## **Godly Sincere Prayer 6 - Nehemiah 9**

- 1 Timothy 2:5 For there is one God, and one Mediator between God and men, the Man Christ Jesus;
- John 14:6 Jesus saith unto him, I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by Me.
- Nehemiah 9:1-3 Now in the twenty and fourth day of this month the children of Israel were assembled with fasting, and with sackclothes, and earth upon them. 2 And the seed of Israel separated themselves from all strangers, and stood and confessed their sins, and the iniquities of their fathers. 3 And they stood up in their place, and read in the Book of the Law of the LORD their God one fourth part of the day; and another fourth part they confessed, and worshipped the LORD their God.

Nehemiah 9:16-24 (AV) & (NKJV)

- Nehemiah 9:16 (AV) But they and our fathers dealt proudly, and hardened their necks, and hearkened not to Thy commandments,
- Nehemiah 9:16 (NKJV) But they and our fathers acted proudly, Hardened their necks, And did not heed Your commandments.
- Luke 11:24-26 When the unclean spirit is gone out of a man, he walketh through dry places, seeking rest; and finding none, he saith, I will return unto my house whence I came out.25 And when he cometh, he findeth it swept and garnished.26 Then goeth he, and taketh to him seven other spirits more wicked than himself; and they enter in, and dwell there: and the last state of that man is worse than the first.
- Matthew 18:18 Verily I say unto you, Whatsoever ye shall bind on earth shall be bound in heaven: and whatsoever ye shall loose on earth shall be loosed in heaven.
- Luke 24:45 Then opened He their understanding, that they might understand the scriptures,
- Nehemiah 9:17 (AV) And refused to obey, neither were mindful of Thy wonders that Thou didst among them; but hardened their necks, and in their rebellion appointed a captain to return to their bondage: but Thou art a God ready to pardon, gracious and merciful, slow to anger, and of great kindness, and forsookest them not.
- Nehemiah 9:17 (NKJV) They refused to obey, And they were not mindful of Your wonders That You did among them. But they hardened their necks, And in their rebellion they appointed a leader to return to their bondage. But You *are* God, Ready to pardon, Gracious and merciful, Slow to anger,

- Abundant in kindness, And did not forsake them.
- Exodus 32 Referred to Israel's golden calf sin.
- Deuteronomy 18:9-14 When thou art come into the land which the LORD thy God giveth thee, thou shalt not learn to do after the abominations of those nations. ...
- Romans 12:2 And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what is that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God.
- Joshua 24:15 And if it seem evil unto you to serve the LORD, choose you this day whom ye will serve; whether the gods which your fathers served that were on the other side of the flood, or the gods of the Amorites, in whose land ye dwell: but as for me and my house, we will serve the LORD.
- **Exodus Summarized of many miracles God did for Israel in the wilderness.**
- Romans 1:21 Because that, when they knew God, they glorified Him not as God, neither were thankful; but became vain in their imaginations, and their foolish heart was darkened.
- Genesis 2:17 But of the tree of the knowledge of good and evil, thou shalt not eat of it: for in the day that thou eatest thereof thou shalt surely die.
- Exodus 14:13 And Moses said unto the people, Fear ye not, stand still, and see the salvation of the LORD, which he will shew to you to day: for the Egyptians whom ye have seen to day,
- Numbers 11:4 And the mixt multitude that was among them fell a lusting: and the children of Israel also wept again, and said, Who shall give us flesh to eat?
- Matthew 16:19 And I will give unto thee the keys of the kingdom of heaven: and whatsoever thou shalt bind on earth shall be bound in heaven: and whatsoever thou shalt loose on earth shall be loosed in heaven.
- 2 Corinthians 10:4 (For the weapons of our warfare are not carnal, but mighty through God to the pulling down of strong holds;)
- Ephesians 6:12 For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high places.
- Matthew 7:14 Because strait is the gate, and narrow is the way, which leadeth unto life, and few there be that find it.
- Judges Referred to the Judges of Israelites turning from God & being judged, then repenting & God freeing them, etc.
- Mark 1:1 The beginning of the gospel of Jesus Christ, the Son of God;
- 1 John 4:15 Whosoever shall confess that Jesus is the Son of God, God dwelleth in him, and he in God.
- 1 John 1:9 If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins,

- and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.
- Matthew 6:14,15 For if ye forgive men their trespasses, your heavenly Father will also forgive you: 15 But if ye forgive not men their trespasses, neither will your Father forgive your trespasses.
- Ephesians 2:8,9 For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: it is the gift of God: 9 Not of works, lest any man should boast.
- Psalms 103:8 The LORD is merciful and gracious, slow to anger, and plenteous in mercy.
- John 2:17 And his disciples remembered that it was written, The zeal of thine house hath eaten me up.
- Luke 19:45,46 And he went into the temple, and began to cast out them that sold therein, and them that bought; 46 Saying unto them, It is written, My house is the house of prayer: but ye have made it a den of thieves.
- Luke 22:31,32 And the Lord said, Simon, Simon, behold, Satan hath desired to have you, that he may sift you as wheat: 32 But I have prayed for thee, that thy faith fail not: and when thou art converted, strengthen thy brethren.
- Nehemiah 9:18 (AV) Yea, when they had made them a molten calf, and said, This *is* thy God that brought thee up out of Egypt, and had wrought great provocations;
- Nehemiah 9:18 (NKJV) Even when they made a molded calf for themselves, And said, This *is* your god That brought you up out of Egypt, And worked great provocations,
- Exodus 34:14 For thou shalt worship no other god: for the LORD, whose name is Jealous, is a jealous God:
- 1 Corinthians 6:19,20 What? know ye not that your body is the temple of the Holy Ghost which is in you, which ye have of God, and ye are not your own? 20 For ye are bought with a price: therefore glorify God in your body, and in your spirit, which are God's.
- Exodus 32,33 Summarized of Israel's sins & God's plan to judge them & Moses intercession.
- Nehemiah 9:19 (AV) Yet Thou in Thy manifold mercies forsookest them not in the wilderness: the pillar of the cloud departed not from them by day, to lead them in the way; neither the pillar of fire by night, to shew them light, and the way wherein they should go.
- Nehemiah 9:19 (NKJV) Yet in Your manifold mercies You did not forsake them in the wilderness. The pillar of the cloud did not depart from them by day, To lead them on the road; Nor the pillar of fire by night, To show them light, And the way they should go.
- Psalms 136 Every second line is " for His mercy endureth for ever."

- Luke 23:34 Then said Jesus, Father, forgive them; for they know not what they do. And they parted his raiment, and cast lots.
- Acts 7:60 And he kneeled down, and cried with a loud voice, Lord, lay not this sin to their charge. And when he had said this, he fell asleep.
- Psalms 78 Referred to Israel testing God 10 times in the wilderness.
- Numbers 14:2 And all the children of Israel murmured against Moses and against Aaron: and the whole congregation said unto them, Would God that we had died in the land of Egypt! or would God we had died in this wilderness!
- Numbers 14:22,23 Because all those men which have seen My glory, and my miracles, which I did in Egypt and in the wilderness, and have tempted me now these ten times, and have not hearkened to my voice; 23 Surely they shall not see the land which I sware unto their fathers, neither shall any of them that provoked Me see it:
- Numbers 20 Summarized of Moses smiting the rock the second time.
- Deuteronomy 3:25,26 I pray thee, let me go over, and see the good land that is beyond Jordan, that goodly mountain, and Lebanon. 26 But the LORD was wroth with me for your sakes, and would not hear me: and the LORD said unto me, Let it suffice thee; speak no more unto me of this matter.
- Exodus 13:21 And the LORD went before them by day in a pillar of a cloud, to lead them the way; and by night in a pillar of fire, to give them light; to go by day and night:
- Exodus 12:22 And ye shall take a bunch of hyssop, and dip it in the blood that is in the bason, and strike the lintel and the two side posts with the blood that is in the bason; and none of you shall go out at the door of his house until the morning.
- Ezra Summarized of God protecting them returning to Jerusalem.
- Nehemiah Summarized of God protecting them in Jerusalem.
- John 8:12 Then spake Jesus again unto them, saying, I am the light of the world: he that followeth me shall not walk in darkness, but shall have the light of life.
- Acts 26:18 To open their eyes, and to turn them from darkness to light, and from the power of Satan unto God, that they may receive forgiveness of sins, and inheritance among them which are sanctified by faith that is in Me.
- Nehemiah 9:20 (AV) Thou gavest also Thy good Spirit to instruct them, and withheldest not Thy manna from their mouth, and gavest them water for their thirst.
- Nehemiah 9:20 (NKJV) You also gave Your good Spirit to instruct them, And did not withhold Your manna from their mouth, And gave them water for

their thirst.

- Matthew 16:19 And I will give unto thee the keys of the kingdom of heaven: and whatsoever thou shalt bind on earth shall be bound in heaven: and whatsoever thou shalt loose on earth shall be loosed in heaven.
- Ephesians 6:12 For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high places.
- Numbers 11:17 And I will come down and talk with thee there: and I will take of the Spirit which *is* upon thee, and will put *it* upon them; and they shall bear the burden of the people with thee, that thou bear *it* not thyself alone.
- Acts 2 Referred to the baptism of the Holy Spirit.
- Numbers 11:25 And the LORD came down in a cloud, and spake unto him, and took of the Spirit that *was* upon him, and gave *it* unto the seventy elders: and it came to pass, *that*, when the Spirit rested upon them, they prophesied, and did not cease.
- Acts 19:6 And when Paul had laid his hands upon them, the Holy Ghost came on them; and they spake with tongues, and prophesied.
- 1 Corinthians 14 Summarized of Paul's admonisions on prophesy vs tongues.
- 1 Corinthians 14:39 Wherefore, brethren, covet to prophesy, and forbid not to speak with tongues.
- 1 Corinthians 12 & Romans 12 Referred to the gifts of the Holy Spirit.
- John 6 Summarized of people wanting to make Jesus a king & His reply. John 6:48 I am that bread of life.
- Nehemiah 9:21 (AV) Yea, forty years didst Thou sustain them in the wilderness, so that they lacked nothing; their clothes waxed not old, and

- their feet swelled not.
- Nehemiah 9:21 (NKJV) Forty years You sustained them in the wilderness, They lacked nothing; Their clothes did not wear out And their feet did not swell.
- Nehemiah 9:22 (AV) Moreover Thou gavest them kingdoms and nations, and didst divide them into corners: so they possessed the land of Sihon, and the land of the king of Heshbon, and the land of Og king of Bashan.
- Nehemiah 9:22 (NKJV) Moreover You gave them kingdoms and nations, And divided them into districts. So they took possession of the land of Sihon, The land of the king of Heshbon, And the land of Og king of Bashan.
- Joshua Referred to the miracles as God gave Israelites victory & the land.
- Nehemiah 9:23 (AV) Their children also multipliedst thou as the stars of heaven, and broughtest them into the land, concerning which Thou hadst promised to their fathers, that they should go in to possess *it*.
- Nehemiah 9:23 (NKJV) You also multiplied their children as the stars of heaven, And brought them into the land which You had told their fathers To go in and possess.
- Exodus Summarized of Israel entering Egypt & when they all left.
- Nehemiah 9:24 (AV) So the children went in and possessed the land, and Thou subduedst before them the inhabitants of the land, the Canaanites, and gavest them into their hands, with their kings, and the people of the land, that they might do with them as they would.
- Nehemiah 9:24 (NKJV) So the people went in And possessed the land; You subdued before them the inhabitants of the land, The Canaanites, And gave them into their hands, With their kings And the people of the land, That they might do with them as they wished.
- Joshua Summarized of the Israelites entering the promised land & God giving them victory.
- Ezra 9:7 Since the days of our fathers have we been in a great trespass unto this day; and for our iniquities have we, our kings, and our priests, been delivered into the hand of the kings of the lands, to the sword, to captivity, and to a spoil, and to confusion of face, as it is this day.
- Matthew 6:10 Thy kingdom come. Thy will be done in earth, as it is in heaven.
