- Mark 14:25 Verily I say unto you, I will drink no more of the fruit of the vine, until that day that I drink it new in the kingdom of God.
- Luke 22:18 For I say unto you, I will not drink of the fruit of the vine, until the kingdom of God shall come.
- Strongs #4608 sikera sik'-er-ah AV-strong drink 1; 1) strong drink, an intoxicating beverage, different from wine; it was an artificial product, made of a mixture of sweet ingredients, whether derived from grain and vegetables, or from the juice of fruits (dates), or a decoction of honey.
- Leviticus 10:9 Do not <u>drink wine</u> nor <u>strong drink</u>, thou, nor thy sons with thee, when ye go into the tabernacle of the congregation, lest ye die: *it shall be* a statute for ever throughout your generations:
- Numbers 26:61 And Nadab and Abihu died, when they offered strange fire before the LORD.
- John 6:63 It is the Spirit that quickeneth; the flesh profiteth nothing: the Words that I speak unto you, they are Spirit, and they are life.
- Numbers 6:3 He shall separate *himself* from <u>wine</u> and <u>strong</u> <u>drink</u>, and shall <u>drink</u> no vinegar of <u>wine</u>, or vinegar of <u>strong</u> <u>drink</u>, neither shall he <u>drink</u> any liquor of grapes, nor eat moist grapes, or dried.
- Numbers 28:7 And the <u>drink offering</u> thereof *shall be* the fourth *part* of an hin for the one lamb: in the Holy *place* shalt thou cause the <u>strong wine</u> to be poured unto the LORD *for* a <u>drink offering</u>.
- Hebrews 9:12 Neither by the blood of goats and calves, but by His Own Blood He entered in once into the Holy Place, having obtained eternal redemption for us.
- Deuteronomy 14:26 And thou shalt bestow that money for whatsoever thy soul lusteth after, for oxen, or for sheep, or for wine, or for strong drink, or for whatsoever thy soul desireth: and thou shalt eat there before the LORD thy God, and thou shalt rejoice, thou, and thine household,
- Jesus re-itterated 9 of the 10 Commandments Not the observing of the Sabbath. In the new covenant, we worship on the first day of the week.
- Mark 16:9 Now when Jesus was risen early the first day of the week, he appeared first to Mary Magdalene, out of whom he had cast seven devils.
- Acts 20:7 And upon the first day of the week, when the disciples came together to break bread, Paul preached unto them, ready to depart on the morrow; and continued his speech until midnight.
- Deuteronomy 29:6 Ye have not eaten bread, neither have ye drunk <u>wine</u> or <u>strong drink</u>: that ye might know that I *am* the LORD your God.
- Summarized of God providing manna for the Israelites in the wilderness.
- John 14:17 Even the Spirit of Truth; Whom the world cannot receive, because it seeth Him not, neither knoweth Him: but ye know Him; for He dwelleth

- with you, and shall be in you.
- Judges 13:4 Now therefore beware, I pray thee, and <u>drink</u> not <u>wine</u> nor <u>strong</u> <u>drink</u>, and eat not any unclean *thing*:
- Judges 13:7 But he said unto me, Behold, thou shalt conceive, and bear a son; and now <u>drink</u> no <u>wine</u> nor <u>strong</u> <u>drink</u>, neither eat any unclean <u>thing</u>: for the <u>child shall be a Nazarite to God from the womb</u> to the day of his death.
- Judges 13:14 She may not eat of any *thing* that cometh of the vine, neither let her <u>drink</u> wine or <u>strong</u> <u>drink</u>, nor eat any unclean *thing*: all that I commanded her let her observe.
- 1 Samuel 1:15 And Hannah answered and said, No, my lord, I *am* a woman of a sorrowful spirit: I have drunk neither <u>wine</u> nor <u>strong</u> <u>drink</u>, but have poured out my soul before the LORD.
- 1 Samuel 2:29 Wherefore kick ye at My sacrifice and at Mine offering, which I have commanded in My habitation; & honour thy sons above Me, to make yourselves fat with the chiefest of all the offerings of Israel My people?
- Proverbs 20:1 <u>Wine</u> *is* a mocker, <u>strong</u> <u>drink</u> *is* raging: and whosoever is deceived thereby is not wise.
- Proverbs 31:4 *It is* not for kings, O Lemuel, *it is* not for kings to drink wine; nor for princes strong drink:
- Daniel 1:8,15 But Daniel purposed in his heart that he would not defile himself with the portion of the king's meat, nor with the wine which he drank: therefore he requested of the prince of the eunuchs that he might not defile himself. 15 And at the end of ten days their countenances appeared fairer and fatter in flesh than all the children which did eat the portion of the king's meat.
- Proverbs 31:6 Give <u>strong drink</u> unto him that is ready to perish, and <u>wine</u> unto those that be of heavy hearts.
- Matthew 27:34 They gave Him vinegar to drink mingled with gall: and when He had tasted thereof, He would not drink.
- Isaiah 5:11 Woe unto them that rise up early in the morning, *that* they may follow <u>strong drink</u>; that continue until night, *till* <u>wine</u> inflame them!
- Isaiah 5:22 Woe unto *them that are* mighty to <u>drink</u> <u>wine</u>, and men of strength to mingle <u>strong</u> <u>drink</u>:
- Isaiah 24:9 They shall not <u>drink</u> <u>wine</u> with a song; <u>strong</u> <u>drink</u> shall be bitter to them that <u>drink</u> it.
- Isaiah 28:7 But they also have <u>erred</u> through <u>wine</u>, and through <u>strong</u> <u>drink</u> are out of the way; the <u>priest and the prophet have erred</u> through <u>strong</u> <u>drink</u>, they are swallowed up of <u>wine</u>, they are <u>out of the way through</u> strong drink; they err in vision, they stumble *in* judgment.
- Matthew 7:14 Because strait is the gate, and narrow is the way, which leadeth unto life, and few there be that find it.

- Isaiah 29:9 Stay yourselves, and wonder; cry ye out, and cry: they are drunken, but not with wine; they stagger, but not with strong drink.
- Isaiah 56:12 Come ye, say they, I will fetch wine, & we will fill ourselves with strong drink; & to morrow shall be as this day, & much more abundant.
- Micah 2:11 If a man walking in the spirit and falsehood do lie, *saying*, I will prophesy unto thee of <u>wine</u> and of <u>strong drink</u>; he shall even be the prophet of this people.
- 2 Timothy 4:3,4 For the time will come when they will not endure sound doctrine; but after their own lusts shall they heap to themselves teachers, having itching ears; 4 And they shall turn away their ears from the truth, and shall be turned unto fables.
- Luke 1:15 For he shall be great in the sight of the Lord, and shall <u>drink</u> neither <u>wine</u> nor <u>strong drink</u>; and he shall be filled with the Holy Ghost, even from his mother's womb.
- Matthew 11:11 Verily I say unto you, Among them that are born of women there hath not risen a greater than John the Baptist: notwithstanding he that is least in the kingdom of heaven is greater than he.
- Luke 3:4 As it is written in the book of the words of Esaias the prophet, saying, The voice of one crying in the wilderness, Prepare ye the way of the Lord, make His paths straight.
- John 3:16 For God so loved the world, that He gave His only begotten Son, that whosoever believs in Him should not perish, but have everlasting life.
- 2 Samuel 12:14 Howbeit, because by this deed thou hast given great occasion to the enemies of the LORD to blaspheme, the child also that is born unto thee shall surely die.
- 1 Thessalonians 5:22 Abstain from all appearance of evil.
- Leviticus 20:7 Sanctify yourselves therefore, and <u>be ye Holy</u>: for I *am* the LORD your God.
