- Isaiah 35:8 And an highway shall be there, and a way, and it shall be called The way of holiness; the unclean shall not pass over it; but it shall be for those: the wayfaring men, though fools, shall not err therein.
- Matthew 7:14 Because strait is the gate, and narrow is the way, which leadeth unto life, and few there be that find it.
- Matthew 5:3 Blessed are the poor in spirit: for theirs is the kingdom of heaven.
- Proverbs 24:1-34 (AV) & (NKJV)
- Proverbs 24:1 (AV) Be not thou envious against evil men, neither desire to be with them.
- Proverbs 24:1 (NKJV) Do not be envious of evil men (people), Nor desire to be with them;
- Exodus 20:17 <u>Thou shalt not covet</u> thy neighbour's house, thou shalt not covet thy neighbour's wife, nor his manservant, nor his maidservant, nor his ox, nor his ass, nor any thing that is thy neighbour's.
- Proverbs 24:2 (AV) For their heart studieth destruction, and their lips talk of mischief.
- Proverbs 24:2 (NKJV) For their heart devises violence, And their lips talk of troublemaking.
- 1 Kings 18:37 Hear me, O LORD, hear me, that this people may know that Thou *art* the LORD God, and *that* Thou hast turned their heart back again.
- Romans 10:9,10 That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised him from the dead, thou shalt be saved. 10 For with the heart man believeth unto righteousness; and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation.
- Strongs #07701 shod *shode* or showd (Job 5:21) *shode* AV-spoil 10, destruction 7, desolation 2, robbery 2, wasting 2, oppression 1, spoiler 1; 25 1) havoc, violence, destruction, devastation, ruin 1a) violence, havoc (as social sin) 1b) devastation, ruin.
- 1 Corinthians 15:33 Be not deceived: evil communications corrupt good manners.
- Proverbs 24:3 (AV) Through wisdom is an house builded; and by understanding it is established:
- Proverbs 24:3 (NKJV) Through wisdom a house is built, And by understanding it is established;
- Proverbs 4:5 Get wisdom, get understanding: forget it not; neither decline from the words of my mouth.

- Proverbs 9:10 The fear of the LORD is the beginning of wisdom: and the knowledge of the holy is understanding.
- Matthew 7:20 Wherefore by their fruits ye shall know them.
- Proverbs 24:4 (AV) And by knowledge shall the chambers be filled with all precious and pleasant riches.
- Proverbs 24:4 (NKJV) By knowledge the rooms are filled With all precious and pleasant riches.
- Joshua 24:15 And if it seem evil unto you to serve the LORD, choose you this day whom ye will serve; whether the gods which your fathers served that were on the other side of the flood, or the gods of the Amorites, in whose land ye dwell: but as for me and my house, we will serve the LORD.
- Proverbs 24:5 (AV) A wise man *is* strong; yea, a man of knowledge increaseth strength.
- Proverbs 24:5 (NKJV) A wise man (person) *is* strong, Yes, a man of knowledge increases strength;
- 1 Corinthians 6:19 What? know ye not that your body is the temple of the Holy Ghost which is in you, which ye have of God, & ye are not your own?
- Luke 16:13 No servant can serve two masters: for either he will hate the one, and love the other; or else he will hold to the one, and despise the other. Ye cannot serve God and mammon.
- Proverbs 24:6 (AV) For by wise counsel thou shalt make thy war: and in multitude of counsellors *there is* safety.
- Proverbs 24:6 (NKJV) For by wise counsel you will wage your own war, And in a multitude of counselors *there is* safety.
- Mark 9:29 And he said unto them, This kind can come forth by nothing, but by prayer and fasting.
- Proverbs 24:7 (AV) Wisdom *is* too high for a fool: he openeth not his mouth in the gate.
- Proverbs 24:7 (NKJV) Wisdom *is* too lofty for a fool; He does not open his mouth in the gate.
- Proverbs 24:8 (AV) He that deviseth to do evil shall be called a mischievous person.
- Proverbs 24:8 (NKJV) He who plots to do evil will be called a schemer.
- Luke 8:11 Now the parable is this: The seed is the Word of God. (mis-used)
- Proverbs 24:9 (AV) The thought of foolishness *is* sin: and the scorner *is* an abomination to men.
- Proverbs 24:9 (NKJV) The devising of foolishness *is* sin, And the scoffer *is* an abomination to men.
- Genesis 6:5 And GOD saw that the wickedness of man was great in the earth, and that every imagination of the thoughts of his heart was only evil continually.

- Proverbs 6:16,18 These six things doth the LORD hate: yea, seven are an abomination unto him: 18 An heart that deviseth wicked imaginations, feet that be swift in running to mischief,
- Proverbs 24:10 (AV) If thou faint in the day of adversity, thy strength is small.
- Proverbs 24:10 (NKJV) *If* you faint in the day of adversity, Your strength *is* small.
- Job 1:21 And said, Naked came I out of my mother's womb, and naked shall I return thither: the LORD gave, and the LORD hath taken away; blessed be the name of the LORD.
- Luke 22:31,32 And the Lord said, Simon, Simon, behold, Satan hath desired to have you, that he may sift you as wheat: 32 But I have prayed for thee, that thy faith fail not: and when thou art converted, strengthen thy brethren.
- Matthew 7:24,25 Therefore whosoever heareth these sayings of mine, and doeth them, I will liken him unto a wise man, which built his house upon a rock: 25 And the rain descended, and the floods came, and the winds blew, and beat upon that house; and it fell not: for it was founded upon a rock.
- Romans 8:38,39 For I am persuaded, that neither death, nor life, nor angels, nor principalities, nor powers, nor things present, nor things to come, 39 Nor height, nor depth, nor any other creature, shall be able to separate us from the love of God, which is in Christ Jesus our Lord.
- Hebrews 13:5 Let your conversation be without covetousness; and be content with such things as ye have: for He hath said, I will never leave thee, nor forsake thee.
- Proverbs 24:11 (AV) If thou forbear to deliver *them that are* drawn unto death, and *those that are* ready to be slain;
- Proverbs 24:11 (NKJV) Deliver *those who* are drawn toward death, And hold back *those* stumbling to the slaughter.
- Proverbs 24:12 (AV) If thou sayest, Behold, we knew it not; doth not he that pondereth the heart consider *it*? and he that keepeth thy soul, doth *not* he know *it*? and shall *not* he render to *every* man according to his works?
- Proverbs 24:12 (NKJV) If you say, Surely we did not know this, Does not He who weighs the hearts consider *it*? He who keeps your soul, does He *not* know *it*? And will He *not* render to *each* man according to his deeds?
- Galatians 6:1 Brethren, if a man be overtaken in a fault, ye which are spiritual, restore such an one in the spirit of meekness; considering thyself, lest thou also be tempted.
- Mark 5:6 But when he saw Jesus afar off, he ran and worshipped Him, Proverbs Referred to the cautions against the immoral woman.
- Proverbs 6:32 But whose committeth adultery with a woman lacketh

- understanding: he that doeth it destroyeth his own soul.
- Matthew 25:25 And I was afraid, and went and hid thy talent in the earth: lo, there thou hast that is thine.
- Proverbs 24:13 (AV) My son, eat thou honey, because *it is* good; and the honeycomb, *which is* sweet to thy taste:
- Proverbs 24:13 (NKJV) My son, eat honey because *it is* good, And the honeycomb *which is* sweet to your taste;
- 1 Samuel 14 Summarized of Johnathan & Saul & eating honey.
- Proverbs 24:14 (AV) So *shall* the knowledge of wisdom *be* unto thy soul: when thou hast found *it*, then there shall be a reward, and thy expectation shall not be cut off.
- Proverbs 24:14 (NKJV) So *shall* the knowledge of wisdom *be* to your soul; If you have found *it*, there is a prospect, And your hope will not be cut off.
- Luke 24:32 And they said one to another, Did not our heart burn within us, while he talked with us by the way, and while he opened to us the scriptures?
- Proverbs 24:15 (AV) Lay not wait, O wicked *man*, against the dwelling of the righteous; spoil not his resting place:
- Proverbs 24:15 (NKJV) Do not lie in wait, O wicked *man*, against the dwelling of the righteous; Do not plunder his resting place;
- Proverbs 24:16 (AV) For a just *man* falleth seven times, and riseth up again: but the wicked shall fall into mischief.
- Proverbs 24:16 (NKJV) For a righteous *man* may fall seven times And rise again, But the wicked shall fall by calamity.
- John 10:28,29 And I give unto them eternal life; and they shall never perish, neither shall any man pluck them out of My hand. 29 My Father, which gave them Me, is greater than all; and no man is able to pluck them out of My Father's hand.
- 1 John 1:9 If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.
- Matthew 18:21,22 Then came Peter to him, and said, Lord, how oft shall my brother sin against me, and I forgive him? till seven times? 22 Jesus saith unto him, I say not unto thee, Until seven times: but, Until seventy times seven.
- Matthew 6:12 And forgive us our debts, as we forgive our debtors.
- Luke 15:17,18 And when he came to himself, he said, How many hired servants of my father's have bread enough and to spare, and I perish with hunger! 18 I will arise and go to my father, and will say unto him, Father, I have sinned against heaven, and before thee,
- Proverbs 24:17 (AV) Rejoice not when thine enemy falleth, and let not thine heart be glad when he stumbleth:

- Proverbs 24:17 (NKJV) Do not rejoice when your enemy falls, And do not let your heart be glad when he stumbles;
- Proverbs 24:18 (AV) Lest the LORD see *it*, and it displease him, and he turn away his wrath from him.
- Proverbs 24:18 (NKJV) Lest the LORD see *it*, and it displease Him, And He turn away His wrath from him.
- Psalms 109:4 For my love they are my adversaries: but I give myself unto prayer.
- Romans 12:19 Dearly beloved, avenge not yourselves, but rather give place unto wrath: for it is written, Vengeance is Mine; I will repay, saith the Lord.
- Proverbs 24:19 (AV) Fret not thyself because of evil *men*, neither be thou envious at the wicked;
- Proverbs 24:19 (NKJV) Do not fret because of evildoers, Nor be envious of the wicked;
- Isaiah 1:26 And I will restore thy judges as at the first, and thy counsellors as at the beginning: afterward thou shalt be called, The city of righteousness, the faithful city.
- Daniel 4 Referred to God dealing with Nebuchadnezzar.
- Proverbs 24:20 (AV) For there shall be no reward to the evil *man*; the candle of the wicked shall be put out.
- Proverbs 24:20 (NKJV) For there will be no prospect for the evil *man*; The lamp of the wicked will be put out.
- Proverbs 24:21 (AV) My son, fear thou the LORD and the king: *and* meddle not with them that are given to change:
- Proverbs 24:21 (NKJV) My son, fear the LORD and the king; Do not associate with those given to change;
- Acts 5:29 Then Peter and the other apostles answered and said, We ought to obey God rather than men.
- 1 Timothy 2:1,2 I exhort therefore, that, first of all, supplications, prayers, intercessions, and giving of thanks, be made for all men; 2 For kings, and for all that are in authority; that we may lead a quiet and peaceable life in all godliness and honesty.
- Proverbs 24:22 (AV) For their calamity shall rise suddenly; and who knoweth the ruin of them both?
- Proverbs 24:22 (NKJV) For their calamity will rise suddenly, And who knows the ruin those two can bring?
- Luke 12:18,20 And he said, This will I do: I will pull down my barns, and build greater; and there will I bestow all my fruits and my goods. 20 But God said unto him, Thou fool, this night thy soul shall be required of thee: then whose shall those things be, which thou hast provided?

- Matthew 6:20 But lay up for yourselves treasures in heaven, where neither moth nor rust doth corrupt, and where thieves do not break through nor steal:
- Proverbs 24:23 (AV) These *things* also *belong* to the wise. *It is* not good to have respect of persons in judgment.
- Proverbs 24:23 (NKJV) These *things* also *belong* to the wise: *It is* not good to show partiality in judgment.
- Proverbs 24:24 (AV) He that saith unto the wicked, Thou *art* righteous; him shall the people curse, nations shall abhor him:
- Proverbs 24:24 (NKJV) He who says to the wicked, You *are* righteous, Him the people will curse; nations will abhor him.
- Proverbs 24:25 (AV) But to them that rebuke *him* shall be delight, and a good blessing shall come upon them.
- Proverbs 24:25 (NKJV) But those who rebuke *the wicked* will have delight, And a good blessing will come upon them.
- Proverbs 24:26 (AV) Every man shall kiss his lips that giveth a right answer.
- Proverbs 24:26 (NKJV) He who gives a right answer kisses the lips.
- Proverbs 24:27 (AV) Prepare thy work without, and make it fit for thyself in the field; and afterwards build thine house.
- Proverbs 24:27 (NKJV) Prepare your outside work, Make it fit for yourself in the field; And afterward build your house. (Prioritize work)
- Proverbs 24:28 (AV) Be not a witness against thy neighbour without cause; and deceive *not* with thy lips.
- Proverbs 24:28 (NKJV) Do not be a witness against your neighbor without cause, for would you deceive with your lips?
- Proverbs 24:29 (AV) Say not, I will do so to him as he hath done to me: I will render to the man according to his work.
- Proverbs 24:29 (NKJV) Do not say, I will do to him just as he has done to me; I will render to the man according to his work.
- Deuteronomy 19:21 And thine eye shall not pity; but life shall go for life, eye for eye, tooth for tooth, hand for hand, foot for foot.
- Matthew 5:38,39 Ye have heard that it hath been said, An eye for an eye, and a tooth for a tooth: 39 But I say unto you, That ye resist not evil: but whosoever shall smite thee on thy right cheek, turn to him the other also.
- Proverbs 24:30 (AV) I went by the field of the slothful, and by the vineyard of the man void of understanding;
- Proverbs 24:30 (NKJV) I went by the field of the lazy *man*, And by the vineyard of the man devoid of understanding;
- Proverbs 24:31 (AV) And, lo, it was all grown over with thorns, & nettles had covered the face thereof, and the stone wall thereof was broken down.
- Proverbs 24:31 (NKJV) And there it was, all overgrown with thorns; Its

- surface was covered with nettles; Its stone wall was broken down.
- 1 Corinthians 7:33 But he that is married careth for the things that are of the world, how he may please his wife.
- Isaiah 59:19 So shall they fear the Name of the LORD from the west, and his glory from the rising of the sun. When the enemy shall come in like a flood, the Spirit of the LORD shall lift up a standard against him.
- Matthew 18:18 Verily I say unto you, Whatsoever ye shall bind on earth shall be bound in heaven: and whatsoever ye shall loose on earth shall be loosed in heaven.
- **Ephesians 6 Referred to the Godly spiritual armour.**
- Proverbs 24:32 (AV) Then I saw, and considered it well: I looked upon it, and received instruction.
- Proverbs 24:32 (NKJV) When I saw *it*, I considered *it* well; I looked on *it and* received instruction:
- Esther 4:14 For if thou altogether holdest thy peace at this time, then shall there enlargement and deliverance arise to the Jews from another place; but thou and thy father's house shall be destroyed: and who knoweth whether thou art come to the kingdom for such a time as this?
- Proverbs 24:33 (AV) *Yet* a little sleep, a little slumber, a little folding of the hands to sleep:
- Proverbs 24:33 (NKJV) A little sleep, a little slumber, A little folding of the hands to rest;
- Proverbs 24:34 (AV) So shall thy poverty come *as* one that travelleth; and thy want as an armed man.
- Proverbs 24:34 (NKJV) So shall your poverty come *like* a prowler, And your need like an armed man.
- Mark 9:29 And he said unto them, This kind can come forth by nothing, but by prayer and fasting.
- Ephesians 6:12 For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high places.
- 2 Corinthians 6:2 (For he saith, I have heard thee in a time accepted, and in the day of salvation have I succoured thee: behold, now is the accepted time; behold, now is the day of salvation.)
