## **Are You Really A New Creation - Galatians 6C**

- Summarized of Salvation & a new life in Jesus.
- Galatians 6:1 Brethren, if a man be overtaken in a fault, ye which are spiritual, restore such an one in the spirit of meekness; considering thyself, lest thou also be tempted.
- 1 Timothy 2:1,2 I exhort therefore, that, first of all, supplications, prayers, intercessions, and giving of thanks, be made for all men; 2 For kings, and for all that are in authority; that we may lead a quiet and peaceable life in all godliness and honesty.
- Mark 14:27 And Jesus saith unto them, All ye shall be offended because of me this night: for it is written, I will smite the shepherd, and the sheep shall be scattered.
- **Galatians 6:11-18 (AV) & (NKJV)**
- Galatians 6:11 (AV) Ye see how large a letter I have written unto you with mine own hand.
- Galatians 6:11 (NKJV) See with what large letters I have written to you with my own hand!
- Acts 15:1,2 And certain men which came down from Judaea taught the brethren, and said, Except ye be circumcised after the manner of Moses, ye cannot be saved. 2 When therefore Paul and Barnabas had no small dissension and disputation with them, they determined that Paul and Barnabas, and certain other of them, should go up to Jerusalem unto the apostles and elders about this question.
- Acts 15:19,20 Wherefore my sentence is, that we trouble not them, which from among the Gentiles are turned to God: 20 But that we write unto them, that they abstain from pollutions of idols, and from fornication, and from things strangled, and from blood.
- Mark 16:17,18 And these signs shall follow them that believe; In My Name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues; 18 They shall take up serpents; and if they drink any deadly thing, it shall not hurt them; they shall lay hands on the sick, and they shall recover.
- Galatians 6:12 (AV) As many as desire to make a fair shew in the flesh, they constrain you to be circumcised; only lest they should suffer persecution for the cross of Christ.
- Galatians 6:12 (NKJV) As many as desire to make a good showing in the flesh, these *would* <u>compel</u> you to be circumcised, only that they may not suffer persecution for the cross of Christ.
- Acts 15:5 But there rose up certain of the sect of the Pharisees which believed, saying, That it was needful to circumcise them, and to command

- them to keep the law of Moses.
- Romans 2:29 But he is a Jew, which is one inwardly; and circumcision is that of the heart, in the spirit, and not in the letter; whose praise is not of men, but of God.
- Matthew 14:14 And Jesus went forth, and saw a great multitude, and was moved with compassion toward them, and he healed their sick.
- John 6:14,15 Then those men, when they had seen the miracle that Jesus did, said, This is of a truth that prophet that should come into the world. 15 When Jesus therefore perceived that they would come and take Him by force, to make Him a king, he departed again into a mountain Himself alone.
- Romans 12:2 And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what is that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God.
- Acts 26 Referred to Saul hating & persecuting Christians. V10 Which thing I also did in Jerusalem: and many of the saints did I shut up in prison, having received authority from the chief priests; and when they were put to death, I gave my voice against them.
- John 14:6 Jesus saith unto him, I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by Me.
- Galatians 6:13 (AV) For neither they themselves who are circumcised keep the law; but desire to have you circumcised, that they may glory in your flesh.
- Galatians 6:13 (NKJV) For not even those who are circumcised keep the law, but they desire to have you circumcised that they may boast in your flesh.
- Luke 12:1 In the mean time, when there were gathered together an innumerable multitude of people, insomuch that they trode one upon another, He began to say unto His disciples first of all, Beware ye of the leaven of the Pharisees, which is hypocrisy.
- 1 Timothy 2:5 For there is one God, and one Mediator between God and men, the Man Christ Jesus:
- 2 Corinthians 13:5 Examine yourselves, whether ye be in the faith; prove your own selves. Know ye not your own selves, how that Jesus Christ is in you, except ye be reprobates?
- Matthew 16:6 Then Jesus said unto them, Take heed and beware of the leaven of the Pharisees and of the Sadducees.
- Galatians 6:14 (AV) But God forbid that I should glory, save in the cross of our Lord Jesus Christ, by Whom the world is crucified unto me, and I unto the world.
- Galatians 6:14 (NKJV) But God forbid that I should boast except in the cross of our Lord Jesus Christ, by Whom the world has been crucified to me, and I to the world.

- Galatians 6:14 (Message) For my part, I am going to boast about nothing but the Cross of our Master, Jesus Christ. Because of that Cross, I have been crucified in relation to the world, set free from the stifling atmosphere of pleasing others and fitting into the little patterns that they dictate.
- 2 Timothy 2:4 No man that warreth entangleth himself with the affairs of this life; that he may please him who hath chosen him to be a soldier.
- Acts 14:19 And there came thither certain Jews from Antioch and Iconium, who persuaded the people, and, having stoned Paul, drew him out of the city, supposing he had been dead. 20 Howbeit, as the disciples stood round about him, he rose up, and came into the city: and the next day he departed with Barnabas to Derbe.
- 1 Corinthians 11 Referred to Paul's Perils.
- John 8:36 If the Son therefore shall make you free, ye shall be free indeed.
- Galatians 5:1 Stand fast therefore in the liberty wherewith Christ hath made us free, and be not entangled again with the yoke of bondage.
- Galatians 6:15 (AV) For in Christ Jesus neither circumcision availeth any thing, nor uncircumcision, but a new creature.
- Galatians 6:15 (NKJV) For in Christ Jesus neither circumcision nor uncircumcision avails anything, but a new creation.
- 2 Corinthians 5:17 Therefore if any man be in Christ, he is a new creature: old things are passed away; behold, all things are become new.
- Luke 10:19 Behold, I give unto you power to tread on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy: and nothing shall by any means hurt you.
- Matthew 18:18 Verily I say unto you, Whatsoever ye shall bind on earth shall be bound in heaven: and whatsoever ye shall loose on earth shall be loosed in heaven.
- Mark 16:17 And these signs shall follow them that believe; In My Name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues;
- Romans 8:13 For if ye live after the flesh, ye shall die: but if ye through the Spirit do mortify the deeds of the body, ye shall live.
- Luke 8 Summarized of the changes in the Gadarene demoniac before & after Jesus cast out the demons. V35 Then they went out to see what was done; and came to Jesus, and found the man, out of whom the devils were departed, sitting at the feet of Jesus, clothed, and in his right mind: and they were afraid.
- Luke 8:39 Return to thine own house, and shew how great things God hath done unto thee. And he went his way, and published throughout the whole city how great things Jesus had done unto him.
- John 10:10 The thief cometh not, but for to steal, and to kill, and to destroy: I am come that they might have life, and that they might have it more abundantly.

- Genesis 3 Referred to the fall of mankind. V10 And he said, I heard thy voice in the garden, and I was afraid, because I was naked; and I hid myself.
- Galatians 6:16 (AV) And as many as walk according to this rule, peace *be* on them, and mercy, and upon the Israel of God.
- Galatians 6:16 (NKJV) And as many as walk according to this rule, peace and mercy *be* upon them, and upon the Israel of God.
- Matthew 7:14 Because strait is the gate, and narrow is the way, which leadeth unto life, and few there be that find it.
- 1 Timothy 1:2 Unto Timothy, my own son in the faith: Grace, mercy, and peace, from God our Father and Jesus Christ our Lord.
- Revelation 7:4 And I heard the number of them which were sealed: and there were sealed an hundred and forty and four thousand of all the tribes of the children of Israel.
- Galatians 6:17 (AV) From henceforth let no man trouble me: for I bear in my body the marks of the Lord Jesus.
- Galatians 6:17 (NKJV) From now on let no one trouble me, for I bear in my body the marks of the Lord Jesus.
- Galatians 6:18 (AV) Brethren, the grace of our Lord Jesus Christ *be* with your spirit. Amen. « *To the* Galatians written from Rome. »
- Galatians 6:18 (NKJV) Brethren, the grace of our Lord Jesus Christ *be* with your spirit. Amen.
- Ezra 9:13 And after all that is come upon us for our evil deeds, and for our great trespass, seeing that thou our God hast punished us less than our iniquities deserve, and hast given us such deliverance as this;
- Luke 23:34 Then said Jesus, Father, forgive them; for they know not what they do. And they parted His raiment, and cast lots.
- Romans 8:29 For whom He did foreknow, He also did predestinate *to be* <u>conformed</u> to the image of His Son, that He might be the firstborn among many brethren.
- Jeremiah 1:5 Before I formed thee in the belly I knew thee; and before thou camest forth out of the womb I sanctified thee, and I ordained thee a prophet unto the nations.
- Referred to God calling John Baptist, Samson, & Samuel to His work before their birth.
- Acts 17:30 And the times of this ignorance God winked at; but now commandeth all men every where to repent:
- 1 Kings 18:37 Hear me, O LORD, hear me, that this people may know that Thou *art* the LORD God, and *that* Thou hast turned their heart back again.
- John 16:8 And when He is come, He will reprove the world of sin, and of righteousness, and of judgment:
- Romans 10:13 For whosoever shall call upon the Name of the Lord shall be saved.

- Romans 10:9 That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised Him from the dead, thou shalt be saved.
- Romans 12:2 And be not <u>conformed</u> to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what *is* that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God.
- Philippians 3:10 That I may know him, and the power of his resurrection, and the fellowship of his sufferings, being made <u>conformable</u> unto his death;
- Hebrews 13:5 Let your conversation be without covetousness; and be content with such things as ye have: for he hath said, I will never leave thee, nor forsake thee.
- Ezekiel 33:30-33 (AV) & (NKJV)
- Ezekiel 33:30 (AV) Also, thou son of man, the children of thy people still are talking against thee by the walls and in the doors of the houses, and speak one to another, every one to his brother, saying, Come, I pray you, and hear what is the word that cometh forth from the LORD.
- Ezekiel 33:30 (NKJV) As for you, son of man, the children of your people are talking about you beside the walls and in the doors of the houses; and they speak to one another, everyone saying to his brother, Please come and hear what the word is that comes from the LORD.
- Ezekiel 33:31 (AV) And they come unto thee as the people cometh, and they sit before thee *as* my people, and they hear thy words, but they will not do them: for with their mouth they shew much love, *but* their heart goeth after their covetousness.
- Ezekiel 33:31 (NKJV) So they come to you as people do, they sit before you as My people, and they hear your words, but they do not do them; for with their mouth they show much love, but their hearts pursue their own gain.
- Ezekiel 33:32 (AV) And, lo, thou *art* unto them as a very lovely song of one that hath a pleasant voice, and can play well on an instrument: for they hear thy words, but they do them not.
- Ezekiel 33:32 (NKJV) Indeed you *are* to them as a very lovely song of one who has a pleasant voice and can play well on an instrument; for they hear your words, but they do not do them.
- James 1:25 But whoso looketh into the perfect law of liberty, and continueth therein, he being not a forgetful hearer, but a doer of the work, this man shall be blessed in his deed.
- Ezekiel 33:33 (AV) And when this cometh to pass, (lo, it will come,) then shall they know that a prophet hath been among them.
- Ezekiel 33:33 (NKJV) And when this comes to pass surely it will come then they will know that a prophet has been among them.
- Isaiah 29:13 Wherefore the Lord said, Forasmuch as this people draw near *Me* with their mouth, and with their <u>lips</u> do <u>honour</u> Me, but have removed

- their <u>heart</u> far from Me, and their fear toward Me is taught by the precept of men:
- Matthew 15:8 This people draweth nigh unto Me with their mouth, and honoureth Me with *their* lips; but their heart is far from Me.
- Mark 7:6 He answered and said unto them, Well hath Isaiah prophesied of you hypocrites, as it is written, This people <u>honoureth</u> Me with *their* <u>lips</u>, but their heart is far from Me.
- Ezekiel 11:19 And I will give them one <u>heart</u>, and I will put a <u>new spirit</u> within you; and I will take the stony <u>heart</u> out of their flesh, and will give them an heart of flesh:
- Ezekiel 18:31 Cast away from you all your transgressions, whereby ye have transgressed; and make you a <u>new heart</u> and a <u>new spirit</u>: for why will ye die, O house of Israel?
- Ezekiel 36:26 A <u>new heart</u> also will I give you, and a <u>new spirit</u> will I put within you: and I will take away the stony <u>heart</u> out of your flesh, and I will give you an <u>heart</u> of flesh.
- Hebrews 10:19-25 Having therefore, brethren, boldness to enter into the Holiest by the Blood of Jesus, 20 By a new and living way, which He hath consecrated for us, through the veil, that is to say, His flesh; 21 And having an high priest over the house of God; 22 Let us draw near with a true heart in full assurance of faith, having our hearts sprinkled from an evil conscience, and our bodies washed with pure water. 23 Let us hold fast the profession of our faith without wavering (compromising); (for he is faithful that promised;) 24 And let us consider one another to provoke unto love and to good works: 25 Not forsaking the assembling of ourselves together, as the manner of some is; but exhorting one another: and so much the more, as ye see the day approaching.
- John 3:7 Marvel not that I said unto thee, Ye must be born again.
- 2 Corinthians 6:2 (For he saith, I have heard thee in a time accepted, and in the day of salvation have I succoured thee: behold, now is the accepted time; behold, now is the day of salvation.)
