A Tale Of Two Brothers - 1 John 3B

Genesis 4 Referred to the first brothers Cain & Abel.

Luke 15 Summarized the parable of the Prodigal son & his older brother.

- 2 Corinthians 5:17 Therefore if any man be in Christ, he is a new creature: old things are passed away; behold, all things are become new.
- 1 John 5:18 We know that whosoever is born of God sinneth not; but he that is begotten of God keepeth himself, and that wicked one toucheth him not.
- Hebrews 6:6 If they shall fall away, to renew them again unto repentance; seeing they crucify to themselves the Son of God afresh, and put Him to an open shame. Luke 18 Referred to the parable of the Pharisee & the Publican.
- 1 John 1:9 If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.
- 1 John 1:7 But if we walk in the light, as he is in the light, we have fellowship one with another, and the blood of Jesus Christ his Son cleanseth us from all sin.

Numbers 13 Summarized of the report of the 10 Spies.

Numbers 14:1,2 And all the congregation lifted up their voice, and cried; and the people wept that night. 2 And all the children of Israel murmured against Moses and against Aaron: and the whole congregation said unto them, Would God that we had died in the land of Egypt! or would God we had died in this wilderness!

Exodus 32 Referred to Israel's sin of the golden calf & Moses intercession to God to forgive them.

- them, and said, Ye know not what manner of spirit ye are of. 56 For the Son of man is not come to destroy men's lives, but to save them. And they went to another village.
- Revelation 12:10 And I heard a loud voice saying in heaven, Now is come salvation, and strength, and the kingdom of our God, and the power of His Christ: for the accuser of our brethren is cast down, which accused them before our God day and night.
- Ezekiel 18:4 Behold, all souls are mine; as the soul of the father, so also the soul of the son is mine: the soul that sinneth, it shall die.
- **Exodus 20 Referred to many of the 10 Commandments.**
- 1 John 4:20 If a man say, I love God, and hateth his brother, he is a liar: for he that loveth not his brother whom he hath seen, how can he love God whom he hath not seen?
- 1 Peter 1:16 Because it is written, Be ye Holy; for I am Holy.
- Matthew 5:48 Be ye therefore perfect, even as your Father which is in heaven is perfect.
- Isaiah 35:8 And an highway shall be there, and a way, and it shall be called The way of Holiness; the unclean shall not pass over it; but it shall be for those: the wayfaring men, though fools, shall not err therein.
- Exodus 12:22 And ye shall take a bunch of hyssop, and dip it in the blood that is in the bason, and strike the lintel and the two side posts with the blood that is in the bason; and none of you shall go out at the door of his house until the morning.

- John 19:30 When Jesus therefore had received the vinegar, he said, It is finished: and he bowed his head, and gave up the ghost.
- Mark 9 Summarized of the transfiguration of Jesus.

- Exodus 31 Referred to when Jesus was on the mount inside the thick darkness.
- John 18:38 Pilate saith unto him, What is truth? And when he had said this, he went out again unto the Jews, and saith unto them, I find in him no fault at all.
- John 19:19 And Pilate wrote a title, and put it on the cross. And the writing was, JESUS OF NAZARETH THE KING OF THE JEWS.
- Mark 15:39 And when the centurion, which stood over against Him, saw that He so cried out, and gave up the ghost, he said, Truly this Man was the Son of God.
- Matthew 15:8 This people draweth nigh unto Me with their mouth, and honoureth Me with their lips; but their heart is far from Me.

- Genesis 39 Summarized of Joseph falsely accused. V12 And she caught him by his garment, saying, Lie with me: and he left his garment in her hand, and fled, and got him out.
- Matthew 14:29 And He said, Come. And when Peter was come down out of the ship, he walked on the water, to go to Jesus. 30 But when he saw the wind boisterous, he was afraid; and beginning to sink, he cried, saying, Lord, save me.
- 1 John 3:6 (AV) Whosoever abideth in Him sinneth not: whosoever sinneth hath not seen Him, neither known Him.
- 1 John 3:6 (NKJV) Whoever abides in Him does not sin. Whoever sins has neither seen Him nor known Him.
- Luke 4:13 And when the devil had ended all the temptation, he departed from him for a season.
- John 8 Summarized of Jesus' reaction to the woman caught in adultery. Mark 5 Referred to the Gadarene Demoniac ran to Jesus for help.
- 2 Chronicles 13:14 Howbeit, because by this deed thou hast given great occasion to the enemies of the LORD to blaspheme, the child also that is born unto thee shall surely die.
- John 10:10 The thief cometh not, but for to steal, and to kill, and to destroy: I am come that they might have life, and that they might have it more abundantly.

- Psalms 23:3A He restoreth my soul.
- Daniel 4 Summarized of Nebuchadnezzar's knowing of God but not accepting Him as his God.
- 1 John 3:7 (AV) Little children, let no man deceive you: he that doeth righteousness is righteous, even as He is righteous.
- 1 John 3:7 (NKJV) Little children, let no one deceive you. He who practices righteousness is righteous, just as He is righteous.
- Matthew 24:4 And Jesus answered and said unto them, Take heed that no man deceive you.
- James 1:5 If any of you lack wisdom, let him ask of God, that giveth to all men liberally, and upbraideth not; and it shall be given him.
- John 14:15 If ye love Me, keep My commandments.
- Romans 12:2 And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what is that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God.
- 1 John 3:8 (AV) He that committeth sin is of the devil; for the devil sinneth from the beginning. For this purpose the Son of God was manifested, that He might destroy the works of the devil.
- 1 John 3:8 (NKJV) He who sins is of the devil, for the devil has sinned from the beginning. For this purpose the Son of God was manifested, that He might destroy the works of the devil.
- John 16:8 And when he is come, he will reprove the world of sin, and of righteousness, and of judgment:
- Matthew 24:38 For as in the days that were before the flood they were eating and drinking, marrying and giving in marriage, until the day that Noe entered into the ark,
- 2 Corinthians 11:4 For if he that cometh preacheth another Jesus, whom we have not preached, or if ye receive another spirit, which ye have not received, or another gospel, which ye have not accepted, ye might well bear with him.
- Matthew 7:21 Not every one that saith unto me, Lord, Lord, shall enter into the kingdom of heaven; but he that doeth the will of my Father which is in heaven.
- Acts 8:21 Thou (Simon Magus) hast neither part nor lot in this matter: for thy heart is not right in the sight of God.

- 1 John 3:9 (NKJV) Whoever has been born of God does not sin, for His seed remains in him; and he cannot sin, because he has been born of God.
- Ephesians 1:13 In whom ye also trusted, after that ye heard the word of truth, the gospel of your salvation: in whom also after that ye believed, ye were sealed with that Holy Spirit of promise,
- Summarized of people that Jesus healed who followed Him.
- John 12:10 But the chief priests consulted that they might put Lazarus also to death;
- Matthew 11:28 Come unto me, all ye that labour and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest.
- 1 John 3:10 (AV) In this the children of God are manifest, and the children of the devil: whosoever doeth not righteousness is not of God, neither he that loveth not his brother.
- 1 John 3:10 (NKJV) In this the children of God and the children of the devil are manifest: Whoever does not practice righteousness is not of God, nor *is* he who does not love his brother.
- Genesis 4:7,8 If thou doest well, shalt thou not be accepted? and if thou doest not well, sin lieth at the door. And unto thee shall be his desire, and thou shalt rule over him. 8 And Cain talked with Abel his brother: and it came to pass, when they were in the field, that Cain rose up against Abel his brother, and slew him.
- 2 Corinthians 10:5 Casting down imaginations, and every high thing that exalteth itself against the knowledge of God, and bringing into captivity every thought to the obedience of Christ;
- John 13:34 A new commandment I give unto you, That ye love one another; as I have loved you, that ye also love one another.
