- Proverbs 30:31 (AV) A greyhound; an he goat also; and a king, against whom

- there is no rising up.
- Proverbs 30:31 (NKJV) A greyhound, A male goat also, And a king *whose* troops *are* with him.
- Proverbs 30:32 (AV) If thou hast done foolishly in lifting up thyself, or if thou hast thought evil, *lay* thine hand upon thy mouth.
- Proverbs 30:32 (NKJV) If you have been foolish in exalting yourself, Or if you have devised evil, *put your* hand on *your* mouth.
- Esther 7 Summarized of Haman's evil. V6,8 And Esther said, The adversary and enemy is this wicked Haman. Then Haman was afraid before the king and the queen. 8 Then the king returned out of the palace garden into the place of the banquet of wine; and Haman was fallen upon the bed whereon Esther was.
