father's hand.
- Genesis 6 Referred to God Judging the earth saving Noah & family.
- Genesis 9:13 I do set my bow in the cloud, and it shall be for a token of a covenant between me and the earth.
- Deuteronomy 7:8 (AV) But because the LORD loved you, and because he would keep the oath which he had sworn unto your fathers, hath the LORD brought you out with a mighty hand, and redeemed you out of the house of bondmen, from the hand of Pharaoh king of Egypt.
- Deuteronomy 7:8 (NKJV) but because the LORD loves you, and because He would keep the oath which He swore to your fathers, the LORD has brought you out with a mighty hand, and redeemed you from the house of bondage, from the hand of Pharaoh king of Egypt.
- Deuteronomy 7:9 (AV) Know therefore that the LORD thy God, he *is* God, the faithful God, which keepeth covenant and mercy with them that love him and keep his commandments to a thousand generations;
- Deuteronomy 7:9 (NKJV) Therefore know that the LORD your God, He *is* God, the faithful God who keeps covenant and mercy for a thousand generations with those who love Him and keep His commandments;
- Deuteronomy 7:9 Know therefore that the LORD thy God, he is God, the faithful God, which keepeth covenant and mercy with them that love him and keep his commandments to a thousand generations;
- 2 Corinthians 5:8 We are confident, I say, and willing rather to be absent from the body, and to be present with the Lord.

- John 14:3 And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again, and receive you unto myself; that where I am, there ye may be also.
- Revelation 19 Referred to Jesus' return & His Global rule for 1000 years.
- Deuteronomy 7:10 (AV) And repayeth them that hate him to their face, to destroy them: he will not be slack to him that hateth him, he will repay him to his face.
- Deuteronomy 7:10 (NKJV) and He repays those who hate Him to their face, to destroy them. He will not be slack with him who hates Him; He will repay him to his face.
- John 15:25 But this cometh to pass, that the word might be fulfilled that is written in their law, They hated me without a cause.
- **Acts 5 Referred to Ananias & Sapphira**
- 2 Corinthians 13:5 Examine yourselves, whether ye be in the faith; prove your own selves. Know ye not your own selves, how that Jesus Christ is in you, except ye be reprobates?
- 1 Corinthians 11:30 For this cause many are weak and sickly among you, and many sleep.
- Romans 14:12 So then every one of us shall give account of himself to God.
- Deuteronomy 7:11 (AV) Thou shalt therefore keep the commandments, and the statutes, and the judgments, which I command thee this day, to do them.
- Deuteronomy 7:11 (NKJV) Therefore you shall keep the commandment, the statutes, and the judgments which I command you today, to observe them. Exodus 32 Summarized of the golden calf sin.
- Ephesians 1:13 In whom ye also trusted, after that ye heard the Word of Truth, the gospel of your salvation: in whom also after that ye believed, ye were sealed with that Holy Spirit of promise,
- Deuteronomy 7:12 (AV) Wherefore it shall come to pass, if ye hearken to these judgments, and keep, and do them, that the LORD thy God shall keep unto thee the covenant and the mercy which he sware unto thy fathers:
- Deuteronomy 7:12 (NKJV) Then it shall come to pass, because you listen to these judgments, and keep and do them, that the LORD your God will keep with you the covenant and the mercy which He swore to your fathers.
- James 1:22 But be ye doers of the word, and not hearers only, deceiving your own selves.
- Matthew 5:45 That ye may be the children of your Father which is in heaven: for he maketh his sun to rise on the evil and on the good, and sendeth rain on the just and on the unjust.
- Deuteronomy 6:5 And thou shalt love the LORD thy God with all thine heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy might.
- Leviticus 19:18 Thou shalt not avenge, nor bear any grudge against the

- children of thy people, but thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself: I am the LORD.
- Matthew 22:37-39 Jesus said unto him, Thou shalt love the Lord thy God with all thy heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy mind. 38 This is the first and great commandment. 39 And the second is like unto it, Thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself.
- 1 John 1:9 If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.
- Romans 6:1,2 What shall we say then? Shall we continue in sin, that grace may abound? 2 God forbid. How shall we, that are dead to sin, live any longer therein?
- Deuteronomy 7:13 (AV) And he will love thee, and bless thee, and multiply thee: he will also bless the fruit of thy womb, and the fruit of thy land, thy corn, and thy wine, and thine oil, the increase of thy kine, and the flocks of thy sheep, in the land which he sware unto thy fathers to give thee.
- Deuteronomy 7:13 (NKJV) And He will love you and bless you and multiply you; He will also bless the fruit of your womb and the fruit of your land, your grain and your new wine and your oil, the increase of your cattle and the offspring of your flock, in the land of which He swore to your fathers to give you.
- Deuteronomy 7:14 (AV) Thou shalt be blessed above all people: there shall not be male or female barren among you, or among your cattle.
- Deuteronomy 7:14 (NKJV) You shall be blessed above all peoples; there shall not be a male or female barren among you or among your livestock.
- Isaiah 58:8 Then shall thy light break forth as the morning, and thine health shall spring forth speedily: and thy righteousness shall go before thee; the glory of the LORD shall be thy rereward.
- Deuteronomy 7:15 (AV) And the LORD will take away from thee all sickness, and will put none of the evil diseases of Egypt, which thou knowest, upon thee; but will lay them upon all *them* that hate thee.
- Deuteronomy 7:15 (NKJV) And the LORD will take away from you all sickness, and will afflict you with none of the terrible diseases of Egypt which you have known, but will lay *them* on all those who hate you.
- Deuteronomy 7:16 (AV) And thou shalt consume all the people which the LORD thy God shall deliver thee; thine eye shall have no pity upon them: neither shalt thou serve their gods; for that will be a snare unto thee.
- Deuteronomy 7:16 (NKJV) And you shall destroy all the peoples whom the LORD your God delivers over to you; your eye shall have no pity on them; nor shall you serve their gods, for that *will be* a snare to you.
- Deuteronomy 7:17 (AV) If thou shalt say in thine heart, These nations *are* more than I; how can I dispossess them?
- Deuteronomy 7:17 (NKJV) If you should say in your heart, These nations are

- greater than I; how can I dispossess them?
- Deuteronomy 7:18 (AV) Thou shalt not be afraid of them: *but* shalt well remember what the LORD thy God did unto Pharaoh, and unto all Egypt;
- Deuteronomy 7:18 (NKJV) you shall not be afraid of them, *but* you shall remember well what the LORD your God did to Pharaoh and to all Egypt:
- Mark 16:17,18 And these signs shall follow them that believe; In My Name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues; 18 They shall take up serpents; and if they drink any deadly thing, it shall not hurt them; they shall lay hands on the sick, and they shall recover.
- 2 Timothy 1:7 For God hath not given us the spirit of fear; but of power, and of love, and of a sound mind.
- Deuteronomy 7:19 (AV) The great temptations which thine eyes saw, and the signs, and the wonders, and the mighty hand, and the stretched out arm, whereby the LORD thy God brought thee out: so shall the LORD thy God do unto all the people of whom thou art afraid.
- Deuteronomy 7:19 (NKJV) the great trials which your eyes saw, the signs and the wonders, the mighty hand and the outstretched arm, by which the LORD your God brought you out. So shall the LORD your God do to all the peoples of whom you are afraid.
- Deuteronomy 7:20 (AV) Moreover the LORD thy God will send the hornet among them, until they that are left, and hide themselves from thee, be destroyed.
- Deuteronomy 7:20 (NKJV) Moreover the LORD your God will send the hornet among them until those who are left, who hide themselves from you, are destroyed.
- Deuteronomy 7:21 (AV) Thou shalt not be affrighted at them: for the LORD thy God *is* among you, a mighty God and terrible.
- Deuteronomy 7:21 (NKJV) You shall not be terrified of them; for the LORD your God, the great and awesome God, *is* among you.
- Deuteronomy 7:22 (AV) And the LORD thy God will put out those nations before thee by little and little: thou mayest not consume them at once, lest the beasts of the field increase upon thee.
- Deuteronomy 7:22 (NKJV) And the LORD your God will drive out those nations before you little by little; you will be unable to destroy them at once, lest the beasts of the field become *too* numerous for you.
- Deuteronomy 7:23 (AV) But the LORD thy God shall deliver them unto thee, and shall destroy them with a mighty destruction, until they be destroyed.
- Deuteronomy 7:23 (NKJV) But the LORD your God will deliver them over to you, and will inflict defeat upon them until they are destroyed.
- Referred to Jesus cleaning out the temple.
- Deuteronomy 7:24 (AV) And he shall deliver their kings into thine hand, and thou shalt destroy their name from under heaven: there shall no man be

- able to stand before thee, until thou have destroyed them.
- Deuteronomy 7:24 (NKJV) And He will deliver their kings into your hand, and you will destroy their name from under heaven; no one shall be able to stand against you until you have destroyed them.
- Mark 3:27 No man can enter into a strong man's house, and spoil his goods, except he will first bind the strong man; and then he will spoil his house.
- Zechariah 13:7 Awake, O sword, against my shepherd, and against the man that is my fellow, saith the LORD of hosts: smite the shepherd, and the sheep shall be scattered: and I will turn mine hand upon the little ones.
- Deuteronomy 7:25 (AV) The graven images of their gods shall ye burn with fire: thou shalt not desire the silver or gold *that is* on them, nor take *it* unto thee, lest thou be snared therein: for it *is* an abomination to the LORD thy God.
- Deuteronomy 7:25 (NKJV) You shall burn the carved images of their gods with fire; you shall not covet the silver or gold *that is* on them, nor take *it* for yourselves, lest you be snared by it; for it *is* an abomination to the LORD your God.
- Deuteronomy 7:26 (AV) Neither shalt thou bring an abomination into thine house, lest thou be a cursed thing like it: *but* thou shalt utterly detest it, and thou shalt utterly abhor it; for it *is* a cursed thing.
- Deuteronomy 7:26 (NKJV) Nor shall you bring an abomination into your house, lest you be doomed to destruction like it. You shall utterly detest it and utterly abhor it, for it *is* an accursed thing.
- Genesis 39:12 And she caught him (Joseph) by his garment, saying, Lie with me: and he left his garment in her hand, and fled, and got him out.
- 2 Timothy 2:22 Flee also youthful lusts: but follow righteousness, faith, charity, peace, with them that call on the Lord out of a pure heart.
- Daniel 3:16 Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego, answered and said to the king, O Nebuchadnezzar, we are not careful to answer thee in this matter. 17 If it be so, our God whom we serve is able to deliver us from the burning fiery furnace, and He will deliver us out of thine hand, O king. 18 But if not, be it known unto thee, O king, that we will not serve thy gods, nor worship the golden image which thou hast set up.
