- Hebrews 9:12 Neither by the blood of goats and calves, but by His Own Blood He entered in once into the Holy Place, having obtained eternal redemption for us.
- 2 Timothy 2:15 Study to shew thyself approved unto God, a workman that needeth not to be ashamed, rightly dividing the Word of Truth.
- Proverbs 21:1-31 (AV) & (NKJV)
- Proverbs 21:1 (AV) The king's (leader's) heart *is* in the hand of the LORD, *as* the rivers of water: He turneth it whithersoever He will.
- Proverbs 21:1 (NKJV) The king's (ruler's) heart *is* in the hand of the LORD, *Like* the rivers of water; He turns it wherever He wishes.
- Proverbs 21:2 (AV) Every way of a man *is* right in his own eyes: but the LORD pondereth the hearts.
- Proverbs 21:2 (NKJV) Every way of a man *is* right in his own eyes, But the LORD weighs the hearts.
- Summarized of many kings they "did right in his own eyes" but it was seen as doing evil in the sight of God".
- Proverbs 21:3 (AV) To do justice and judgment *is* more acceptable to the LORD than sacrifice.
- Proverbs 21:3 (NKJV) To do righteousness and justice *Is* more acceptable to the LORD than sacrifice.
- 1 Samuel 15 Summarized of Saul's actions & Samuel. V22 And Samuel said, Hath the LORD as great delight in burnt offerings and sacrifices, as in obeying the voice of the LORD? Behold, to obey is better than sacrifice, and to hearken than the fat of rams.
- Romans 6:1,2 What shall we say then? Shall we continue in sin, that grace may abound? 2 God forbid. How shall we, that are dead to sin, live any longer therein?
- Isaiah 1:26 And I will restore thy judges as at the first, and thy counsellors as at the beginning: afterward thou shalt be called, The city of righteousness, the faithful city.
- 1 John 1:9 If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

- Proverbs 21:4 (NKJV) A haughty look, a proud heart, *And* the plowing of the wicked *are* sin.
- Isaiah 14 & Ezekiel 28 Referred to the devil's 5 "I will's" & God's "No"
- John 10:10 The thief cometh not, but for to steal, and to kill, and to destroy: I am come that they might have life, and that they might have it more abundantly.
- Proverbs 21:5 (AV) The thoughts of the diligent *tend* only to plenteousness; but of every one *that is* hasty only to want.
- Proverbs 21:5 (NKJV) The plans of the diligent *lead* surely to plenty, But *those of* everyone *who is* hasty, surely to poverty.
- Proverbs 21:6 (AV) The getting of treasures by a lying tongue *is* a vanity tossed to and fro of them that seek death.
- Proverbs 21:6 (NKJV) Getting treasures by a lying tongue *Is* the fleeting fantasy of those who seek death.
- Proverbs 21:7 (AV) The robbery of the wicked shall destroy them; because they refuse to do judgment.
- Proverbs 21:7 (NKJV) The violence of the wicked will destroy them, Because they refuse to do justice.
- Proverbs 21:8 (AV) The way of man *is* froward and strange: but *as for* the pure, his work *is* right.
- Proverbs 21:8 (NKJV) The way of a guilty man *is* perverse; But *as for* the pure, his work *is* right.
- Proverbs 21:9 (AV) *It is* better to dwell in a corner of the housetop, than with a brawling woman in a wide house.
- Proverbs 21:9 (NKJV) Better to dwell in a corner of a housetop, Than in a house shared with a contentious woman.
- 1 Kings 11:3 And he (Solomon) had seven hundred wives, princesses, and three hundred concubines: and his wives turned away his heart.
- Genesis 2:24 Therefore shall a man leave his father and his mother, and shall cleave unto his wife: and they shall be one flesh.
- Deuteronomy 17:17 Neither shall he multiply wives to himself, that his heart turn not away: neither shall he greatly multiply to himself silver and gold.
- Proverbs 21:10 (AV) The soul of the wicked desireth evil: his neighbour findeth no favour in his eyes.

- Proverbs 21:10 (NKJV) The soul of the wicked desires evil; His neighbor finds no favor in his eyes.
- Proverbs 21:11 (AV) When the scorner is punished, the simple is made wise: and when the wise is instructed, he receiveth knowledge.
- Proverbs 21:11 (NKJV) When the scoffer is punished, the simple is made wise; But when the wise is instructed, he receives knowledge.
- Proverbs 15:32 He that refuseth instruction despiseth his own soul: but he that heareth reproof getteth understanding.
- Proverbs 21:12 (AV) The righteous *man* wisely considereth the house of the wicked: *but God* overthroweth the wicked for *their* wickedness.
- Proverbs 21:12 (NKJV) The righteous *God* wisely considers the house of the wicked, Overthrowing the wicked for *their* wickedness.
- Proverbs 21:13 (AV) Whoso stoppeth his ears at the cry of the poor, he also shall cry himself, but shall not be heard.
- Proverbs 21:13 (NKJV) Whoever shuts his ears to the cry of the poor Will also cry himself and not be heard.
- Matthew 26 Summarized of the Alabaster box annointing Jesus. V11 For ye have the poor always with you; but Me ye have not always.
- Proverbs 21:14 (AV) A gift in secret pacifieth anger: and a reward in the bosom strong wrath.
- Proverbs 21:14 (NKJV) A gift in secret pacifies anger, And a bribe behind the back, strong wrath.
- Daniel 2 & 6 Referred to Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego, & Daniel standing for God.
- Proverbs 21:15 (AV) *It is* joy to the just to do judgment: but destruction *shall be* to the workers of iniquity.
- Proverbs 21:15 (NKJV) *It is* a joy for the just to do justice, But destruction *will come* to the workers of iniquity.
- Proverbs 21:16 (AV) The man that wandereth out of the way of understanding shall remain in the congregation of the dead.
- Proverbs 21:16 (NKJV) A man who wanders from the way of understanding will rest in the assembly of the dead.
- Proverbs 21:17 (AV) He that loveth pleasure *shall be* a poor man: he that loveth wine and oil shall not be rich.
- Proverbs 21:17 (NKJV) He who loves pleasure *will be* a poor man; He who loves wine and oil will not be rich.
- Proverbs 20:1 Wine is a mocker, strong drink is raging: and whosoever is deceived thereby is not wise.
- Proverbs 21:18 (AV) The wicked *shall be* a ransom for the righteous, and the transgressor for the upright.

- Proverbs 21:18 (NKJV) The wicked *shall be* a ransom for the righteous, and the unfaithful (ungodly) for the upright.
- Proverbs 13:22 A good man leaveth an inheritance to his children's children: and the wealth of the sinner is laid up for the just.
- Proverbs 21:19 (AV) *It is* better to dwell in the wilderness, than with a contentious and an angry woman.
- Proverbs 21:19 (NKJV) Better to dwell in the wilderness, Than with a contentious and angry woman.
- Proverbs 21:20 (AV) *There is* treasure to be desired and oil in the dwelling of the wise; but a foolish man spendeth it up.
- Proverbs 21:20 (NKJV) *There is* desirable treasure, and oil in the dwelling of the wise (God's blessings), But a foolish man squanders it.
- 1 Timothy 5:8 But if any provide not for his own, and specially for those of his own house, he hath denied the faith, and is worse than an infidel.
- Proverbs 21:21 (AV) He that followeth after righteousness and mercy findeth life, righteousness, and honour.
- Proverbs 21:21 (NKJV) He who follows righteousness and mercy finds life, righteousness, and honor.
- John 14:6 Jesus saith unto him, I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by Me.
- Luke 23:34 Then said Jesus, Father, forgive them; for they know not what they do. And they parted his raiment, and cast lots.
- Acts 7:60 And he (Stephen) kneeled down, and cried with a loud voice, Lord, lay not this sin to their charge. And when he had said this, he fell asleep.
- Proverbs 21:22 (AV) A wise *man* scaleth the city of the mighty, and casteth down the strength of the confidence thereof.
- Proverbs 21:22 (NKJV) A wise *man* scales the city of the mighty, And brings down the trusted stronghold.
- 2 Samuel 5 Summarized of David getting through the stronghold of the Jebusites.
- Daniel 5 Summarized of Belshazzar defeated.
- Proverbs 21:23 (AV) Whoso keepeth his mouth and his tongue keepeth his soul from troubles.
- Proverbs 21:23 (NKJV) Whoever guards his mouth and tongue Keeps his soul from troubles.
- Proverbs 21:23 Whoso keepeth his mouth and his tongue keepeth his soul from troubles.
- Proverbs 21:24 (AV) Proud *and* haughty scorner *is* his name, who dealeth in proud wrath.

- Proverbs 21:24 (NKJV) A proud *and* haughty *man* Scoffer *is* his name; He acts with arrogant pride.
- Proverbs 16:18 Pride goeth before destruction, and an haughty spirit before a fall.
- Proverbs 21:25 (AV) The desre of the slothful killeth him; for his hands refuse to labour.
- Proverbs 21:25 (NKJV) The desire of the lazy *man* kills him, for his hands refuse to labor.
- Proverbs 21:26 (AV) He coveteth greedily all the day long: but the righteous giveth and spareth not.
- Proverbs 21:26 (NKJV) He covets greedily all day long, But the righteous gives and does not spare.
- Proverbs 21:27 (AV) The sacrifice of the wicked *is* abomination: how much more, *when* he bringeth it with a wicked mind?
- Proverbs 21:27 (NKJV) The sacrifice of the wicked *is* an abomination; How much more *when* he brings it with wicked intent!
- Matthew 5:23,24 Therefore if thou bring thy gift to the altar, and there rememberest that thy brother hath ought against thee; 24 Leave there thy gift before the altar, and go thy way; first be reconciled to thy brother, and then come and offer thy gift.
- Genesis 4 Referred to Cain's offering not accepted by God.
- Proverbs 21:28 (AV) A false witness shall perish: but the man that heareth speaketh constantly.
- Proverbs 21:28 (NKJV) A false witness shall perish, But the man who hears *him* will speak endlessly.
- Deuteronomy 19:18,19 And the judges shall make diligent inquisition: and, behold, if the witness be a false witness, and hath testified falsely against his brother; 19 Then shall ye do unto him, as he had thought to have done unto his brother: so shalt thou put the evil away from among you.
- Proverbs 21:29 (AV) A wicked man hardeneth his face: but *as for* the upright, he directeth his way.
- Proverbs 21:29 (NKJV) A wicked man hardens his face, But *as for* the upright, he establishes his way.
- Proverbs 26:24,25 He that hateth dissembleth with his lips, and layeth up deceit within him; 25 When he speaketh fair, believe him not: for there are seven abominations in his heart.
- Matthew 7:14 Because strait is the gate, and narrow is the way, which leadeth unto life, and few there be that find it.
- Proverbs 21:30 (AV) *There is* no wisdom nor understanding nor counsel

- against the LORD.
- Proverbs 21:30 (NKJV) *There is* no wisdom or understanding or counsel against the LORD.
- 1 Kings 18 Summarized of Elijah & the shoot out on Mount Carmel.
- Exodus 8:1 And the LORD spake unto Moses, Go unto Pharaoh, and say unto him, Thus saith the LORD, Let My people go, that they may serve Me.
- Exodus 7 Summarized of Moses versus Pharoah. V12 For they cast down every man his rod, and they became serpents: but Aaron's rod swallowed up their rods.

- Strongs #08668 teshuw'ah *tesh-oo-aw'* or teshu'ah *tesh-oo-aw'* AV-salvation 17, deliverance 5, help 5, safety 4, victory 3; 34 1) salvation, deliverance 1a) deliverance (usually by God through human agency) 1b) salvation (spiritual in sense).
- Summarized of the Judges. When Israel was obedient, God blessed them. When they went after other gods, God punished them into slavery. When they repented & turned back to God, God sent a judge to free them.
