- Matthew 10:37 He that loveth father or mother more than Me is not worthy of Me: and he that loveth son or daughter more than Me is not worthy of Me.
- Ezekiel 28:16 (AV) By the multitude of thy merchandise they have filled the midst of thee with violence, and thou hast sinned: therefore I will cast thee as profane out of the mountain of God: and I will destroy thee, O covering cherub, from the midst of the stones of fire.
- Ezekiel 28:16 (NKJV) By the abundance of your trading You became filled with violence within, And you sinned; Therefore I cast you as a profane thing out of the mountain of God; And I destroyed you, O covering cherub, From the midst of the fiery stones.
- Psalms 73:6 Therefore pride compasseth them about as a chain; violence covereth them as a garment.
- John 10:10 (AV) The thief (devil) cometh not, but for to steal, and to kill, and to destroy: I am come that they might have life, and that they might have it more abundantly.
- John 10:10 (NKJV) The thief does not come except to steal, and to kill, and to destroy. I have come that they may have life, and that they may have *it* more abundantly.
- Genesis 6:11 The earth also was corrupt before God, and the earth was filled with violence.

- Ecclesiastes 5:8 If thou seest the oppression of the poor, and <u>violent perverting of judgment</u> and justice in a province, marvel not at the matter: for *he that is* higher than the highest regardeth; and *there be* higher than they.
- Ecclesiastes 5:8 (NKJV) If you see the oppression of the poor, and the <u>violent</u> <u>perversion of justice</u> and righteousness in a province, do not marvel at the

- matter; for high official watches over high official, and higher officials are over them.
- Hebrews 7:25 Wherefore He is able also to save them to the uttermost that come unto God by Him, seeing He ever liveth to make intercession for them.
- 1 John 2:1 My little children, these things write I unto you, that ye sin not.

  And if any man sin, we have an advocate with the Father, Jesus Christ the righteous:

- Isaiah 53:9 (NKJV) And they made His grave with the wicked But with the rich at His death, Because He had done no violence, Nor *was any* deceit in His mouth.
- Isaiah 59:6 Their webs shall not become garments, neither shall they cover themselves with their works: their works *are* works of iniquity, and the act of violence *is* in their hands.
- Isaiah 59:6 (NKJV) Their webs will not become garments, Nor will they cover themselves with their works; Their works *are* works of iniquity, And the act of violence *is* in their hands.
- Isaiah 60:18 <u>Violence</u> shall no more be heard in thy land, wasting nor destruction within thy borders; but thou shalt call thy walls Salvation, and thy gates Praise.
- Isaiah 60:18 (NKJV) Violence shall no longer be heard in your land, Neither wasting nor destruction within your borders; But you shall call your walls Salvation, and your gates Praise.
- Psalms 140:1 « To the chief Musician, A Psalm of David. » Deliver me, O LORD, from the evil man: preserve me from the violent man;
- Isaiah 61:3 To appoint unto them that mourn in Zion, to give unto them beauty for ashes, the oil of joy for mourning, the garment of praise for the spirit of heaviness; that they might be called trees of righteousness, the planting of the LORD, that he might be glorified.
- Jeremiah 6:7 As a fountain casteth out her waters, so she casteth out her wickedness: <u>violence</u> and spoil is heard in her; before Me continually *is* grief and wounds.

- Jeremiah 6:7 (NKJV) As a fountain wells up with water, So she wells up with her wickedness. Violence and plundering are heard in her. Before Me continually *are* grief and wounds.
- Jeremiah 20:8 For since I spake, I cried out, I cried <u>violence</u> and spoil; because the Word of the LORD was made a reproach unto me, and a derision, daily.
- Jeremiah 20:8 (NKJV) For when I spoke, I cried out; I shouted, Violence and plunder! Because the Word of the LORD was made to me A reproach and a derision daily.
- Referred to Nebuchadnezzar attacking Jerusalem 3 times before he destroyed it.
- Jeremiah 38:6 Then took they Jeremiah, and cast him into the dungeon of Malchiah the son of Hammelech, that was in the court of the prison: and they let down Jeremiah with cords. And in the dungeon there was no water, but mire: so Jeremiah sunk in the mire.
- Jeremiah 22:3 Thus saith the LORD; Execute ye judgment and righteousness, and deliver the spoiled out of the hand of the oppressor: and do no wrong, do no <u>violence</u> to the stranger, the fatherless, nor the widow, neither shed innocent blood in this place.
- Jeremiah 22:3 (NKJV) Thus says the LORD: Execute judgment and righteousness, and deliver the plundered out of the hand of the oppressor. Do no wrong and do no violence to the stranger, the fatherless, or the widow, nor shed innocent blood in this place.
- Ruth Referred to no violence to Ruth & Naomi.
- Jeremiah 22:17 But thine eyes and thine heart *are* not but for thy covetousness, and for to shed innocent blood, and for oppression, and for <u>violence</u>, to do *it*.
- Jeremiah 22:17 (NKJV) Yet your eyes and your heart *are* for nothing but your covetousness, For shedding innocent blood, and practicing oppression and violence.
- 1 Peter 4:17 For the time is come that judgment must begin at the house of God: and if it first begin at us, what shall the end be of them that obey not the gospel of God?
- Jeremiah 51:35 The <u>violence</u> done to me and to my flesh *be* upon Babylon, shall the inhabitant of Zion say; and my blood upon the inhabitants of Chaldea, shall Jerusalem say.
- Jeremiah 51:35 (NKJV) Let the violence *done* to me and my flesh *be* upon Babylon, The inhabitant of Zion will say; And my blood be upon the inhabitants of Chaldea! Jerusalem will say.
- Hebrews 10:30 For we know Him that hath said, Vengeance belongeth unto Me, I will recompense, saith the Lord. And again, The Lord shall judge His people.

- Proverbs 24:17,18 Rejoice not when thine enemy falleth, and let not thine heart be glad when he stumbleth: 18 Lest the LORD see it, and it displease him, and he turn away his wrath from him.
- Psalms 109:4 For my love they are my adversaries: but I give myself unto prayer.
- Hebrews 9:27 And as it is appointed unto men once to die, but after this the judgment:
- Jeremiah 51:46 And lest your heart faint, and ye fear for the rumour that shall be heard in the land; a rumour shall both come *one* year, and after that in another year shall come a rumour, and violence in the land, ruler against ruler.
- Jeremiah 51:46 (NKJV) And lest your heart faint, And you fear for the rumor that will be heard in the land (A rumor will come one year, And after that, in another year A rumor will come, And violence in the land, Ruler against ruler),
- Lamentations 2:6 And He hath <u>violently</u> taken away His tabernacle, as *if it* were of a garden: He hath destroyed His places of the assembly: the LORD hath caused the solemn feasts and sabbaths to be forgotten in Zion, and hath despised in the indignation of His anger the king and the priest.
- Lamentations 2:6 (NKJV) He has done violence to His tabernacle, *As if it were* a garden; He has destroyed His place of assembly; The LORD has caused The appointed feasts and Sabbaths to be forgotten in Zion. In His burning indignation He has spurned the king and the priest.
- 2 Chronicles 35:25 And Jeremiah lamented for Josiah: and all the singing men and the singing women spake of Josiah in their lamentations to this day, and made them an ordinance in Israel: and, behold, they are written in the lamentations.
- Ezekiel 7:11 <u>Violence</u> is risen up into a rod of wickedness: none of them *shall remain*, nor of their multitude, nor of any of theirs: neither *shall there be* wailing for them.
- Ezekiel 7:11 (NKJV) Violence has risen up into a rod of wickedness; None of them *shall remain*, None of their multitude, None of them; Nor *shall there be* wailing for them.
- Psalms 23:4 Yea, though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, I will fear no evil: for Thou art with me; Thy rod & Thy staff comfort me.
- 2 Corinthians 6:2 (For he saith, I have heard thee in a time accepted, and in the day of salvation have I succoured thee: behold, now is the accepted time; behold, now is the day of salvation.)
- Ezekiel 7:23 Make a chain: for the land is full of bloody crimes, and the city is full of violence.
- Ezekiel 7:23 (NKJV) Make a chain, For the land is filled with crimes of blood, And the city is full of violence.

- 1 John 1:9 If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.
- Ezekiel 8:17 Then he said unto me, Hast thou seen *this*, O son of man? Is it a light thing to the house of Judah that they commit the abominations which they commit here? for they have filled the land with <u>violence</u>, and have returned to provoke me to anger: &, lo, they put the branch to their nose.
- Ezekiel 8:17 (NKJV) And He said to me, Have you seen *this*, O son of man? Is it a trivial thing to the house of Judah to commit the abominations which they commit here? For they have filled the land with violence; then they have returned to provoke Me to anger. Indeed they put the branch to their nose.
- Matthew 5:23,24 Therefore if thou bring thy gift to the altar, and there rememberest that thy brother hath ought against thee; 24 Leave there thy gift before the altar, and go thy way; first be reconciled to thy brother, and then come and offer thy gift.
- Ezekiel 12:19 And say unto the people of the land, Thus saith the Lord GOD of the inhabitants of Jerusalem, *and* of the land of Israel; They shall eat their bread with carefulness, and drink their water with astonishment, that her land may be desolate from all that is therein, because of the <u>violence</u> of all them that dwell therein.
- Ezekiel 12:19 (NKJV) And say to the people of the land, Thus says the Lord GOD to the inhabitants of Jerusalem and to the land of Israel: They shall eat their bread with anxiety, and drink their water with dread, so that her land may be emptied of all who are in it, because of the violence of all those who dwell in it.
- Ezekiel 18:7 And hath <u>not</u> oppressed any, *but* hath restored to the debtor his pledge, hath spoiled none by <u>violence</u>, hath given his bread to the hungry, and hath covered the naked with a garment;
- Ezekiel 18:7 (NKJV) If he has <u>not</u> oppressed anyone, *But* has restored to the debtor his pledge; Has robbed no one by violence, *But* has given his bread to the hungry And covered the naked with clothing;
- Ezekiel 18:12 Hath oppressed the poor and needy, hath spoiled by <u>violence</u>, hath not restored the pledge, and hath lifted up his eyes to the idols, hath committed abomination,
- Ezekiel 18:12 (NKJV) If he has oppressed the poor and needy, Robbed by violence, Not restored the pledge, Lifted his eyes to the idols, *or* committed abomination;
- Nehemiah 5 Summarized of the rich oppressing the poor.
- Ezekiel 18:16 <u>Neither</u> hath oppressed any, hath <u>not</u> withholden the pledge, neither hath spoiled by <u>violence</u>, *but* hath given his bread to the hungry, and hath covered the naked with a garment,
- Ezekiel 18:16 (NKJV) Has <u>not</u> oppressed anyone, <u>Nor</u> withheld a pledge, <u>Nor</u>

- robbed by violence, *But* has given his bread to the hungry And covered the naked with clothing;
- Ezekiel 18:18 *As for* his father, because he cruelly oppressed, spoiled his brother by <u>violence</u>, and did *that* which *is* not good among his people, lo, even he shall die in his iniquity.
- Ezekiel 18:18 (NKJV) *As for* his father, Because he cruelly oppressed, Robbed his brother by violence, And did what *is* not good among his people, Behold, he shall die for his iniquity.
- Nehemiah 9:2 And the seed of Israel separated themselves from all strangers, & stood & confessed their sins, & the iniquities of their fathers.
- Ezekiel 28:16 By the multitude of thy merchandise they have filled the midst of thee with <u>violence</u>, and thou hast sinned: therefore I will cast thee as profane out of the mountain of God: and I will destroy thee, O covering cherub, from the midst of the stones of fire.

- Isaiah 1:26 And I will restore thy judges as at the first, and thy counsellors as at the beginning: afterward thou shalt be called, The city of righteousness, the faithful city.
- Joel 3:19 Egypt shall be a desolation, and Edom shall be a desolate wilderness, for the violence against the children of Judah, because they have shed innocent blood in their land.
- Joel 3:19 (NKJV) Egypt shall be a desolation, And Edom a desolate wilderness, <u>Because of violence against</u> the people of <u>Judah</u>, For they have shed innocent blood in their land.
- Amos 3:10 For they know not to do right, saith the LORD, who store up violence and robbery in their palaces.
- Amos 3:10 (NKJV) For they do not know to do right, Says the LORD, Who store up violence and robbery in their palaces.
- Mark 3:27 No man can enter into a strong man's house, and spoil his goods, except he will first bind the strong man; and then he will spoil his house.

- Amos 6:3 Ye that put far away the evil day, and cause the seat of <u>violence</u> to come near;
- Amos 6:3 (NKJV) *Woe to* you who put far off the day of doom, Who cause the seat of violence to come near;
- Obadiah 1:10 For *thy* <u>violence</u> against thy brother Jacob shame shall cover thee, and thou shalt be cut off for ever.
- Obadiah 1:10 (NKJV) For violence against your brother Jacob, Shame shall cover you, and you shall be cut off forever.
- Jonah 3:8 But let man and beast be covered with sackcloth, and cry mightily unto God: yea, let them turn every one from his evil way, and from the violence that *is* in their hands.
- Jonah 3:8 (NKJV) But let man and beast be covered with sackcloth, and cry mightily to God; yes, let every one turn from his evil way and from the violence that is in his hands.
- 2 Chronicles 7:14 If My people, which are called by My Name, shall humble themselves, & pray, & seek My face, & turn from their wicked ways; then will I hear from heaven, and will forgive their sin, and will heal their land.
- Micah 2:2 And they covet fields, and take *them* by <u>violence</u>; and houses, and take *them* away: so they oppress a man and his house, even a man and his heritage.
- Micah 2:2 (NKJV) They covet fields and take *them* by violence, Also houses, and seize *them*. So they oppress a man and his house, a man and his inheritance.
- Micah 6:12 For the rich men thereof are <u>full of violence</u>, and the inhabitants thereof have spoken lies, and their tongue *is* deceitful in their mouth.
- Micah 6:12 (NKJV) For her rich men are <u>full of violence</u>, Her inhabitants have spoken lies, And their tongue is deceitful in their mouth.
- Habakkuk 1:2 O LORD, how long shall I cry, and Thou wilt not hear! *even* cry out unto Thee *of* <u>violence</u>, and Thou wilt not save!
- Habakkuk 1:2 (NKJV) O LORD, how long shall I cry, and You will not hear? Even cry out to You, Violence! And You will not save.
- Luke 18:3,7 And there was a widow in that city; and she came unto him, saying, Avenge me of mine adversary. 7 And shall not God avenge His own elect, which cry day and night unto Him, though He bear long with them?
- Habakkuk 1:3 Why dost Thou shew me iniquity, and cause *me* to behold grievance? for spoiling and <u>violence</u> are before me: and there are that raise up strife and contention.
- Habakkuk 1:3 (NKJV) Why do You show me iniquity, And cause *me* to see trouble? For plundering and violence *are* before me; There is strife, and contention arises.
- Habakkuk 1:9 They shall come all for <u>violence</u>: their faces shall sup up *as* the east wind, and they shall gather the captivity as the sand.

- Habakkuk 1:9 (NKJV) They all come for violence; Their faces are set *like* the east wind. They gather captives like sand.
- Genesis 6:5 And GOD saw that the wickedness of man was great in the earth, and that every imagination of the thoughts of his heart was only evil continually.
- Habakkuk 2:8 Because thou hast spoiled many nations, all the remnant of the people shall spoil thee; because of men's blood, and *for* the <u>violence</u> of the land, of the city, and of all that dwell therein.
- Habakkuk 2:8 (NKJV) Because you have plundered many nations, All the remnant of the people shall plunder you, Because of men's blood and the violence of the land *and* the city, and of all who dwell in it.
- **Ezekiel 22 Referred to confessing sins of leaders.**
- Habakkuk 2:17 For the <u>violence</u> of Lebanon shall cover thee, and the spoil of beasts, *which* made them afraid, because of men's blood, and for the <u>violence</u> of the land, of the city, and of all that dwell therein.
- Habakkuk 2:17 (NKJV) For the violence *done to* Lebanon will cover you, And the plunder of beasts *which* made them afraid, Because of men's blood And the violence of the land *and* the city, And of all who dwell in it.
- Zephaniah 1:9 In the same day also will I punish all those that leap on the threshold, which fill their masters' houses with <u>violence</u> and deceit.
- Zephaniah 1:9 (NKJV) In the same day I will punish All those who leap over the threshold, Who fill their masters' houses with violence and deceit.
- Zephaniah 3:4 Her prophets *are* light *and* treacherous persons: her priests have polluted the sanctuary, they have done <u>violence</u> to the law.
- Zephaniah 3:4 (NKJV) Her prophets are insolent, treacherous people; Her priests have polluted the sanctuary, They have done violence to the law.
- Ezekiel 22:30 And I sought for a man among them, that should make up the hedge, and stand in the gap before me for the land, that I should not destroy it: but I found none.
- Leviticus 10 Referred to God dealing with Nadab & Abihu.
- Mark 16:15 And he said unto them, Go ye into all the world, and preach the gospel to every creature. 16 He that believeth and is baptized shall be saved; but he that believeth not shall be damned. 17 And these signs shall follow them that believe; In my name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues; 18 They shall take up serpents; and if they drink any deadly thing, it shall not hurt them; they shall lay hands on the sick, and they shall recover.
- 2 Corinthians 13:5 Examine yourselves, whether ye be in the faith; prove your own selves. Know ye not your own selves, how that Jesus Christ is in you, except ye be reprobates?
- Malachi 2:16 For the LORD, the God of Israel, saith that he hateth putting away: for *one* covereth <u>violence</u> with his garment, saith the LORD of hosts:

- therefore take heed to your spirit, that ye deal not treacherously.
- Malachi 2:16 (NKJV) For the LORD God of Israel says That He hates divorce, For it covers one's garment with violence, Says the LORD of hosts. Therefore take heed to your spirit, That you do not deal treacherously.
- Matthew 8:32 And he said unto them, Go. And when they were come out,
- they went into the herd of swine: and, behold, the whole herd of swine ran violently down a steep place into the sea, and perished in the waters.
- Matthew 8:32 (NKJV) And He said to them, Go. So when they had come out, they went into the herd of swine. And suddenly the whole herd of swine ran violently down the steep place into the sea, and perished in the water.
- Matthew 11:12 And from the days of John the Baptist until now the kingdom of heaven suffereth violence, and the violent take it by force.
- Matthew 11:12 (NKJV) And from the days of John the Baptist until now the kingdom of heaven suffers violence, and the violent take it by force.
- Mark 5:13 And forthwith Jesus gave them leave. And the unclean spirits went out, & entered into the swine: & the herd ran violently down a steep place into the sea, (they were about two thousand;) and were choked in the sea.
- Mark 5:13 (NKJV) And at once Jesus gave them permission. Then the unclean spirits went out and entered the swine (there were about two thousand); and the herd ran violently down the steep place into the sea, and drowned in the sea.
- Luke 3:14 And the soldiers likewise demanded of him, saying, And what shall we do? And he said unto them, Do violence to no man, neither accuse *any* falsely; and be content with your wages.
- Luke 3:14 (NKJV) Likewise the soldiers asked him, saying, And what shall we do? So he said to them, Do not intimidate anyone or accuse falsely, and be content with your wages.
- Hebrews 11 Referred to God's Hall of Faith of those afflicted & killed.
- Luke 8:33 Then went the devils out of the man, & entered into the swine: & the herd ran violently down a steep place into the lake, and were choked.
- Luke 8:33 (NKJV) Then the demons went out of the man & entered the swine, & the herd ran violently down the steep place into the lake and drowned.
- Acts 5:26 Then went the captain with the officers, and brought them without violence: for they feared the people, lest they should have been stoned.
- Acts 5:26 (NKJV) Then the captain went with the officers and brought them without violence, for they feared the people, lest they should be stoned.
- Acts 21:35 And when he came upon the stairs, so it was, that he was borne of the soldiers for the violence of the people.
- Acts 21:35 (NKJV) When he reached the stairs, he had to be carried by the soldiers because of the violence of the mob.
- Acts 24:7 But the chief captain Lysias came upon us, and with great violence took *him* away out of our hands,

- Acts 24:7 (NKJV) But the commander Lysias came by and with great violence took *him* out of our hands,
- Acts 27:41 And falling into a place where two seas met, they ran the ship aground; and the forepart stuck fast, and remained unmoveable, but the hinder part was broken with the <u>violence</u> of the waves.
- Acts 27:41 (NKJV) But striking a place where two seas met, they ran the ship aground; and the prow stuck fast and remained immovable, but the stern was being broken up by the violence of the waves.
- Luke 8 Summarized of the violent storm on the Sea.
- Mark 4:39 And he arose, and rebuked the wind, and said unto the sea, Peace, be still. And the wind ceased, and there was a great calm.
- Hebrews 11:34 Quenched the <u>violence</u> of fire, escaped the edge of the sword, out of weakness were made strong, waxed valiant in fight, turned to flight the armies of the aliens.
- Hebrews 11:34 (NKJV) quenched the violence of fire, escaped the edge of the sword, out of weakness were made strong, became valiant in battle, turned to flight the armies of the aliens.
- Revelation 18:21 And a mighty angel took up a stone like a great millstone, and cast *it* into the sea, saying, Thus with <u>violence</u> shall that great city Babylon be thrown down, and shall be found no more at all.
- Revelation 18:21 (NKJV) Then a mighty angel took up a stone like a great millstone and threw *it* into the sea, saying, Thus with violence the great city Babylon shall be thrown down, and shall not be found anymore.
- 2 Chronicles 7:14 If My people, which are called by My Name, shall humble themselves, and pray, and seek My face, and turn from their wicked ways; then will I hear from heaven, and will forgive their sin, and will heal their land.
- 2 Corinthians 10:5 Casting down imaginations, and every high thing that exalteth itself against the knowledge of God, and bringing into captivity every thought to the obedience of Christ;
- Isaiah 53:9 And He made His grave with the wicked, and with the rich in His death; because <u>He had done no violence</u>, neither *was any* deceit in His mouth.
- Luke 10:19 Behold, I give unto you power to tread on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy: and nothing shall by any means hurt you.
