- Leviticus 6:4 (NKJV) then it shall be, because he has sinned and is guilty, that he shall restore what he has stolen, or the thing which he has extorted, or what was delivered to him for safekeeping, or the lost thing

- which he found,
- Deuteronomy 28:31 Thine ox *shall be* slain before thine eyes, and thou shalt not eat thereof: thine ass *shall be* <u>violently</u> taken away from before thy face, and shall not be restored to thee: thy sheep *shall be* given unto thine enemies, and thou shalt have none to rescue *them*.
- Deuteronomy 28:31 (NKJV) Your ox *shall be* slaughtered before your eyes, but you shall not eat of it; your donkey *shall be* violently taken away from before you, and shall not be restored to you; your sheep *shall be* given to your enemies, and you shall have no one to rescue *them*.
- **Deuteronomy 28 Referred to the blessings & curses.**
- 2 Samuel 22:3 The God of my rock; in Him will I trust: *He is* my Shield, and the Horn of my Salvation, my high Tower, and my Refuge, my Saviour; Thou savest me from violence.
- 2 Samuel 22:3 (NKJV) The God of my strength, in Whom I will trust; My Shield and the Horn of my Salvation, My Stronghold and my Refuge; My Savior, You save me from violence.
- 2 Samuel 22:49 And that bringeth me forth from mine enemies: Thou also hast lifted me up on high above them that rose up against me: Thou hast delivered me from the violent man.
- 2 Samuel 22:49 (NKJV) He delivers me from my enemies. You also lift me up above those who rise against me; You have delivered me from the violent man.
- Job 20:19 Because he hath oppressed *and* hath forsaken the poor; *because* he hath <u>violently</u> taken away an house which he builded not;
- Job 20:19 (NKJV) For he has oppressed *and* forsaken the poor, He has violently seized a house which he did not build.
- Job 24:2 *Some* remove the landmarks; they <u>violently</u> take away flocks, and feed *thereof*.
- Job 24:2 (NKJV) *Some* remove landmarks; They seize flocks violently and feed *on them*;
- Psalms 7:16 His mischief shall return upon his own head, and his <u>violent</u> dealing shall come down upon his own pate.
- Psalms 7:16 (NKJV) His trouble shall return upon his own head, and his violent dealing shall come down on his own crown.
- Psalms 11:5 The LORD trieth the righteous: but the wicked and him that loveth <u>violence</u> His soul hateth.
- Psalms 11:5 (NKJV) The LORD tests the righteous, But the wicked and the one who loves violence His soul hates.
- 1 John 1:9 If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.
- Psalms 18:48 He delivereth me from mine enemies: yea, Thou liftest me up above those that rise up against me: Thou hast delivered me from the

- violent man.
- Psalms 18:48 (NKJV) He delivers me from my enemies. You also lift me up above those who rise against me; You have delivered me from the violent man.
- Referred to Saul tying to kill David.
- 2 Samuel 11:15 And he (David) wrote in the letter, saying, Set ye Uriah in the forefront of the hottest battle, and retire ye from him, that he may be smitten, and die.
- Psalms 55:9 Destroy, O Lord, *and* divide their tongues: for I have seen violence and strife in the city.
- Psalms 55:9 (NKJV) Destroy, O Lord, and divide their tongues, For I have seen violence and strife in the city.
- Psalms 58:2 Yea, in heart ye work wickedness; ye weigh the <u>violence of your</u> hands in the earth.
- Psalms 58:2 (NKJV) No, in heart you work wickedness; You weigh out the violence of your hands in the earth.
- Psalms 72:14 <u>He shall redeem their soul from deceit and violence</u>: and precious shall their blood be in His sight.
- Psalms 72:14 (NKJV) <u>He will redeem their life from oppression and violence;</u> And precious shall be their blood in His sight.
- Psalms 73:6 Therefore pride compasseth them about as a chain; <u>violence</u> covereth them *as* a garment.
- Psalms 73:6 (NKJV) Therefore pride serves as their necklace; Violence covers them *like* a garment.
- Malachi 2:16 For the LORD, the God of Israel, saith that he hateth putting away: for *one* covereth <u>violence</u> with his garment, saith the LORD of hosts: therefore take heed to your <u>spirit</u>, that ye deal not treacherously.
- Psalms 86:14 O God, the proud are risen against me, and the assemblies of violent men have sought after my soul; and have not set Thee before them.
- Psalms 86:14 (NKJV) O God, the proud have risen against me, and a mob of violent *men* have sought my life, and have not set You before them.
- Jeremiah 5:3 O LORD, are not thine eyes upon the truth? thou hast stricken them, but they have not grieved; thou hast consumed them, but they have refused to receive correction: they have made their faces harder than a rock; they have refused to return.
- Proverbs 23:9 Speak not in the ears of a fool: for he will despise the wisdom of thy words.
- Psalms 140:1 « To the chief Musician, A Psalm of David. » Deliver me, O LORD, from the evil man: preserve me from the violent man;
- Psalms 140:1 (NKJV) « To the Chief Musician. A Psalm of David. » Deliver me, O LORD, from evil men; <u>Preserve me from violent men</u>,
- Psalms 140:4 Keep me, O LORD, from the hands of the wicked; preserve me

- from the violent man; who have purposed to overthrow my goings.
- Psalms 140:4 (NKJV) Keep me, O LORD, from the hands of the wicked; <u>Preserve me from violent men</u>, Who have purposed to make my steps stumble.
- Psalms 140:11 Let not an evil speaker be established in the earth: evil shall hunt the violent man to overthrow *him*.
- Psalms 140:11 (NKJV) Let not a slanderer be established in the earth; Let evil hunt the violent man to overthrow *him*.
- Proverbs 4:17 For they eat the bread of wickedness, and <u>drink the wine of violence</u>. Proverbs 4:17 (NKJV) For they eat the bread of wickedness, And drink the wine of violence.
- Proverbs 20:1 Wine is a mocker, strong drink is raging: and whosoever is deceived thereby is not wise.
- Proverbs 10:6 Blessings *are* upon the head of the just: but <u>violence</u> covereth the mouth of the wicked.
- Proverbs 10:6 (NKJV) Blessings *are* on the head of the righteous, But violence covers the mouth of the wicked.
- **Deuteronomy 28 Referred to God's blessings.**
- Proverbs 10:11 The mouth of a righteous *man is* a well of life: but <u>violence</u> covereth the mouth of the wicked.
- Proverbs 10:11 (NKJV) The mouth of the righteous *is* a well of life, But violence covers the mouth of the wicked.
- 1 Samuel 17 Referred to Goliath's violent talk against God & David.
- Proverbs 13:2 A man shall eat good by the fruit of *his* mouth: but the <u>soul of</u> the transgressors *shall eat* violence.
- Proverbs 13:2 (NKJV) A man shall eat well by the fruit of *his* mouth, But the soul of the unfaithful feeds on violence.
- Proverbs 16:29 A <u>violent</u> man enticeth his neighbour, and leadeth him into the way *that is* not good.
- Proverbs 16:29 (NKJV) A violent man entices his neighbor, And leads him in a way *that is* not good.
- Proverbs 28:17 A man that doeth <u>violence</u> to the blood of *any* person shall flee to the pit; let no man stay him.
- Proverbs 28:17 (NKJV) A man burdened with bloodshed will flee into a pit; Let no one help him.
- Nehemiah 9:2 And the seed of Israel separated themselves from all strangers, and stood and confessed their sins, and the iniquities of their fathers.
