- 1 John 3:12 (NKJV) not as Cain *who* was of the wicked one and murdered his brother. And why did he murder him? Because his works were evil and his brother's righteous.
- John 13:34 (AV) A new commandment I give unto you, That ye love one another; as I have loved you, that ye also love one another.
- John 13:34 (NKJV) A new commandment I give to you, that you love one another; as I have loved you, that you also love one another.
- Mark 16:15 And He said unto them, Go ye into all the world, and preach the gospel to every creature.
- Galatians 3:28 There is neither Jew nor Greek, there is neither bond nor free, there is neither male nor female: for ye are all one in Christ Jesus.
- 1 Corinthians 11:3 But I would have you know, that the head of every man is Christ; and the head of the woman is the man; and the head of Christ is God.

- Genesis 4:6 (AV) And the LORD said unto Cain, Why art thou wroth? and why is thy countenance fallen?
- Genesis 4:6 (NKJV) So the LORD said to Cain, Why are you angry? And why has your countenance fallen?
- Genesis 4:7 (AV) If thou doest well, shalt thou not be accepted? and if thou doest not well, sin lieth at the door. And unto thee *shall be* his desire, and thou shalt rule over him.
- Genesis 4:7 (NKJV) If you do well, will you not be accepted? And if you do not do well, <u>sin lies at the door</u>. And its desire *is* for you, but <u>you should</u> rule over it.
- Malachi 1:8 And if ye offer the blind for sacrifice, is it not evil? and if ye offer the lame and sick, is it not evil? offer it now unto thy governor; will he be pleased with thee, or accept thy person? saith the LORD of hosts.
- James 1:25 But whoso looketh into the perfect law of liberty, and continueth therein, he being not a forgetful hearer, but a doer of the work, this man shall be blessed in his deed.
- 1 John 2:1 My little children, these things write I unto you, that ye sin not. And if any man sin, we have an Advocate with the Father, Jesus Christ the righteous:
