- Proverbs 23:1-35 (AV) & (NKJV)
- Proverbs 23:1 (AV) When thou sittest to eat with a ruler, consider diligently what *is* before thee:
- Proverbs 23:1 (NKJV) When you sit down to eat with a ruler, Consider carefully what *is* before you;
- Proverbs 23:2 (AV) And put a knife to thy throat, if thou *be* a man given to appetite.
- Proverbs 23:2 (NKJV) And put a knife to your throat If you *are* a man given to appetite.
- Proverbs 23:3 (AV) Be not desirous of his dainties: for they *are* deceitful meat.
- Proverbs 23:3 (NKJV) Do not desire his delicacies, For they *are* deceptive food.
