- Acts 15:20 But that we write unto them, that they abstain from pollutions of idols, and from fornication, and from things strangled, and from blood.
- Mark 16:17 And these signs shall follow them that believe; In My Name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues;
- Ezekiel 22:30 And I sought for a man among them, that should make up the hedge, and stand in the gap before me for the land, that I should not destroy it: but I found none.
- Habakkuk 2:1 (AV) I will stand upon my watch, and set me upon the tower, and will watch to see what he will say unto me, and what I shall answer when I am reproved.
- Habakkuk 2:1 (NKJV) I will stand my watch And set myself on the rampart, And watch to see what He will say to me, And what I will answer when I am corrected.
- Habakkuk 1 Referred to the evil doings of Israel.
- Genesis 6:5 And GOD saw that the wickedness of man was great in the earth, and that every imagination of the thoughts of his heart was only evil continually.
- 2 Peter 3:9 The Lord is not slack concerning his promise, as some men count slackness; but is longsuffering to us-ward, not willing that any should perish, but that all should come to repentance.
- Amos 7 Summarized of God revealing the punishment due & Amos interceded 4 times. God held off the first 3 times, but the last time judgement fell.

- Matthew 7:15 Beware of false prophets, which come to you in sheep's clothing, but inwardly they are ravening wolves.
- John 10:11,12 I am the good shepherd: the good shepherd giveth his life for the sheep. 12 But he that is an hireling, and not the shepherd, whose own

- the sheep are not, seeth the wolf coming, and leaveth the sheep, and fleeth: and the wolf catcheth them, and scattereth the sheep.

- Habakkuk 2:4 (NKJV) Behold the proud, His soul is not upright in him; But the just shall live by his faith.
- Acts 8:21 Thou hast neither part nor lot in this matter: for thy heart is not right in the sight of God.
- Acts 13:11 And now, behold, the hand of the Lord is upon thee, and thou shalt be blind, not seeing the sun for a season. And immediately there fell on him a mist and a darkness; and he went about seeking some to lead him by the hand.
- Ephesians 2:8,9 For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: it is the gift of God: 9 Not of works, lest any man should boast.
- Habakkuk 2:4 Behold, his soul *which* is lifted up is not upright in him: but the <u>just</u> shall <u>live</u> <u>by</u> his <u>faith</u>.

- Matthew 16:24 Then said Jesus unto His disciples, If any man will come after Me, let him deny himself, and take up his cross, and follow Me.
- Hebrews 3:13 But exhort one another daily, while it is called To day; lest any of you be hardened through the deceitfulness of sin.
- Acts 9:31 Then had the churches rest throughout all Judaea and Galilee and Samaria, and were edified; and walking in the fear of the Lord, and in the comfort of the Holy Ghost, were multiplied.
- Isaiah 21:6 For thus hath the Lord said unto me, Go, set a <u>watchman</u>, let him declare what he seeth.
- Galatians 6:1 Brethren, if a man be overtaken in a fault, ye which are spiritual, restore such an one in the spirit of meekness; considering thyself, lest thou also be tempted.

- 1 Timothy 5:13 And withal they (young widows) learn to be idle, wandering about from house to house; and not only idle, but tattlers also and busybodies, speaking things which they ought not.
- Isaiah 21:11 The burden of Dumah. He calleth to me out of Seir, <u>Watchman</u>, what of the night? <u>Watchman</u>, what of the night?
- Matthew 14:24,25 But the ship was now in the midst of the sea, tossed with waves: for the wind was contrary. 25 And in the fourth watch of the night Jesus went unto them, walking on the sea.
- Isaiah 21:12 The <u>watchman</u> said, The morning cometh, and also the night: if ye will enquire, enquire ye: return, come.
- Isaiah 52:8 Thy <u>watchmen</u> shall lift up the voice; with the voice together shall they sing: for they shall see eye to eye, when the LORD shall bring again Zion.
- Romans 12:2 And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what is that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God.
- Isaiah 56:10 His <u>watchmen</u> *are* blind: they are all ignorant, they *are* all dumb dogs, they cannot bark; sleeping, lying down, loving to slumber.
- Jeremiah 23 & Ezekiel 34 Referred to the ungodly watchmen.
- Psalms 140:1 « To the chief Musician, A Psalm of David. » Deliver me, O LORD, from the evil man: preserve me from the violent man;
- Summarized of Godly watchmen John Bunyan & Oliver Cromwell.
- Isaiah 62:6 I have set <u>watchmen</u> upon thy walls, O Jerusalem (symbol of the Church), *which* shall never hold their peace day nor night: ye that make mention of the LORD, keep not silence,
- Jeremiah 6:17 Also I set <u>watchmen</u> over you, *saying*, Hearken to the sound of the trumpet. But they said, We will not hearken.
- Hebrews 5:14 But strong meat belongeth to them that are of full age, even those who by reason of use have their senses exercised to discern both good and evil.
- Joel 3:9 Proclaim ye this among the Gentiles; Prepare war, wake up the mighty men, let all the men of war draw near; let them come up:
- Summarized of Winston Churchill as God's watchman in Britain.
- Jeremiah 31:6 For there shall be a day, *that* the <u>watchmen</u> upon the mount Ephraim shall cry, Arise ye, and let us go up to Zion unto the LORD our God.
- Matthew 10:37 He that loveth father or mother more than Me is not worthy of Me: and he that loveth son or daughter more than Me is not worthy of Me.
- 1 Samuel 2:29 Wherefore kick ye at My sacrifice and at Mine offering, which I have commanded in My habitation; and honourest thy sons above Me, to

- make yourselves fat with the chiefest of all the offerings of Israel My people?
- Jeremiah 51:12 Set up the standard upon the walls of Babylon, make the watch strong, set up the <u>watchmen</u>, prepare the ambushes: for the LORD hath both devised and done that which he spake against the inhabitants of Babylon.
- Daniel 5 Summarized of God dealing with Belshazzar V25 And this is the writing that was written, MENE, MENE, TEKEL, UPHARSIN.
- Referred to many of God's judgements on the ungodly.
- Isaiah 37 Summarized of God dealing with Sennacherib.
- Ezekiel 3:17 Son of man, I have made thee a <u>watchman</u> unto the house of Israel: therefore hear the Word at My mouth, and give them warning from Me.
- Ezekiel 33:2,6,7 Son of man, speak to the children of thy people, and say unto them, When I bring the sword upon a land, if the people of the land take a man of their coasts, and set him for their watchman: 6 But if the watchman see the sword come, and blow not the trumpet, and the people be not warned; if the sword come, and take any person from among them, he is taken away in his iniquity; but his blood will I require at the watchman's hand. 7 So thou, O son of man, I have set thee a watchman unto the house of Israel; therefore thou shalt hear the Word at My mouth, and warn them from Me.
- Leviticus 26 Summarized of God judging Israel in stages increasing it as they rebelled.
- Hosea 9:8 The <u>watchman</u> of Ephraim *was* with my God: *but* the prophet *is* a snare of a fowler in all his ways, *and* hatred in the house of his God.
- 1 Kings 13 Summarized of the Man of God & the old prophet.
- Micah 7:4 The best of them *is* as a brier: the most upright *is sharper* than a thorn hedge: the day of thy <u>watchmen</u> and thy visitation cometh; now shall be their perplexity.
- Matthew 24:38,39 For as in the days that were before the flood they were eating and drinking, marrying and giving in marriage, until the day that Noe entered into the ark, 39 And knew not until the flood came, and took them all away; so shall also the coming of the Son of Man be.
