- Proverbs 22:1 (AV) A *good* name *is* rather to be chosen than great riches, *and* loving favour rather than silver and gold.
- Proverbs 22:1 (NKJV) A *good* name is to be chosen rather than great riches, Loving favor rather than silver and gold.

- Proverbs 22:2 (AV) The rich and poor meet together: the LORD *is* the maker of them all.
- Proverbs 22:2 (NKJV) The rich and the poor have this in common, The LORD is the maker of them all.
- Proverbs 22:3 (AV) A <u>prudent man (person) foreseeth the evil, and hideth</u> <u>himself</u>: but the simple (fool) zpass on, and are punished.
- Proverbs 22:3 (NKJV) A <u>prudent man foresees evil and hides himself</u>, But the simple pass on and are punished.
- Proverbs 22:4 (AV) By humility *and* the fear of the LORD *are* riches, and honour, and life.
- Proverbs 22:4 (NKJV) By humility *and* the fear of the LORD *Are* riches and honor and life.
- Numbers 12:3 (Now the man Moses was very meek, above all the men which were upon the face of the earth.)
- Matthew 11:29 Take My yoke upon you, and learn of Me; for I am meek and lowly in heart: and ye shall find rest unto your souls.
- Proverbs 22:5 (AV) Thorns *and* snares *are* in the way of the froward: he that doth keep his soul shall be far from them.

- Proverbs 22:9 (NKJV) He who has a generous eye will be blessed, For he gives of his bread to the poor.
- Referred to Job helping the poor.
- Luke 21 Referred to the Widow's mites. V3 And he said, Of a truth I say unto you, that this poor widow hath cast in more than they all:
- Mark 14:7 For ye have the poor with you always, and whensoever ye will ye may do them good: but me ye have not always.
- Proverbs 22:10 (AV) Cast out the scorner, and contention shall go out; yea, strife and reproach shall cease.
- Proverbs 22:10 (NKJV) Cast out the scoffer, and contention will leave; Yes, strife and reproach will cease.
- Galatians 3:28 There is neither Jew nor Greek, there is neither bond nor free, there is neither male nor female: for ye are all one in Christ Jesus.
- Proverbs 22:11 (AV) He that loveth pureness of heart, *for* the grace of his lips the king *shall be* his friend.
- Proverbs 22:11 (NKJV) He who loves purity of heart *And has* grace on his lips, The king *will be* his friend.

- Proverbs 22:13 (AV) The slothful *man* saith, *There is* a lion without, I shall be slain in the streets.
- Proverbs 22:13 (NKJV) The lazy *man* says, *There is* a lion outside! I shall be slain in the streets!
- Proverbs 22:14 (AV) The mouth of strange women *is* a deep pit: he that is abhorred of the LORD shall fall therein.
- Proverbs 22:14 (NKJV) The mouth of an immoral woman *is* a deep pit; He who is abhorred by the LORD will fall there.
- Genesis 39:12 And she caught him by his garment, saying, Lie with me: and he left his garment in her hand, and fled, and got him out.
- 2 Timothy 2:22 Flee also youthful lusts: but follow righteousness, faith, charity, peace, with them that call on the Lord out of a pure heart.

- Proverbs 13:22 A good man leaveth an inheritance to his children's children: and the wealth of the sinner is laid up for the just.
- Proverbs 22:17 (AV) Bow down thine ear, and hear the words of the wise, and apply thine heart unto my knowledge.
- Proverbs 22:17 (NKJV) Incline your ear and hear the words of the wise, And apply your heart to my knowledge;
- Proverbs 22:18 (AV) For *it is* a pleasant thing if thou keep them within thee; they shall withal be fitted in thy lips.
- Proverbs 22:18 (NKJV) For *it is* a pleasant thing if you keep them within you; Let them all be fixed upon your lips,
- Proverbs 22:19 (AV) That thy trust may be in the LORD, I have made known to thee this day, even to thee.
- Proverbs 22:19 (NKJV) So that your trust may be in the LORD; I have instructed you today, even you.
- Psalms 37:5 Commit thy way unto the LORD; trust also in Him; and He shall bring it to pass.
- Proverbs 22:20 (AV) Have not I written to thee excellent things in counsels and knowledge,
- Proverbs 22:20 (NKJV) Have I not written to you excellent things of counsels and knowledge,
- Proverbs 22:21 (AV) That I might make thee know the certainty of the words of truth; that thou mightest answer the words of truth to them that send unto thee?
- Proverbs 22:21 (NKJV) That I may make you know the certainty of the words of truth, That you may answer words of truth to those who send to you?
- Proverbs 22:22 (AV) Rob not the poor, because he *is* poor: neither oppress the afflicted in the gate:
- Proverbs 22:22 (NKJV) Do not rob the poor because he *is* poor, Nor oppress the afflicted at the gate;
- Proverbs 22:23 (AV) For the LORD will plead their cause, and spoil the soul of those that spoiled them.
- Proverbs 22:23 (NKJV) For the LORD will plead their cause, And plunder the soul of those who plunder them.
- Hebrews 7:25 Wherefore He is able also to save them to the uttermost that come unto God by Him, seeing He ever liveth to make intercession for them.
- 1 John 2:1 My little children, these things write I unto you, that ye sin not.

- Proverbs 22:26 (NKJV) Do not be one of those who shakes hands in a pledge, One of those who is surety for debts;
- Proverbs 22:27 (AV) If thou hast nothing to pay, why should he take away thy bed from under thee?
- Proverbs 22:27 (NKJV) If you have nothing with which to pay, Why should he take away your bed from under you?
- Proverbs 22:28 (AV) Remove not the ancient landmark, which thy fathers have set.
- Proverbs 22:28 (NKJV) Do not remove the ancient landmark Which your fathers have set.
- Proverbs 22:29 (AV) Seest thou a man diligent in his business? he shall stand before kings; he shall not stand before mean *men*.
- Proverbs 22:29 (NKJV) Do you see a man *who* excels in his work? He will stand before kings; He will not stand before unknown *men*.
- Colossians 3:23 And whatsoever ye do, do it heartily, as to the Lord, and not unto men;
- Summarized of Nehemiah, Ezra, & Joseph raise from slave to ruler for God.
- Colossians 3:17 And whatsoever ye do in word or deed, do all in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks to God and the Father by him.
