- 1 John 3:14 We know that we have passed from death unto life, because we love the brethren. He that loveth not his brother abideth in death.

- John 18:38; 19:4 & 19:6 Pilate said "I find no fault in this man."
- 1 John 3:16-19 (AV) & (NKJV)
- 1 John 3:16 (AV) Hereby perceive we the love *of God*, because He laid down His life for us: and we ought to lay down *our* lives for the brethren.
- 1 John 3:16 (NKJV) By this we know love, because He laid down His life for us. And we also ought to lay down *our* lives for the brethren.
- Ephesians 6:4 And, ye fathers, provoke not your children to wrath: but bring them up in the nurture and admonition of the Lord.
- Acts 8:32 The place of the scripture which he read was this, He was led as a sheep to the slaughter; and like a lamb dumb before his shearer, so opened he not his mouth:
- Luke 23:34 Then said Jesus, Father, forgive them; for they know not what they do. And they parted his raiment, and cast lots.
- Acts 7:60 And he kneeled down, and cried with a loud voice, Lord, lay not this sin to their charge.
- Psalms 31:15 My times are in Thy hand: deliver me from the hand of mine enemies, and from them that persecute me.

- John 15:13 (NKJV) Greater love has no one than this, than to lay down one's life for his friends.
- John 15:14 (AV) Ye are My friends, if ye do whatsoever I command you.
- John 15:14 (NKJV) You are My friends if you do whatever I command you.
- Matthew 4:17 From that time Jesus began to preach, and to say, Repent: for the kingdom of heaven is at hand.
- John 15:15 (AV) Henceforth I call you not servants; for the servant knoweth

- not what his lord doeth: but I have called you friends; for all things that I have heard of My Father I have made known unto you.
- John 15:15 (NKJV) No longer do I call you servants, for a servant does not know what his master is doing; but I have called you friends, for all things that I heard from My Father I have made known to you.
- John 15:16 (AV) Ye have not chosen Me, but I have chosen you, and ordained you, that ye should go and bring forth fruit, and *that* your fruit should remain: that whatsoever ye shall ask of the Father in My Name, He may give it you.
- John 15:16 (NKJV) You did not choose Me, but I chose you and appointed you that you should go and bear fruit, and *that* your fruit should remain, that whatever you ask the Father in My Name He may give you.
- John 15:17 (AV) These things I command you, that ye love one another.
- John 15:17 (NKJV) These things I command you, that you love one another.
- Contracted Jesus ministering amoung an sinful world VS religious leaders not wanting to be made unclean from sinners.
- John 10:15 As the Father knoweth Me, even so know I the Father: and I <u>lay</u> <u>down</u> My <u>life</u> for the sheep.
- John 10:17 Therefore doth My Father love Me, because I <u>lay down</u> My <u>life</u>, that I might take it again.
- John 15:13 Greater love hath no man than this, that a man <u>lay down</u> his <u>life</u> for his friends.

- Deuteronomy 15:7,8 If there be among you a poor man of one of thy brethren within any of thy gates in thy land which the LORD thy God giveth thee, thou shalt not harden thine heart, nor shut thine hand from thy poor brother: 8 But thou shalt open thine hand wide unto him, and shalt surely lend him sufficient for his need, in that which he wanteth.
- 2 Corinthians 9:7 Every man according as he purposeth in his heart, so let him give; not grudgingly, or of necessity: for God loveth a cheerful giver.
- Revelation 13:17 And that no man might buy or sell, save he that had the mark, or the name of the beast, or the number of his name.
- Deuteronomy 15:9 Beware that there be not a thought in thy wicked heart, saying, The seventh year, the year of release, is at hand; and thine eye be evil against thy poor brother, and thou givest him nought; and he cry unto the LORD against thee, and it be sin unto thee.
- Proverbs 22:22,23 Rob not the poor, because he is poor: neither oppress the afflicted in the gate: 23 For the LORD will plead their cause, and spoil the soul of those that spoiled them.

- 1 John 1:9 If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.
- Deuteronomy 15:10,11 Thou shalt surely give him, and thine heart shall not be grieved when thou givest unto him: because that for this thing the LORD thy God shall bless thee in all thy works, and in all that thou puttest thine hand unto. 11 For the poor shall never cease out of the land: therefore I command thee, saying, Thou shalt open thine hand wide unto thy brother, to thy poor, and to thy needy, in thy land.
- John 12:8 For the poor always ye have with you; but Me ye have not always. Proverbs 19:17 He that <u>hath pity upon the poor lendeth unto the LORD</u>; and that which he hath given will He pay him again.
- Isaiah 58:7,10 *Is it* not to deal thy bread to the hungry, and that thou bring the poor that are cast out to thy house? when thou seest the naked, that thou cover him; and that thou hide not thyself from thine own flesh? 10 And *if* thou draw out thy soul to the hungry, and satisfy the afflicted soul; then shall thy light rise in obscurity, and thy darkness *be* as the noonday:
- Luke 10:31,32 And by chance there came down a certain priest that way: and when he saw him, he passed by on the other side. 32 And likewise a Levite, when he was at the place, came and looked on him, and passed by on the other side.
- Luke 16 Summarized of the parable of the Rich man & Lazarus. V21 And desiring to be fed with the crumbs which fell from the rich man's table: moreover the dogs came and licked his sores.
- Luke 3:11 He answereth and saith unto them, He that hath two coats, let him impart to him that hath none; and he that hath meat, let him do likewise.
- 2 Corinthians 8:14 But by an equality, *that* now at this time your abundance *may be a supply* for their want, that their abundance also may be *a supply* for your want: that there may be equality:
