- Psalms 80:3 Turn us again, O <u>God</u>, and cause Thy <u>face</u> to <u>shine</u>; and we shall be saved.
- Psalms 80:7 Turn us again, O <u>God</u> of hosts, and cause Thy <u>face</u> to <u>shine</u>; and we shall be saved.
- Psalms 80:19 Turn us again, O <u>LORD</u> <u>God</u> of hosts, cause Thy <u>face</u> to <u>shine</u>; and we shall be saved.
- Daniel 9:17 Now therefore, O our <u>God</u>, hear the prayer of Thy servant, and his supplications, and cause Thy <u>face</u> to <u>shine</u> upon Thy sanctuary that is desolate, for the Lord's sake.

- Daniel 9:18 (NKJV) O my God, incline Your ear and hear; open Your eyes and see our desolations, and the city which is called by Your name; for we do not present our supplications before You because of our righteous deeds, but because of Your great mercies.
- Luke 23:34 Then said Jesus, Father, forgive them; for they know not what they do. And they parted his raiment, and cast lots.

- Matthew 15:32 Then Jesus called His disciples *unto Him*, and said, I have compassion on the multitude, because they continue with Me now three days, and have nothing to eat: and I will not send them away fasting, lest they faint in the way.

- Acts 2:5 And there were dwelling at Jerusalem Jews, devout men, out of every nation under heaven.

- Referred to Ezra rebuilding the temple & Nehemiah rebuilding the walls of Jerusalem.
- Daniel 9:26 (AV) And after threescore and two weeks shall Messiah be cut off, but not for Himself: and the people of the prince that shall come shall

- destroy the city and the sanctuary; and the end thereof *shall be* with a flood, and unto the end of the war desolations are determined.
- Daniel 9:26 (NKJV) And after the sixty-two weeks Messiah shall be cut off, but not for Himself; And the people of the prince who is to come Shall destroy the city and the sanctuary. The end of it *shall be* with a flood, And till the end of the war desolations are determined.
- Daniel 9:27 (AV) And he shall confirm the covenant with many for one week: and in the midst of the week he shall cause the sacrifice and the oblation to cease, and for the overspreading of abominations he shall make *it* desolate, even until the consummation, and that determined shall be poured upon the desolate.
- Daniel 9:27 (NKJV) Then he shall confirm a covenant with many for one week; But in the middle of the week He shall bring an end to sacrifice and offering. And on the wing of abominations shall be one who makes desolate, Even until the consummation, which is determined, Is poured out on the desolate.
- Revelation Summarized of the tribulation then Jesus' return & 1000 year rule.

More Service Notes:

- Numbers 30:5 But if her father disallow her in the day that he <u>heareth</u>; not any of her vows, or of her bonds wherewith she hath bound her soul, shall stand: and the <u>LORD</u> shall <u>forgive</u> her, because her father disallowed her.
- Numbers 30:8 But if her husband disallowed her on the day that he <u>heard</u> *it*; then he shall make her vow which she vowed, and that which she uttered with her lips, wherewith she bound her soul, of none effect: and the <u>LORD</u> shall forgive her.
- Numbers 30:12 But if her husband hath utterly made them void on the day he <u>heard</u> them; then whatsoever proceeded out of her lips concerning her vows, or concerning the bond of her soul, shall not stand: her husband hath made them void; and the <u>LORD</u> shall <u>forgive</u> her.
