Godly Sincere Prayer 7 - Nehemiah 9

- Nehemiah 9:25-29 (AV) & (NKJV)
- Nehemiah 9:25 (AV) And they took strong cities, and a fat land, and possessed houses full of all goods, wells digged, vineyards, and oliveyards, and fruit trees in abundance: so they did eat, and were filled, and became fat, and delighted themselves in Thy great goodness.
- Nehemiah 9:25 (NKJV) And they took strong cities and a rich land, And possessed houses full of all goods, Cisterns *already* dug, vineyards, olive groves, And fruit trees in abundance. So they ate and were filled and grew fat, And delighted themselves in Your great goodness.
- Joshua 5:12 And the manna ceased on the morrow after they had eaten of the old corn of the land; neither had the children of Israel manna any more; but they did eat of the fruit of the land of Canaan that year.
- Summarized of Jesus feeding the thousands & the banquet table in Heaven.
- Romans 1:21 Because that, when they knew God, they glorified him not as God, neither were thankful; but became vain in their imaginations, and their foolish heart was darkened.
- Nehemiah 9:26 (AV) Nevertheless they were disobedient, & rebelled against Thee, and cast Thy law behind their backs, and slew Thy prophets which testified against them to turn them to Thee, and they wrought great provocations.

 Nehemiah 9:26 (NKJV) Nevertheless they were disobedient And rebelled against You, Cast Your law behind their backs And killed Your prophets, who testified against them To turn them to Yourself; And they worked great provocations.
- Luke 12:6 Are not five sparrows sold for two farthings, and not one of them is forgotten before God?
- Matthew 6:8 Be not ye therefore like unto them: for your Father knoweth what things ye have need of, before ye ask him.
- James 4:3 Ye ask, and receive not, because ye ask amiss, that ye may consume it upon your lusts.
- **Exodus 20 Referred to the 10 Commandments (not followed).**
- Malachi Referred to Malachi recounting Israel's sins.
- Ezekiel 20:38 And I will purge out from among you the rebels, and them that transgress against me: I will bring them forth out of the country where they sojourn, and they shall not enter into the land of Israel: and ye shall know that I am the LORD.
- 2 Timothy 4:3 For the time will come when they will not endure sound doctrine; but after their own lusts shall they heap to themselves teachers, having itching ears;
- Jeremiah 44 Summarized of Israelites pretending to ask of God but not following God's will.

- Jonah Referred to Jonah trying to run from God.
- Acts 15:20 But that we write unto them, that they abstain from pollutions of idols, and from fornication, and from things strangled, and from blood.
- Jeremiah 5:25 Your iniquities have turned away these things, and your sins have withholden good things from you.
- Nehemiah 9:27 (AV) Therefore Thou deliveredst them into the hand of their enemies, who vexed them: and in the time of their trouble, when they cried unto Thee, Thou heardest them from heaven; and according to Thy manifold mercies Thou gavest them saviours, who saved them out of the hand of their enemies.

 Nehemiah 9:27 (NKJV)

 Therefore You delivered them into the hand of their enemies, Who oppressed them; And in the time of their trouble, When they cried to You, You heard from heaven; And according to Your abundant mercies You gave them deliverers who saved them From the hand of their enemies.
- Luke 12:48 But he that knew not, and did commit things worthy of stripes, shall be beaten with few stripes. For unto whomsoever much is given, of him shall be much required: and to whom men have committed much, of him they will ask the more.
- Romans 12:2 And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what is that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God.
- 1 Corinthians 6:19,20 What? know ye not that your body is the temple of the Holy Ghost which is in you, which ye have of God, and ye are not your own? 20 For ye are bought with a price: therefore glorify God in your body, and in your spirit, which are God's.
- Leviticus 26 Referred to God's seven times worse judgement as Israel continued to sin.
- Referred to the Judges of Israelites turning from God & being judged, then repenting & God freeing them, etc.
- 2 Chronicles 7:14 If My people, which are called by My Name, shall humble themselves, & pray, & seek My face, & turn from their wicked ways; then will I hear from heaven, and will forgive their sin, and will heal their land.
- Ezra 9:13 And after all that is come upon us for our evil deeds, and for our great trespass, seeing that Thou our God hast punished us less than our iniquities deserve, and hast given us such deliverance as this;
- Nehemiah 9:28 (AV) But after they had rest, they did evil again before Thee: therefore leftest Thou them in the hand of their enemies, so that they had the dominion over them: yet when they returned, and cried unto Thee, Thou heardest *them* from heaven; and many times didst Thou deliver them according to Thy mercies;

 Nehemiah 9:28 (NKJV) But after they had rest, they again did evil before You. Therefore You left them in the hand of their enemies, So that they had dominion over them; Yet when

- they returned and cried out to You, You heard from heaven; And many times You delivered them according to Your mercies,
- Matthew 11:16 But whereunto shall I liken this generation? It is like unto children sitting in the markets, and calling unto their fellows,
- Psalms 35:12 They rewarded me evil for good to the spoiling of my soul.
- Judges 3:12 And the children of <u>Israel did evil again in the sight of the LORD</u>: and the LORD strengthened Eglon the king of Moab against Israel, because they had done evil in the sight of the LORD.
- Isaiah 35:8 And an highway shall be there, and a way, and it shall be called The Way of Holiness; the unclean shall not pass over it; but it shall be for those: the wayfaring men, though fools, shall not err therein.
- Genesis 3 Summarized of mankind's fall.
- Exodus 20:5 Thou shalt not bow down thyself to them, nor serve them: for I the LORD thy God am a jealous God, visiting the iniquity of the fathers upon the children unto the third and fourth generation of them that hate e;
- Judges 10:6 And the children of <u>Israel did evil again in the sight of the LORD</u>, and served Baalim, and Ashtaroth, and the gods of Syria, and the gods of Zidon, and the gods of Moab, and the gods of the children of Ammon, and the gods of the Philistines, and forsook the LORD, and served not Him.
- Exodus 34:13 But ye shall destroy their altars, break their images, and cut down their groves:
- 1 Samuel 5 Summarized of when the Philistines captured the Ark of God.
- Judges 13:1 And the children of <u>Israel did evil again in the sight of the LORD</u>; and the LORD delivered them into the hand of the Philistines forty years.
- Numbers 14:2 And all the children of Israel murmured against Moses and against Aaron: and the whole congregation said unto them, Would God that we had died in the land of Egypt! or would God we had died in this wilderness!
- Numbers 14:29,30 Your carcases shall fall in this wilderness; and all that were numbered of you, according to your whole number, from twenty years old and upward, which have murmured against Me, 30 Doubtless ye shall not come into the land, concerning which I sware to make you dwell therein, save Caleb the son of Jephunneh, and Joshua the son of Nun.
- Nehemiah 9:28 But after they had rest, they did evil again before Thee: therefore leftest Thou them in the hand of their enemies, so that they had the dominion over them: yet when they returned, and cried unto Thee, Thou heardest them from heaven; and many times didst Thou deliver them according to Thy mercies;
- 2 Chronicles 7:14 If My people, which are called by My Name, shall humble themselves, & pray, & seek My face, & turn from their wicked ways; then will I hear from heaven, and will forgive their sin, and will heal their land. Summarized of Salvation by Jesus.

- Romans 6:1,2 What shall we say then? Shall we continue in sin, that grace may abound? 2 God forbid. How shall we, that are dead to sin, live any longer therein?
- Matthew 18:21,22 Then came Peter to him, and said, Lord, how oft shall my brother sin against me, and I forgive him? till 7 times? 22 Jesus saith unto him, I say not unto thee, Until seven times: but, Until seventy times seven.
- Matthew 6:14,15 For if ye forgive men their trespasses, your heavenly Father will also forgive you: 15 But if ye forgive not men their trespasses, neither will your Father forgive your trespasses.
- Psalms 78 Referred to David's summary of Israel's sins.
- Psalms 106:43 <u>Many times</u> did he <u>deliver</u> them; but they provoked *him* with their counsel, and were brought low for their iniquity.
- Nehemiah 9:29 (AV) And testifiedst against them, that Thou mightest bring them again unto Thy law: yet they dealt proudly, and hearkened not unto Thy commandments, but sinned against Thy judgments, (which if a man do, he shall live in them;) and withdrew the shoulder, and hardened their neck, and would not hear.

 Nehemiah 9:29 (NKJV) And testified against them, that You might bring them back to Your law. Yet they acted proudly, And did not heed Your commandments, But sinned against Your judgments, Which if a man does, he shall live by them. And they shrugged their shoulders, Stiffened their necks, And would not hear.

Referred to the 400 silent years without God's prophets.

Referred to John the Baptist the next prophet.

- Mark 1:3 The voice of one crying in the wilderness, Prepare ye the way of the Lord, make His paths straight.
- Luke 11:50 That the blood of all the prophets, which was shed from the foundation of the world, may be required of this generation;
- Mark 10:24 And the disciples were astonished at his words. But Jesus answereth again, and saith unto them, Children, how hard is it for them that trust in riches to enter into the kingdom of God!
- Matthew 18:3 And said, Verily I say unto you, Except ye be converted, and become as little children, ye shall not enter into the kingdom of heaven.
- Matthew 23 Referred to Jesus' 8 curses on the religious leaders.
- Isaiah 30:21 thine ears shall hear a word behind thee, saying, This is the way walk ye in it, when ye turn to the right hand, and when ye turn to the left.
- Jeremiah 7,11, & 14 God said "Pray not for them".
- Psalms 91:1 He that dwelleth in the secret place of the most High shall abide under the shadow of the Almighty.
