The Curse Causeless Shall Not Come - Proverbs 26

- Proverbs 26:2 (AV) <u>As</u> the bird by wandering, as the swallow by flying, <u>so the curse causeless shall not come</u>.
- Proverbs 26:2 (NKJV) <u>Like</u> a flitting sparrow, like a flying swallow, <u>So a curse</u> without cause shall not alight.
- **Exodus 20:3 Thou shalt have no other gods before Me.**
- Deuteronomy 18:9-14 When thou art come into the land which the LORD thy God gives thee, thou shalt not learn to do after the abominations of those nations. 10 There shall not be found among you any one that makes his son or his daughter to pass through the fire, or that uses divination, or an observer of times, or an enchanter, or a witch, 11 Or a charmer, or a consulter with familiar spirits, or a wizard, or a necromancer. 12 For all that do these things are an abomination unto the LORD: & because of these abominations the LORD thy God doth drive them out from before thee. 13 Thou shalt be perfect with the LORD thy God. 14 For these nations, which thou shalt possess, hearkened unto observers of times, & unto diviners: but as for thee, the LORD thy God hath not suffered thee so to do.
- Revelation 19:11 Referred to Jesus' return & 1000 year rule.
- Ezra 9:7 Since the days of our fathers have we been in a great trespass unto this day; and for our iniquities have we, our kings, and our priests, been delivered into the hand of the kings of the lands, to the sword, to captivity, and to a spoil, and to confusion of face, as it is this day.
- Ephesians 6:12 For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high places.
- Romans 16:20 And the God of peace shall bruise Satan under your feet shortly. The grace of our Lord Jesus Christ be with you. Amen.

- Proverbs 26:2B So the curse causeless shall not come Curses can come in with cause.
- John 20:23 Whose soever sins ye remit, they are remitted unto them; and whose soever sins ye retain, they are retained.
- Luke 23:34 Then said Jesus, Father, forgive them; for they know not what they do. And they parted His raiment, and cast lots.
- Acts 7:60 And he kneeled down, and cried with a loud voice, Lord, lay not this sin to their charge. And when he had said this, he fell asleep.

- Nehemiah 9:2 And the seed of Israel separated themselves from all strangers, & stood & confessed their sins, & the iniquities of their fathers.
- Psalms 109:14 Let the iniquity of his fathers be remembered with the LORD; and let not the sin of his mother be blotted out.
- 2 Samuel 12:14 Howbeit, because by this deed thou hast given great occasion to the enemies of the LORD to blaspheme, the child also that is born unto thee shall surely die.

- Numbers 22:12 (AV) And God said unto Balaam, Thou shalt not go with them; thou shalt not curse the people: for they *are* blessed.
- Numbers 22:12 (NKJV) And God said to Balaam, You shall not go with them; you shall not curse the people, for they *are* blessed.
- Acts 8:9 But there was a certain man, called Simon, which beforetime in the same city used sorcery, and bewitched the people of Samaria, giving out that himself was some great one:
- Acts 8:21 Thou hast neither part nor lot in this matter: for thy heart is not right in the sight of God.
- John 3:7 Marvel not that I said unto thee, Ye must be born again.
- Numbers 22 Summarized of Balaam trying to curse Israel for reward.
- Referred to many judgments from God on sinful Israelites.
- Numbers 14:29,30 Your carcases shall fall in this wilderness; and all that were numbered of you, according to your whole number, from twenty years old and upward, which have murmured against me, 30 Doubtless ye shall not come into the land, concerning which I sware to make you dwell therein, save Caleb the son of Jephunneh, and Joshua the son of Nun.
- Luke 18 Referred to the account of the Pharisee & the Publican.
- Galatians 3:10 For as many as are of the works of the <u>law</u> are under the <u>curse</u>: for it is written, <u>Cursed</u> is every one that continueth not in all things which are written in the book of the <u>law</u> to do them.
- Galatians 3:10 (NKJV) For as many as are of the works of the law are under the curse; for it is written, Cursed *is* everyone who does not continue in all things which are written in the book of the law, to do them.
- Galatians 3:13 Christ has redeemed us from the <u>curse</u> of the <u>law</u>, being made a <u>curse</u> for us: for it is written, <u>Cursed</u> *is* every one that hangeth on a tree:
- Galatians 3:13 (NKJV) Christ has redeemed us from the curse of the law, having become a curse for us (for it is written, Cursed *is* everyone who hangs on a tree),
- Romans 10:9,10 That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised him from the dead, thou shalt be saved. 10 For with the heart man believeth unto righteousness; and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation.
- Acts 15:1,2 And certain men which came down from Judaea taught the brethren, and said, Except ye be circumcised after the manner of Moses, ye cannot be saved. 2 When therefore Paul and Barnabas had no small dissension and disputation with them, they determined that Paul and Barnabas, and certain other of them, should go up to Jerusalem unto the apostles and elders about this question.
- John 19:30 When Jesus therefore had received the vinegar, He said, It is finished: and He bowed His head, and gave up the ghost.
- Acts 15:20 But that we write unto them, that they abstain from pollutions of

- idols, and from fornication, and from things strangled, and from blood.
- Isaiah 35:8 And an highway shall be there, and a way, and it shall be called The way of holiness; the unclean shall not pass over it; but it shall be for those: the wayfaring men, though fools, shall not err therein.
- Ezekiel 18:4 Behold, all souls are Mine; as the soul of the father, so also the soul of the son is Mine: the soul that sinneth, it shall die.
- 1 John 1:7,9 But if we walk in the light, as he is in the light, we have fellowship one with another, and the blood of Jesus Christ his Son cleanseth us from all sin. 9 If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.
- 2 Samuel 12 Summarized of David's sin with Bathsheba.

- Leviticus 19:18 Thou shalt not avenge, nor bear any grudge against the children of thy people, but thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself: I am the LORD.
- Proverbs 3:33 The <u>curse</u> of the LORD *is* in the house of the wicked: but He blesseth the habitation of the just.
- Proverbs 11:26 He that withholdeth corn, the people shall <u>curse</u> him: but blessing *shall be* upon the head of him that selleth *it*.
- Proverbs 20:20 Whoso <u>curseth</u> his father or his mother, his lamp shall be put out in obscure darkness.
- Proverbs 24:24 He that saith unto the wicked, Thou *art* righteous; him shall the people <u>curse</u>, nations shall abhor him:
- Isaiah 1:26 And I will restore thy judges as at the first, and thy counsellors as at the beginning: afterward thou shalt be called, The city of righteousness, the faithful city.
- Proverbs 26:2 As the bird by wandering, as the swallow by flying, so the <u>curse</u> causeless shall not come.
- Proverbs 27:14 He that blesseth his friend with a loud voice, rising early in the morning, it shall be counted a <u>curse</u> to him.
- Matthew 7:12 Therefore all things whatsoever ye would that men should do to you, do ye even so to them: for this is the law and the prophets.
- Proverbs 28:27 He that giveth unto the poor shall not lack: but he that hideth his eyes shall have many a <u>curse</u>.
- John 12:8 For the poor always ye have with you; but Me ye have not always. Ephesians 4:28 Let him that stole steal no more: but rather let him labour,

- working with his hands the thing which is good, that he may have to give to him that needeth.
- 1 John 3:17 But whoso hath this world's good, and seeth his brother have need, and shutteth up his bowels of compassion from him, how dwelleth the love of God in him?
- Proverbs 30:10 Accuse not a servant unto his master, lest he <u>curse</u> thee, and thou be found guilty.
- Proverbs 30:11 *There is* a generation *that* <u>curseth</u> their father, and doth not bless their mother.
- Romans 12:19 Dearly beloved, avenge not yourselves, but rather give place unto wrath: for it is written, Vengeance is Mine; I will repay, saith the Lord.
- 1 Timothy 5:19 Against an elder receive not an accusation, but before two or three witnesses.
- Matthew 18:15-17 Moreover if thy brother shall trespass against thee, go and tell him his fault between thee and him alone: if he shall hear thee, thou hast gained thy brother. 16 But if he will not hear thee, then take with thee one or two more, that in the mouth of two or three witnesses every word may be established. 17 And if he shall neglect to hear them, tell it unto the church: but if he neglect to hear the church, let him be unto thee as an heathen man and a publican.
- 1 Peter 1:16 Because it is written, Be ye Holy; for I am Holy. Matthew 5:48 Be ye therefore perfect, even as your Father which is in heaven is perfect.
- Jeremiah 35:18,19 And Jeremiah said unto the house of the Rechabites, Thus saith the LORD of hosts, the God of Israel; Because ye have obeyed the commandment of Jonadab your father, and kept all his precepts, and done according unto all that he hath commanded you: 19 Therefore thus saith the LORD of hosts, the God of Israel; Jonadab the son of Rechab shall not want a man to stand before me for ever.
- Deuteronomy 27:13 And these shall stand upon mount Ebal to <u>curse</u>; Reuben, Gad, and Asher, and Zebulun, Dan, and Naphtali.
- Deuteronomy 27:15-26 <u>Cursed</u> be the man that maketh any graven or molten image, an abomination unto the LORD, the work of the hands of the craftsman, and putteth it in a secret place. And all the people shall answer and say, Amen.
- Matthew 10:37 He that loveth father or mother more than Me is not worthy of Me: and he that loveth son or daughter more than Me is not worthy of Me.
- 2 Corinthians 13:5 Examine yourselves, whether ye be in the faith; prove your own selves. Know ye not your own selves, how that Jesus Christ is in you, except ye be reprobates?
- Deuteronomy 27:16 <u>Cursed</u> be he that setteth light by his father or his mother. And all the people shall say, Amen.
- Genesis 9 Referred to Noah's son cursed.

Deuteronomy 27:17-20 <u>Cursed</u> <u>be</u> he that removeth his neighbour's landmark. And all the people shall say, Amen. 18 <u>Cursed</u> <u>be</u> he that maketh the blind to wander out of the way. & all the people shall say, Amen. 19 <u>Cursed</u> <u>be</u> he that pervertes the judgment of the stranger, fatherless, and widow. & all the people shall say, Amen. 20 <u>Cursed</u> <u>be</u> he that lieth with his father's wife because he uncoveres his father's skirt. & all the people shall say, Amen.

Leviticus 18 Referred to God's laws on immorality.

- Deuteronomy 27:21-26 <u>Cursed</u> <u>be</u> he that lieth with any manner of beast. & all the people shall say, Amen. 22 <u>Cursed</u> <u>be</u> he that lieth with his sister, the daughter of his father, or the daughter of his mother. & all the people shall say, Amen. 23 <u>Cursed</u> <u>be</u> he that lieth with his mother in law. And all the people shall say, Amen. 24 <u>Cursed</u> <u>be</u> he that smiteth his neighbour secretly. & all the people shall say, Amen. 25 <u>Cursed</u> <u>be</u> he that taketh reward to slay an innocent person. And all the people shall say, Amen.
- Deuteronomy 27:26 <u>Cursed</u> be he that confirmeth not all the words of this law to do them. And all the people shall say, Amen.
- Deuteronomy 28:15 But it shall come to pass, if thou wilt not hearken unto the voice of the LORD thy God, to observe to do all His commandments and his statutes which I command thee this day; that all these curses shall come upon thee, and overtake thee:
- 1 John 1:9 If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.
- Deuteronomy 28:16-19 <u>Cursed</u> shalt thou be in the city, and <u>cursed</u> shalt thou be in the field. 17 <u>Cursed</u> shall be thy basket and thy store. 18 <u>Cursed</u> shall be the fruit of thy body, and the fruit of thy land, the increase of thy kine, and the flocks of thy sheep. 19 <u>Cursed</u> shalt thou be when thou comest in, and cursed shalt thou be when thou goest out.
- Deuteronomy 28:45 Moreover all these <u>curses</u> shall come upon thee, and shall pursue thee, and <u>overtake thee</u>, till thou be destroyed; because thou hearkenedst not unto the voice of the LORD thy God, to keep His commandments and His statutes which He commanded thee:
- 2 Chronicles 7:14 If My people, which are called by My Name, shall humble themselves, & pray, & seek My face, & turn from their wicked ways; then will I hear from heaven, and will forgive their sin, and will heal their land.
- Ezra 9:7 Since the days of our fathers have we been in a great trespass unto this day; and for our iniquities have we, our kings, and our priests, been delivered into the hand of the kings of the lands, to the sword, to captivity, and to a spoil, and to confusion of face, as it is this day.
