## Wise Sayings Of Solomon 20 - Proverbs 29

- Referred to the 10 Commandments & Solomon's wise sayings to learn from.
- **Proverbs 29:1-27 (AV) & (NKJV)**
- Proverbs 29:1 (AV) He, that being often reproved hardeneth *his* neck, shall <u>suddenly be destroyed</u>, and that without remedy.
- Proverbs 29:1 (NKJV) He who is often rebuked, *and* hardens *his* neck, Will suddenly be destroyed, and that without remedy.
- 2 Peter 3:9 The Lord is not slack concerning his promise, as some men count slackness; but is longsuffering to us-ward, not willing that any should perish, but that all should come to repentance.
- Hebrews 9:27 And as it is appointed unto men once to die, but after this the judgment:
- 2 Corinthians 6:2 (For He saith, I have heard thee in a time accepted, and in the day of salvation have I succoured thee: behold, now is the accepted time; behold, now is the day of salvation.)
- Hebrews 3:15 While it is said, To day if ye will hear His voice, harden not your hearts, as in the provocation.
- Proverbs 29:2 (AV) When the righteous are in authority, the people rejoice: but when the wicked beareth rule, the people mourn.
- Proverbs 29:2 (NKJV) When the righteous are in authority, the people rejoice; But when a wicked *man* rules, the people groan.
- 1 Kings 12 Referred to Israel asking Rehobaom to lower taxes.
- Proverbs 29:3 (AV) Whoso loveth wisdom rejoiceth his father: but he that keepeth company with harlots spendeth *his* substance.
- Proverbs 29:3 (NKJV) Whoever loves wisdom makes his father rejoice, But a companion of harlots wastes *his* wealth.
- Luke 15 Summarized of the parable of the prodigal son.
- Proverbs 4:7 Wisdom is the principal thing; therefore get wisdom: and with all thy getting get understanding.
- Proverbs 29:4 (AV) The king by judgment establisheth the land: but he that receiveth gifts overthroweth it.
- Proverbs 29:4 (NKJV) The king establishes the land by justice, But he who receives bribes overthrows it.
- Referred to Kings Saul, David, Solomon, etc.
- 1 Kings 11:4 For it came to pass, when Solomon was old, that his wives turned away his heart after other gods: and his heart was not perfect with the LORD his God, as was the heart of David his father.
- 1 Timothy 2:1,2 I exhort therefore, that, first of all, supplications, prayers, intercessions, and giving of thanks, be made for all men; 2 For kings, and

- for all that are in authority; that we may lead a quiet and peaceable life in all godliness and honesty.
- Daniel 2:21 And He changeth the times and the seasons: He removeth kings, and setteth up kings: He giveth wisdom unto the wise, and knowledge to them that know understanding:
- Proverbs 29:5 (AV) A man that flattereth his neighbour spreadeth a net for his feet.
- Proverbs 29:5 (NKJV) A man who flatters his neighbor Spreads a net for his feet.
- Numbers 12:3 (Now the man Moses was very meek, above all the men which were upon the face of the earth.)
- Matthew 11:29 Take My yoke upon you, and learn of Me; for I am meek and lowly in heart: and ye shall find rest unto your souls.
- Proverbs 29:6 (AV) In the transgression of an evil man *there is* a snare: but the righteous doth sing and rejoice.
- Proverbs 29:6 (NKJV) By transgression an evil man is snared, But the righteous sings and rejoices.
- Proverbs 29:7 (AV) The righteous (Godly) considereth the cause of the poor: but the wicked regardeth not to know it.
- Proverbs 29:7 (NKJV) The righteous considers the cause of the poor, *But* the wicked does not understand *such* knowledge.
- Acts 3 Referred to the lame man healed at the temple.
- 1 Timothy 5:8 But if any provide not for his own, and specially for those of his own house, he hath denied the faith, and is worse than an infidel.
- Luke 12 Referred to the parable of the rich man building bigger barns. V20 But God said unto him, Thou fool, this night thy soul shall be required of thee: then whose shall those things be, which thou hast provided?
- Luke 16 Referred to the parable of the Lazarus & the Rich man.
- Proverbs 29:8 (AV) Scornful men bring a city into a snare: but wise *men* turn away wrath.
- Proverbs 29:8 (NKJV) Scoffers set a city aflame, But wise *men* turn away wrath.
- Proverbs 29:9 (AV) *If* a wise man contendeth with a foolish man, whether he rage or laugh, *there is* no rest.
- Proverbs 29:9 (NKJV) *If* a wise man contends with a foolish man, Whether *the fool* rages or laughs, *there is* no peace.
- Summarized of the Gadarene Demoniac set free by Jesus.
- Mark 9 Summarized of the disciples unable to cast a demon from boy.
- Luke 10:19 Behold, I give unto you power to tread on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy: and nothing shall by any means hurt you.

- Mark 9:29 And He said unto them, This kind can come forth by nothing, but by prayer and fasting.
- Proverbs 29:10 (AV) The bloodthirsty hate the upright: but the just seek his soul.
- Proverbs 29:10 (NKJV) The bloodthirsty hate the blameless, But the upright seek his well-being.
- Proverbs 23:10,11 Remove not the old landmark; and enter not into the fields of the fatherless: 11 For their Redeemer is mighty; He shall plead their cause with thee.
- Nahum 1:2 God is jealous, and the LORD revengeth; the LORD revengeth, and is furious; the LORD will take vengeance on His adversaries, and He reserveth wrath for His enemies.
- John 10:10 The thief cometh not, but for to steal, and to kill, and to destroy: I am come that they might have life, and that they might have it more abundantly.
- Proverbs 29:11 (AV) A fool uttereth all his mind: but a wise *man* keepeth it in till afterwards.
- Proverbs 29:11 (NKJV) A fool vents all his feelings, But a wise *man* holds them back.
- Proverbs 29:12 (AV) If a ruler hearken to lies, all his servants are wicked.
- Proverbs 29:12 (NKJV) If a ruler pays attention to lies, All his servants become wicked.
- 1 Kings 12:8 But he forsook the counsel of the old men, which they had given him, and consulted with the young men that were grown up with him, and which stood before him:
- Proverbs 29:13 (AV) The poor and the deceitful man meet together: the LORD lighteneth both their eyes.
- Proverbs 29:13 (NKJV) The poor *man* and the oppressor have this in common: The LORD gives light to the eyes of both.
- Matthew 5:45 That ye may be the children of your Father which is in heaven: for he maketh his sun to rise on the evil and on the good, and sendeth rain on the just and on the unjust.
- Romans 8:31 What shall we then say to these things? If God be for us, who can be against us?
- 1 John 4:4 Ye are of God, little children, and have overcome them: because greater is He that is in you, than he that is in the world.
- Proverbs 29:14 (AV) The king that faithfully judgeth the poor, his throne shall be established for ever.
- Proverbs 29:14 (NKJV) The king who judges the poor with truth, His throne will be established forever.
- Proverbs 29:15 (AV) The rod and reproof give wisdom: but a child left to

- himself bringeth his mother to shame.
- Proverbs 29:15 (NKJV) The rod and rebuke give wisdom, But a child left *to himself* brings shame to his mother.
- Matthew 18:18 Verily I say unto you, Whatsoever ye shall bind on earth shall be bound in heaven: and whatsoever ye shall loose on earth shall be loosed in heaven.
- Ephesians 5:33 Nevertheless let every one of you in particular so love his wife even as himself; and the wife see that she reverence her husband.
- Ephesians 6:4 And, ye fathers, provoke not your children to wrath: but bring them up in the nurture and admonition of the Lord.
- Proverbs 29:16 (AV) When the wicked are multiplied, transgression increaseth: but the righteous shall see their fall.
- Proverbs 29:16 (NKJV) When the wicked are multiplied, transgression increases; But the righteous will see their fall.
- Proverbs 29:17 (AV) Correct thy son, and he shall give thee rest; yea, he shall give delight unto thy soul.
- Proverbs 29:17 (NKJV) Correct your son, and he will give you rest; Yes, he will give delight to your soul.
- Proverbs 29:18 (AV) Where *there is* no vision, the people perish: but he that keepeth the law, happy *is* he.
- Proverbs 29:18 (NKJV) Where *there is* no revelation, the people cast off restraint; But happy *is* he who keeps the law.
- 1 Corinthians 6:19 What? know ye not that your body is the temple of the Holy Ghost which is in you, which ye have of God, and ye are not your own?
- Proverbs 29:19 (AV) A servant will not be corrected by words: for though he understand he will not answer.
- Proverbs 29:19 (NKJV) A servant will not be corrected by mere words; For though he understands, he will not respond.
- Proverbs 29:20 (AV) Seest thou a man *that is* hasty in his words? *there is* more hope of a fool than of him.
- Proverbs 29:20 (NKJV) Do you see a man hasty in his words? *There is* more hope for a fool than for him.
- Genesis 1:27 So God created man in His own image, in the image of God created He him; male and female created He them.
- Proverbs 29:21 (AV) He that delicately bringeth up his servant from a child shall have him become *his* son at the length.
- Proverbs 29:21 (NKJV) He who pampers his servant from childhood Will have him as a son in the end.
- Proverbs 29:22 (AV) An angry man stirreth up strife, and a furious man aboundeth in transgression.

- Proverbs 29:22 (NKJV) An angry man stirs up strife, And a furious man abounds in transgression.
- Proverbs 29:23 (AV) A man's pride shall bring him low: but honour shall uphold the humble in spirit.
- Proverbs 29:23 (NKJV) A man's pride will bring him low, But the humble in spirit will retain honor.
- Proverbs 16:18 Pride goeth before destruction, and an haughty spirit before a fall.
- Proverbs 29:24 (AV) Whoso is partner with a thief hateth his own soul: he heareth cursing, and bewrayeth *it* not.
- Proverbs 29:24 (NKJV) Whoever is a partner with a thief hates his own life; He swears to tell the truth, but reveals nothing.
- Proverbs 29:25 (AV) The fear of man bringeth a snare: but whoso putteth his trust in the LORD shall be safe.
- Proverbs 29:25 (NKJV) The fear of man brings a snare, But whoever trusts in the LORD shall be safe.
- Daniel 1:8 But Daniel purposed in his heart that he would not defile himself with the portion of the king's meat, nor with the wine which he drank: therefore he requested of the prince of the eunuchs that he might not defile himself.
- Proverbs 29:26 (AV) Many seek the ruler's favour; but *every* man's judgment *cometh* from the LORD.
- Proverbs 29:26 (NKJV) Many seek the ruler's favor, But justice for man comes from the LORD.
- Revelation 20:12 And I saw the dead, small and great, stand before God; and the books were opened: and another book was opened, which is the book of life: and the dead were judged out of those things which were written in the books, according to their works.
- Proverbs 29:27 (AV) An unjust man *is* an abomination to the just: and *he that is* upright in the way *is* abomination to the wicked.
- Proverbs 29:27 (NKJV) An unjust man *is* an abomination to the righteous, And *he who is* upright in the way *is* an abomination to the wicked.
- Isaiah 1:26 And I will restore thy judges as at the first, and thy counsellors as at the beginning: afterward thou shalt be called, The city of righteousness, the faithful city.
