

Wise Sayings Of Solomon 17 - Proverbs 26

1 Samuel 25 Summarized of Nabal the fool.

Proverbs 22:15 Foolishness is bound in the heart of a child; but the rod of correction shall drive it far from him.

Mark 16:17 And these signs shall follow them that believe; In My Name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues;

James 5:14 Is any sick among you? let him call for the elders of the church; and let them pray over him, anointing him with oil in the name of the Lord:

Luke 10:19 Behold, I give unto you power to tread on serpents & scorpions, & over all the power of the enemy: and nothing shall by any means hurt you.

Luke 8:35 Then they went out to see what was done; and came to Jesus, and found the man, out of whom the devils were departed, sitting at the feet of Jesus, clothed, and in his right mind: and they were afraid.

John 14:12 Verily, verily, I say unto you, He that believeth on me, the works that I do shall he do also; and greater works than these shall he do; because I go unto my Father.

Proverbs 26:1-28 (AV) & (NKJV)

Proverbs 26:1 (AV) As snow in summer, and as rain in harvest, so honour is not seemly for a fool.

Proverbs 26:1 (NKJV) As snow in summer and rain in harvest, So honor is not fitting for a fool.

Proverbs 31 Referred to the Virtuous Woman.

Proverbs 26:2 (AV) As the bird by wandering, as the swallow by flying, so the curse causeless shall not come.

Proverbs 26:2 (NKJV) Like a flitting sparrow, like a flying swallow, So a curse without cause shall not alight.

Galatians 3:10,13 For as many as are of the works of the law are under the curse: for it is written, Cursed is every one that continueth not in all things which are written in the book of the law to do them. 13 Christ hath redeemed us from the curse of the law, being made a curse for us: for it is written, Cursed is every one that hangeth on a tree:

1 John 1:9 If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

Nehemiah 9:2 And the seed of Israel separated themselves from all strangers, and stood and confessed their sins, and the iniquities of their fathers.

Proverbs 26:3 (AV) A whip for the horse, a bridle for the ass, and a rod for the fool's back.

Proverbs 26:3 (NKJV) A whip for the horse, A bridle for the donkey, And a rod for the fool's back.

Proverbs 26:4 (AV) Answer not a fool according to his folly, lest thou also be like unto him.

Proverbs 26:4 (NKJV) Do not answer a fool according to his folly, Lest you also be like him.

Proverbs 21:23 Whoso keepeth his mouth and his tongue keepeth his soul from troubles.

Proverbs 26:5 (AV) Answer a fool according to his folly, lest he be wise in his own conceit.

Proverbs 26:5 (NKJV) Answer a fool according to his folly, Lest he be wise in his own eyes.

Referred to Jesus addressing the fools.

John 8:19 Then said they unto him, Where is thy Father? Jesus answered, Ye neither know me, nor my Father: if ye had known me, ye should have known my Father also.

John 8:44 Ye are of your father the devil, and the lusts of your father ye will do. He was a murderer from the beginning, and abode not in the truth, because there is no truth in him. When he speaketh a lie, he speaketh of his own: for he is a liar, and the father of it.

John 8:7 So when they continued asking Him, He lifted up Himself, and said unto them, He that is without sin among you, let him first cast a stone at her.

Proverbs 26:6 (AV) He that sendeth a message by the hand of a fool cutteth off the feet, *and* drinketh damage.

Proverbs 26:6 (NKJV) He who sends a message by the hand of a fool Cuts off *his own* feet *and* drinks violence.

Proverbs 26:7 (AV) The legs of the lame are not equal: so *is* a parable in the mouth of fools.

Proverbs 26:7 (NKJV) *Like* the legs of the lame that hang limp *is* a proverb in the mouth of fools.

Luke 12:1 In the mean time, when there were gathered together an innumerable multitude of people, insomuch that they trode one upon another, he began to say unto his disciples first of all, Beware ye of the leaven of the Pharisees, which is hypocrisy.

2 Samuel 12:14 Howbeit, because by this deed thou hast given great occasion to the enemies of the LORD to blaspheme, the child also that is born unto thee shall surely die.

Proverbs 26:8 (AV) As he that bindeth a stone in a sling, so *is* he that giveth honour to a fool.

Proverbs 26:8 (NKJV) Like one who binds a stone in a sling *is* he who gives honor to a fool.

Proverbs 26:9 (AV) As a thorn goeth up into the hand of a drunkard, so *is* a parable in the mouth of fools.

Proverbs 26:9 (NKJV) *Like a thorn that goes into the hand of a drunkard /is a proverb in the mouth of fools.*

1 Thessalonians 5:6 Therefore let us not sleep, as do others; but let us watch and be sober.

Proverbs 26:10 (AV) The great *God* that formed all *things* both rewardeth the fool, and rewardeth transgressors.

Proverbs 26:10 (NKJV) The great *God* who formed everything Gives the fool *his* hire and the transgressor *his* wages.

Romans 1:25 Who changed the truth of God into a lie, and worshipped and served the creature more than the Creator, who is blessed for ever. Amen.

Galatians 6:7 Be not deceived; God is not mocked: for whatsoever a man soweth, that shall he also reap.

Luke 16 Referred to the parable of the rich man & Lazarus.

Hebrews 9:27 And as it is appointed unto men once to die, but after this the judgment:

Proverbs 26:11 (AV) As a dog returneth to his vomit, *so* a fool returneth to his folly.

Proverbs 26:11 (NKJV) As a dog returns to his own vomit, *So* a fool repeats his folly.

2 Chronicles 7:13,14 If I shut up heaven that there be no rain, or if I command the locusts to devour the land, or if I send pestilence among My people; 14 If My people, which are called by My Name, shall humble themselves, and pray, and seek My face, and turn from their wicked ways; then will I hear from heaven, and will forgive their sin, and will heal their land.

2 Samuel 15:6 And on this manner did Absalom to all Israel that came to the king for judgment: so Absalom stole the hearts of the men of Israel.

Proverbs 26:12 (AV) Seest thou a man wise in his own conceit? *there is* more hope of a fool than of him.

Proverbs 26:12 (NKJV) Do you see a man wise in his own eyes? *There is* more hope for a fool than for him.

Proverbs 26:13 (AV) The slothful *man* saith, *There is* a lion in the way; a lion *is* in the streets.

Proverbs 26:13 (NKJV) The lazy *man* says, *There is* a lion in the road! A fierce lion *is* in the streets!

Proverbs 26:14 (AV) As the door turneth upon his hinges, so *doth* the slothful upon his bed.

Proverbs 26:14 (NKJV) As a door turns on its hinges, *So does* the lazy *man* on his bed.

Proverbs 26:15 (AV) The slothful hideth his hand in *his* bosom; it grieveth him to bring it again to his mouth.

Proverbs 26:15 (NKJV) The lazy *man* buries his hand in the bowl; It wearies him to bring it back to his mouth.

Ephesians 4:28 Let him that stole steal no more: but rather let him labour, working with his hands the thing which is good, that he may have to give to him that needeth.

Exodus 20:15 Thou shalt not steal.

Colossians 3:23 And whatsoever ye do, do it heartily, as to the Lord, and not unto men;

Proverbs 26:16 (AV) The sluggard *is* wiser in his own conceit than seven men that can render a reason.

Proverbs 26:16 (NKJV) The lazy *man is* wiser in his own eyes Than seven men who can answer sensibly.

Proverbs 26:17 (AV) He that passeth by, *and* meddleth with strife *belonging* not to him, *is like* one that taketh a dog by the ears.

Proverbs 26:17 (NKJV) He who passes by *and* meddles in a quarrel not his own *Is like* one who takes a dog by the ears.

Proverbs 26:18 (AV) As a mad *man* who casteth firebrands, arrows, and death,

Proverbs 26:18 (NKJV) Like a madman who throws firebrands, arrows, and death,

Proverbs 26:19 (AV) So *is* the man *that* deceiveth his neighbour, and saith, Am not I in sport?

Proverbs 26:19 (NKJV) *Is* the man *who* deceives his neighbor, And says, I was only joking!

Luke 10:34 And (the Good Samaritan) went to him, and bound up his wounds, pouring in oil and wine, and set him on his own beast, and brought him to an inn, and took care of him.

Proverbs 26:20 (AV) Where no wood is, *there* the fire goeth out: so where *there is* no talebearer, the strife ceaseth.

Proverbs 26:20 (NKJV) Where *there is* no wood, the fire goes out; And where *there is* no talebearer, strife ceases.

Proverbs 26:21 (AV) As coals *are* to burning coals, and wood to fire; so *is* a contentious man to kindle strife.

Proverbs 26:21 (NKJV) As charcoal *is* to burning coals, and wood to fire, So *is* a contentious man to kindle strife.

Proverbs 26:22 (AV) The words of a talebearer *are* as wounds, and they go down into the innermost parts of the belly.

Proverbs 26:22 (NKJV) The words of a talebearer *are* like tasty trifles, And they go down into the inmost body.

Proverbs 26:23 (AV) Burning lips and a wicked heart *are like* a potsherd covered with silver dross.

Proverbs 26:23 (NKJV) Fervent lips with a wicked heart *Are like* earthenware covered with silver dross.

1 Timothy 5:13,14 And withal they learn to be idle, wandering about from

house to house; and not only idle, but tattlers also and busybodies, speaking things which they ought not. 14 I will therefore that the younger women marry, bear children, guide the house, give none occasion to the adversary to speak reproachfully.

Proverbs 26:24 (AV) He that hateth dissembleth with his lips, and layeth up deceit within him;

Proverbs 26:24 (NKJV) He who hates, disguises *it* with his lips, And lays up deceit within himself;

Proverbs 26:25 (AV) When he speaketh fair, believe him not: for *there are* seven abominations in his heart.

Proverbs 26:25 (NKJV) When he speaks kindly, do not believe him, For *there are* seven abominations in his heart;

Proverbs 26:26 (AV) Whose hatred is covered by deceit, his wickedness shall be shewed before the *whole* congregation.

Proverbs 26:26 (NKJV) Though his hatred is covered by deceit, His wickedness will be revealed before the assembly.

Proverbs 26:27 (AV) Whoso diggeth a pit shall fall therein: and he that rolleth a stone, it will return upon him.

Proverbs 26:27 (NKJV) Whoever digs a pit will fall into it, And he who rolls a stone will have it roll back on him.

Psalms 140:9 As for the head of those that compass me about, let the mischief of their own lips cover them.

Proverbs 26:28 (AV) A lying tongue hateth *those that are* afflicted by it; and a flattering mouth worketh ruin.

Proverbs 26:28 (NKJV) A lying tongue hates *those who are* crushed by it, And a flattering mouth works ruin.

Matthew 5:21,22 Ye have heard that it was said by them of old time, Thou shalt not kill; and whosoever shall kill shall be in danger of the judgment: 22 But I say unto you, That whosoever is angry with his brother without a cause shall be in danger of the judgment: and whosoever shall say to his brother, Raca, shall be in danger of the council: but whosoever shall say, Thou fool, shall be in danger of hell fire.

1 John 3:15 Whosoever hateth his brother is a murderer: and ye know that no murderer hath eternal life abiding in him.

Acts 11:23 Who, when he came, and had seen the grace of God, was glad, and exhorted them all, that with purpose of heart they would cleave unto the Lord.
