Daniel 9:2 In the first year of his reign I Daniel understood by books the number of the years, whereof the word of the LORD came to Jeremiah the prophet, that he would accomplish seventy years in the desolations of Jerusalem.

Romans 12:2 And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what is that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God.

Strong's #06290 Pa'ran *paw-rawn'* AV-Paran 11; Paran= "place of caverns" 1) wilderness area bounded on the north by Palestine, on the west by the wilderness of Etham, on the south by the desert of Sinai, and on the east by the valley of Arabah; the exodus was through this area and probably all 18 stops were in this area.

Exodus 13:21 And the LORD went before them by day in a pillar of a cloud, to lead them the way; and by night in a pillar of fire, to give them light; to go by day and night:

Habakkuk 3:4 (AV) And *His* brightness was as the light; He had horns *coming* out of His hand: and there *was* the hiding of His power.

Exodus 8:19 Then the magicians said unto Pharaoh, This is the finger of God: and Pharaoh's heart was hardened, and he hearkened not unto them; as the LORD had said.

Habakkuk 3:7 (AV) I saw the tents of Cushan in affliction: *and* the curtains of the land of Midian did tremble.

Habakkuk 3:7 (NKJV) I saw the tents of Cushan in affliction; The curtains of the land of Midian trembled.

Exodus - Summarized of attacks on Israelites & God's protection.

Habakkuk 3:8 (AV) Was the LORD displeased against the rivers? *was* thine anger against the rivers? *was* Thy wrath against the sea, that Thou didst ride upon thine horses *and* Thy chariots of salvation?

Habakkuk 3:12 (AV) Thou didst march through the land in indignation, Thou didst thresh the heathen in anger.

Habakkuk 3:12 (NKJV) You marched through the land in indignation; You trampled the nations in anger.

Exodus 12:22 And ye shall take a bunch of hyssop, and dip it in the blood that is in the bason, and strike the lintel and the two side posts with the blood that is in the bason; and none of you shall go out at the door of his house until the morning.

Exodus 12:12 For I will pass through the land of Egypt this night, and will smite all the firstborn in the land of Egypt, both man and beast; and against all the gods of Egypt I will execute judgment: I am the LORD.

Habakkuk 3:14 (AV) Thou didst strike through with his staves the head of his villages: they came out as a whirlwind to scatter me: their rejoicing *was* as to devour the poor secretly.

Habakkuk 3:14 (NKJV) You thrust through with his own arrows The head of his villages. They came out like a whirlwind to scatter me; Their rejoicing was like feasting on the poor in secret.

Luke 4:13 And when the devil had ended all the temptation, he departed from him for a season.

Habakkuk 3:15 (AV) Thou didst walk through the sea with thine horses, *through* the heap of great waters.

Habakkuk 3:15 (NKJV) You walked through the sea with Your horses, Through the heap of great waters.

Judges 4 Summarized of Sisera against Deborah & Barak.

Job 12:21 He poureth contempt upon princes, and weakeneth the strength of the mighty.

Job 3:25 For the thing which I greatly feared is come upon me, and that which I was afraid of is come unto me.

Habakkuk 3:16 (AV) When I heard, my belly trembled; my lips quivered at the voice: rottenness entered into my bones, and I trembled in myself, that I might rest in the day of trouble: when he cometh up unto the people, he will invade them with his troops.
