

Godly Sincere Prayer 3 - Daniel 9

Hebrews 11 Referred to God's Hall of Faith list.

Luke 18 Referred to the persistent widow. V1 And He spake a parable unto them to this end, that men ought always to pray, and not to faint;

Daniel 9:9-14 (AV) & (NKJV)

Daniel 9:9 (AV) To the Lord our God *belong* mercies and forgivenesses, though we have rebelled against Him;

Daniel 9:9 (NKJV) To the Lord our God *belong* mercy and forgiveness, though we have rebelled against Him.

Ezra 9:13 And after all that is come upon us for our evil deeds, and for our great trespass, seeing that Thou our God hast punished us less than our iniquities deserve, and hast given us such deliverance as this;

Ezekiel 18:4 Behold, all souls are Mine; as the soul of the father, so also the soul of the son is Mine: the soul that sinneth, it shall die.

Ezekiel 5 Referred to Ezekiel's interceding for Israel. V5,6 Thus saith the Lord GOD; This is Jerusalem: I have set it in the midst of the nations and countries that are round about her. 6 And she hath changed My judgments into wickedness more than the nations, and My statutes more than the countries that are round about her: for they have refused My judgments and My statutes, they have not walked in them.

Jeremiah 44 Summarized God's answer to Israel through Jeremiah.

Daniel 9:10 (AV) Neither have we obeyed the voice of the LORD our God, to walk in His laws, which He set before us by His servants the prophets.

2 Timothy 4:3 For the time will come when they will not endure sound doctrine; but after their own lusts shall they heap to themselves teachers, having itching ears;

Exodus 32 Referred to the sin of the golden calf.

Acts 15:20 But that we write unto them, that they abstain from pollutions of idols, and from fornication, and from things strangled, and from blood.

Isaiah 30:21 And thine ears shall hear a word behind thee, saying, This is the way, walk ye in it, when ye turn to the right hand, and when ye turn to the left.

Daniel 9:11 (AV) Yea, all Israel have transgressed Thy law, even by departing, that they might not obey Thy voice; therefore the curse is poured upon us, and the oath that *is* written in the Law of Moses the servant of God,

because we have sinned against Him.

Daniel 9:11 (NKJV) Yes, all Israel has transgressed Your law, and has departed so as not to obey Your voice; therefore the curse and the oath written in the Law of Moses the servant of God have been poured out on us, because we have sinned against Him.

2 Kings 16:11 And Urijah the priest built an altar according to all that king Ahaz had sent from Damascus: so Urijah the priest made it against king Ahaz came from Damascus.

Romans 12:2 And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what is that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God.

Ephesians 6:4 And, ye fathers, provoke not your children to wrath: but bring them up in the nurture and admonition of the Lord.

Deuteronomy 27 & 28 Referred to God's Blessings & Curses.

Exodus 20 Referred to the 10 Commandments.

Galatians 3:13 Christ hath redeemed us from the curse of the law, being made a curse for us: for it is written, Cursed is every one that hangeth on a tree:

Daniel 9:8 O Lord, to us *belongeth* confusion of face, to our kings, to our princes, and to our fathers, because we have sinned against Thee.

John 3:16 For God so loved the world, that He gave His only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in Him should not perish, but have everlasting life.

Exodus 20:5,6 Thou shalt not bow down thyself to them, nor serve them: for I the LORD thy God am a jealous God, visiting the iniquity of the fathers upon the children unto the third and fourth generation of them that hate Me; 6 And shewing mercy unto thousands of them that love Me, and keep My commandments.

Numbers 14:2 And all the children of Israel murmured against Moses and against Aaron: and the whole congregation said unto them, Would God that we had died in the land of Egypt! or would God we had died in this wilderness!

Psalms 78:8 And might not be as their fathers, a stubborn and rebellious generation; a generation *that* set not their heart aright, and whose spirit was not stedfast with God.

2 Kings 17:13 Yet the LORD testified against Israel, and against Judah, by all the prophets, and by all the seers, saying, Turn ye from your evil ways, and keep My commandments and My statutes, according to all the law which I commanded your fathers, and which I sent to you by My servants the prophets.

2 Chronicles 24:19 Yet He sent prophets to them, to bring them again unto the LORD; and they testified against them: but they would not give ear.

Zechariah 7:12 Yea, they made their hearts as an adamant stone, lest they should hear the law, and the words which the LORD of hosts hath sent in his spirit by the former prophets: therefore came a great wrath from the LORD of hosts.

Nehemiah 9:30 Yet many years didst Thou forbear them, and testifiedst against them by Thy Spirit in Thy prophets: yet would they not give ear: therefore gavest Thou them into the hand of the people of the lands.

Referred to the Judges of Israelites turning from God & being judged, then repenting & God freeing them, etc.

1 Samuel Summarized of the sins of the leaders & priests.

1 Samuel 8:7 And the LORD said unto Samuel, Hearken unto the voice of the people in all that they say unto thee: for they have not rejected thee, but they have rejected Me, that I should not reign over them.

Amos 8:11 Behold, the days come, saith the Lord GOD, that I will send a famine in the land, not a famine of bread, nor a thirst for water, but of hearing the Words of the LORD:

Mark 5 Referred to the Gadarene Demoniac set free by Jesus.

Daniel 9:14 (AV) Therefore hath the LORD watched upon the evil, and brought it upon us: for the LORD our God *is* righteous in all His works which He doeth: for we obeyed not His voice.

Daniel 9:14 (NKJV) Therefore the LORD has kept the disaster in mind, and brought it upon us; for the LORD our God *is* righteous in all the works which He does, though we have not obeyed His voice.

Job 1&2 Referred to the disasters on Job from the devil with God's permission to test Job.

Galatians 6:7 Be not deceived; God is not mocked: for whatsoever a man soweth, that shall he also reap.

Acts 5 Referred to Ananias & Sapphira's sin judged. V11 And great fear came upon all the church, and upon as many as heard these things.

1 Peter 4:17 For the time *is come* that judgment must begin at the house of God: and if *it first begin* at us, what shall the end *be* of them that obey not the gospel of God?

Hebrews 5:14 But strong meat belongeth to them that are of full age, even those who by reason of use have their senses exercised to discern both good and evil.

Jeremiah 23:3 And I will gather the remnant of My flock out of all countries whither I have driven them, and will bring them again to their folds; and they shall be fruitful and increase.
