

Woe To The Oppressors Of God's People - Habakkuk 2B

Acts 9:4 And he fell to the earth, and heard a voice saying unto him, Saul, Saul, why persecutest thou Me?

Jeremiah 51 Referred to God's vengeance on evil.

John 15:25 But this cometh to pass, that the Word might be fulfilled that is written in their law, They hated Me without a cause.

Revelation 6:10 And they cried with a loud voice, saying, How long, O Lord, Holy and True, dost thou not judge and avenge our blood on them that dwell on the earth?

Genesis 1 Referred to the Creation. **V31** And God saw every thing that He had made, and, behold, it was very good. And the evening and the morning were the sixth day.

John 3:16 For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life.

Habakkuk 1 Summarized of God's Judgement to fall soon.

2 Chronicles 34:28 Behold, I will gather thee (Josiah) to thy fathers, and thou shalt be gathered to thy grave in peace, neither shall thine eyes see all the evil that I will bring upon this place, and upon the inhabitants of the same. So they brought the king word again.

1 Kings 11:11-13 Wherefore the LORD said unto Solomon, Forasmuch as this is done of thee, and thou hast not kept My covenant and My statutes, which I have commanded thee, I will surely rend the kingdom from thee, and will give it to thy servant. **12** Notwithstanding in thy days I will not do it for David thy father's sake: but I will rend it out of the hand of thy son. **13** Howbeit I will not rend away all the kingdom; but will give one tribe to thy son for David My servant's sake, and for Jerusalem's sake which I have chosen.

2 Peter 3:9 The Lord is not slack concerning His promise, as some men count slackness; but is longsuffering to us-ward, not willing that any should perish, but that all should come to repentance.

Habakkuk 2:5-20 (AV) & (NKJV)

Habakkuk 2:5 (AV) Yea also, because he transgresseth by wine, *he is* a proud man, neither keepeth at home, who enlargeth his desire as hell, and *is* as death, and cannot be satisfied, but gathereth unto him all nations, and heapeth unto him all people:

Habakkuk 2:5 (NKJV) Indeed, because he transgresses by wine, *He is* a proud man, And he does not stay at home. Because he enlarges his desire as hell, And he *is* like death, and cannot be satisfied, He gathers to

himself all nations And heaps up for himself all peoples.

2 Chronicles Summarized of Sennacherib dealt with by God.

Nahum Summarized of Assyria dealt with by God.

Daniel 5 Summarized of Belshazzar dealt with by God.

1 Corinthians 6:19 What? know ye not that your body is the temple of the Holy Ghost which is in you, which ye have of God, and ye are not your own?

Daniel 4 Summarized of Nebuchadnezzar's pride dealt with by God.

Habakkuk 2:6 (AV) Shall not all these take up a parable against him, and a taunting proverb against him, and say, Woe to him that increaseth *that which is* not his! how long? and to him that ladeth himself with thick clay!

Habakkuk 2:6 (NKJV) Will not all these take up a proverb against him, And a taunting riddle against him, and say, Woe to him who increases *what is* not his — how long? And to him who loads himself with many pledges?

Isaiah 1:26 And I will restore thy judges as at the first, and thy counsellors as at the beginning: afterward thou shalt be called, The city of righteousness, the faithful city.

Proverbs 22:22,23 Rob not the poor, because he is poor: neither oppress the afflicted in the gate: 23 For the LORD will plead their cause, and spoil the soul of those that spoiled them.

Matthew 6:10 Thy kingdom come. Thy will be done in earth, as it is in heaven.

Habakkuk 2:7 (AV) Shall they not rise up suddenly that shall bite thee, and awake that shall vex thee, and thou shalt be for booties unto them?

Habakkuk 2:7 (NKJV) Will not your creditors rise up suddenly? Will they not awaken who oppress you? And you will become their booty.

Referred to Nebuchadnezzar afflicting Judah 3 times & finally destroying Jerusalem.

Leviticus 26 Referred to God dealing with a rebellious Israel.

Referred to the Judges of Israelites turning from God & being judged, then repenting & God freeing them, etc. getting worse each time.

Habakkuk 2:8 (AV) Because thou hast spoiled many nations, all the remnant of the people shall spoil thee; because of men's blood, and *for* the violence of the land, of the city, and of all that dwell therein.

Habakkuk 2:8 (NKJV) Because you have plundered many nations, All the remnant of the people shall plunder you, Because of men's blood And the violence of the land *and* the city, And of all who dwell in it.

Numbers 35:33 So ye shall not pollute the land wherein ye are: for blood it defileth the land: and the land cannot be cleansed of the blood that is shed therein, but by the blood of him that shed it.

Habakkuk 2:9 (AV) Woe to him that coveteth an evil covetousness to his house, that he may set his nest on high, that he may be delivered from the

power of evil!

Habakkuk 2:9 (NKJV) Woe to him who covets evil gain for his house, That he may set his nest on high, That he may be delivered from the power of disaster!

Exodus 20:17 Thou shalt not covet thy neighbour's house, thou shalt not covet thy neighbour's wife, nor his manservant, nor his maidservant, nor his ox, nor his ass, nor any thing that is thy neighbour's.

1 Timothy 6:10 For the love of money is the root of all evil: which while some coveted after, they have erred from the faith, and pierced themselves through with many sorrows.

Isaiah 14:14 I will ascend above the heights of the clouds; I will be like the most High.

Genesis 6 Summarized of the tower of Babel.

Habakkuk 2:10 (AV) Thou hast consulted shame to thy house by cutting off many people, and hast sinned *against* thy soul.

Habakkuk 2:10 (NKJV) You give shameful counsel to your house, Cutting off many peoples, And sin *against* your soul.

Mark 5 Summarized of the Gadarene Demoniac who ran to Jesus & was set free.

Luke 8:35,38 Then they went out to see what was done; and came to Jesus, and found the man, out of whom the devils were departed, sitting at the feet of Jesus, clothed, and in his right mind: and they were afraid. 38 Now the man out of whom the devils were departed besought him that he might be with him: but Jesus sent him away, saying,

Mark 10:52 And Jesus said unto him (Blind Bartimaeus), Go thy way; thy faith hath made thee whole. And immediately he received his sight, and followed Jesus in the way.

Exodus 7-9 God said to Pharaoh "Let My people go, that they may serve Me"

1 Kings 18:37 Hear me, O LORD, hear me, that this people may know that Thou art the LORD God, and that Thou hast turned their heart back again.

Psalms 51:4 Against thee, thee only, have I sinned, and done this evil in thy sight: that thou mightest be justified when thou speakest, and be clear when thou judgest.

Habakkuk 2:11 (AV) For the stone shall cry out of the wall, and the beam out of the timber shall answer it.

Habakkuk 2:11 (NKJV) For the stone will cry out from the wall, And the beam from the timbers will answer it.

Luke 19:40 And He answered and said unto them, I tell you that, if these should hold their peace, the stones would immediately cry out.

Ezekiel 8 Referred to God's knothole to see the evil.

Matthew 23 Referred to the 8 Woes of Jesus against the religious leaders.

Habakkuk 2:12 (AV) Woe to him that buildeth a town with blood, and

stablisheth a city by iniquity!

Habakkuk 2:12 (NKJV) Woe to him who builds a town with bloodshed, Who establishes a city by iniquity!

Habakkuk 2:13 (AV) Behold, *is it* not of the LORD of hosts that the people shall labour in the very fire, and the people shall weary themselves for very vanity?

Habakkuk 2:13 (NKJV) Behold, *is it* not of the LORD of hosts That the peoples labor to feed the fire, And nations weary themselves in vain?

Leviticus 26:26 And when I have broken the staff of your bread, ten women shall bake your bread in one oven, and they shall deliver you your bread again by weight: and ye shall eat, and not be satisfied.

2 Chronicles 7:13,14 If I shut up heaven that there be no rain, or if I command the locusts to devour the land, or if I send pestilence among My people; 14 If My people, which are called by My Name, shall humble themselves, and pray, and seek My face, and turn from their wicked ways; then will I hear from heaven, and will forgive their sin, and will heal their land.

Habakkuk 2:14 (AV) For the earth shall be filled with the knowledge of the glory of the LORD, as the waters cover the sea.

Habakkuk 2:14 (NKJV) For the earth will be filled With the knowledge of the glory of the LORD, As the waters cover the sea.

Revelation 13 Referred to taking of the mark of the beast. V8 And all that dwell upon the earth shall worship him, whose names are not written in the book of life of the Lamb slain from the foundation of the world.

Psalms 19:1 « To the chief Musician, A Psalm of David. » The heavens declare the glory of God; and the firmament sheweth his handywork.

Habakkuk 2:15 (AV) Woe unto him that giveth his neighbour drink, that puttest thy bottle to *him*, and makest *him* drunken also, that thou mayest look on their nakedness!

Habakkuk 2:15 (NKJV) Woe to him who gives drink to his neighbor, Pressing *him to* your bottle, Even to make *him* drunk, That you may look on his nakedness!

Leviticus 18 & 20 Referred to God's laws on immorality. (The Message clearly says "Don't have sex with ...)

Psalms 127:3,5 Lo, children are an heritage of the LORD: and the fruit of the womb is his reward. 5 Happy is the man that hath his quiver full of them: they shall not be ashamed, but they shall speak with the enemies in the gate.

Genesis 39:12 And she caught him by his garment, saying, Lie with me: and he left his garment in her hand, and fled, and got him out.

1 Corinthians 15:33 Do not be deceived: Evil company corrupts good habits.

Habakkuk 2:16 (AV) Thou art filled with shame for glory: drink thou also, and let thy foreskin be uncovered: the cup of the LORD'S right hand shall be

turned unto thee, and shameful spewing *shall be* on thy glory.

Habakkuk 2:16 (NKJV) You are filled with shame instead of glory. You also — drink! And be exposed as uncircumcised! The cup of the LORD'S right hand *will be* turned against you, And utter shame will be on your glory.

Habakkuk 2:17 (AV) For the violence of Lebanon shall cover thee, and the spoil of beasts, *which* made them afraid, because of men's blood, and for the violence of the land, of the city, and of all that dwell therein.

Habakkuk 2:17 (NKJV) For the violence *done to* Lebanon will cover you, And the plunder of beasts *which* made them afraid, Because of men's blood and the violence of the land *and* the city, And of all who dwell in it.

Habakkuk 2:18 (AV) What profiteth the graven image that the maker thereof hath graven it; the molten image, and a teacher of lies, that the maker of his work trusteth therein, to make dumb idols?

Habakkuk 2:18 (NKJV) What profit is the image, that its maker should carve it, The molded image, a teacher of lies, That the maker of its mold should trust in it, To make mute idols?

Isaiah 36 & 37 Referred to Sennacherib taunting Israel.

2 Chronicles 32:17 He wrote also letters to rail on the LORD God of Israel, and to speak against him, saying, As the gods of the nations of other lands have not delivered their people out of mine hand, so shall not the God of Hezekiah deliver his people out of mine hand.

Habakkuk 2:19 (AV) Woe unto him that saith to the wood, Awake; to the dumb stone, Arise, it shall teach! Behold, it *is* laid over with gold and silver, and *there is* no breath at all in the midst of it.

Habakkuk 2:19 (NKJV) Woe to him who says to wood, Awake! To silent stone, Arise! It shall teach! Behold, it is overlaid with gold and silver, Yet in it there is no breath at all.

Habakkuk 2:20 (AV) But the LORD *is* in his holy temple: let all the earth keep silence before him.

Habakkuk 2:20 (NKJV) But the LORD is in His holy temple. Let all the earth keep silence before Him.

Exodus 19 Summarized of Jesus' return & 1000 year rule.

2 Corinthians 6:2 (For He saith, I have heard thee in a time accepted, and in the day of salvation have I succoured thee: behold, now is the accepted time; behold, now is the day of salvation.)
