- 1 Kings 18:37 Hear me, O LORD, hear me, that this people may know that Thou art the LORD God, and that Thou hast turned their heart back again.
- Jeremiah 5:25 Your iniquities have turned away these things, and your sins have withholden good things from you.
- Genesis 27:41 And Esau <u>hated</u> Jacob because of the blessing wherewith his father blessed him: and Esau said in his <u>heart</u>, The days of mourning for my father are at hand; then will I slay my brother Jacob.
- Genesis 25:33,34 And Jacob said, Swear to me this day; and he sware unto him: and he sold his birthright unto Jacob. 34 Then Jacob gave Esau bread and pottage of lentiles; and he did eat and drink, and rose up, and went his way: thus Esau despised his birthright.
- 2 Thessalonians 2:7 For the mystery of iniquity doth already work: only He Who now letteth will let, until He be taken out of the way.
- Ephesians 4:26 Be ye angry, & sin not: let not the sun go down on your wrath Matthew 6:12 And forgive us our debts (sins), as we forgive our debtors.
- Leviticus 19:17 (AV) Thou shalt <u>not hate thy brother in thine heart</u>: thou shalt in any wise rebuke thy neighbour, and not suffer sin upon him.
- Leviticus 19:17 (NKJV) You shall not hate your brother in your heart. You shall surely rebuke your neighbor, and not bear sin because of him.
- Deuteronomy 19:6 Lest the avenger of the blood pursue the slayer, while <u>his</u> <u>heart is hot</u>, & overtake him, because the way is long, & slay him; whereas he *was* not worthy of death, inasmuch as he hated him not in time past.
- Leviticus 24:20 Breach for breach, eye for eye, tooth for tooth: as he hath caused a blemish in a man, so shall it be done to him again.

- Numbers 35:11 Then ye shall appoint you cities to be cities of refuge for you; that the slayer may flee thither, which killeth any person at unawares.
- Psalms 105:25 He <u>turned their heart to hate His people</u>, to deal subtilly with His servants.
- Proverbs 5:12 And say, How have I <u>hated instruction</u>, and my <u>heart despised</u> <u>reproof</u>;
- Nehemiah 9:16 But they and our fathers dealt proudly, and hardened their necks, and hearkened not to thy commandments,

- 2 Peter 2:5 And spared not the old world, but saved Noah the eighth person, a preacher of righteousness, bringing in the flood upon the world of the ungodly;
- Ezekiel 25:15 Thus saith the Lord GOD; Because the Philistines have dealt by revenge, and have taken vengeance with a despiteful heart, to destroy it for the old hatred;
- Strongs #07589 she'at *sheh-awt'* AV-despiteful 2, despite 1; 3 1) despite, contempt.
- Zechariah 8:17 And <u>let none of you imagine evil in your hearts against his</u>
 <u>neighbour</u>; and love no false oath: for all these *are things* that I <u>hate</u>, saith
 the LORD.
- Genesis 6:5 And GOD saw that the wickedness of man was great in the earth, and that every imagination of the thoughts of his heart was only evil continually.
- Ezekiel 14:3 Son of man, these men have set up their idols in their heart, and put the stumblingblock of their iniquity before their face: should I be enquired of at all by them?
- Ezekiel 11:19 And I will give them one heart, and I will put a new spirit within you; and I will take the stony heart out of their flesh, and will give them an heart of flesh:
- Matthew 9:17 Neither do men put new wine into old bottles: else the bottles break, and the wine runneth out, and the bottles perish: but they put new wine into new bottles, and both are preserved.
