- Proverbs 27:1-27 (AV) & (NKJV)
- Proverbs 27:1 (AV) Boast not thyself of to morrow; for thou knowest not what a day may bring forth.
- Proverbs 27:1 (NKJV) Do not boast about tomorrow, For you do not know what a day may bring forth.
- Matthew 6:34 Take therefore no thought for the morrow: for the morrow shall take thought for the things of itself. Sufficient unto the day is the evil thereof.
- Psalms 31:15 My times are in Thy hand: deliver me from the hand of mine enemies, and from them that persecute me.
- Job 1:21 And said, Naked came I out of my mother's womb, and naked shall I return thither: the LORD gave, and the LORD hath taken away; blessed be the name of the LORD.
- Matthew 5:36 Neither shalt thou swear by thy head, because thou canst not make one hair white or black.
- Proverbs 27:2 (AV) Let another man praise thee, and not thine own mouth; a stranger, and not thine own lips.

- Proverbs 27:7 (NKJV) A satisfied soul loathes the honeycomb, But to a hungry soul every bitter thing *is* sweet.
- James 5:14 Is any sick among you? let him call for the elders of the church; and let them pray over him, anointing him with oil in the name of the Lord:
- Proverbs 27:8 (AV) As a bird that wandereth from her nest, so *is* a man that wandereth from his place.
- Proverbs 27:8 (NKJV) Like a bird that wanders from its nest *Is* a man who wanders from his place.
- Proverbs 27:9 (AV) Ointment and perfume rejoice the heart: so *doth* the sweetness of a man's friend by hearty counsel.
- Proverbs 27:9 (NKJV) Ointment and perfume delight the heart, And the sweetness of a man's friend *gives delight* by hearty counsel.
- 1 Kings 11:3,4 And he (Solomon) had seven hundred wives, princesses, and

- three hundred concubines: and his wives turned away his heart.
- Hebrews 3:13 But exhort one another daily, while it is called To day; lest any of you be hardened through the deceitfulness of sin.
- Proverbs 27:10 (AV) Thine own friend, and thy father's friend, forsake not; neither go into thy brother's house in the day of thy calamity: *for* better *is* a neighbour *that is* near than a brother far off.
- Proverbs 27:10 (NKJV) Do not forsake your own friend or your father's friend, Nor go to your brother's house in the day of your calamity; Better *is* a neighbor nearby than a brother far away.
- Proverbs 27:11 (AV) My son, be wise, and make my heart glad, that I may answer him that reproacheth me.
- Proverbs 27:11 (NKJV) My son, be wise, and make my heart glad, That I may answer him who reproaches me.
- 2 Chronicles 10:13,14 And the king answered them roughly; and king Rehoboam forsook the counsel of the old men, 14 And answered them after the advice of the young men, saying, My father made your yoke heavy, but I will add thereto: my father chastised you with whips, but I will chastise you with scorpions.
- Proverbs 27:12 (AV) A prudent *man* foreseeth the evil, *and* hideth himself; *but* the simple pass on, *and* are punished.

- Proverbs 27:13 (AV) Take his garment that is surety for a stranger, and take a pledge of him for a strange woman.
- Proverbs 27:13 (NKJV) Take the garment of him who is surety for a stranger, And hold it in pledge *when* he is surety for a seductress.
- Proverbs 27:14 (AV) He that blesseth his friend with a loud voice, rising early in the morning, it shall be counted a curse to him.
- Proverbs 27:14 (NKJV) He who blesses his friend with a loud voice, rising early in the morning, It will be counted a curse to him.
- Proverbs 27:15 (AV) A continual dropping in a very rainy day and a contentious woman are alike.
- Proverbs 27:15 (NKJV) A continual dripping on a very rainy day And a contentious woman are alike;
- Ephesians 6:12 For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high places.
- Proverbs 27:16 (AV) Whosoever hideth her hideth the wind, and the

- ointment of his right hand, which bewrayeth itself.
- Proverbs 27:16 (NKJV) Whoever restrains her restrains the wind, And grasps oil with his right hand.
- Mark 16:17 And these signs shall follow them that believe; In My Name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues;
- Luke 11:24-26 When the unclean spirit is gone out of a man, he walketh through dry places, seeking rest; and finding none, he saith, I will return unto my house whence I came out. 25 And when he cometh, he findeth it swept and garnished. 26 Then goeth he, and taketh to him seven other spirits more wicked than himself; and they enter in, and dwell there: and the last state of that man is worse than the first.

- Proverbs 27:18 (AV) Whoso keepeth the fig tree shall eat the fruit thereof: so he that waiteth on his master shall be honoured.
- Proverbs 27:18 (NKJV) Whoever keeps the fig tree will eat its fruit; So he who waits on his master will be honored.
- Luke 13:6-9 He spake also this parable; A certain man had a fig tree planted in his vineyard; and he came and sought fruit thereon, and found none. 7 Then said he unto the dresser of his vineyard, Behold, these three years I come seeking fruit on this fig tree, and find none: cut it down; why cumbereth it the ground? 8 And he answering said unto him, Lord, let it alone this year also, till I shall dig about it, and dung it: 9 And if it bear fruit, well: and if not, then after that thou shalt cut it down.

- Proverbs 27:22 (AV) Though thou shouldest bray a fool in a mortar among wheat with a pestle, *yet* will not his foolishness depart from him.
- Proverbs 27:22 (NKJV) Though you grind a fool in a mortar with a pestle along with crushed grain, *Yet* his foolishness will not depart from him.
- Ephesians 6:4 And, ye fathers, provoke not your children to wrath: but bring them up in the nurture and admonition of the Lord.
- Jeremiah 5:3 O LORD, are not thine eyes upon the truth? thou hast stricken them, but they have not grieved; thou hast consumed them, but they have refused to receive correction: they have made their faces harder than a rock; they have refused to return.
- Proverbs 27:23 (AV) Be thou diligent to know the state of thy flocks, *and* look well to thy herds.
- Proverbs 27:23 (NKJV) Be diligent to know the state of your flocks, *And* attend to your herds;
- Proverbs 27:24 (AV) For riches *are* not for ever: and doth the crown *endure* to every generation?
- Proverbs 27:24 (NKJV) For riches *are* not forever, Nor does a crown *endure* to all generations.
- 2 Samuel 12:10 Now therefore the sword shall never depart from thine house; because thou hast despised me, and hast taken the wife of Uriah the Hittite to be thy wife.
- 1 Kings 11:4 For it came to pass, when Solomon was old, that his wives turned away his heart after other gods: and his heart was not perfect with the LORD his God, as was the heart of David his father.
- Proverbs 27:25 (AV) The hay appeareth, and the tender grass sheweth itself, and herbs of the mountains are gathered.
- Proverbs 27:25 (NKJV) *When* the hay is removed, and the tender grass shows itself, And the herbs of the mountains are gathered in,

- Proverbs 27:26 (AV) The lambs *are* for thy clothing, and the goats *are* the price of the field.
- Proverbs 27:26 (NKJV) The lambs *will provide* your clothing, And the goats the price of a field;
- Proverbs 27:27 (AV) And *thou shalt have* goats' milk enough for thy food, for the food of thy household, and *for* the maintenance for thy maidens.
- Proverbs 27:27 (NKJV) *You shall have* enough goats' milk for your food, For the food of your household, And the nourishment of your maidservants.
- 1 Samuel 17:17,18 And Jesse said unto David his son, Take now for thy brethren an ephah of this parched corn, and these ten loaves, and run to the camp to thy brethren; 18 And carry these ten cheeses unto the captain of their thousand, and look how thy brethren fare, and take their pledge.
