- Proverbs 31:1 (AV) The words of king Lemuel, the prophecy that his mother taught him.
- Proverbs 31:1 (NKJV) The words of King Lemuel, the utterance which his mother taught him:
- Strongs #03927 Lemuw'el *lem-oo-ale'* or Lemow'el *lem-o-ale'* AV-Lemuel 2; Lemuel= for God 1) the name of an unknown king to whom his mother addressed the prudential maxims contained in some of the Proverbs 1a) might be same as king Solomon.
- Summarized of David, Bathsheba, & the Lord's promise of Solomon to be king.
- 1 Chronicles 22:9 Behold, a son shall be born to thee, who shall be a man of rest; and I will give him rest from all his enemies round about: for his name shall be Solomon, and I will give peace & quietness unto Israel in his days.
- 1 Kings 1 Summarized of Adonijah trying to be king.
- Exodus 8:1 And the LORD spake unto Moses, Go unto Pharaoh, and say unto him, Thus saith the LORD, Let My people go, that they may serve Me.

- 1 Samuel 2:35 And I will raise me up a faithful priest, that shall do according to that which is in mine heart and in my mind: and I will build him a sure house; and he shall walk before mine anointed for ever.
- 1 Samuel 2:17,22 Wherefore the sin of the young men was very great before the LORD: for men abhorred the offering of the LORD. 22 Now Eli was very old, and heard all that his sons did unto all Israel; and how they lay with the women that assembled at the door of the tabernacle of the congregation.

- Leviticus 10:9 Do not drink wine nor strong drink, thou, nor thy sons with thee, when ye go into the tabernacle of the congregation, lest ye die: it shall be a statute for ever throughout your generations:
- Acts 5 Referred to God judging Ananias & Sapphira.
- 1 Peter 4:17 For the time is come that judgment must begin at the house of God: and if it first begin at us, what shall the end be of them that obey not the gospel of God?
- Jonah Referred to God dealing with Jonah.
- Luke 15:17 And when he came to himself, he said, How many hired servants of my father's have bread enough and to spare, and I perish with hunger!
- Proverbs 31:7 (AV) Let him drink, and forget his poverty, and remember his misery no more.
- Proverbs 31:7 (NKJV) Let him drink and forget his poverty, And remember his misery no more.
- Proverbs 31:8 (AV) Open thy mouth for the dumb in the cause of all such as are appointed to destruction.
- Proverbs 31:8 (NKJV) Open your mouth for the speechless, In the cause of all who are appointed to die.
- Proverbs 31:9 (AV) Open thy mouth, judge righteously, and plead the cause of the poor and needy.
- Proverbs 31:9 (NKJV) Open your mouth, judge righteously, And plead the cause of the poor and needy.
- Leviticus 19:15 Ye shall do no unrighteousness in judgment: thou shalt not respect the person of the poor, nor honour the person of the mighty: but in righteousness shalt thou judge thy neighbour.
- 1 Kings 3 Summarized of Solomon judging between the 2 prostitutes.

- Isaiah 1:26 And I will restore thy judges as at the first, and thy counsellors as at the beginning: afterward thou shalt be called, The city of righteousness, the faithful city.
- Proverbs 22:22,23 Rob not the poor, because he is poor: neither oppress the afflicted in the gate: 23 For the LORD will plead their cause, and spoil the soul of those that spoiled them.
- Daniel 10:20 Then said he, Knowest thou wherefore I come unto thee? and now will I return to fight with the prince of Persia: and when I am gone forth, lo, the prince of Grecia shall come.
- **Deuteronomy 17:14-20 (AV) & (NKJV)**
- Deuteronomy 17:14 (AV) When thou art come unto the land which the LORD thy God giveth thee, & shalt possess it, and shalt dwell therein, and shalt say, I will set a king over me, like as all the nations that *are* about me;
- Deuteronomy 17:14 (NKJV) When you come to the land which the LORD your God is giving you, and possess it and dwell in it, and say, I will set a king over me like all the nations that *are* around me,
- 2 Samuel 8 Summarized of Israel wanting a king. V7 And the LORD said unto Samuel, Hearken unto the voice of the people in all that they say unto thee: for they have not rejected thee, but they have rejected Me, that I should not reign over them.
- Deuteronomy 17:15 (AV) Thou shalt in any wise set *him* king over thee, <u>whom</u> the LORD thy God shall choose: one from among thy brethren shalt thou set king over thee: thou mayest not set a stranger over thee, which *is* not thy brother.
- Deuteronomy 17:15 (NKJV) you shall surely set a king over you whom the LORD your God chooses; one from among your brethren you shall set as king over you; you may not set a foreigner over you, who is not your brother.
- 1 Samuel 9 Summarized of the Lord choosing Saul as King.
- Deuteronomy 17:16 (AV) But he shall not multiply horses to himself, nor cause the people to return to Egypt, to the end that he should multiply horses: forasmuch as the LORD hath said unto you, Ye shall henceforth return no more that way.
- Deuteronomy 17:16 (NKJV) But he shall not multiply horses for himself (military might), nor cause the people to return to Egypt to multiply horses (for military alliances), for the LORD has said to you, You shall not return that way again.
- 1 Kings 3:1 And Solomon made affinity with Pharaoh king of Egypt, and took Pharaoh's daughter, and brought her into the city of David, until he had made an end of building his own house, and the house of the LORD, and the wall of Jerusalem round about.

- Jeremiah 44 Summarized of Israel going to Egypt & judged there.
- Deuteronomy 17:17 (AV) Neither shall he multiply wives to himself, that his heart turn not away: neither shall he greatly multiply to himself silver and gold.
- Deuteronomy 17:17 (NKJV) Neither shall he multiply wives for himself, lest his heart turn away; nor shall he greatly multiply silver and gold for himself.
- Matthew 19:5 And said, For this cause shall a man leave father and mother, and shall cleave to his wife: and they twain shall be one flesh?
- John 12:8 For the poor always ye have with you; but Me ye have not always.
- Deuteronomy 17:18 (AV) And it shall be, when he sitteth upon the throne of his kingdom, that he shall write him a copy of this law in a book out of that which is before the priests the Levites:
- Deuteronomy 17:18 (NKJV) Also it shall be, when he sits on the throne of his kingdom, that he shall write for himself a copy of this law in a book, from the one before the priests, the Levites.
- Deuteronomy 17:19 (AV) And it shall be with him, and <u>he shall read therein all</u> the days of his life: that he may <u>learn to fear the LORD his God</u>, to keep all the Words of this law and these statutes, to do them:
- Deuteronomy 17:19 (NKJV) And it shall be with him, and he shall read it all the days of his life, that he may learn to fear the LORD his God and be careful to observe all the Words of this law and these statutes,
- Proverbs 9:10 The fear of the LORD is the beginning of wisdom: and the knowledge of the holy is understanding.
- Deuteronomy 17:20 (AV) That his heart be not lifted up above his brethren, and that he turn not aside from the commandment, *to* the right hand, or *to* the left: to the end that he may prolong *his* days in his kingdom, he, and his children, in the midst of Israel.
- Deuteronomy 17:20 (NKJV) that his heart may not be lifted above his brethren (no pride), that he may not turn aside from the commandment *to* the right hand or *to* the left, and that he may prolong *his* days in his kingdom, he and his children in the midst of Israel.
- Acts 5:29 Then Peter and the other apostles answered and said, We ought to obey God rather than men.
