

Godly Sincere Prayer 2 - Daniel 9

Matthew 6 Referred to Jesus' mottle prayer.

John 17 Referred to Jesus' prayer.

Mark 11:17 And He taught, saying unto them, Is it not written, My house shall be called of all nations the house of prayer? but ye have made it a den of thieves.

Daniel 9:3 And I set my face unto the Lord God, to seek by prayer and supplications, with fasting, and sackcloth, and ashes:

Daniel 6:10 Now when Daniel knew that the writing was signed, he went into his house; and his windows being open in his chamber toward Jerusalem, he kneeled upon his knees three times a day, and prayed, and gave thanks before his God, as he did aforetime.

Matthew 10:37 He that loveth father or mother more than Me is not worthy of Me: and he that loveth son or daughter more than Me is not worthy of Me.

Daniel 3 Referred to Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego not compromising.

Ezra 8:22 For I was ashamed to require of the king a band of soldiers and horsemen to help us against the enemy in the way: because we had spoken unto the king, saying, The hand of our God is upon all them for good that seek Him; but His power and His wrath is against all them that forsake Him.

2 Samuel 12:14 Howbeit, because by this deed thou hast given great occasion to the enemies of the LORD to blaspheme, the child also that is born unto thee shall surely die.

Daniel 9:4-27 (AV) & (NKJV)

Daniel 9:4 (AV) And I prayed unto the LORD my God, and made my confession, and said, O Lord, the great and dreadful God, keeping the covenant and mercy to them that love Him, and to them that keep His commandments;

Daniel 9:4 (NKJV) And I prayed to the LORD my God, and made confession, and said, O Lord, great and awesome God, who keeps His covenant and mercy with those who love Him, and with those who keep His commandments,

Genesis 6:8 But Noah found grace in the eyes of the LORD.

John 14:15 If ye love Me, keep My commandments.

James 1:25 But whoso looketh into the perfect law of liberty, and continueth therein, he being not a forgetful hearer, but a doer of the work, this man shall be blessed in his deed.

Daniel 9:5 (AV) We have sinned, and have committed iniquity, and have done wickedly, and have rebelled, even by departing from Thy precepts and from Thy judgments:

Daniel 9:5 (NKJV) we have sinned and committed iniquity, we have done wickedly and rebelled, even by departing from Your precepts and Your judgments.

Luke 10:27 And He answering said, Thou shalt love the Lord thy God with all thy heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy strength, and with all thy mind; and thy neighbour as thyself.

Exodus 32 Referred to Moses interceding for sinful Israel.

Summarized of the prophets in this time period.

Psalms 109:14 Let the iniquity of his fathers be remembered with the LORD; and let not the sin of his mother be blotted out.

Summarized of the areas of sin that should be confessed.

Acts 15:20 But that we write unto them, that they abstain from pollutions of idols, and from fornication, and from things strangled, and from blood.

Leviticus 18 & 20 Referred to God's laws on immorality.

1 John 1:9 If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

2 Chronicles 7:13,14 If I shut up heaven that there be no rain, or if I command the locusts to devour the land, or if I send pestilence among My people; 14 If My people, which are called by My Name, shall humble themselves, and pray, and seek My face, and turn from their wicked ways; then will I hear from heaven, and will forgive their sin, and will heal their land.

Exodus 8:15 But when Pharaoh saw that there was respite, he hardened his heart, and hearkened not unto them; as the LORD had said.

Deuteronomy 27 & 28 Referred to Moses having the blessings & curses proclaimed from the mountain tops.

John 4:5 Then cometh He to a city of Samaria, which is called Sychar, near to the parcel of ground that Jacob gave to his son Joseph.

Matthew 27:25 Then answered all the people, and said, His blood be on us, and on our children.

Matthew 7:13,14 Enter ye in at the strait gate: for wide is the gate, and broad is the way, that leadeth to destruction, and many there be which

go in thereat: 14 Because strait is the gate, and narrow is the way, which leadeth unto life, and few there be that find it.

1 Corinthians 11:29,30 For he that eateth and drinketh unworthily, eateth and drinketh damnation to himself, not discerning the Lord's body. 30 For this cause many are weak and sickly among you, and many sleep.

Numbers 3:4 And Nadab and Abihu died before the LORD, when they offered strange fire before the LORD, in the wilderness of Sinai, and they had no children: and Eleazar and Ithamar ministered in the priest's office in the sight of Aaron their father.

Luke 23 Referred to Peter when he lied & denied Jesus.

Daniel 9:6 (AV) Neither have we hearkened unto Thy servants the prophets, which spake in Thy Name to our kings, our princes, and our fathers, and to all the people of the land.

Daniel 9:6 (NKJV) Neither have we heeded Your servants the prophets, who spoke in Your Name to our kings and our princes, to our fathers and all the people of the land.

Acts 8:21 Thou hast neither part nor lot in this matter: for thy heart is not right in the sight of God.

Referred to many prophets warning Israel & God's deliverances or

judgments.

Jeremiah 23 & Ezekiel 34 Referred to God warning of the false prophets.

Ezekiel 33 Referred to the responsibility of the watchman.

Ezekiel 22:30 And I sought for a man among them, that should make up the hedge, and stand in the gap before Me for the land, that I should not destroy it: but I found none.

Summarized of some incidents where prayer intercession changed the outcome of World War 2.

Daniel 9:7 (AV) O Lord, righteousness *belongeth* unto Thee, but unto us confusion of faces, as at this day; to the men of Judah, and to the inhabitants of Jerusalem, and unto all Israel, *that are* near, and *that are* far off, through all the countries whither Thou hast driven them, because of their trespass that they have trespassed against Thee.

Daniel 9:7 (NKJV) O Lord, righteousness *belongs* to You, but to us shame of face, as *it is* this day, to the men of Judah, to the inhabitants of Jerusalem and all Israel, those near and those far off in all the countries to which You have driven them, because of the unfaithfulness which they have committed against You.

Leviticus 26 Referred to God increasing punishment on rebellious Israel.

Luke 18:8 I tell you that He will avenge them speedily. Nevertheless when the Son of man cometh, shall He find faith on the earth?

Daniel 9:8 (AV) O Lord, to us *belongeth* confusion of face, to our kings, to our princes, and to our fathers, because we have sinned against Thee.

Daniel 9:8 (NKJV) O Lord, to us *belongs* shame of face, to our kings, our princes, and our fathers, because we have sinned against You.

John 14:6 Jesus saith unto him, I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by Me.

Jeremiah 39 Summarized of King Zedekiah trying to flee & his capture.

Exodus 7-9 God challenged Pharaoh "Let My people go, that they may serve Me."

John 16:8 And when He is come, He will reprove the world of sin, and of righteousness, and of judgment:

Jonah 2:9 But I will sacrifice unto thee with the voice of thanksgiving; I will pay that that I have vowed. Salvation is of the LORD.

1 John 1:9 If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our
sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.
Matthew 6:12,14,15 And forgive us our debts, as we forgive our debtors. 14
For if ye forgive men their trespasses, your heavenly Father will also
forgive you: 15 But if ye forgive not men their trespasses, neither will
your Father forgive your trespasses.
Ephesians 4:26 Be ye angry, and sin not: let not the sun go down upon your
wrath:
Genesis 6:5 And GOD saw that the wickedness of man was great in the
earth, and that every imagination of the thoughts of his heart was only
evil continually.
Genesis 7:1 And the LORD said unto Noah, Come thou and all thy house
into the ark; for thee have I seen righteous before Me in this generation.
Genesis 9:13-15 I do set My bow in the cloud, and it shall be for a token of a

house of God; and if *it begins* with us first, what will *be* the end of those
who do not obey the gospel of God?
