- Nahum followed up in Nineveh 100 years after Jonah's preaching & revival. John 4 Referred to Jesus ministering to the woman at the well.
- Psalms 106:38 And shed innocent blood, even the blood of their sons and of their daughters, whom they sacrificed unto the idols of Canaan: and the land was polluted with blood.
- Jeremiah 7,11 & 14 & Amos God said "Pray not for them."
- Nahum 2:6 The gates of the rivers shall be opened, and the palace shall be dissolved.

 Nahum 3:1-19 (AV) & (NKJV)
- Nahum 3:1 (AV) Woe to the bloody city! it *is* all full of lies *and* robbery; the prey departeth not;

 Nahum 3:1 (NKJV) Woe to the bloody city! It *is* all full of lies *and* robbery. *Its* victim never departs.
- Nahum 3:2 (AV) The noise of a whip, and the noise of the rattling of the wheels, and of the pransing horses, and of the jumping chariots.
- Nahum 3:2 (NKJV) The noise of a whip And the noise of rattling wheels, Of galloping horses, Of clattering chariots!
- Nahum 3:3 (AV) The horseman lifteth up both the bright sword and the glittering spear: and there is a multitude of slain, and a great number of carcases; and there is none end of their corpses; they stumble upon their corpses:

 Nahum 3:3 (NKJV) Horsemen charge with bright sword and glittering spear. There is a multitude of slain, A great number of bodies, Countless corpses, They stumble over the corpses,
- Nahum 3:4 (AV) Because of the multitude of the whoredoms of the wellfavoured harlot, the mistress of witchcrafts, that selleth nations through her whoredoms, and families through her witchcrafts.
- Nahum 3:4 (NKJV) Because of the multitude of harlotries of the seductive harlot, The mistress of sorceries, Who sells nations through her harlotries, And families through her sorceries.
- 2 Kings 18:33 Hath any of the gods of the nations delivered at all his land out of the hand of the king of Assyria?
- 1 Samuel 17:45 Then said David to the Philistine, Thou comest to me with a sword, & with a spear, and with a shield: but I come to thee in the name of the LORD of hosts, the God of the armies of Israel, whom thou hast defied.
- Nahum 3:5 (AV) Behold, I *am* against thee, saith the LORD of hosts; and I will discover thy skirts upon thy face, and I will shew the nations thy nakedness, and the kingdoms thy shame.
- Nahum 3:5 (NKJV) Behold, I *am* against you, says the LORD of hosts; I will lift your skirts over your face, I will show the nations your nakedness, And the kingdoms your shame.
- Matthew 23 Referred to Jesus' 8 woes against the religious leaders.
- Mark 4:7 And some fell among thorns, and the thorns grew up, and choked it,

- and it yielded no fruit.
- Nahum 3:6 (AV) And I will cast abominable filth upon thee, and make thee vile, and will set thee as a gazingstock.

 Nahum 3:6 (NKJV) I will cast abominable filth upon you, Make you vile, And make you a spectacle.
- 2 Kings 19:36,37 So Sennacherib king of Assyria departed, and went and returned, and dwelt at Nineveh. 37 And it came to pass, as he was worshipping in the house of Nisroch his god, that Adrammelech and Sharezer his sons smote him with the sword: and they escaped into the land of Armenia. And Esarhaddon his son reigned in his stead.
- Nahum 3:7 (AV) And it shall come to pass, *that* all they that look upon thee shall flee from thee, and say, Nineveh is laid waste: who will bemoan her? whence shall I seek comforters for thee?
- Nahum 3:7 (NKJV) It shall come to pass *that* all who look upon you Will flee from you, and say, Nineveh is laid waste! Who will bemoan her? Where shall I seek comforters for you?
- Job 12:21 He poureth contempt upon princes, and weakeneth the strength of the mighty.

 Job 3:25 For the thing which I greatly feared is come upon me, and that which I was afraid of is come unto me.
- Nahum 3:8 (AV) Art thou better than populous No, that was situate among the rivers, *that had* the waters round about it, whose rampart *was* the sea, *and* her wall *was* from the sea?
- Nahum 3:8 (NKJV) Are you better than No Amon *That was* situated by the River, That had the waters around her, Whose rampart *was* the sea, Whose wall *was* the sea?
- Romans 12:19 Dearly beloved, avenge not yourselves, but rather give place unto wrath: for it is written, Vengeance is mine; I will repay, said the Lord.
- Amos prayed 3 times for the people & God withheld judgement, but the fourth time judgement fell.
- Nahum 3:9 (AV) Ethiopia and Egypt *were* her strength, and *it was* infinite; Put and Lubim were thy helpers.
- Nahum 3:9 (NKJV) Ethiopia and Egypt *were* her strength, And *it was* boundless; Put and Lubim were your helpers.
- Nahum 3:10 (AV) Yet was she carried away, she went into captivity: her young children also were dashed in pieces at the top of all the streets: and they cast lots for her honourable men, and all her great men were bound in chains.

 Nahum 3:10 (NKJV) Yet she was carried away, She went into captivity; Her young children also were dashed to pieces At the head of every street; They cast lots for her honorable men, And all her great men were bound in chains.
- Nahum 3:11 (AV) Thou also shalt be drunken: thou shalt be hid, thou also shalt seek strength because of the enemy.
- Nahum 3:11 (NKJV) You also will be drunk; You will be hidden; You also will

- seek refuge from the enemy.
- Nahum 3:12 (AV) All thy strong holds *shall be like* fig trees with the firstripe figs: if they be shaken, they shall even fall into the mouth of the eater.
- Nahum 3:12 (NKJV) All your strongholds *are* fig trees with ripened figs: If they are shaken, They fall into the mouth of the eater.
- Nahum 3:13 (AV) Behold, thy people in the midst of thee *are* women: the gates of thy land shall be set wide open unto thine enemies: the fire shall devour thy bars.

 Nahum 3:13 (NKJV) Surely, your people in your midst *are* women! The gates of your land are wide open for your enemies; Fire shall devour the bars of your *gates*.
- Nahum 3:14 (AV) Draw thee waters for the siege, fortify thy strong holds: go into clay, and tread the morter, make strong the brickkiln.
- Nahum 3:14 (NKJV) Draw your water for the siege! Fortify your strongholds! Go into the clay and tread the mortar! Make strong the brick kiln!
- Nahum 3:15 (AV) There shall the fire devour thee; the sword shall cut thee off, it shall eat thee up like the cankerworm: make thyself many as the cankerworm, make thyself many as the locusts.
- Nahum 3:15 (NKJV) There the fire will devour you, The sword will cut you off; It will eat you up like a locust. Make yourself many, like the locust! Make yourself many, like the *swarming* locusts!
- Nahum 3:16 (AV) Thou hast multiplied thy merchants above the stars of heaven: the cankerworm spoileth, and flieth away.
- Nahum 3:16 (NKJV) You have multiplied your merchants more than the stars of heaven. The locust plunders and flies away.
- Nahum 3:17 (AV) Thy crowned *are* as the locusts, and thy captains as the great grasshoppers, which camp in the hedges in the cold day, *but* when the sun ariseth they flee away, & their place is not known where they *are*.
- Nahum 3:17 (NKJV) Your commanders *are* like *swarming* locusts, And your generals like great grasshoppers, Which camp in the hedges on a cold day; When the sun rises they flee away, And the place where they *are* is not known.
- Nahum 3:18 (AV) Thy shepherds slumber, O king of Assyria: thy nobles shall dwell in the dust: thy people is scattered upon the mountains, and no man gathereth them.

 Nahum 3:18 (NKJV) Your shepherds slumber, O king of Assyria; Your nobles rest in the dust. Your people are scattered on the mountains, And no one gathers them.
- Zechariah 13:7 Awake, O sword, against my shepherd, and against the man that is my fellow, saith the LORD of hosts: smite the shepherd, and the sheep shall be scattered: and I will turn mine hand upon the little ones. Compaired how God chose Kings Saul & David.
- Nahum 3:19 (AV) *There is* no healing of thy bruise; thy wound is grievous: all that hear the bruit of thee shall clap the hands over thee: for upon whom

- hath not thy wickedness passed continually?
- Nahum 3:19 (NKJV) Your injury *has* no healing, Your wound is severe. All who hear news of you Will clap *their* hands over you, For upon whom has not your wickedness passed continually?
- Daniel 4:16 Let his heart be changed from man's, and let a beast's heart be given unto him; and let seven times pass over him.
- Strongs #04996 No' *no* AV-No 5; No= disrupting 1) the ancient capital of Egypt; also Thebes.
- Genesis 6:5 GOD saw that the wickedness of man *was* great in the earth, & every imagination of the thoughts of his heart *was* only evil continually.
- Ezekiel 13:1-23 V1-5 And the Word of the LORD came unto me, saying, 2 Son of man, prophesy against the prophets of Israel that prophesy, and say thou unto them that prophesy out of their own hearts, Hear ye the Word of the LORD; 3 Thus saith the Lord GOD; Woe unto the foolish prophets, that follow their own spirit, and have seen nothing! 4 O Israel, thy prophets are like the foxes in the deserts. 5 Ye have not gone up into the gaps, neither made up the hedge for the house of Israel to stand in the battle in the day of the LORD.
- Ezekiel 22:30 And I sought for a man among them, that should make up the hedge, and stand in the gap before Me for the land, that I should not destroy it: but I found none.
- Ezekiel 13:6-10 They have seen vanity and lying divination, saying, The LORD saith: and the LORD hath not sent them: and they have made *others* to hope that they would confirm the word. 7 Have ye not seen a vain vision, and have ye not spoken a lying divination, whereas ye say, The LORD saith *it*; albeit I have not spoken? 8 Therefore thus saith the Lord GOD; Because ye have spoken vanity, and seen lies, therefore, behold, I *am* against you, saith the Lord GOD. 9 And Mine hand shall be upon the prophets that see vanity, and that divine lies: they shall not be in the assembly of My people, neither shall they be written in the writing of the house of Israel, neither shall they enter into the land of Israel; and ye shall know that I *am* the Lord GOD. 10 Because, even because they have seduced My people, saying, Peace; and *there was* no peace; and one built up a wall, and, lo, others daubed it with untempered *morter*:
- Ezekiel 13:11 Say unto them which daub *it* with untempered *morter*, that it shall fall: there shall be an overflowing shower; and ye, 0 great hailstones, shall fall; and a stormy wind shall rend *it*. 12 Lo, when the wall is fallen, shall it not be said unto you, Where *is* the daubing wherewith ye have daubed *it*?

 Joshua 6 Referred to the walls of Jericho falling.
- Ezekiel 13:13-23 (Summarized) Therefore thus saith the Lord GOD; I will even rend *it* with a stormy wind in My fury; and there shall be an overflowing shower in mine anger, and great hailstones in *My* fury to consume *it*. 14 So

will I break down the wall that ye have daubed with untempered morter, and bring it down to the ground, so that the foundation thereof shall be discovered, and it shall fall, and ye shall be consumed in the midst thereof: and ye shall know that I am the LORD. 15 Thus will I accomplish My wrath upon the wall, and upon them that have daubed it with untempered *morter*, and will say unto you, The wall *is* no *more*, neither they that daubed it; 16 To wit, the prophets of Israel which prophesy concerning Jerusalem, and which see visions of peace for her, and there is no peace, saith the Lord GOD. 17 Likewise, thou son of man, set thy face against the daughters of thy people, which prophesy out of their own heart; and prophesy thou against them, 18 And say, Thus saith the Lord GOD; Woe to the women that sew pillows to all armholes, and make kerchiefs upon the head of every stature to hunt souls! Will ye hunt the souls of My people, and will ye save the souls alive that come unto you? 19 And will ye pollute Me among My people for handfuls of barley and for pieces of bread, to slay the souls that should not die, and to save the souls alive that should not live, by your lying to My people that hear your lies? 20 Wherefore thus saith the Lord GOD; Behold, I am against your pillows, wherewith ye there hunt the souls to make them fly, and I will tear them from your arms, and will let the souls go, even the souls that ye hunt to make them fly. 21 Your kerchiefs also will I tear, and deliver My people out of your hand, and they shall be no more in your hand to be hunted; and ye shall know that I am the LORD. 22 Because with lies ye have made the heart of the righteous sad, whom I have not made sad; and strengthened the hands of the wicked, that he should not return from his wicked way, by promising him life: 23 Therefore ye shall see no more vanity, nor divine divinations: for I will deliver My people out of your hand: and ye shall know that I am the LORD.

- 1 John 4:4 Ye are of God, little children, and have overcome them: because greater is he that is in you, than he that is in the world.
- 2 Corinthians 10:4 (For the weapons of our warfare are not carnal, but mighty through God to the pulling down of strong holds;)
- Ephesians 6:12 For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high places.
- Strongs #06316 Puwt *poot* AV-Put 2, Phut 2, Libya 2, Libyan 1; 7 Phut or Put= a bow 1) a nation and people of northern Africa; probably Libyans.
- Strongs #03864 Luwbiy *loo-bee'* or Lubbiy (Da 11:43) *loob-bee'* AV-Lubim 3, Libyan 1; 4 Libyans= empty-hearted (Da 11:43) or afflicted (Jer 46:9) 1) a people of northern Africa west of Egypt.
- Strongs #07462 ra'ah *raw-aw'* AV-feed 75, shepherd 63, pastor 8, herdmen 7, keep 3, companion 2, broken 1, company 1, devour 1, eat 1, entreateth 1,

- Jeremiah 10:21 For the <u>pastors</u> are become brutish, and have not sought the LORD: therefore they shall not prosper, and all their flocks shall be scattered.
- Jeremiah 12:10 Many <u>pastors</u> have destroyed My vineyard, they have trodden My portion under foot, they have made My pleasant portion a desolate wilderness.
- Jeremiah 17:16 As for me, I have not hastened from *being* a <u>pastor</u> to follow Thee: neither have I desired the woeful day; Thou knowest: that which came out of my lips was *right* before Thee.
- Jeremiah 22:22 The wind shall eat up all thy <u>pastors</u>, and thy lovers shall go into captivity: surely then shalt thou be ashamed and confounded for all thy wickedness.
- Jeremiah 23:1,2 Woe be unto the <u>pastors</u> that destroy and scatter the sheep of My pasture! saith the LORD. 2 Therefore thus saith the LORD God of Israel against the <u>pastors</u> that feed My people; Ye have scattered My flock, and driven them away, and have not visited them: behold, I will visit upon you the evil of your doings, saith the LORD.
- Luke 10 Referred to Jesus as the Good Samaratan.
- Jeremiah 23:4 And <u>I will set up shepherds over them which shall feed them</u>: and they shall fear no more, nor be dismayed, neither shall they be lacking, saith the LORD.

- Luke 24:45 Then opened He their understanding, that they might understand the scriptures,
- Jeremiah 25:34-36 Howl, ye <u>shepherds</u>, & cry; and wallow yourselves *in the ashes*, ye principal of the flock: for the days of your slaughter and of your dispersions are accomplished; & ye shall fall like a pleasant vessel. 35 & the <u>shepherds</u> shall have no way to flee, nor the principal of the flock to escape. 36 A voice of the cry of the <u>shepherds</u>, & an howling of the principal of the flock, *shall be heard*: for the LORD hath spoiled their pasture.
- Jeremiah 31:10 Hear the Word of the LORD, O ye nations, and declare *it* in the isles afar off, and say, He that scattered Israel will gather him, and keep him, as a <u>shepherd</u> *doth* his flock.
- Jeremiah 33:12 Thus saith the LORD of hosts; Again in this place, which is desolate without man and without beast, and in all the cities thereof, shall be an habitation of sheepherds causing their flocks to lie down.
- Psalms 23 Referred to the Lord is my Shepherd Psalm.
- Jeremiah 43:12 And I will kindle a fire in the houses of the gods of Egypt; and he shall burn them, and carry them away captives: and he shall array himself with the land of Egypt, as a sheepherd putteth on his garment; and he shall go forth from thence in peace.
- Exodus 12:12 For I will pass through the land of Egypt this night, and will smite all the firstborn in the land of Egypt, both man and beast; and against all the gods of Egypt I will execute judgment: I am the LORD.
- Jeremiah 49:19 Behold, he shall come up like a lion from the swelling of Jordan against the habitation of the strong: but I will suddenly make him run away from her: and who *is* a chosen *man, that* I may appoint over her? for who *is* like Me? and who will appoint Me the time? and who *is* that shepherd that will stand before Me?
- Jeremiah 50:6 My people hath been lost sheep: their <u>shepherds</u> have caused them to go astray, they have turned them away *on* the mountains: they have gone from mountain to hill, they have forgotten their restingplace.
- Jeremiah 50:44 Behold, he shall come up like a lion from the swelling of Jordan unto the habitation of the strong: but I will make them suddenly run away from her: and who *is* a chosen *man, that* I may appoint over her? for who *is* like Me? and who will appoint Me the time? and who *is* that shepherd that will stand before Me?
- Jeremiah 51:23 I will also break in pieces with thee the <u>shepherd</u> and his flock; and with thee will I break in pieces the husbandman and his yoke of oxen; and with thee will I break in pieces captains and rulers.
