- James 1:25 But whoso looketh into the perfect law of liberty, and continueth therein, he being not a forgetful hearer, but a doer of the work, this man shall be blessed in his deed.
- Ecclesiastes 12:13 Let us hear the conclusion of the whole matter: Fear God, and keep his commandments: for this is the whole duty of man.
- Proverbs 28:1-28 (AV) & (NKJV)
- Proverbs 28:1 (AV) The wicked flee when no man pursueth: but the righteous are bold as a lion.
- Proverbs 28:1 (NKJV) The wicked flee when no one pursues, But the righteous are bold as a lion.
- Referred th Solomon a man in peace & Summarized of David a Man of War.
- 1 Kings 6 Referred to Elisha battling like Jesus did.
- Luke 20:23 But he perceived their craftiness, and said unto them, Why tempt ye Me?
- Proverbs 28:2 (AV) For the transgression of a land many *are* the princes thereof: but by a man of understanding *and* knowledge the state *thereof* shall be prolonged.
- Proverbs 28:2 (NKJV) Because of the transgression of a land, many *are* its princes; But by a man of understanding *and* knowledge Right will be prolonged.
- 1 Samuel 8:7 And the LORD said unto Samuel, Hearken unto the voice of the people in all that they say unto thee: for they have not rejected thee, but they have rejected Me, that I should not reign over them.
- Genesis 6 Referred to mankind "as in the days of Noah".
- Proverbs 28:3 (AV) A poor man that oppresseth the poor *is like* a sweeping rain which leaveth no food.
- Proverbs 28:3 (NKJV) A poor man who oppresses the poor *Is like* a driving rain which leaves no food.
- Matthew 18:18 Verily I say unto you, Whatsoever ye shall bind on earth shall be bound in heaven: and whatsoever ye shall loose on earth shall be loosed in heaven.
- Proverbs 28:4 (AV) They that forsake the law praise the wicked: but such as keep the law contend with them.
- Proverbs 28:4 (NKJV) Those who forsake the law praise the wicked, But such as keep the law contend with them.
- Isaiah 1:26 And I will restore thy judges as at the first, and thy counsellors as at the beginning: afterward thou shalt be called, The city of righteousness, the faithful city.

- 1 Timothy 2:1,2 I exhort therefore, that, first of all, supplications, prayers, intercessions, and giving of thanks, be made for all men; 2 For kings, and for all that are in authority; that we may lead a quiet and peaceable life in all godliness and honesty.
- Proverbs 28:5 (AV) Evil men understand not judgment: but they that seek the LORD understand all *things*.
- Proverbs 28:5 (NKJV) Evil men do not understand justice, But those who seek the LORD understand all.
- 2 Peter 3:9 The Lord is not slack concerning His promise, as some men count slackness; but is longsuffering to us-ward, not willing that any should perish, but that all should come to repentance.
- Proverbs 28:6 (AV) Better *is* the poor that walketh in his uprightness, than *he* that is perverse in his ways, though he be rich.
- Proverbs 28:6 (NKJV) Better *is* the poor who walks in his integrity than one perverse *in his* ways, though he *be* rich.
- John 6:15 When Jesus therefore perceived that they would come and take him by force, to make him a king, he departed again into a mountain himself alone.
- Job 1:21,22 And said, Naked came I out of my mother's womb, and naked shall I return thither: the LORD gave, and the LORD hath taken away; blessed be the name of the LORD. 22 In all this Job sinned not, nor charged God foolishly.
- Daniel 1:8 But Daniel purposed in his heart that he would not defile himself with the portion of the king's meat, nor with the wine which he drank: therefore he requested of the prince of the eunuchs that he might not defile himself.
- Luke 12:48 But he that knew not, and did commit things worthy of stripes, shall be beaten with few stripes. For unto whomsoever much is given, of him shall be much required: and to whom men have committed much, of him they will ask the more.
- Proverbs 28:7 (AV) Whoso keepeth the law *is* a wise son: but he that is a companion of riotous *men* shameth his father.
- Proverbs 28:7 (NKJV) Whoever keeps the law *is* a discerning son, But a companion of gluttons shames his father.
- Hebrews 5:14 But strong meat belongeth to them that are of full age, even those who by reason of use have their senses exercised to discern both good and evil.
- Joshua 24:15 And if it seem evil unto you to serve the LORD, choose you this day whom ye will serve; whether the gods which your fathers served that were on the other side of the flood, or the gods of the Amorites, in whose land ye dwell: but as for me and my house, we will serve the LORD.
- 1 Corinthians 15:33 Do not be deceived: Evil company corrupts good habits.

- Galatians 5:22,23 But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, longsuffering, gentleness, goodness, faith, 23 Meekness, temperance: against such there is no law.
- Proverbs 28:8 (AV) He that by usury and unjust gain increaseth his substance, he shall gather it for him that will pity the poor.
- Proverbs 28:8 (NKJV) One who increases his possessions by usury and extortion Gathers it for him who will pity the poor.
- Exodus 22:25 If thou lend money to any of my people that is poor by thee, thou shalt not be to him as an usurer, neither shalt thou lay upon him usury.
- Nehemiah 5 Summarized of the rulers oppressing the poor Israelites.
- Proverbs 13:11 Wealth gotten by vanity shall be diminished: but he that gathereth by labour shall increase.
- Proverbs 13:22 A good man leaveth an inheritance to his children's children: and the wealth of the sinner is laid up for the just.
- Proverbs 28:9 (AV) He that turneth away his ear from hearing the law, even his prayer *shall be* abomination.
- Proverbs 28:9 (NKJV) One who turns away his ear from hearing the law, Even his prayer *is* an abomination.
- 2 Chronicles 7:14 If My people, which are called by My Name, shall humble themselves, and pray, and seek My face, and turn from their wicked ways; then will I hear from heaven, and will forgive their sin, and will heal their land.
- Proverbs 28:10 (AV) Whoso causeth the righteous to go astray in an evil way, he shall fall himself into his own pit: but the upright shall have good *things* in possession.
- Proverbs 28:10 (NKJV) Whoever causes the upright to go astray in an evil way, He himself will fall into his own pit; But the blameless will inherit good.
- Psalms 140:5 The proud have hid a snare for me, and cords; they have spread a net by the wayside; they have set gins for me. Selah.
- Genesis 39:12 And she caught him by his garment, saying, Lie with me: and he left his garment in her hand, and fled, and got him out.
- Psalms 18 & 109 Referred to the Imprecatory Psalms.
- Psalms 140:8 Grant not, O LORD, the desires of the wicked: further not his wicked device; lest they exalt themselves. Selah.
- Matthew 5:44 But I say unto you, Love your enemies, bless them that curse you, do good to them that hate you, and pray for them which despitefully use you, and persecute you;
- Romans 12:19 Dearly beloved, avenge not yourselves, but rather give place unto wrath: for it is written, Vengeance is mine; I will repay, saith the Lord.

- John 8:7 So when they continued asking him, he lifted up himself, and said unto them, He that is without sin among you, let him first cast a stone at her.
- Proverbs 28:11 (AV) The rich man *is* wise in his own conceit; but the poor that hath understanding searcheth him out.
- Proverbs 28:11 (NKJV) The rich man *is* wise in his own eyes, But the poor who has understanding searches him out.
- Proverbs 28:12 (AV) When righteous *men* do rejoice, *there is* great glory: but when the wicked rise, a man is hidden.
- Proverbs 28:12 (NKJV) When the righteous rejoice, *there is* great glory; But when the wicked arise, men hide themselves.
- Proverbs 28:13 (AV) He that covereth his sins shall not prosper: but whoso confesseth and forsaketh *them* shall have mercy.
- Proverbs 28:13 (NKJV) He who covers his sins will not prosper, But whoever confesses and forsakes *them* will have mercy.
- Psalms 90:8 Thou hast set our iniquities before Thee, our secret sins in the light of Thy countenance.
- 1 John 1:9 If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.
- 2 Chronicles 7:14 If My people, which are called by My Name, shall humble themselves, and pray, and seek My face, and turn from their wicked ways; then will I hear from heaven, and will forgive their sin, and will heal their land.
- Proverbs 28:14 (AV) Happy *is* the man that feareth alway: but he that hardeneth his heart shall fall into mischief.
- Proverbs 28:14 (NKJV) Happy *is* the man who is always reverent (to God), But he who hardens his heart will fall into calamity.
- Mark 16:14 Afterward He appeared unto the eleven as they sat at meat, and upbraided them with their unbelief and hardness of heart, because they believed not them which had seen Him after He was risen.
- Proverbs 28:15 (AV) *As* a roaring lion, and a ranging bear; *so is* a wicked ruler over the poor people.
- Proverbs 28:15 (NKJV) *Like* a roaring lion and a charging bear *Is* a wicked ruler over poor people.
- Matthew 16:19 And I will give unto thee the keys of the kingdom of heaven: and whatsoever thou shalt bind on earth shall be bound in heaven: and whatsoever thou shalt loose on earth shall be loosed in heaven.
- Proverbs 28:16 (AV) The prince that wanteth understanding *is* also a great oppressor: *but* he that hateth covetousness shall prolong *his* days.
- Proverbs 28:16 (NKJV) A ruler who lacks understanding *is* a great oppressor, *But* he who hates covetousness will prolong *his* days.
- Proverbs 28:17 (AV) A man that doeth violence to the blood of any person

- shall flee to the pit; let no man stay him.
- Proverbs 28:17 (NKJV) A man burdened with bloodshed will flee into a pit; Let no one help him.
- Numbers 35 Summarized of the Cities of Refuge.
- Deuteronomy 19:21 And thine eye shall not pity; but life shall go for life, eye for eye, tooth for tooth, hand for hand, foot for foot.
- Ezekiel 36:18 Wherefore I poured my fury upon them for the blood that they had shed upon the land, and for their idols wherewith they had polluted it:
- Proverbs 28:18 (AV) Whoso walketh uprightly shall be saved: but *he that is* perverse *in his* ways shall fall at once.
- Proverbs 28:18 (NKJV) Whoever walks blamelessly will be saved, But *he who is* perverse *in his* ways will suddenly fall.
- Psalm 140 Referred to David's prayer V4 Keep me, O LORD, from the hands of the wicked; preserve me from the violent man; who have purposed to overthrow my goings.
- Proverbs 28:19 (AV) He that tilleth his land shall have plenty of bread: but he that followeth after vain *persons* shall have poverty enough.
- Proverbs 28:19 (NKJV) He who tills his land will have plenty of bread, But he who follows frivolity will have poverty enough!
- Proverbs 21:1 The king's heart is in the hand of the LORD, as the rivers of water: He turneth it whithersoever He will.
- Daniel 2:21 And He changeth the times and the seasons: He removeth kings, and setteth up kings: He giveth wisdom unto the wise, and knowledge to them that know understanding:
- Proverbs 28:20 (AV) A faithful man shall abound with blessings: but he that maketh haste to be rich shall not be innocent.
- Proverbs 28:20 (NKJV) A faithful (Godly) man will abound with blessings, But he who hastens to be rich (ungodly ways) will not go unpunished.
- Proverbs 28:21 (AV) To have respect of persons *is* not good: for for a piece of bread *that* man will transgress.
- Proverbs 28:21 (NKJV) To show partiality *is* not good, Because for a piece of bread a man will transgress.
- Revelation 20:12 And I saw the dead, small and great, stand before God; and the books were opened: and another book was opened, which is the book of life: and the dead were judged out of those things which were written in the books, according to their works.
- Proverbs 28:22 (AV) He that hasteth to be rich *hath* an evil eye, and considereth not that poverty shall come upon him.
- Proverbs 28:22 (NKJV) A man with an evil eye hastens after riches, And does not consider that poverty will come upon him.
- 1 Timothy 6:10 For the love of money is the root of all evil: which while some coveted after, they have erred from the faith, and pierced themselves

- through with many sorrows.
- Exodus 20:17 <u>Thou shalt not covet</u> thy neighbour's house, thou shalt not covet thy neighbour's wife, nor his manservant, nor his maidservant, nor his ox, nor his ass, nor any thing that is thy neighbour's.
- Proverbs 28:23 (AV) He that rebuketh a man afterwards shall find more favour than he that flattereth with the tongue.
- Proverbs 28:23 (NKJV) He who rebukes a man will find more favor afterward than he who flatters with the tongue.
- Proverbs 28:24 (AV) Whoso robbeth his father or his mother, and saith, *It is* no transgression; the same *is* the companion of a destroyer.
- Proverbs 28:24 (NKJV) Whoever robs his father or his mother, And says, *It is* no transgression, The same *is* companion to a destroyer.
- Exodus 20:12 Honour thy father and thy mother: that thy days may be long upon the land which the LORD thy God giveth thee.
- Romans 14:12 So then every one of us shall give account of himself to God.
- Proverbs 28:25 (AV) He that is of a proud heart stirreth up strife: but he that putteth his trust in the LORD shall be made fat.
- Proverbs 28:25 (NKJV) He who is of a proud heart stirs up strife, But he who trusts in the LORD will be prospered.
- Proverbs 28:26 (AV) He that trusteth in his own heart is a fool: but whoso walketh wisely, he shall be delivered.
- Proverbs 28:26 (NKJV) He who trusts in his own heart is a fool, But whoever walks wisely will be delivered.
- Romans 3:23 For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God;
- Proverbs 28:27 (AV) He that giveth unto the poor shall not lack: but he that hideth his eyes shall have many a curse.
- Proverbs 28:27 (NKJV) He who gives to the poor will not lack, But he who hides his eyes will have many curses.
- John 12 Summarized of the Alabastar box account V8 For the poor always ye have with you; but Me ye have not always.
- Proverbs 28:28 (AV) When the wicked rise, men hide themselves: but when they perish, the righteous increase.
- Proverbs 28:28 (NKJV) When the wicked arise, men hide themselves; But when they perish, the righteous increase.
