## Pleasing God Through Obedience - 1 John 3H

- Hebrews 5:8 Though He were a Son, yet learned He obedience by the things which He suffered;
- Joshua 24:15 And if it seem evil unto you to serve the LORD, choose you this day whom ye will serve; whether the gods which your fathers served that were on the other side of the flood, or the gods of the Amorites, in whose land ye dwell: but as for me and my house, we will serve the LORD.
- 1 John 3:22-24 (AV) & (NKJV)
- 1 John 3:22 (AV) And whatsoever we ask, we receive of Him, because we keep His commandments, and do those things that are pleasing in His sight.
- 1 John 3:22 (NKJV) And whatever we ask we receive from Him, because we keep His commandments and do those things that are pleasing in His sight.
- Matthew 3:2 And (John the Baptist) saying, Repent ye: for the kingdom of heaven is at hand.
- Matthew 4:17 From that time Jesus began to preach, and to say, Repent: for the kingdom of heaven is at hand.
- Exodus 20 Summarized of the 10 Commandments. the first table was on honouring God. The second table was on honouring mankind.
- Deuteronomy 6:5 And thou shalt love the LORD thy God with all thine heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy might.
- Mark 12:29-31 And Jesus answered him, The first of all the commandments is, Hear, O Israel; The Lord our God is one Lord: 30 And thou shalt love the Lord thy God with all thy heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy mind, and with all thy strength: this is the first commandment. 31 And the second is like, namely this, Thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself. There is none other commandment greater than these.
- Mark 16:17,18 And these signs shall follow them that believe; In My Name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues; 18 They shall take up serpents; and if they drink any deadly thing, it shall not hurt them; they shall lay hands on the sick, and they shall recover.
- Matthew 4:23-25 And Jesus went about all Galilee, teaching in their synagogues, and preaching the gospel of the kingdom, and healing all manner of sickness and all manner of disease among the people. 24 And His fame went throughout all Syria: and they brought unto Him all sick people that were taken with divers diseases and torments, and those which were possessed with devils, and those which were lunatick, and those that had the palsy; and He healed them. 25 And there followed Him

- great multitudes of people from Galilee, and from Decapolis, and from Jerusalem, and from Judaea, and from beyond Jordan.
- 1 John 3:23 (AV) And this is His commandment, That we should believe on the Name of His Son Jesus Christ, and love one another, as He gave us commandment.
- 1 John 3:23 (NKJV) And this is His commandment: that we should believe on the Name of His Son Jesus Christ and love one another, as He gave us commandment.
- 1 John 2:22 Who is a liar but he that denieth that Jesus is the Christ? He is antichrist, that denieth the Father and the Son.
- John 15:24 If I had not done among them the works which none other man did, they had not had sin: but now have they both seen and hated both Me and My Father.
- John 8:44 Ye are of your father the devil, and the lusts of your father ye will do. He was a murderer from the beginning, and abode not in the truth, because there is no truth in him. When he speaketh a lie, he speaketh of his own: for he is a liar, and the father of it.
- John 3:16-18 For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life. 17 For God sent not his Son into the world to condemn the world; but that the world through him might be saved. 18 He that believeth on him is not condemned: but he that believeth not is condemned already, because he hath not believed in the name of the only begotten Son of God.

Revelation 19:11 Referred to Jesus' return.

- John 13:34,35 A new commandment I give unto you, That ye love one another; as I have loved you, that ye also love one another. 35 By this shall all men know that ye are my disciples, if ye have love one to another.
- Colossians 3:23 And whatsoever ye do, do it heartily, as to the Lord, and not unto men;
- John 10:27 My sheep hear my voice, and I know them, and they follow me: Matthew 25:33 And He shall set the sheep on His right hand, but the goats on the left.
- Matthew 7:15 Beware of false prophets, which come to you in sheep's clothing, but inwardly they are ravening wolves.
- 1 John 3:24 (AV) And he that keepeth His commandments dwelleth in Him, and He in him. And hereby we know that He abideth in us, by the Spirit which He hath given us.
- 1 John 3:24 (NKJV) Now he who keeps His commandments abides in Him, and He in him. And by this we know that He abides in us, by the Spirit Whom He has given us.
- Ephesians 1:13 In whom ye also trusted, after that ye heard the Word of

Truth, the gospel of your salvation: in whom also after that ye believed, ye were sealed with that Holy Spirit of promise,

Acts 1& 2 Compaired with the difference with the infilling of the Holy Spirit.

James 4:3 Ye ask, and receive not, because ye ask amiss, that ye may consume it upon your lusts.

Matthew 6:8 Be not ye therefore like unto them: for your Father knoweth what things ye have need of, before ye ask him.

John 17 Referred to Jesus' prayer.

Luke 11:1-13 - V1 And it came to pass, that, as He was praying in a certain place, when He ceased, one of His disciples said unto Him, Lord, teach us to pray, as John also taught his disciples.

Luke 18 Summarized of the Pharisee & the publican praying. V14 I tell you, this man went down to his house justified rather than the other: for every one that exalteth himself shall be abased; and he that humbleth himself shall be exalted.

Luke 11:2-4 And He said unto them, When ye pray, say, Our Father which art in heaven, Hallowed be Thy Name. Thy kingdom come. Thy will be done, as in heaven, so in earth. 3 Give us day by day our daily bread. 4 And forgive us our sins; for we also forgive every one that is indebted to us. And lead us not into temptation; but deliver us from evil (one).

Daniel 9:8 O Lord, to us *belongeth* confusion of face, to our kings, to our princes, and to our fathers, because we have sinned against Thee.

Luke 4 Summarized of the temptations of Jesus.

Luke 11:5-13 And He said unto them, Which of you shall have a friend, and shall go unto him at midnight, and say unto him, Friend, lend me three loaves; 6 For a friend of mine in his journey is come to me, and I have nothing to set before him? 7 And he from within shall answer and say, Trouble me not: the door is now shut, and my children are with me in bed; I cannot rise and give thee. 8 I say unto you, Though he will not rise and give him, because he is his friend, yet because of his importunity he will rise and give him as many as he needeth. 9 And I say unto you, Ask, and it shall be given you; seek, and ye shall find; knock, and it shall be opened unto you. 10 For every one that asketh receiveth; and he that seeketh findeth; and to him that knocketh it shall be opened. 11 If a son shall ask bread of any of you that is a father, will he give him a stone? or if he ask a fish, will he for a fish give him a serpent? 12 Or if he shall ask an egg, will he offer him a scorpion? 13 If ye then, being evil, know how to give good gifts unto your children: how much more shall your heavenly Father give the Holy Spirit to them that ask Him?

Matthew 7:8 For every one that asketh receiveth; and he that seeketh

- findeth; and to him that knocketh it shall be opened.
- Matthew 21:22 And all things, whatsoever ye shall <u>ask</u> in prayer, believing, ye shall <u>receive</u>.
- Luke 11:10 For every one that <u>asketh</u> <u>receiveth</u>; and he that seeketh findeth; and to him that knocketh it shall be opened.
- John 16:24 Hitherto have ye <u>asked</u> nothing in My Name: <u>ask</u>, and ye shall <u>receive</u>, that your joy may be full.
- James 4:3 Ye <u>ask</u>, and <u>receive</u> not, because ye <u>ask</u> amiss, that ye may consume *it* upon your lusts.
- 1 John 3:22 And whatsoever we <u>ask</u>, we <u>receive</u> of Him, because we keep His commandments, and do those things that are pleasing in His sight.
- Matthew 19:17 And He said unto him, Why callest thou Me good? *there is* none good but One, *that is*, God: but if thou wilt enter into life, <u>keep</u> the <u>commandments</u>.
- Mark 7:9 And He said unto them, Full well ye reject the <u>commandment</u> of God, that ye may <u>keep</u> your own tradition.
- Matthew 24:35 Heaven and earth shall pass away, but My Words shall not pass away.
- Mark 7:13 Making the word of God of none effect through your tradition, which ye have delivered: and many such like things do ye.
- 2 Corinthians 13:5 Examine yourselves, whether ye be in the faith; prove your own selves. Know ye not your own selves, how that Jesus Christ is in you, except ye be reprobates?
- Romans 8:8 So then they that are in the flesh cannot <u>please</u> <u>God</u>.
- Jeremiah 6:16 Thus saith the LORD, Stand ye in the ways, and see, and ask for the old paths, where is the good way, and walk therein, and ye shall find rest for your souls. But they said, We will not walk therein.
- Romans 15:3 For even <u>Christ pleased</u> not Himself; but, as it is written, The reproaches of them that reproached thee fell on Me.
- John 6:38 For I came down from heaven, not to do Mine Own will, but the will of Him that sent Me.
- 1 Corinthians 1:21 For after that in the wisdom of <u>God</u> the world by wisdom knew not <u>God</u>, it <u>pleased God</u> by the foolishness of preaching to save them that believe.
- Ezekiel 36:26 A new heart also will I give you, and a new spirit will I put within you: and I will take away the stony heart out of your flesh, and I will give you an heart of flesh.
- Daniel 4:16 Let his heart be changed from man's, and let a beast's heart be given unto him; and let seven times pass over him.
- 1 Corinthians 7:32 But I would have you without carefulness. He that is unmarried careth for the things that belong to the <u>Lord</u>, how he may

please the Lord:

1 Corinthians 10:5 But with many of them <u>God</u> was not well <u>pleased</u>: for they were overthrown in the wilderness.

Leviticus 26 Referred to God judging sinful Israel.

Psalms 78 Referred to David's summary of Israel in the wilderness.

Numbers 16 Referred to God dealing with Korah & the rebels.

- 1 Peter 4:17 For the time is come that judgment must begin at the house of God: and if it first begin at us, what shall the end be of them that obey not the gospel of God?
- 1 Corinthians 12:18 But now hath <u>God</u> set the members every one of them in the body, as it hath <u>pleased</u> Him.
- 1 Corinthians 15:38 But <u>God</u> giveth it a body as it hath <u>pleased</u> Him, and to every seed his own body.
- Genesis 1 At the end of each day of creation, "God saw that it was good."
- Galatians 1:10 For do I now persuade men, or <u>God</u>? or do I seek to <u>please</u> men? for if I yet <u>pleased</u> men, I should not be the servant of <u>Christ</u>.
- Acts 9 Summarized of Saul's conversion to Paul. V4 And he fell to the earth, and heard a voice saying unto him, Saul, Saul, why persecutest thou Me?
- Galatians 1:15 But when it <u>pleased</u> <u>God</u>, Who separated me from my mother's womb, and called *me* by His grace,
- 2 Corinthians 9:7 Every man according as he purposeth in his heart, so let him give; not grudgingly, or of necessity: for God loveth a cheerful giver.
- Ephesians 1:5 Having predestinated us unto the adoption of children by <u>Jesus Christ</u> to Himself, according to the good <u>pleasure</u> of His will, Summarized of Salvation by Jesus.
- Ezekiel 18:4 Behold, all souls are mine; as the soul of the father, so also the soul of the son is mine: the soul that sinneth, it shall die.
- Acts 17:30 And the times of this ignorance God winked at; but now commandeth all men every where to repent:
- Mark 8:34 And when He had called the people unto Him with His disciples also, He said unto them, Whosoever will come after Me, let him deny himself, and take up his cross, and follow Me.

Matthew 22:14 For many are called, but few are chosen.

Genesis 12 Summarized of God calling Abraham.

- John 16:8 And when He is come, He will reprove the world of sin, and of righteousness, and of judgment:
- 1 John 1:9 If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.
- Acts 16 Summarized of the Jail incident. V30,31 And brought them out, and said, Sirs, what must I do to be saved? 31 And they said, Believe on the Lord Jesus Christ, and thou shalt be saved, and thy house.

- John 21:21,22 Peter seeing him saith to Jesus, Lord, and what shall this man do? 22 Jesus saith unto him, If I will that he tarry till I come, what is that to thee? follow thou Me.
- Luke 12:48 But he that knew not, and did commit things worthy of stripes, shall be beaten with few stripes. For unto whomsoever much is given, of him shall be much required: and to whom men have committed much, of him they will ask the more.
- Romans 14:12 So then every one of us shall give account of himself to God. Matthew 25 Referred to the parable of the talents.
- Philippians 2:13 For it is <u>God</u> which worketh in you both to will and to do of *His* good <u>pleasure</u>.
- Colossians 1:10 That ye might walk worthy of the <u>Lord</u> unto all <u>pleasing</u>, being fruitful in every good work, and increasing in the knowledge of <u>God</u>;
- Romans 10:17 So then faith comes by hearing, & hearing by the Word of God.
- Colossians 3:20 Children, obey *your* parents in all things: for this is well pleasing unto the Lord.
- 1 Thessalonians 2:4 But as we were allowed of <u>God</u> to be put in trust with the gospel, even so we speak; not as <u>pleasing</u> men, but <u>God</u>, which trieth our hearts.
- John 14:30 Hereafter I will not talk much with you: for the prince of this world cometh, and hath nothing in Me.
- Hebrews 7:25 Wherefore He is able also to save them to the uttermost that come unto God by Him, seeing He ever liveth to make intercession for them.

## **More service Notes:**

- 1 Thessalonians 2:15 Who both killed the <u>Lord Jesus</u>, and their own prophets, & have persecuted us; and they please not God, & are contrary to all men:
- 1 Thessalonians 4:1 Furthermore then we beseech you, brethren, and exhort *you* by the <u>Lord Jesus</u>, that as ye have received of us how ye ought to walk and to <u>please God</u>, *so* ye would abound more and more.
- 2 Thessalonians 1:11 Wherefore also we pray always for you, that our <u>God</u> would count you worthy of *this* calling, and fulfil all the good <u>pleasure</u> of *His* goodness, and the work of faith with power:
- Hebrews 11:5,6 By faith Enoch was translated that he should not see death; and was not found, because <u>God</u> had translated him: for before his translation he had this testimony, that he <u>pleased God</u>. 6 But without faith *it is* impossible to <u>please</u> *Him*: for he that cometh to <u>God</u> must believe that He is, and *that* He is a rewarder of them that diligently seek Him.
- Hebrews 13:16 But to do good and to communicate forget not: for with such sacrifices <u>God</u> is well <u>pleased</u>.
- 2 Peter 1:17 For He received from **God** the Father honour and glory, when

- there came such a voice to Him from the excellent glory, This is My beloved Son, in Whom I am well pleased.
- Revelation 4:11 Thou art worthy, O <u>Lord</u>, to receive glory and honour and power: for Thou hast created all things, and for Thy <u>pleasure</u> they are and were created.
- John 14:15 If ye love Me, <u>keep</u> My <u>commandments</u>.
- John 14:21 He that hath My <u>commandments</u>, and <u>keepeth</u> them, he it is that loveth Me: and he that loveth Me shall be loved of my Father, and I will love him, and will manifest Myself to him.
- John 15:10 If ye <u>keep</u> My <u>commandments</u>, ye shall abide in My love; even as I have kept My Father's <u>commandments</u>, and abide in His love.
- Acts 15:5 But there rose up certain of the sect of the Pharisees which believed, saying, That it was needful to circumcise them, and to <u>command</u> them to <u>keep</u> the law of Moses.
- 1 Corinthians 7:19 Circumcision is nothing, and uncircumcision is nothing, but the <u>keeping</u> of the <u>commandments</u> of God.
- 1 Timothy 6:14 That thou <u>keep this commandment</u> without spot, unrebukeable, until the appearing of our Lord Jesus Christ:
- 1 John 2:3,4 And hereby we do know that we know Him, if we <u>keep</u> His <u>commandments</u>. 4 He that saith, I know Him, and <u>keepeth</u> not His <u>commandments</u>, is a liar, and the truth is not in him.
- 1 John 3:22 And whatsoever we ask, we receive of Him, because we <u>keep</u> His <u>commandments</u>, and do those things that are pleasing in His sight.
- 1 John 3:24 (AV) And he that keepeth His commandments dwelleth in Him, and He in him. And hereby we know that He abideth in us, by the Spirit which He hath given us.
- 1 John 5:2 By this we know that we love the children of God, when we love God, and <u>keep</u> His <u>commandments</u>.
- 1 John 5:3 For this is the love of God, that we <u>keep</u> His <u>commandments</u>: and His <u>commandments</u> are not grievous.
- Revelation 12:17 And the dragon was wroth with the woman, and went to make war with the remnant of her seed, which <u>keep</u> the <u>commandments</u> of God, and have the testimony of Jesus Christ.
- Revelation 14:12 Here is the patience of the saints: here *are* they that <u>keep</u> the <u>commandments</u> of God, and the faith of Jesus.
