

Wise Sayings Of Solomon 18 - Proverbs 27

Referred to our Lord Jesus' parables being more important than Solomon's proverbs.

Proverbs 27:1-27 (AV) & (NKJV)

Proverbs 27:1 (AV) Boast not thyself of to morrow; for thou knowest not what a day may bring forth.

Proverbs 27:1 (NKJV) Do not boast about tomorrow, For you do not know what a day may bring forth.

Matthew 6:34 Take therefore no thought for the morrow: for the morrow shall take thought for the things of itself. Sufficient unto the day is the evil thereof.

Psalms 31:15 My times are in Thy hand: deliver me from the hand of mine enemies, and from them that persecute me.

Job 1:21 And said, Naked came I out of my mother's womb, and naked shall I return thither: the LORD gave, and the LORD hath taken away; blessed be the name of the LORD.

Matthew 5:36 Neither shalt thou swear by thy head, because thou canst not make one hair white or black.

Proverbs 27:2 (AV) Let another man praise thee, and not thine own mouth; a stranger, and not thine own lips.

Proverbs 27:2 (NKJV) Let another man praise you, and not your own mouth; A stranger, and not your own lips.

Matthew 18:18 Verily I say unto you, Whatsoever ye shall bind on earth shall be bound in heaven: and whatsoever ye shall loose on earth shall be loosed in heaven.

Proverbs 27:3 (AV) A stone *is* heavy, and the sand weighty; but a fool's wrath *is* heavier than them both.

Proverbs 27:3 (NKJV) A stone *is* heavy and sand *is* weighty, But a fool's wrath *is* heavier than both of them.

Proverbs 27:4 (AV) Wrath *is* cruel, and anger *is* outrageous; but who *is* able to stand before envy?

Proverbs 27:4 (NKJV) Wrath *is* cruel and anger a torrent, But who *is* able to stand before jealousy?

Numbers 5 Referred to the spirit of jealousy.

Luke 10:19 Behold, I give unto you power to tread on serpents and

scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy: and nothing shall by any means hurt you.

Hebrews 1:14 Are they (God's angels) not all ministering spirits, sent forth to minister for them who shall be heirs of salvation?

Matthew 13 Referred to Jesus' 8 woes on the religious leaders.

1 Timothy 1:2 Unto Timothy, my own son in the faith: Grace, mercy, and peace, from God our Father and Jesus Christ our Lord.

Proverbs 27:5 (AV) Open rebuke *is* better than secret love.

Proverbs 27:5 (NKJV) Open rebuke *is* better Than love carefully concealed.

Galatians 6:1 Brethren, if a man be overtaken in a fault, ye which are spiritual, restore such an one in the spirit of meekness; considering thyself, lest thou also be tempted.

Proverbs 27:6 (AV) Faithful *are* the wounds of a friend; but the kisses of an enemy *are* deceitful.

Proverbs 27:6 (NKJV) Faithful *are* the wounds of a friend, But the kisses of an enemy *are* deceitful.

Luke 22:48 But Jesus said unto him, Judas, betrayest thou the Son of man with a kiss?

John 6:70 Jesus answered them, Have not I chosen you twelve, and one of you is a devil?

1 Thessalonians 5:26 Greet all the brethren with an holy kiss.

Genesis 3 Referred to Eve deceived by satan.

Proverbs 27:7 (AV) The full soul loatheth an honeycomb; but to the hungry soul every bitter thing is sweet.

Proverbs 27:7 (NKJV) A satisfied soul loathes the honeycomb, But to a hungry soul every bitter thing *is* sweet.

James 5:14 Is any sick among you? let him call for the elders of the church; and let them pray over him, anointing him with oil in the name of the Lord:

Proverbs 27:8 (AV) As a bird that wandereth from her nest, so *is* a man that wandereth from his place.

Proverbs 27:8 (NKJV) Like a bird that wanders from its nest *is* a man who wanders from his place.

Proverbs 27:9 (AV) Ointment and perfume rejoice the heart: so *doth* the sweetness of a man's friend by hearty counsel.

Proverbs 27:9 (NKJV) Ointment and perfume delight the heart, And the sweetness of a man's friend *gives delight* by hearty counsel.

1 Kings 11:3,4 And he (Solomon) had seven hundred wives, princesses, and

three hundred concubines: and his wives turned away his heart.

Hebrews 3:13 But exhort one another daily, while it is called To day; lest any of you be hardened through the deceitfulness of sin.

Proverbs 27:10 (AV) Thine own friend, and thy father's friend, forsake not; neither go into thy brother's house in the day of thy calamity: *for* better *is* a neighbour *that is* near than a brother far off.

Proverbs 27:10 (NKJV) Do not forsake your own friend or your father's friend, Nor go to your brother's house in the day of your calamity; Better *is* a neighbor nearby than a brother far away.

Proverbs 27:11 (AV) My son, be wise, and make my heart glad, that I may answer him that reproacheth me.

Proverbs 27:11 (NKJV) My son, be wise, and make my heart glad, That I may answer him who reproaches me.

2 Chronicles 10:13,14 And the king answered them roughly; and king Rehoboam forsook the counsel of the old men, 14 And answered them after the advice of the young men, saying, My father made your yoke heavy, but I will add thereto: my father chastised you with whips, but I will chastise you with scorpions.

Proverbs 27:12 (AV) A prudent *man* foreseeeth the evil, *and* hideth himself; *but* the simple pass on, *and* are punished.

Proverbs 27:12 (NKJV) A prudent *man* foresees evil *and* hides himself; The simple pass on *and* are punished.

Proverbs 27:13 (AV) Take his garment that is surety for a stranger, and take a pledge of him for a strange woman.

Proverbs 27:13 (NKJV) Take the garment of him who is surety for a stranger, And hold it in pledge *when* he is surety for a seductress.

Proverbs 27:14 (AV) He that blesseth his friend with a loud voice, rising early in the morning, it shall be counted a curse to him.

Proverbs 27:14 (NKJV) He who blesses his friend with a loud voice, rising early in the morning, It will be counted a curse to him.

Proverbs 27:15 (AV) A continual dropping in a very rainy day and a contentious woman are alike.

Proverbs 27:15 (NKJV) A continual dripping on a very rainy day And a contentious woman are alike;

Ephesians 6:12 For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high places.

Proverbs 27:16 (AV) Whosoever hideth her hideth the wind, and the

ointment of his right hand, *which* bewrayeth *itself*.

Proverbs 27:16 (NKJV) Whoever restrains her restrains the wind, And grasps oil with his right hand.

Mark 16:17 And these signs shall follow them that believe; In My Name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues;

Luke 11:24-26 When the unclean spirit is gone out of a man, he walketh through dry places, seeking rest; and finding none, he saith, I will return unto my house whence I came out. 25 And when he cometh, he findeth it swept and garnished. 26 Then goeth he, and taketh to him seven other spirits more wicked than himself; and they enter in, and dwell there: and the last state of that man is worse than the first.

Proverbs 27:17 (AV) Iron sharpeneth iron; so a man sharpeneth the countenance of his friend.

Proverbs 27:17 (NKJV) As iron sharpens iron, So a man sharpens the countenance of his friend.

Proverbs 27:18 (AV) Whoso keepeth the fig tree shall eat the fruit thereof: so he that waiteth on his master shall be honoured.

Proverbs 27:18 (NKJV) Whoever keeps the fig tree will eat its fruit; So he who waits on his master will be honored.

Luke 13:6-9 He spake also this parable; A certain man had a fig tree planted in his vineyard; and he came and sought fruit thereon, and found none. 7 Then said he unto the dresser of his vineyard, Behold, these three years I come seeking fruit on this fig tree, and find none: cut it down; why cumbereth it the ground? 8 And he answering said unto him, Lord, let it alone this year also, till I shall dig about it, and dung it: 9 And if it bear fruit, well: and if not, then after that thou shalt cut it down.

Colossians 3:23 And whatsoever ye do, do it heartily, as to the Lord, and not unto men;

Proverbs 27:19 (AV) As in water face *answereth* to face, so the heart of man to man.

Proverbs 27:19 (NKJV) As in water face *reflects* face, So a man's heart *reveals* the man.

Proverbs 27:20 (AV) Hell and destruction are never full; so the eyes of man are never satisfied.

Proverbs 27:20 (NKJV) Hell and Destruction are never full; So the eyes of man are never satisfied.

Isaiah 5:14 Therefore hell hath enlarged herself, and opened her mouth without measure: and their glory, and their multitude, and their pomp,

and he that rejoiceth, shall descend into it.

Exodus 20:17 Thou shalt not covet thy neighbour's house, thou shalt not covet thy neighbour's wife, nor his manservant, nor his maidservant, nor his ox, nor his ass, nor any thing that is thy neighbour's.

Proverbs 27:21 (AV) As the fining pot for silver, and the furnace for gold; so *is* a man to his praise.

Proverbs 27:21 (NKJV) The refining pot *is* for silver and the furnace for gold, And a man *is valued* by what others say of him.

Proverbs 27:22 (AV) Though thou shouldest bray a fool in a mortar among wheat with a pestle, *yet* will not his foolishness depart from him.

Proverbs 27:22 (NKJV) Though you grind a fool in a mortar with a pestle along with crushed grain, *Yet* his foolishness will not depart from him.

Ephesians 6:4 And, ye fathers, provoke not your children to wrath: but bring them up in the nurture and admonition of the Lord.

Jeremiah 5:3 O LORD, are not thine eyes upon the truth? thou hast stricken them, but they have not grieved; thou hast consumed them, but they have refused to receive correction: they have made their faces harder than a rock; they have refused to return.

Proverbs 27:23 (AV) Be thou diligent to know the state of thy flocks, *and* look well to thy herds.

Proverbs 27:23 (NKJV) Be diligent to know the state of your flocks, *And* attend to your herds;

Proverbs 27:24 (AV) For riches *are* not for ever: and doth the crown *endure* to every generation?

Proverbs 27:24 (NKJV) For riches *are* not forever, Nor does a crown *endure* to all generations.

2 Samuel 12:10 Now therefore the sword shall never depart from thine house; because thou hast despised me, and hast taken the wife of Uriah the Hittite to be thy wife.

1 Kings 11:4 For it came to pass, when Solomon was old, that his wives turned away his heart after other gods: and his heart was not perfect with the LORD his God, as was the heart of David his father.

Proverbs 27:25 (AV) The hay appeareth, and the tender grass sheweth itself, and herbs of the mountains are gathered.

Proverbs 27:25 (NKJV) *When* the hay is removed, and the tender grass shows itself, And the herbs of the mountains are gathered in,

Ecclesiastes 3:1,2 To every thing there is a season, and a time to every purpose under the heaven: 2 A time to be born, and a time to die; a time

to plant, and a time to pluck up that which is planted;
Proverbs 27:26 (AV) The lambs *are* for thy clothing, and the goats *are* the price of the field.
Proverbs 27:26 (NKJV) The lambs *will provide* your clothing, And the goats the price of a field;
Proverbs 27:27 (AV) And *thou shalt have* goats' milk enough for thy food, for the food of thy household, and *for* the maintenance for thy maidens.
Proverbs 27:27 (NKJV) *You shall have* enough goats' milk for your food, For the food of your household, And the nourishment of your maidservants.
1 Samuel 17:17,18 And Jesse said unto David his son, Take now for thy brethren an ephah of this parched corn, and these ten loaves, and run to the camp to thy brethren; 18 And carry these ten cheeses unto the captain of their thousand, and look how thy brethren fare, and take their pledge.
Genesis 1:31 And God saw every thing that He had made, and, behold, it was very good. And the evening and the morning were the sixth day.
