- Matthew 11:28,29 Come unto Me, all ye that labour and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest. 29 Take My yoke upon you, and learn of Me; for I am meek and lowly in heart: and ye shall find rest unto your souls.
- 1 John 1:9 If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.
- John 10:10 The thief cometh not, but for to steal, and to kill, and to destroy: I am come that they might have life, and that they might have it more abundantly.
- 1 John 3:20 (AV) For if our heart condemn us, God is greater than our heart, and knoweth all things.
- 1 John 3:20 (NKJV) For if our heart condemns us, God is greater than our heart, and knows all things.
- John 16:8 And when He is come, He will reprove the world of sin, and of righteousness, and of judgment:
- Romans 8:13 For if ye live after the flesh, ye shall die: but if ye through the Spirit do mortify the deeds of the body, ye shall live.
- 1 John 1:9 If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.
- Luke 10:19 Behold, I give unto you power to tread on serpents & scorpions, & over all the power of the enemy: and nothing shall by any means hurt you.
- Roamans 16:20 And the God of peace shall bruise Satan under your feet shortly. The grace of our Lord Jesus Christ be with you. Amen.

- Romans 8 Referred to the Spirit of God greater than the devil.
- 1 John 4:4 Ye are of God, little children, and have overcome them: because greater is he that is in you, than he that is in the world.
- 1 John 3:21 (AV) Beloved, if our heart condemn us not, *then* have we confidence toward God.

- 1 John 3:21 (NKJV) Beloved, if our heart does not condemn us, we have confidence toward God.
- John 8:10,11 When Jesus had lifted up Himself, and saw none but the woman, He said unto her, Woman, where are those thine accusers? hath no man <u>condemned</u> thee? 11 She said, No man, Lord. And Jesus said unto her, Neither do I <u>condemn</u> thee: go, and sin no more.
- Strongs #2607 kataginosko *kat-ag-in-o'-sko* AV-condemn 2, blame 1; 3 1) to find fault with, blame 2) to accuse, condemn.
- John 3:17 For God sent not His Son into the world to <u>condemn</u> the world; but that the world through Him might be saved.
- Strongs #2588 kardia *kar-dee'-ah* AV-heart 159, broken hearted + 4937 1; 160 1) the heart 1a) that organ in the animal body which is the centre of the circulation of the blood, and hence was regarded as the seat of physical life 1b) denotes the centre of all physical and spiritual life 1b1) the vigour and sense of physical life 1b2) the centre and seat of spiritual life 1b2a) the soul or mind, as it is the fountain and seat of the thoughts, passions, desires, appetites, affections, purposes, endeavours 1b2b) of the understanding, the faculty and seat of the intelligence 1b2c) of the will and character 1b2d) of the soul so far as it is affected and stirred in a bad way or good, or of the soul as the seat of the sensibilities, affections, emotions, desires, appetites, passions 1c) of the middle or central or inmost part of anything, even though inanimate.
- Ephesians 1:13 In whom ye also trusted, after that ye heard the word of truth, the gospel of your salvation: in whom also after that ye believed, ye were sealed with that holy Spirit of promise,
- 2 Corinthians 7:10 For godly sorrow worketh repentance to salvation not to be repented of: but the sorrow of the world worketh death.
- Matthew 27 Summarized of Judas Iscariot' remorse.
- John 16:7-12 Nevertheless I tell you the truth; It is expedient for you that I go away: for if I go not away, the Comforter will not come unto you; but if I depart, I will send Him unto you. 8 And when He is come, He will reprove the world of sin, and of righteousness, and of judgment: 9 Of sin, because they believe not on Me; 10 Of righteousness, because I go to My Father, and ye see Me no more; 11 Of judgment, because the prince of this world is judged. 12 I have yet many things to say unto you, but ye cannot bear them now. 13 Howbeit when He, the Spirit of Truth, is come, He will guide you into all Truth: for He shall not speak of Himself; but whatsoever He shall hear, that shall He speak: and He will shew you things to come. 14 He shall glorify Me: for He shall receive of Mine, and shall shew it unto you. 15 All things that the Father hath are Mine: therefore said I, that He

- shall take of Mine, and shall shew it unto you.
- 2 Timothy 2:15 Study to shew thyself approved unto God, a workman that needeth not to be ashamed, rightly dividing the word of truth.
- Hebrews 4:12 For the Word of God *is* quick, and powerful, and sharper than any twoedged sword, piercing even to the dividing asunder of soul and spirit, and of the joints and marrow, and *is* a discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart.
- Luke 24:45 Then opened He their understanding, that they might understand the scriptures,
- Luke 8:11 Now the parable is this: The seed is the word of God. (miss-used often)
- John 8:44 Ye are of your father the devil, and the lusts of your father ye will do. He was a murderer from the beginning, and abode not in the truth, because there is no truth in him. When he speaketh a lie, he speaketh of his own: for he is a liar, and the father of it.
- Revelation 12:10 And I heard a loud voice saying in heaven, Now is come salvation, and strength, and the kingdom of our God, and the power of His Christ: for the <u>accuser</u> of our <u>brethren</u> is cast down, which <u>accused</u> them before our God day and night.
- Daniel 9:8 (AV) O Lord, to us *belongeth* confusion of face, to our kings, to our princes, and to our fathers, because we have sinned against Thee.
- 2 Corinthians 10:5 Casting down imaginations, and every high thing that exalteth itself against the knowledge of God, and bringing into captivity every thought to the obedience of Christ;
- James 4:7 Submit yourselves therefore to God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you.
- Job 1 & 2 Summarized of Job's trials.
- Job 1:21,22 And said, Naked came I out of my mother's womb, and naked shall I return thither: the LORD gave, and the LORD hath taken away; blessed be the name of the LORD. 22 In all this Job sinned not, nor charged God foolishly.
- Job 42:8 Therefore take unto you now seven bullocks and seven rams, and go to my servant Job, and offer up for yourselves a burnt offering; and my servant Job shall pray for you: for him will I accept: lest I deal with you after your folly, in that ye have not spoken of me the thing which is right, like my servant Job.
- Romans 8:34 Who is he that condemneth? It is Christ that died, yea rather, that is risen again, who is even at the right hand of God, who also maketh intercession for us.
- Hebrews 7:25 Wherefore he is able also to save them to the uttermost that

- come unto God by him, seeing he ever liveth to make intercession for them.
- Matthew 12:7 But if ye had known what *this* meaneth, I will have mercy, and not sacrifice, ye would not have condemned the guiltless.
- Matthew 12:37 For by thy words thou shalt be justified, and by thy words thou shalt be condemned.
- James 1:26 If any man among you seem to be religious, and bridleth not his tongue, but deceiveth his own heart, this man's religion is vain.
- 1 Timothy 5:13,14 And withal they (Younger widows) learn to be idle, wandering about from house to house; and not only idle, but tattlers also and busybodies, speaking things which they ought not. 14 I will therefore that the younger women marry, bear children, guide the house, give none occasion to the adversary to speak reproachfully.
- Ephesians 6:4 And, ye fathers, provoke not your children to wrath: but bring them up in the nurture and admonition of the Lord.
- Matthew 12:41,42 The men of Nineveh shall rise in judgment with this generation, and shall <u>condemn</u> it: because they repented at the preaching of Jonas; and, behold, a greater than Jonas *is* here. 42 The queen of the south shall rise up in the judgment with this generation, and shall <u>condemn</u> it: for she came from the uttermost parts of the earth to hear the wisdom of Solomon; and, behold, a greater than Solomon *is* here.
- 1 John 2:23 Whosoever denieth the Son, the same hath not the Father: but he that acknowledgeth the Son hath the Father also.
- Matthew 20:18 Behold, we go up to Jerusalem; and the Son of Man shall be betrayed unto the chief priests and unto the scribes, and they shall <u>condemn</u> Him to death,
- Matthew 23 Referred to Jesus' 8 curses on the religious leaders.
- Matthew 27:3 Then Judas, which had betrayed Him, when he saw that He was <u>condemned</u>, repented himself, and brought again the thirty pieces of silver to the chief priests and elders,
- John 6:70 Jesus answered them, Have not I chosen you twelve, and one of you is a devil?
- Luke 6:37 Judge not, and ye shall not be judged: <u>condemn</u> not, and ye shall not be condemned: forgive, and ye shall be forgiven:
- John 3:16,17 For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life. 17 For God sent not His Son into the world to <u>condemn</u> the world; but that the world through Him might be saved.
- Revelation 19:11 Summarized of Jesus' return & 1000 year rule.
- John 3:18 He that believeth on Him is not condemned: but he that believeth

- not is <u>condemned</u> already, because he hath not believed in the Name of the only begotten Son of God.
- 1 Samuel 8:7 And the LORD said unto Samuel, Hearken unto the voice of the people in all that they say unto thee: for they have not rejected thee, but they have rejected Me, that I should not reign over them.
- John 3:19 And this is the <u>condemnation</u>, that light is come into the world, and men loved darkness rather than light, because their deeds were evil.
- Genesis 3:8 And they heard the voice of the LORD God walking in the garden in the cool of the day: and Adam and his wife hid themselves from the presence of the LORD God amongst the trees of the garden.
- John 5:24 Verily, verily, I say unto you, He that heareth My Word, and believeth on Him that sent Me, hath everlasting life, and shall not come into <u>condemnation</u>; but is passed from death unto life.
- Revelation 20:12,15 And I saw the dead, small and great, stand before God; and the books were opened: and another book was opened, which is the book of life: and the dead were judged out of those things which were written in the books, according to their works. 15 And whosoever was not found written in the book of life was cast into the lake of fire.
- John 8:10,11 When Jesus had lifted up Himself, and saw none but the woman, He said unto her, Woman, where are those thine accusers? hath no man <u>condemned</u> thee? 11 She said, No man, Lord. And Jesus said unto her, Neither do I <u>condemn</u> thee: go, and sin no more.
- John 8:7 So when they continued asking him, he lifted up himself, and said unto them, He that is without sin among you, let him first cast a stone at her.
- Romans 6:1,2 What shall we say then? Shall we continue in sin, that grace may abound? 2 God forbid. How shall we, that are dead to sin, live any longer therein?
- Acts 13:27 For they that dwell at Jerusalem, and their rulers, because they knew Him not, nor yet the voices of the prophets which are read every sabbath day, they have fulfilled *them* in condemning *Him*.
- Romans 2:1 Therefore thou art inexcusable, O man, whosoever thou art that judgest: for wherein thou judgest another, thou <u>condemnest</u> thyself; for thou that judgest doest the same things.
- Matthew 16:6 Then Jesus said unto them, Take heed and beware of the leaven of the Pharisees and of the Sadducees.
- Romans 5:16 And not as *it was* by one that sinned, *so is* the gift: for the judgment *was* by one to <u>condemnation</u>, but the free gift *is* of many offences unto justification.
- Romans 5:18 Therefore as by the offence of one judgment came upon all men

- to <u>condemnation</u>; even so by the righteousness of One *the free gift came* upon all men unto justification of life.
- Romans 8:1,3 *There is* therefore now no <u>condemnation</u> to them which are in Christ Jesus, who walk not after the flesh, but after the Spirit. 3 For what the law could not do, in that it was weak through the flesh, God sending His Own Son in the likeness of sinful flesh, and for sin, <u>condemned</u> sin in the flesh:
- Ezekiel 18:4 Behold, all souls are mine; as the soul of the father, so also the soul of the son is mine: the soul that sinneth, it shall die.
- Romans 8:34 Who *is* he that <u>condemneth</u>? *It is* Christ that died, yea rather, that is risen again, Who is even at the right hand of God, Who also maketh intercession for us.
- Romans 8:38,39 For I am persuaded, that neither death, nor life, nor angels, nor principalities, nor powers, nor things present, nor things to come, 39 Nor height, nor depth, nor any other creature, shall be able to separate us from the love of God, which is in Christ Jesus our Lord.
- James 4:7 Submit yourselves therefore to God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you.

More Service Notes:

- Romans 14:22 Hast thou faith? have *it* to thyself before God. Happy *is* he that <u>condemneth</u> not himself in that thing which he alloweth.
- 1 Corinthians 11:32,34 But when we are judged, we are chastened of the Lord, that we should not be <u>condemned</u> with the world. 34 And if any man hunger, let him eat at home; that ye come not together unto <u>condemnation</u>. And the rest will I set in order when I come.
- 2 Corinthians 3:9 For if the ministration of <u>condemnation</u> *be* glory, much more doth the ministration of righteousness exceed in glory.
- 2 Corinthians 7:3 I speak not *this* to <u>condemn</u> *you*: for I have said before, that ye are in our hearts to die and live with *you*.
- 1 Timothy 3:6 Not a novice, lest being lifted up with pride he fall into the <u>condemnation</u> of the devil.
- Titus 2:8 Sound speech, that cannot be <u>condemned</u>; that he that is of the contrary part may be ashamed, having no evil thing to say of you.
- Titus 3:11 Knowing that he that is such is subverted, and sinneth, being <u>condemned</u> of himself.
- Hebrews 11:7 By faith Noah, being warned of God of things not seen as yet, moved with fear, prepared an ark to the saving of his house; by the which he <u>condemned</u> the world, and became heir of the righteousness which is by faith.
- James 3:1 My brethren, be not many masters, knowing that we shall receive

the greater condemnation.

- James 5:6,9,12 Ye have <u>condemned</u> and killed the just; and he doth not resist you. 9 Grudge not one against another, brethren, lest ye be <u>condemned</u>: behold, the judge standeth before the door. 12 But above all things, my brethren, swear not, neither by heaven, neither by the earth, neither by any other oath: but let your yea be yea; and *your* nay, nay; lest ye fall into <u>condemnation</u>.
- 2 Peter 2:6 And turning the cities of Sodom and Gomorrha into ashes condemned them with an overthrow, making them an ensample unto those that after should live ungodly;
- 1 John 3:20,21 For if our heart <u>condemn</u> us, God is greater than our heart, and knoweth all things. 21 Beloved, if our heart <u>condemn</u> us not, *then* have we confidence toward God.
- Jude 1:4 For there are certain men crept in unawares, who were before of old ordained to this <u>condemnation</u>, ungodly men, turning the grace of our God into lasciviousness, and denying the only Lord God, and our Lord Jesus Christ.
- Mark 10:33 *Saying*, Behold, we go up to Jerusalem; and the Son of Man shall be delivered unto the chief priests, and unto the scribes; and they shall <u>condemn</u> Him to death, and shall deliver Him to the Gentiles:
- Mark 14:64 Ye have heard the blasphemy: what think ye? And they all condemned Him to be guilty of death.
- Luke 11:31,32 The queen of the south shall rise up in the judgment with the men of this generation, and <u>condemn</u> them: for she came from the utmost parts of the earth to hear the wisdom of Solomon; and, behold, a greater than Solomon *is* here. 32 The men of Nineve shall rise up in the judgment with this generation, and shall <u>condemn</u> it: for they repented at the preaching of Jonas; and, behold, a greater than Jonas *is* here.
- Luke 23:40 But the other answering rebuked him, saying, Dost not thou fear God, seeing thou art in the same condemnation?
- Luke 24:20 And how the chief priests and our rulers delivered Him to be <u>condemned</u> to death, and have crucified Him.
