

Times Of Revival - Hebrews 9

Habakkuk 2:4 Behold, his soul which is lifted up is not upright in him: but the just shall live by his faith.

Leviticus 26:23 And if ye will not be reformed by Me by these things, but will walk contrary unto Me;

Leviticus 26:23 (NKJV) And if by these things you are not reformed by Me, but walk contrary to Me,

Judges 4:1 And the children of Israel again did evil in the sight of the LORD, when Ehud was dead.

Exodus 20:5 Thou shalt not bow down thyself to them, nor serve them: for I the LORD thy God am a jealous God, visiting the iniquity of the fathers upon the children unto the third and fourth generation of them that hate Me;

Exodus 8:1 And the LORD spake unto Moses, Go unto Pharaoh, and say unto him, Thus saith the LORD, Let My people go, that they may serve Me.

Matthew 11:28 Come unto me, all ye that labour and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest.

1 Corinthians 6:19,20 What? know ye not that your body is the temple of the Holy Ghost which is in you, which ye have of God, and ye are not your own? 20 For ye are bought with a price: therefore glorify God in your body, and in your spirit, which are God's.

1 John 3:24 And he that keepeth His commandments dwelleth in Him, and He in him. And hereby we know that He abideth in us, by the Spirit which He hath given us.

Summarized of Salvation by Jesus.

Psalms 22 & Isaiah 53 foretold of Jesus' crucifixion.

Romans 6:1,2 What shall we say then? Shall we continue in sin, that grace may abound? 2 God forbid. How shall we, that are dead to sin, live any longer therein?

Hebrews 9:10 *Which stood* only in meats and drinks, and divers washings, and carnal ordinances, imposed *on them* until the time of reformation.

Hebrews 9:10 (NKJV) *concerned* only with foods and drinks, various washings, and fleshly ordinances imposed until the time of reformation.

Strong's #1357 diorthosis *dee-or'-tho-sis* AV-reformation 1; 1) in a physical sense, a making straight, restoring to its natural and normal condition something which in some way protrudes or has got out of line, as broken or misshapen limbs 2) of acts and institutions, reformation.

Leviticus 26:23-26 - 23,24 And if ye will not be reformed by Me by these things, but will walk contrary unto Me; 24 Then will I also walk contrary unto you, and will punish you yet seven times for your sins.

2 Corinthians 11:14 And no marvel; for Satan himself is transformed into an angel of light.

2 Chronicles 7:14 If My people, which are called by My Name, shall humble themselves, and pray, and seek My face, and turn from their wicked ways; then will I hear from heaven, and will forgive their sin, and will heal their land.

Leviticus 26:25,26 And I will bring a sword upon you, that shall avenge the quarrel of *My* covenant: and when ye are gathered together within your cities, I will send the pestilence among you; and ye shall be delivered into the hand of the enemy. 26 *And* when I have broken the staff of your bread, ten women shall bake your bread in one oven, and they shall deliver *you* your bread again by weight: and ye shall eat, and not be satisfied.

Ephesians 6:4 And, ye fathers, provoke not your children to wrath: but bring them up in the nurture and admonition of the Lord.

Jonah Summarized God dealing with Jonah.

Jonah 2:9 But I will sacrifice unto thee with the voice of thanksgiving; I will pay that that I have vowed. Salvation is of the LORD.

Jonah 3:6 For word came unto the king of Nineveh, and he arose from his throne, and he laid his robe from him, and covered him with sackcloth, and sat in ashes.

Deuteronomy 21:18 If a man have a stubborn and rebellious son, which will not obey the voice of his father, or the voice of his mother, and *that*, when they have chastened <03256> him, will not hearken unto them:

Proverbs 17:10 A reproof entereth more into a wise man than an hundred stripes into a fool.

1 Chronicles 21 Referred to David numbering Israel. V13 And David said unto Gad, I am in a great strait: let me fall now into the hand of the LORD; for very great are His mercies: but let me not fall into the hand of man.

Deuteronomy 22:18 And the elders of that city shall take that man and chastise <03256> him;

1 Kings 12:11 And now whereas my father did lade you with a heavy yoke, I

will add to your yoke: my father hath chastised <03256> you with whips, but I will chastise <03256> you with scorpions.

1 Kings 18 Summarized of the shoot out on Mount Carmel.

1 Kings 12 Summarized of Rehoboam listening to the young advisors.

Proverbs 22:22,23 Rob not the poor, because he is poor: neither oppress the afflicted in the gate: 23 For the LORD will plead their cause, and spoil the soul of those that spoiled them.

1 Kings 12:14 And spake to them after the counsel of the young men, saying, My father made your yoke heavy, and I will add to your yoke: my father *also* chastised <03256> you with whips, but I will chastise <03256> you with scorpions.

John 8:36 If the Son therefore shall make you free, ye shall be free indeed.

1 Chronicles 15:22 And Chenaniah, chief of the Levites, *was* for song: he instructed <03256> about the song, because he *was* skilful.

1 Corinthians 15:33 Be not deceived: evil communications corrupt good manners.

Psalms 2:10 Be wise now therefore, O ye kings: be instructed <03256>, ye judges of the earth.

Deuteronomy 17 Referred to God's laws for kings. V17-19 Neither shall he multiply wives to himself, that his heart turn not away: neither shall he greatly multiply to himself silver and gold. And it shall be, when he sitteth upon the throne of his kingdom, that he shall write him a copy of this law in a book out of that which is before the priests the Levites: 19 And it shall be with him, and he shall read therein all the days of his life: that he may learn to fear the LORD his God, to keep all the words of this law and these statutes, to do them:

1 Kings 11:3 And he (Solomon) had seven hundred wives, princesses, and

three hundred concubines: and his wives turned away his heart.

Isaiah 1:26 And I will restore thy judges as at the first, and thy counsellors as at the beginning: afterward thou shalt be called, The city of righteousness, the faithful city.

Psalms 6:1 « To the chief Musician on Neginoth upon Sheminith, A Psalm of David. » O LORD, rebuke me not in Thine anger, neither chasten <03256> me in Thy hot displeasure.

Psalms 16:7 I will bless the LORD, Who hath given me counsel: my reins also instruct <03256> me in the night seasons.

Psalms 38:1 « A Psalm of David, to bring to remembrance. » O LORD, rebuke me not in Thy wrath: neither chasten <03256> me in Thy hot displeasure.

Psalms 39:11 When Thou with rebukes dost correct <03256> man for iniquity, Thou makest his beauty to consume away like a moth: surely every man *is* vanity. Selah.

John 14:6 Jesus saith unto him, I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by Me.

Psalms 94:10 He that chastiseth <03256> the heathen, shall not He correct? He that teacheth man knowledge, *shall not He know?*

Psalms 94:12 Blessed *is* the man whom Thou chastenest <03256>, O LORD, and teachest him out of Thy law;

Leviticus 22:31 Therefore shall ye keep my commandments, and do them: I am the LORD.

Psalms 118:18 The LORD hath chastened <03256> me sore <03256>: but He hath not given me over unto death.

John 15:6 If a man abide not in Me, he is cast forth as a branch, and is withered; and men gather them, and cast them into the fire, and they are burned.

More Service Notes:

Proverbs 9:7 He that reproveth <03256> a scorner getteth to himself shame: and he that rebuketh a wicked *man getteth* himself a blot.

Proverbs 19:18 Chasten <03256> thy son while there is hope, and let not thy soul spare for his crying.

Proverbs 29:17 Correct <03256> thy son, and he shall give thee rest; yea, he shall give delight unto thy soul.

Proverbs 29:19 A servant will not be corrected <03256> by words: for though he understand he will not answer.

Proverbs 31:1 The words of king Lemuel, the prophecy that his mother taught <03256> him.

Isaiah 8:11 For the LORD spake thus to me with a strong hand, and instructed <03256> me that I should not walk in the way of this people,

saying,

Isaiah 28:26 For his God doth instruct <03256> him to discretion, *and* doth teach him.

Jeremiah 2:19 Thine own wickedness shall correct <03256> thee, and thy backslidings shall reprove thee: know therefore and see that *it is* an evil *thing* and bitter, that thou hast forsaken the LORD thy God, and that My fear *is* not in thee, saith the Lord GOD of hosts.

Jeremiah 6:8 Be thou instructed <03256>, O Jerusalem, lest My soul depart from thee; lest I make thee desolate, a land not inhabited.

Jeremiah 10:24 O LORD, correct <03256> me, but with judgment; not in Thine anger, lest Thou bring me to nothing.

Jeremiah 30:11 For I *am* with thee, saith the LORD, to save thee: though I make a full end of all nations whither I have scattered thee, yet will I not make a full end of thee: but I will correct <03256> thee in measure, and will not leave thee altogether unpunished.

Jeremiah 31:18 I have surely heard Ephraim bemoaning himself *thus*; Thou hast chastised <03256> me, and I was chastised <03256>, as a bullock unaccustomed *to the yoke*: turn Thou me, and I shall be turned; for Thou *art* the LORD my God.

Jeremiah 46:28 Fear thou not, O Jacob My servant, saith the LORD: for I *am* with thee; for I will make a full end of all the nations whither I have driven thee: but I will not make a full end of thee, but correct <03256> thee in measure; yet will I not leave thee wholly unpunished.

Ezekiel 23:48 Thus will I cause lewdness to cease out of the land, that all women may be taught <03256> not to do after your lewdness.

Hosea 7:12 When they shall go, I will spread My net upon them; I will bring them down as the fowls of the heaven; I will chastise <03256> them, as their congregation hath heard.

Hosea 7:15 Though I have bound <03256> *and* strengthened their arms, yet do they imagine mischief against Me.

Hosea 10:10 *It is* in My desire that I should chastise <03256> them; and the people shall be gathered against them, when they shall bind themselves in their two furrows.
