

Overcoming The World - 1 John 4B

- 1 John 4:1 Beloved, believe not every spirit, but try the spirits whether they are of God: because many false prophets are gone out into the world.**
- 1 Kings 22 Summarized of God allowing a lying spirit to deal with Ahab. V22 And the LORD said unto him, Wherewith? And he said, I will go forth, and I will be a lying spirit in the mouth of all his prophets. And He said, Thou shalt persuade him, and prevail also: go forth, and do so.**
- Luke 4 Referred to the temptations of Jesus. V13 And when the devil had ended all the temptation, he departed from Him for a season.**
- Matthew 18:18 Verily I say unto you, Whatsoever ye shall bind on earth shall be bound in heaven: and whatsoever ye shall loose on earth shall be loosed in heaven.**
- 1 John 4:4-6 (AV) & (NKJV)**
- 1 John 4:4 (AV) Ye are of God, little children, and have overcome them: because greater is He that is in you, than he that is in the world.**
- 1 John 4:4 (NKJV) You are of God, little children, and have overcome them, because He Who is in you is greater than he who is in the world.**
- Mark 5:13 And forthwith Jesus gave them leave. And the unclean spirits went out, and entered into the swine: and the herd ran violently down a steep place into the sea, (they were about two thousand;) and were choked in the sea.**
- Mark 5:6 But when he saw Jesus afar off, he ran and worshipped Him,**
- Mark 16:17 And these signs shall follow them that believe; In My Name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues;**
- 1 John 4:5 (AV) They are of the world: therefore speak they of the world, and the world heareth them.**
- 1 John 4:5 (NKJV) They are of the world. Therefore they speak *as* of the world, and the world hears them.**
- 1 John 2:15 Love not the world, neither the things that are in the world. If any man love the world, the love of the Father is not in him.**
- Ephesians 6:12 For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high places.**
- Matthew 16:19 And I will give unto thee the keys of the kingdom of heaven: and whatsoever thou shalt bind on earth shall be bound in heaven: and whatsoever thou shalt loose on earth shall be loosed in heaven.**
- Daniel 2:33 His legs of iron, his feet part of iron and part of clay.**
- 1 Peter 4:4 Wherein they think it strange that ye run not with them to the**

same excess of riot, speaking evil of you:

Romans 12:2 And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what is that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God.

1 John 4:6 (AV) We are of God: he that knoweth God heareth us; he that is not of God heareth not us. Hereby know we the Spirit of Truth, and the spirit of error.

1 John 4:6 (NKJV) We are of God. He who knows God hears us; he who is not of God does not hear us. By this we know the Spirit of Truth and the spirit of error.

John 14:6 Jesus saith unto him, I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by me.

1 John 1:6 If we say that we have fellowship with Him, and walk in darkness, we lie, and do not the Truth:

Luke 10:19 Behold, I give unto you power to tread on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy: and nothing shall by any means hurt you.

Genesis 3 Referred to the Fall of Mankind.

Exodus 5-9 God often said as in Exodus 8:1 And the LORD spake unto Moses, Go unto Pharaoh, and say unto him, Thus saith the LORD, Let My people go, that they may serve Me.

Matthew 16:19 & 18:18 Referred to binding & loosing.

Matthew 12:29 Or else how can one enter into a strong man's house, and spoil his goods, except he first bind the strong man? and then he will spoil his house.

Acts 19 Referred to the false exorcists the 7 sons of Sceva.

Luke 10:17-19 And the seventy returned again with joy, saying, Lord, even the devils are subject unto us through Thy Name. 18 And He said unto them, I beheld Satan as lightning fall from heaven. 19 Behold, I give unto you power (authority) to tread on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy: and nothing shall by any means hurt you.

Mark 16:15-18 And he said unto them, Go ye into all the world, and preach the gospel to every creature. 16 He that believeth and is baptized shall be

saved; but he that believeth not shall be damned. 17 And these signs shall follow them that believe; In My Name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues; 18 They shall take up serpents; and if they drink any deadly thing, it shall not hurt them; they shall lay hands on the sick, and they shall recover.

Proverbs 22:22,23 Rob not the poor, because he is poor: neither oppress the afflicted in the gate: 23 For the LORD will plead their cause, and spoil the soul of those that spoiled them.

Luke 24:45 Then opened He their understanding, that they might understand the Scriptures,

2 Kings 2:9 And it came to pass, when they were gone over, that Elijah said unto Elisha, Ask what I shall do for thee, before I be taken away from thee. And Elisha said, I pray thee, let a double portion of thy Spirit be upon me.

2 Kings 6 Summarized of Elisha & temp blindness of Assyrians.

2 Kings 1 Referred to Elijah calling down fire from heaven.

Matthew 5:44 But I say unto you, Love your enemies, bless them that curse you, do good to them that hate you, and pray for them which despitefully use you, and persecute you;

Romans 12:20 Therefore if thine enemy hunger, feed him; if he thirst, give him drink: for in so doing thou shalt heap coals of fire on his head.

Luke 9:55 But He turned, and rebuked them, and said, Ye know not what

manner of spirit ye are of.

Revelation 11 Referred to the 2 witnesses V5 And if any man will hurt them, fire proceedeth out of their mouth, and devoureth their enemies: and if any man will hurt them, he must in this manner be killed.

Luke 11:22 But when a stronger than he shall come upon him, and overcome <3528> him, he taketh from him all his armour wherein he trusted, and divideth his spoils.

John 16:33 These things I have spoken unto you, that in Me ye might have peace. In the world ye shall have tribulation: but be of good cheer; I have overcome <3528> the world.

Ephesians 1:13 In Whom ye also trusted, after that ye heard the Word of Truth, the gospel of your salvation: in Whom also after that ye believed, ye were sealed with that Holy Spirit of promise,

Ezekiel 18:4 Behold, all souls are mine; as the soul of the father, so also the soul of the son is mine: the soul that sinneth, it shall die.

Hebrews 7:25 Wherefore He is able also to save them to the uttermost that come unto God by Him, seeing He ever liveth to make intercession for them.

John 16:33 These things I have spoken unto you, that in Me ye might have peace. In the world ye shall have tribulation: but be of good cheer; I have overcome the world.

1 Corinthians 2:8 Which none of the princes of this world knew: for had they known it, they would not have crucified the Lord of Glory.

Romans 3:4 God forbid: yea, let God be true, but every man a liar; as it is written, That thou mightest be justified in thy sayings, and mightest overcome <3528> when thou art judged.

Romans 12:21 Be <3528> not overcome <3528> of evil, but overcome <3528> evil with good.

Romans 12:2 And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what is that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God.

1 John 2:13 I write unto you, fathers, because ye have known him *that is* from the beginning. I write unto you, young men, because ye have overcome <3528> the wicked one. I write unto you, little children, because ye have known the Father.

John 4 Referred to Jesus ministering to the woman at the well.

1 John 2:14 I have written unto you, fathers, because ye have known Him *that is* from the beginning. I have written unto you, young men, because ye are strong, and the Word of God abideth in you, and ye have overcome <3528> the wicked one.

Luke 4 Referred to the temptations of Jesus. V4 And Jesus answered him,

saying, It is written, That man shall not live by bread alone, but by every word of God. & V12 And Jesus answering said unto him, It is said, Thou shalt not tempt the Lord thy God.

1 John 4:4 Ye are of God, little children, and have overcome <3528> them: because greater is He that is in you, than he that is in the world.

1 John 5:4 For whatsoever is born of God overcometh <3528> the world: and this is the victory that overcometh <3528> the world, *even* our faith.

1 Corinthians 16:15 I beseech you, brethren, (ye know the house of Stephanas, that it is the firstfruits of Achaia, and that they have addicted themselves to the ministry of the saints,)

1 John 5:5 Who is he that overcometh <3528> the world, but he that believeth that Jesus is the Son of God?

Matthew 7:14 Because strait is the gate, and narrow is the way, which leadeth unto life, and few there be that find it.

Genesis 2:17 But of the tree of the knowledge of good and evil, thou shalt not eat of it: for in the day that thou eatest thereof thou shalt surely die.

Genesis 3:3 (Eve) But of the fruit of the tree which is in the midst of the garden, God hath said, Ye shall not eat of it, neither shall ye touch it, lest ye die.

2 Corinthians 4:4 In whom the god of this world hath blinded the minds of them which believe not, lest the light of the glorious gospel of Christ, Who is the Image of God, should shine unto them.

Revelation 2:7 He that hath an ear, let him hear what the Spirit saith unto the churches; To him that overcometh <3528> will I give to eat of the tree of life, which is in the midst of the paradise of God.

Revelation 2:11 He that hath an ear, let him hear what the Spirit saith unto the churches; He that overcometh <3528> shall not be hurt of the second death.

Revelation 2:17 He that hath an ear, let him hear what the Spirit saith unto the churches; To him that overcometh <3528> will I give to eat of the hidden manna, and will give him a white stone, and in the stone a new name written, which no man knoweth saving he that receiveth *it*.

Revelation 2:26 And he that overcometh <3528>, and keepeth My works unto the end, to him will I give power over the nations:

Revelation 3:5 He that overcometh <3528>, the same shall be clothed in white raiment; and I will not blot out his name out of the book of life, but I will confess his name before My Father, and before His angels.

Revelation 3:12 Him that overcometh <3528> will I make a pillar in the temple of My God, and he shall go no more out: and I will write upon him the Name of My God, and the name of the city of My God, *which is new Jerusalem*, which cometh down out of heaven from My God: and *I will*

write upon him My new Name.

Revelation 3:21 To him that overcometh <3528> will I grant to sit with Me in My throne, even as I also overcame <3528>, and am set down with My Father in His throne.

Luke 10:19 Behold, I give unto you power to tread on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy: and nothing shall by any means hurt you.

Luke 19:13 And he called his ten servants, and delivered them ten pounds, and said unto them, Occupy till I come.

Matthew 18:18 Verily I say unto you, Whatsoever ye shall bind on earth shall be bound in heaven: and whatsoever ye shall loose on earth shall be loosed in heaven.

Romans 14:12 So then every one of us shall give account of himself to God.

2 Corinthians 10:3-5 3 For though we walk in the flesh, we do not war after the flesh: 4 (For the weapons of our warfare are not carnal, but mighty through God to the pulling down of strong holds;) 5 Casting down imaginations, and every high thing that exalteth itself against the knowledge of God, and bringing into captivity every thought to the obedience of Christ;

1 Samuel 17 Referred to David overcoming Goliath.

More Service Notes:

Revelation 5:5 And one of the elders saith unto me, Weep not: behold, the Lion of the tribe of Juda, the Root of David, hath prevailed <3528> to open the book, and to loose the seven seals thereof.

Revelation 6:2 And I saw, and behold a white horse: and He that sat on him had a bow; and a crown was given unto Him: and He went forth conquering <3528>, and to conquer <3528>.

Revelation 11:7 And when they shall have finished their testimony, the beast that ascendeth out of the bottomless pit shall make war against them, and shall overcome <3528> them, and kill them.

Revelation 12:11 And they overcame <3528> him by the Blood of the Lamb, and by the word of their testimony; and they loved not their lives unto the death.

Revelation 13:7 And it was given unto him to make war with the saints, and to overcome <3528> them: and power was given him over all kindreds, and tongues, and nations.

Revelation 15:2 And I saw as it were a sea of glass mingled with fire: and them that had gotten the victory <3528> over the beast, and over his image, and over his mark, *and* over the number of his name, stand on the sea of glass, having the harps of God.

Revelation 21:7 He that overcometh <3528> shall inherit all things; and I will be His God, and He shall be My son.

Luke 10:20-24 Notwithstanding in this rejoice not, that the spirits are subject unto you; but rather rejoice, because your names are written in heaven. 21 In that hour Jesus rejoiced in spirit, and said, I thank thee, O Father, Lord of heaven and earth, that Thou hast hid these things from the wise and prudent, and hast revealed them unto babes: even so, Father; for so it seemed good in Thy sight. 22 All things are delivered to Me of My Father: and no man knoweth Who the Son is, but the Father; and Who the Father is, but the Son, and *he* to whom the Son will reveal *Him*. 23 And He turned Him unto *His* disciples, and said privately, Blessed *are* the eyes which see the things that ye see: 24 For I tell you, that many prophets and kings have desired to see those things which ye see, and have not seen *them*; and to hear those things which ye hear, and have not heard *them*.
